REGULAR SEASON FINALE

» LENOIR-RHYNE WELCOMES THE TUSCULUM PIONEERS TO MORETZ STADIUM FOR THE FINAL HOME GAME OF THE YEAR AND THE FINAL GAME OF THE REGULAR SEASON.

» THE PIONEERS (8-2, 6-2 SAC) CAME UP JUST A TOUCHDOWN SHORT OF THE INAUGURAL SAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME LAST WEEK, FALLING TO MARS HILL 34-27 IN WHAT WAS THE DE FACTO MOUNTAIN DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIP GAME.

» LR CRUSHED RIVAL CATAWBA 62-10 TO GET BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN AND MOVE TO 7-3 ON THE YEAR.

» THIS IS THE FIRST YEAR THAT THE SAC HAD FOOTBALL DIVISIONS, AND THE FIRST YEAR OF THE FINAL WEEK CROSSOVER. NO GAMES HAD TO BE ADJUSTED THIS YEAR TO ACCOMMODATE FOR THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME BECAUSE NEWBERRY AND MARS HILL WERE ALREADY SCHEDULED TO PLAY EACH OTHER THIS WEEK. ALL OF THE PIEDMONT DIVISION SCHOOLS ARE HOSTING THIS WEEK, AND NEXT YEAR, ALL OF THE MOUNTAIN DIVISION SCHOOLS WILL HOST THE FINAL WEEK OF THE YEAR.

» THE BEARS LEAD THE ALL-TIME SERIES WITH TUSCULUM 14-11, AND HAVE WON EIGHT OUT OF THE LAST NINE MEETINGS. TU'S LONE WIN IN THAT TIME FRAME CAME IN THE COVID-SHORTENED SPRING 2021 SEASON IN HICKORY. THIS IS THE THIRD CONSECUTIVE SEASON THAT THE PIONEERS HAVE PLAYED IN MORETZ STADIUM.

» LR WON LAST YEAR'S MEETING 38-31 IN HICKORY AND TOOK ADVANTAGE OF A LATE FUMBLE FOR THE PIONEERS ON A PUNT. DWAYNE MCGEE RUSHED FOR 188 YARDS AND THREE TOUCHDOWNS IN THE GAME FOR THE BEARS.

BLASTED CATAWBA

» IN A DOMINATING 62-10 WIN OVER CATAWBA LAST WEEK, LENOIR-RHYNE SET A SINGLE-GAME PROGRAM RECORD (NCAA ERA) FOR RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS IN A GAME WITH EIGHT. THE BEARS LED 34-0 DESPITE TURNING THE BALL OVER TWICE IN THE FIRST HALF, AND LR DID NOT PUNT IN THE GAME.

» THE BEARS HELD THE INDIANS TO 149 TOTAL YARDS OF OFFENSE, AND FORCED CATAWBA INTO NINE THREE-AND-OUTS AND BLOCKED A PUNT.

NOVEMBER SUCCESS

» SINCE THE 2018 SEASON, LENOIR-RHYNE BOASTS A 12-1 RECORD IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, WITH THE ONLY LOSS COMING IN LAST YEAR'S NCAA PLAYOFFS TO BOWIE STATE.

» IN THOSE 12 WINS, THE BEARS HAVE OUTSCORED THE OPPONENTS BY AN ASTOUNDING AVERAGE OF 45 POINTS.

## LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

### ABOUT TUSCULUM

- » THE PIONEERS HAVE HAD AN UP-AND-DOWN SEASON, BUT COME INTO THIS GAME WITH A SOLID 8-2 RECORD AND 6-2 MARK IN THE SAC.
- » TU'S TWO LEAGUE LOSSES HAVE COME TO WINGATE AND MARS HILL, AND THE PIONEERS HAVE TWO ONE-POINT WINS (14-13 OVER BARTON, 10-9 OVER UVA WISE).
- » TU ALSO HAS BLOWOUT WINS OVER CARSON-NEWMAN (34-6), AND EMORY & HENRY (35-9).
- » QUARTERBACK TRE SIMMONS IS IN HIS FIRST FULL YEAR AS THE STARTER AFTER FINISHING THE SECOND HALF OF LAST YEAR AS THE STARTER. SIMMONS DID NOT PLAY WHEN THE PIONEERS VISITED HICKORY LAST YEAR. SIMMONS LEADS THE SAC WITH 19 PASSING TOUCHDOWNS THIS YEAR.
- » THE PIONEERS FEATURE A THREE RUNNING BACK BACKFIELD, WITH MEKHAI JOHNSON, MAURICE GOMILLION AND CORTNEY JACKSON SPLITTING THE REPS.
- » TUSCULUM IS ONE OF THE BEST TEAMS IN THE NATION AT TAKING THE BALL AWAY, COMING IN FIRST IN THE SAC AND THIRD IN THE COUNTRY IN TAKEAWAYS WITH 25.

