LAST TWO UNBEATENS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE AND LIMESTONE ENTER AS THE LONE UNDEFEATED TEAMS IN SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE PLAY WITH 3-0 RECORDS.
- » THE SAINTS HAVE DISPATCHED OF CARSON-NEWMAN, UVA WISE AND MARS HILL IN THEIR THREE LEAGUE GAMES WHILE THE BEARS HAVE BEATEN THE EAGLES, CAVALIERS AND ERSKINE.
- » LIMESTONE HAS NEVER WON ITS FIRST THREE LEAGUE GAMES IN SAC HISTORY AND ARE JUST ONE WIN AWAY FROM TYING THE PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST WINS A SINGLE SEASON WITH FIVE.
- » LIMESTONE HAS YET TO FINISH ABOVE FOURTH PLACE IN THE LEAGUE STANDINGS AS THEY DID IN 2017 WITH A 3-4 MARK IN SAC PLAY.

TURNAROUND

- » LIMESTONE IS WELL ON ITS WAY TO BEING ONE OF THE BIGGEST TURNAROUND STORIES OF THE 2022 SEASON.
- » MIKE FURREY INHERITED A TEAM THAT WENT WINLESS IN 2021 AND HAS THEM AS ONE OF THE TOP TEAMS IN THE LEAGUE.
- » LIMESTONE IS ALSO RECEIVING VOTES IN THE AFCA NATIONAL POLL. THE SAINTS HAVE NEVER BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED IN PROGRAM HISTORY.
- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAD ITS OWN TURNAROUND STORY IN 2018 AS THE BEARS OWNED THE TITLE AS BIGGEST TURNAROUND PROGRAM THAT SEASON. LR WENT 3-8 IN 2017 AND THEN BOUNCED BACK WITH A 12-2 SEASON. INCREASING THEIR WIN TOTAL BY NINE.

ROAD WARRIORS

- » THE SAINTS HAVE ACCOMPLISHED ALL THESE WINS DESPITE ONLY BEING HOME FOR ONE GAME THIS SEASON. THE SAINTS OPENED WITH THREE CONSECUTIVE ROAD GAMES BEFORE HOSTING UVA WISE, FOLLOWING THAT WIN, THE SAINTS TRAVELED TO MARS HILL AND NOW LR.
- » THE SAINTS BEGAN PLAYING ON CAMPUS FOR THE FIRST TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY THIS SEASON AND THE UVA WISE GAME WAS THE FIRST-EVER FOOTBALL GAME HOSTED ON SAINTS FIELD, NORMALLY THE HOME TO LIMESTONE LACROSSE.
- » LIMESTONE IS THIRD IN ALL OF DIVISION II WITH THREE ROAD VICTORIES. LU TRAILS ONLY DELTA STATE AND WINGATE WHO EACH ARE 4-0 IN ROAD GAMES THIS SEASON.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST THREE NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THIS SEASON.

RANKED SUCCESS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE ENTERS THE WEEKEND RANKED NO. 14 IN THE MOST RECENT AFCA NATIONAL POLL. THE BEARS MOVED UP FIVE SPOTS.
- » LR IS 45-10 AS A NATIONALLY RANKED TEAM, DATING BACK TO THE START OF THE AFCA POLL IN 2000.
- » THE BEARS ARE 25-3 AS A RANKED TEAM PLAYING AT MORETZ STADIUM. THE LAST LOSS AT HOME AS A RANKED TEAM CAME EARLIER IN THE SEASON AGAINST NO. 1 FERRIS ST.
- » THIS IS THE 65TH WEEK THAT LENOIR-RHYNE HAS BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED. THE BEARS WERE NEVER RANKED FROM 2000-12 BUT HAVE BEEN RANKED IN EIGHT OF THE PAST 10 SEASONS.

HEAD-TO-HEAD

» THE BEARS OWN THE HEAD-TO-HEAD MATCHUP WITH LIMESTONE BY A COUNT OF 5-1. THE LONE WIN FOR

- LIMESTONE IN THE MATCHUP WAS IN 2016 WHEN THEY DEFEATED THE BEARS 31-13.
- » THAT MATCHUP WAS BEFORE THE SAINTS WERE A FULL-Time member of the SAC so the Bears are a perfect 4-0 in conference games.

