### » RECAP

**HICKORY, N.C. –** For the second time in his career, Kyle Dugger returned two punts for touchdowns in the same game as Lenoir-Rhyne throttled UVA Wise 63-6 on Homecoming. Dugger had returns of 68 and 67 yards as LR put up 63 points on Homecoming for the second straight season.

**STATS OF THE GAME:**

- No player in LR history ever had multiple punt returns for touchdowns in the same game until Dugger did it against Newberry last season. He did it again today with two returns in the first 6:29 of the contest. Dugger's first run back spanned 68 yards as he broke a handful of tackles to put LR ahead 14-0. Just over three minutes later, Dugger took one back 67 yards as LR put 28 points on the board in the first seven minutes of the game.
- Dareke Young and Jace Jordan each found the end zone twice in the contest, once on the ground and once through the air. Jordan ran 43 yards on the Bears first drive to put LR on the board and Young caught a 38-yarder for the third TD of the first quarter. They each would score again in the second quarter.

- Tre Luttrell and Joshua Stewart each recorded their first career touchdowns in the blowout.
- Grayson Willingham finished 5-for-7 for 91 yards and a pair of TD strikes in his two quarters of action. Willingham's 10 TDs this season gives him 37 for his career, just two shy of tying the all-time record which has stood since 1989.
- Three different players registered a sack on defense. Quentin Hayes, who finished with a team-high seven tackles, was joined by Myles Jackson and Jaquan Artis in the sack column. Clayton Horn and Javoris Smith added interceptions with Horn coming two yards shy of adding a pick-six.
- Lendon Redwine made his first career start for UVA Wise and went 15-for-29 for only 71 yards. The stingy LR defense allowed just nine first downs on the day and 165 total yards.

#### BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:

- The Bears have recorded multiple interceptions in four of their five games on the season. They have also recorded at least three sacks in a game four times.
- No team has rushed for over 100 yards against the stout LR defense this season. This is the second opponent that LR held under 200 yards.
- This is the 68th all-time homecoming game with LR now owning a 41-27 record. This also marks the first game against new SAC opponent UVA Wise who becomes the 99th different program LR has played in its 100 year history.



## » LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

### SECOND MEETING

- » Lenoir-Rhyne will meet UVA Wise, who became a full member of the South Atlantic Conference in 2019, for just the second time in series history on Saturday.
- » The first matchup was memorable back on Homecoming 2019. The Bears won 63-7 that day and future NFL star Kyle Dugger returned two punts for touchdowns in the first 6:29 of the game.

### VIRGINIA ON OUR MIND

- » This will be LR's second trip to the state of Virginia in the first four games of the 2021 season.
- » LR opened the campaign with a 48-7 thrashing of Virginia St. on September 4.
- » This will be the first-ever trip to UVA Wise for the Bears.
- » This is just the fifth trip to the state of Virginia in the NCAA Era for the Bears. LR is 3-1 with the last loss coming at VMI on Sept. 5, 1998

### ABOUT THE CAVS

- » UVA Wise is coming off a 33-7 thrashing of Carson-Newman on Saturday.
- » RB Jaevon Gillespie was named SAC Offensive Player of the Week as he ran for 166 yards and four touchdowns against the Eagles and broke an 80-yard TD run in the third quarter.
- » UVA Wise has forced 10 turnovers in the first four games of the season and the Cavs rank fifth in the nation with 4.5 sacks per game.
- » This is the second of a three-game homestand for the Cavs. UVA was is an even

9-9 at home since the 2017 season.

### HOMECOMING PART II

- » The first matchup in series history was a Homecoming game for the Bears and Saturday will serve as Homecoming for UVA Wise.

### SCORING MARGIN

- » So far this season, UVA Wise has either won or lost by a wide margin in the first four weeks of the season. UVA Wise's wins have come by scores of 54-0 and 33-7 and their two losses have come by counts of 45-14 and 44-9.

### RANKED HISTORY

- » Lenoir-Rhyne enters Saturday's contest with a 42-8 all-time mark as a ranked team. The No. 16 Bears also own an 18-5 all-time mark as a ranked team in road games.
- » The Bears were No. 8 in the nation when these two teams met in 2019.
- » LR has been ranked in 23 straight AFCA polls, just three weeks shy of tying the program record for consecutive weeks in the top 25.

### 1,016

- » Saturday will mark the 1,016th game in the history of Lenoir-Rhyne Football. The 1,000th game came at Tusculum in 2019.
- » The Bears are in search of the 523rd all-time victory in program history and the 139th SAC win.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

#### DEWEE

» With 122 yards rushing against Mars Hill, Dwayne McGee has topped 100 yards in five of his first seven career games. Going into last Saturday's game, Mars Hill led the nation in rush defense and was allowing negative rush yards per game before McGee's 122-yard effort in only 18 carries.

» The freshman from Kissimmee, Fla. ranks 6th in the nation in rushing yards per game at 141.3 and 19th in country with 424 rushing yards through only 3 games. McGee is 3rd in the country in rushing yards among players that have only played 3 games this season.

#### DAREKE THE FREAK

» With 160 yards receiving and a career-high three touchdowns against Mars Hill, Dareke Young became one of seven players in the 102-year history of LR football to have three receiving touchdowns in a game.

» Young crossed the 1,000 yard career receiving mark on Saturday with his big day. Young came into the Mars Hill game with 946 career receiving yards and went over 1,000 in the first half.

#### TARGETS APLENTY

» Including Young, 11 different Bears have caught a pass through three games. Young leads the team with 17 receptions, and Deondre Lester is one behind with 16 for 207 yards. Ryan Carter has eight catches, Kelin Parsons has seven, and Tre Luttrell and Cody Osburn both have six.

