THE BIG ONE

» AS WAS ANTICIPATED IN THE PRESEASON, LENOIR-RHYNE AND NEWBERRY WILL MEET ON SATURDAY IN MORETZ STADIUM AS THE TOP TWO TEAMS IN THE SAC. THIS IS THE 89TH ALL-TIME MEETING BETWEEN THE TWO SAC RIVALS, AND THEY WILL PLAY FOR THE BISHOPS TROPHY FOR THE 36TH TIME.

» NEWBERRY IS THE REIGNING LEAGUE CHAMP AND WAS PICKED FIRST IN THE SAC PRESEASON POLL, AND LENOIR-RHYNE IS THE SAC'S ONLY UNDEFEATED TEAM IN CONFERENCE PLAY. THE BEARS WERE PICKED SECOND IN THE PRESEASON POLL, AND HAVE ROLLED THROUGH CONFERENCE PLAY SO FAR, WINNING EACH LEAGUE GAME BY AT LEAST 21 POINTS.

» BOTH OF THESE TEAMS WERE NCAA PLAYOFF TEAMS A YEAR AGO, WITH NEWBERRY UPSETTING WEST FLORIDA IN OVERTIME IN THE FIRST ROUND OF THE PLAYOFFS BEFORE FALLING TO BOWIE STATE A WEEK LATER. BOWIE STATE ALSO KNOCKED LENOIR-RHYNE OUT OF LAST YEAR'S PLAYOFFS.

» NEWBERRY IS THE SECOND RANKED TEAM LENOIR-RHYNE HAS PLAYED THIS YEAR. THE WOLVES ARE RANKED NO. 16 IN THIS WEEK'S AFCA POLL, AND LR IS NO. 12. THE BEARS FELL TO NO. 1 FERRIS STATE BACK IN SEPTEMBER FOR THEIR ONLY LOSS OF THE SEASON.

» NEWBERRY HAS ONE CONFERENCE LOSS ON THE SEASON, 24-14 IN AN UPSET BY CARSON-NEWMAN. SINCE THAT GAME, THE WOLVES HAVE BEATEN BARTON AND CATAWBA TO GET BACK ON TRACK.

THE BISHOPS' TROPHY

» THE TWO SCHOOLS HAVE BEEN PLAYING FOR THE BISHOPS TROPHY SINCE 1987. THE BEARS HOLD A 19-16 EDGE IN THE TROPHY SERIES, AND HAVE WON THREE OUT OF THE LAST FOUR. OVERALL, LENOIR-RHYNE LEADS THE ALL-TIME SERIES 47-34-7.

» HOWEVER, SINCE 2015, NEWBERRY HOLDS A 4-3 EDGE IN THE SERIES. THE WOLVES ARE THE ONLY TEAM THE BEARS HAVE A LOSING RECORD TO IN THAT TIME FRAME.

WIN NUMBER 100

» WITH SATURDAY'S 34-0 WIN OVER BARTON, LENOIR-RHYNE WON ITS 100TH GAME SINCE 2010.

» LR'S RECORD SINCE 2010 IS 100-41, THE SECOND-MOST WINS IN THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA BEHIND APP STATE, WHO HAS 102 WINS NOT COUNTING THE COVID SEASON.

» IN 22 GAMES AS HEAD COACH OF LENOIR-RHYNE, MIKE JACOBS IS 17-5.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST THREE NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THIS SEASON.

SAC DOMINANCE

- » IN THE LAST FOUR FULL SEASONS, NEWBERRY IS ONE OF ONLY TWO SAC OPPONENTS TO BEAT LENOIR-RHYNE.
- » LR'S 10-GAME WINNING STREAK IN CONFERENCE GAMES IS THE THIRD-LONGEST IN THE NATION RIGHT NOW. NEW HAVEN HAS A 17-GAME WINNING STREAK, AND SHEPHERD HAS A 14-GAME WINNING STREAK.