WIN NUMBER 15

- » MIKE JACOBS OWNS A 15-5 OVERALL RECORD IN HIS TIME AS LR HEAD COACH.
- » JACOBS GARNERED HIS 15TH WIN IN HIS 20TH GAME AS A HEAD COACH.
- » IN LR HISTORY, ONLY DREW CRONIC, IAN SHIELDS, MIKE HOUSTON AND HANLEY PAINTER HAVE WON 15 OF THEIR FIRST 20 GAMES AT LR.
- » JACOBS BECAME THE FIFTH COACH TO ACCOMPLISH THAT FEAT OUT OF THE 23 HEAD COACHES IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

SAC MILESTONE

- » ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 24 AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN, THE LR FOOTBALL TEAM PLAYED THE 325TH SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE GAME IN PROGRAM HISTORY.
- » DESPITE RECENT SUCCESS, LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS AN ALL-TIME MARK OF 146-180 IN LEAGUE GAMES.
- » THE SAC DATES BACK TO 1975 WHEN IT WAS OFFICIALLY THE "SAC 8". THE BEARS WENT 6-0 THAT SEASON AND HAVE SIX UNDEFEATED SEASONS IN SAC HISTORY.
- » FIVE OF THOSE YEARS HAVE TAKEN PLACE SINCE 2013.
- » IN THE FIRST 47 SEASONS OF THE SAC, LR HAS CAPTURED EIGHT LEAGUE CROWNS AND HAVE FINISHED IN SECOND PLACE TWO TIMES, INCLUDING THEIR SECOND PLACE FINISH A SEASON AGO.

LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

DEEWEE SETTING HIS SIGHTS ON THE TOP 10

- » IN JUST HIS SECOND FULL SEASON AT LENOIR-RHYNE, DWAYNE MCGEE IS NEARING SOME PRETTY ELITE COMPANY.
- » THE RB IS ONLY 107 YARDS AWAY FROM ENTERING THE TOP 10 IN PROGRAM HISTORY IN RUSHING YARDS. MCGEE STANDS AT 2,593 AND IS READY TO PASS ISAIAH WHITAKER'S 2,700 CAREER YARDS FOR 10TH.
- » MCGEE CAN ALSO JOIN THE TOP 10 IN CAREER RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS IF HE FINDS PAYDIRT TWICE AGAINST THE SAINTS. MCGEE'S 29 CAREER TOUCHDOWNS ARE JUST SHY OF THE 31 OF MIKE MCREE'S THAT HAVE HIM IN 10TH PLACE IN LR HISTORY.

SAINTS RB1

- » MCGEE'S COUNTERPART IS TRE STEWART FOR LIMESTONE WHO IS THE ONLY PLAYER IN THE CONFERENCE WITH MORE RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS THAN MCGEE. STEWART'S 9 TOUCHDOWNS ON THE GROUND PACE THE SAC AND ARE THIRD IN THE NATION.
- » STEWART SET THE LIMESTONE SINGLE-GAME RUSHING RECORD WITH 320 YARDS IN THE SAINTS WIN OVER UVA WISE ON SEPTEMBER 24.
- » STEWART IS SEVENTH IN THE NATION IN ALL-PURPOSE YARDS AND SECOND IN DIVISION II IN YARDS PER CARRY AT 8.6.

LESTER CLIMBING THE CHARTS

- » DEONDRE LESTER'S 103 CAREER GRABS PLACE HIM 10TH IN PROGRAM HISTORY AS HE PASSED NICK STUTTS' 99 CAREER GRABS TO MOVE INTO THE TOP 10.
- » LESTER STILL HAS ALL OF THIS YEAR AND NEXT YEAR TO MOVE UP THE CHARTS AND TRY TO CHASE DOWN TERRENCE STEWARD'S MARK OF 247 CAREER CATCHES.
- » NO ONE IS WITHIN 100 CATCHES OF STEWARD. SECOND-PLACE IN PROGRAM HISTORY IS HELD BY CHRIS WINFORD FROM 2002-05 WITH 141 CAREER RECEPTIONS.

» LESTER ALSO RAN HIS STREAK OF CONSECUTIVE GAMES WITH AT LEAST ONE CATCH TO 22 IN A ROW.