#### SECOND QUARTER DOMINANCE

» In three games this year, the Bears have scored an even 100 points. 45 out of those 100 points have been scored in the second quarter. LR is outscoring opponents 45-14 in the 2nd quarter this season.

#### RED ZONE EFFICIENCY

» In 10 trips to the red zone this season, the Bears have scored points in all but one trip, including touchdowns on eight trips. LR has four passing touchdowns and four rushing touchdowns from the red zone so far this year.

#### WILLINGHAM MOVIN' UP

» With his 745 yards passing so far this season, Willingham is in second place in program history with 6,159 career passing yards. He sits just 425 yards shy of Brian Bryson's 6,583 all-time passing yard mark which has stood since 1987.

» Willingham is third in program history with 394 career completions and needs just 39 to pass Meunier for second place.

» The senior QB is already the program leader in career touchdown passes and is fourth in history in career completion percentage.

#### G OVER 200 (AGAIN)

» After throwing for 287 yards against Mars Hill, Grayson Willingham topped 200 yards passing for the 13th time in his career. The only player in LR history to have more 200 yard passing games than Willingham is Brett Meunier who had 15.

## » LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

### SACK STREAK REACHES 46

» The Bears continue to wreak havoc on opposing QBs as they ran the program record of consecutive games with a sack to 46 on Saturday.

### LOUBA CAN'T BE STOPPED

» Senior DT Dan Louba recorded four sacks against Mars Hill on Saturday, tying a program record. Three of Louba's four sacks came in the first half as he earned SAC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

» The only other time an LR player recorded four sacks in a game came back in 2001 when Brad Lindamood accomplished the feat.

» With that performance, Louba moves up to fourth in program history with 23 career sacks. Louba sits six behind former teammate and 2019 National Defensive Player of the Year Jaquan Artis who had 29.

### BEND DON'T BREAK

» The LR defense allowed 451 yards of total offense against Mars Hill but allowed the Lions to reach the end zone just twice. Each of the Lions two touchdowns came in the second half as the Bears shutout MHU for the first 43:32 of the game.

» Mars Hill slung it 65 times in the contest with Jimmy Urzua completing 32 of those passes for 394 yards. However, despite the 65 attempts, Urzua didn't throw a touchdown pass on the night. He did connect on a pair of two point conversions.

### BRICK CURTAIN

» After allowing the first 100 yard rusher since the middle of the 2019 season, the Lenoir-Rhyne rush D was strong on Saturday. Mars Hill gained just 60 yards on 30 attempts.

### CAREER-BEST PERFORMANCE

» Senior Eric Jackson tied a career-high with 12 tackles against Mars Hill. Jackson last recorded 12 tackles in a game back in 2019 against Wingate on Nov. 2.

» Jackson added a pair of pass breakups and eight of his tackles were of the solo variety.

### MAYE DAY

» RS-Freshman Jon Ross Maye had a tremendous performance against Mars Hill on Saturday. Maye had 11 tackles and a sack to go with three pass breakups.

» The double-digit tackle total was the third time in just in just seven career games that Maye had 10+ tackles. In his first career game, Maye recorded 14 tackles at Newberry en route to SAC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

### D PUTS POINTS ON THE BOARD

» Since 2010, Lenoir-Rhyne has a 15-1 record when the defense scores a touchdown in a game.

» The last defensive TD in a game came on a Preston Joseph fumble recovery against Wingate in a 44-21 blowout win on April 2, 2021.

## » SACK STREAK

The Lenoir-Rhyne defense has produced at least one sack in 46 straight games and multiple sacks in 29 of their last 32 games.

In the 46-game streak, Lenoir-Rhyne has recorded 140 sacks.

### » LENOIR-RHYNE SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

#### RECORD-BREAKING ALLBAUGH

- » Lenoir-Rhyne senior kicker Chase Allbaugh became the all-time leader in Lenoir-Rhyne history in points by a kicker against Newberry in the spring. Allbaugh entered the game tied with Colin Corpe with 264 career points but his extra point in the fourth quarter put him in sole possession of the all-time record.
- » Allbaugh already owns an NCAA Division II record for most extra points made in a season without a miss. Allbaugh connected on all 76 of his extra points in 2019.
- » In total, Allbaugh has connected on 124 straight extra points which is just four shy of the Division II record of 127 held by Jack Ruggieri from Kutztown.
- » Allbaugh hasn't missed an extra point since November 3, 2018 against Carson-Newman. He made all nine of his extra points the last time LR played UVA Wise in 2019.

#### SPECIAL TEAMS TATERS

- » Since 2010, the Bears have scored a special teams touchdown in 20 different games, compiling a 16-4 record in those games.
- » Former LR safety and NFL draft pick Kyle Dugger had two separate games where he had two punt return TDs in the same game. One of those games was against UVA Wise in 2019. In that game, Dugger's two punt return touchdowns were within four minutes of each other in the first quarter en route to a 63-6 Homecoming win for the Bears. Dugger is now one of the starting safeties for the New England Patriots.

#### BE LIKE MIKE

- » Michael Owen is an all-conference performer as a punter, giving the Bears a big time advantage in special teams.
- » Last week, Owen won the team special teams player of the week after averaging 45 yards per punt and only allowing one punt to be returned against Mars Hill.

#### PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES

- » In a game for the ages in 2019, Preston Joseph blocked two Carson-Newman punts in an NCAA Playoff game with one being returned for a touchdown by teammate Tre Luttrell.
- » Joseph is now a starting linebacker for the Bears and may see his role diminish on special teams.

#### RETURN STREAK

- » Lenoir-Rhyne has not allowed an opposing punt returner to take one back for a touchdown since Isaiah Johnson of North Greenville returned one 79 yards back on Sept. 19, 2009.