HOMECOMING IN HICKORY

- » SATURDAY'S GAME MARKS THE 2022 HOMECOMING GAME FOR LENOIR-RHYNE. IT'S ALSO HALL-OF-FAME WEEKEND, AND TWO FORMER LR FOOTBALL PLAYERS - JAMEIL SURRATT AND CHANDLER REARDEN - WILL BE INDUCTED INTO THE LR ATHLETICS HALL-OF-FAME.
- » THE BEARS HAVE WON THREE STRAIGHT HOMECOMING GAMES DATING BACK TO 2017, BUT THAT 2017 HOMECOMING GAME WAS A 34-7 NEWBERRY WIN AT MORETZ

RANKED HISTORY

- » THIS IS THE FIRST MEETING BETWEEN THE TWO LONGTIME RIVALS WHERE BOTH TEAMS HAVE BEEN RANKED.
- » LR IS 7-5 WHEN THEY ARE RANKED AND THEIR OPPONENT IS ALSO RANKED. THE BEARS HOLD A 13-33 OVERALL RECORD WHEN PLAYING AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS.
- » LR IS 47-10 AS A RANKED TEAM DATING BACK TO THE START OF THE AFCA POLL IN 2000.
- » THIS IS THE 67TH WEEK LENOIR-RHYNE HAS BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED. THE BEARS WERE NEVER RANKED FROM 2000 TO 2012, BUT HAVE BEEN RANKED IN EIGHT OF THE LAST 10 SEASONS.

COMPLIMENTARY FOOTBALL

- » LENOIR-RHYNE IS THE ONLY TEAM IN THE SAC THAT IS RANKED IN THE TOP-25 IN BOTH SCORING OFFENSE (19TH, 35.1 PPG), AND SCORING DEFENSE (25TH, 17.1 PPG).
- » NEWBERRY IS RANKED 46TH NATIONALLY IN SCORING OFFENSE (30.7 PPG), AND 43RD IN SCORING DEFENSE (19.6 PPG)

REVENGE TIME

- » NEWBERRY NIPPED LR 28-21 AT NEWBERRY LAST YEAR IN AN UPSET, AND THAT GAME IN MID-SEPTEMBER ENDED UP DECIDING THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP.
- » DUAL-THREAT NEWBERRY QB DRE HARRIS WENT 16-FOR-20 FOR 260 YARDS AND A TOUCHDOWN THROUGH THE AIR, AND STAR RUNNING BACK MARIO ANDERSON RAN FOR 124 YARDS AND TWO TOUCHDOWNS FOR THE WOLVES.
- » DWAYNE MCGEE HAD 113 YARDS RUSHING AND A TOUCHDOWN FOR THE BEARS, WHO LOST DESPITE NOT TURNING THE BALL OVER IN THE GAME.

LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

» DYNAMIC DUO

» RUNNING BACKS DWAYNE MCGEE AND ZYHEIR DILLARD EACH TOPPED 100 YARDS RUSHING AGAINST LIMESTONE AND BARTON, THE FIRST RB DUO TO EACH TOP 100 YARDS IN CONSECUTIVE GAMES SINCE JARROD SPEARS AND CHRIS ROBINSON EACH PRODUCED BACK-TO-BACK 100 YARD GAMES AGAINST MARS HILL AND CARSON-NEWMAN IN NOVEMBER 2014.

» DILLARD HAS EMERGED AS OF LATE AS HIS LAST TWO CONTESTS HAVE SEEN THE SOPHOMORE RUSH FOR 225 YARDS ON 22 CARRIES AND PRODUCE TWO TOTAL TOUCHDOWNS. DILLARD IS AVERAGING 10.2 YARDS PER CARRY.

» MCGEE TOPPED THE 100 YARD MARK FOR THE FOURTH TIME THIS SEASON AND THE 16TH TIME IN HIS CAREER.

» THE BEARS OWN A RECORD OF 64-20 IN GAMES WHERE THEY HAVE A 100-YARD RUSHER SINCE THE 2010 SEASON. THEY ARE ALSO 97-20 IN THAT TIME FRAME WHEN OUTFRUSHING THEIR OPPONENTS.

PROTECTING THE ROCK

» SEAN WHITE AND THE LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE HAVE GONE BACK-TO-BACK GAMES WITHOUT COMMITTING A SINGLE TURNOVER.

» LR IMPROVED THEIR RECORD TO 20-2 SINCE 2010 IN GAMES WHERE THEY HAVEN'T TURNED THE BALL OVER ONCE WHICH HAS ONLY BEEN DONE 22 TIMES IN THE PAST 141 GAMES.

CLEAN POCKET

» SEAN WHITE HASN'T BEEN SACKED IN TWO CONSECUTIVE GAMES AND HAS NEARLY GONE THREE STRAIGHT WITHOUT BEING SACKED.

» THE LAST OPPOSING DEFENSE TO BRING WHITE DOWN WAS CARSON-NEWMAN ON THE BEARS FIRST DRIVE OF THE GAME.

» SINCE THAT MOMENT, WHITE HAS GONE 98 STRAIGHT DROPBACKS WITHOUT BEING SACKED.