CLOSING IT OUT

- » LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS A 90-9 MARK WHEN LEADING AFTER THE THIRD QUARTER SINCE 2010 AND ARE 88-8 IN THAT SAME TIME SPAN WHEN TAKING A LEAD INTO THE HALFTIME LOCKER ROOM.
- » CONVERSELY, THE BEARS ARE JUST 10-29 WHEN TRAILING AT THE HALF AND 5-31 WHEN DOWN AFTER THREE OUARTERS.

2ND QUARTER SUCCESS

- » THE LR OFFENSE SEEMS TO HIT ITS STRIDE IN THE SECOND QUARTER.
- » COMING INTO SATURDAY'S GAME, THE BEARS HAVE SCORED 55 OF THEIR 166 POINTS IN THE SECOND QUARTER AND ARE OUTSCORING OPPONENTS 55-16 IN THAT STRETCH.
- » THE BEARS ARE ALSO STRONG IN THE THIRD, PUTTING A TOTAL OF 49 POINTS ON THE BOARD.
- » THANKS TO LARGE MARGINS LATE IN GAMES, LR HAS ONLY NEEDED 21 FOURTH-QUARTER POINTS AND HAS ONLY GIVEN UP 20 POINTS IN THE FINAL 15 MINUTES OF GAMES THIS YFAR.

LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

SACK STREAK REACHES 59

- » IT HAS BEEN AN IMPRESSIVE RUN FOR THE LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSIVE UNIT, A UNIT THAT HAS RECORDED AT LEAST ONE SACK IN 59 CONSECUTIVE GAMES.
- » THE STREAK STARTED IN THE 2016 SEASON FINALE WITH A 3-SACK PERFORMANCE AGAINST CATAWBA AND HASN'T STOPPED SINCE.
- » 38 DIFFERENT PLAYERS HAVE RECORDED A SACK DURING THE STRETCH, LED BY 29 FROM JAQUAN ARTIS AND 25.5 FROM DAN LOUBA. CAM GORDON BECAME THE 38TH PLAYER ADDED TO THE LIST AGAINST UVA WISE.
- » LR HAD THREE SACKS AGAINST WISE LAST WEEK, ONE FROM ANDRE JEFFERSON, ONE FROM GORDON, AND A HALF SACK EACH FOR JON ROSS MAYE AND DOMONIQUE DAVIS.
- » LR HAS HAD AT LEAST FIVE SACKS IN A GAME 12 TIMES DURING THE STREAK.

NEW LEADER

- » DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR JAHMAL BROWN LEFT FOR YOUNGSTOWN STATE FOLLOWING THE 2021 SEASON, LEAVING LR WITH A NEW DEFENSIVE LEADER.
- » SHAWN CHAFFEE WILL STEP UP AND AARON FOSTER WILL SERVE AS THE CO-DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR. CHAFFEE WAS THE DEFENSIVE LINE COACH SINCE HE CAME TO LR AND FOSTER WORKS WITH THE DEFENSIVE BACKS.

GROUNDED THE CAVALIERS

- » UVA WISE ENTERED LAST WEEK'S GAME WITH THE TOP PASSING OFFENSE IN THE SAC, AND THE LR DEFENSE HELD THE CAVALIERS TO 123 YARDS THROUGH THE AIR, OVER 100 YARDS UNDER THEIR SEASON AVERAGE.
- » UVA WISE WAS ALSO AVERAGING OVER 400 YARDS PER GAME IN TOTAL OFFENSE, AND THE BEAR DEFENSE HELD THE CAVALIERS TO 227 TOTAL YARDS.
- » THE BEARS ALSO PICKED OFF THREE PASSES IN THE 2ND HALF, AND HAVE CREATED FIVE TURNOVERS IN THE PAST TWO GAMES.
- » LENOIR-RHYNE IS 9TH IN THE NATION IN TEAM PASSING EFFICIENCY DEFENSE WITH 91.60.

KING PERCY

» PERCY KING PICKED OFF TWO PASSES AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN, TAKING THE FIRST ONE BACK 31 YARDS TO THE END ZONE FOR A PICK-SIX AND THE FIRST DEFENSIVE TOUCHDOWN OF THE YEAR FOR LR. KING NOW HAS THREE PICK-SIXES IN HIS CAREER.