PARSONS TOPS A HUNDO

» WR KELIN PARSONS BECAME THE FIRST BEAR RECEIVER THIS SEASON TO TOP 100 YARDS RECEIVING LAST WEEK AT BARTON.

» PARSONS FINISHED THE CONTEST WITH SIX GRABS FOR 117 YARDS.

» IT WAS THE THIRD 100-YARD RECEIVING GAME IN HIS CAREER.

» PARSONS IS A NAME THAT SHOULD BE FAMILIAR WITH NEWBERRY AS HE HAULED IN THE GAME-WINNING TOUCHDOWN PASS IN THE 2020-21 COVID SEASON-OPENER AT NEWBERRY. THE 8-YARD CONNECTION FROM WHITE TO PARSONS GAVE THE BEARS A 27-20 LEAD IN DOUBLE OVERTIME WHICH THE DEFENSE HELD UP ON NEWBERRY'S ENSUING POSSESSION.

STREAK BUSTERS

» NEWBERRY ENDED LENOIR-RHYNE'S 18-GAME REGULAR SEASON SAC WINNING STREAK LAST SEPTEMBER 18 WHEN THEY DEFEATED LR 28-21 AT SETZLER FIELD.

» IN THAT GAME, THE BEARS THREW FOR 205 YARDS BUT CAME OUT ON THE LOSING END.

MCGEE AGAINST THE WOLVES

» IN HIS FIRST TWO CAREER GAMES AGAINST NEWBERRY, MCGEE HAS RUSHED FOR AT LEAST 100 YARDS BOTH TIMES.

» THE FIRST MATCHUP WAS MCGEE'S COLLEGIATE DEBUT AND HE WENT OFF FOR 160 YARDS ON 30 CARRIES BUT FAILED TO FIND THE END ZONE.

» A SEASON AGO, MCGEE SCORED ONE RUSHING TOUCHDOWN AND FINISHED THE GAME WITH 113 YARDS ON 25 CARRIES.

» ANOTHER 100 YARD GAME ON SATURDAY WOULD GIVE MCGEE HIS 17TH 100-YARD CONTEST WHICH WOULD BE THE SECOND-MOST IN PROGRAM HISTORY BEHIND LEONARD DAVIS.

LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

BIG OLE GOOSE EGG

- » LENOIR-RHYNE'S DEFENSE PITCHED A SHUTOUT FOR THE FIRST TIME THIS YEAR IN LAST WEEK'S 34-0 WIN OVER BARTON.
- » LR'S DEFENSE ALLOWED JUST 141 YARDS OF TOTAL OFFENSE, THE EIGHTH-LOWEST MARK IN THE NCAA ERA (1993-PRESENT).
- » BARTON'S 2.8 YARDS PER PASS ATTEMPT IS THE FIFTH-LOWEST ALLOWED BY THE BEAR DEFENSE IN THE NCAA ERA.
- » THIS IS THE SECOND STRAIGHT SEASON LR HAS SHUT OUT AN OPPONENT. THE BEARS ALSO BLANKED CARSON-NEWMAN 59-0 LAST SEASON. PRIOR TO THAT, THE LAST TIME THE BEARS BLANKED AN OPPONENT WAS IN 2015 AGAINST BREVARD.

SACK STREAK BROKEN

- » DESPITE DOMINATING THE ENTIRE GAME ON DEFENSE, FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE NOVEMBER 2016, LENOIR-RHYNE'S DEFENSE FAILED TO RECORD A SACK.
- » THE BEARS HAD RECORDED A SACK IN 60 STRAIGHT GAMES, BY FAR THE LONGEST STREAK IN PROGRAM HISTORY SINCE SACKS BECAME AN OFFICIAL STAT.
- » 39 DIFFERENT PLAYERS CONTRIBUTED TO THE STREAK, LED BY JAQUAN ARTIS WITH 29 AND DAN LOUBA WITH 25.5. RONDARIUS PORTER RECORDED THE LAST SACK OF THE STREAK. FIVE OF THE 60 GAMES IN THE STREAK CAME AGAINST NEWBERRY.

NEW LEADER

- » DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR JAHMAL BROWN LEFT FOR YOUNGSTOWN STATE FOLLOWING THE 2021 SEASON, LEAVING LR WITH A NEW DEFENSIVE LEADER.
- » SHAWN CHAFFEE WILL STEP UP AND AARON FOSTER WILL SERVE AS THE CO-DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR. CHAFFEE WAS THE DEFENSIVE LINE COACH SINCE HE CAME TO LR AND FOSTER WORKS WITH THE DEFENSIVE BACKS.

STOP THE RUN