### PROTECTING HOME TURF

- » ALL THREE OF LENOIR-RHYNE'S LOSSES THIS YEAR HAVE COME AT HOME.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME SINCE 2017 THE BEARS HAVE LOST MORE THAN ONE GAME AT HOME IN A SINGLE YEAR.
- » LR IS ALSO PLAYING SEVEN REGULAR SEASON HOME GAMES THIS YEAR, THE MOST IN ANY REGULAR SEASON IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

### SAC DOMINANCE

- » DESPITE TWO LEAGUE LOSSES THIS YEAR, LENOIR-RHYNE HAS STILL BEEN THE TOP TEAM IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE IN THE PAST FOUR SEASONS.
- » THE BEARS HAVE ONLY LOST TO THREE OTHER SAC SCHOOLS IN THAT TIME FRAME, AND HAD A 10-GAME WINNING STREAK AT ONE POINT.
- » WITH SATURDAY'S WIN OVER CATAWBA, HEAD COACH MIKE JACOBS BROKE THE FIRST TWO-GAME LOSING STREAK

OF HIS HEAD COACHING CAREER.

### 60 FOR JACOBS

- » SINCE BECOMING A HEAD COACH IN 2016, LENOIR-RHYNE'S MIKE JACOBS HAS BEEN ONE OF THE NATION'S MOST SUCCESSFUL COACHES AT ANY LEVEL OF COLLEGE FOOTBALL.
- » SATURDAY'S WIN OVER CATAWBA WAS JACOBS' 60TH WIN IN 75 GAMES AS A HEAD COACH, AND HIS 60-15 RECORD AS A HEAD COACH PUTS HIM IN ELITE COMPANY.
- » JACOBS IS ONE OF FIVE COACHES AT THE DIVISION I AND II LEVELS WITH A WINNING PERCENTAGE OF AT LEAST .800 WITH A MINIMUM OF 75 GAMES COACHED. THE OTHERS ARE KALEN DEBOER (WASHINGTON), KIRBY SMART (GEORGIA), DABO SWINNEY (CLEMSON), AND TONY ANNESE (FERRIS ST.).

### NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST THREE NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THIS SEASON.

## LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

### » **LIMIT THE TURNOVERS**

- » IN LENOIR-RHYNE'S LOSSES THIS SEASON, TURNOVERS HAVE BEEN A BIG ISSUE FOR THE BEARS.
- » THREE INTERCEPTIONS AGAINST WINGATE DOOMED THE BEARS, WITH THE THIRD ULTIMATELY SETTING UP THE GAME-WINNING SCORE FOR THE BULLDOGS.
- » TUSCULUM HAS THE LEAGUE'S BEST TURNOVER DEFENSE, TAKING THE BALL AWAY 25 TIMES THIS YEAR, GOOD FOR THIRD IN THE NATION.
- » THE BEARS ARE 5-1 THIS YEAR WHEN WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE, WITH THE LONE LOSS COMING TO NEWBERRY.
- » TUSCULUM ALSO LEADS THE SAC IN DEFENSIVE TOUCHDOWNS WITH FOUR, A NUMBER THAT IS GOOD FOR FOURTH IN THE NATION.

### » **MORE HARDWARE FOR WHITE**

- » AFTER THROWING FOR A CAREER-HIGH 292 YARDS AGAINST WINGATE, SEAN WHITE RAN FOR A CAREER-HIGH TWO TOUCHDOWNS AGAINST CATAWBA.
- » WHITE ALSO COMPLETED 15 OUT OF 20 PASSES FOR 269 YARDS AND A TOUCHDOWN, AND WON HIS SECOND SAC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD FOR HIS EFFORTS.
- » THE 75% COMPLETION RATE WAS WHITE'S SECOND-HIGHEST THIS SEASON, ONLY BEHIND HIS SEASON DEBUT WHEN HE PLAYED THE SECOND HALF AGAINST VIRGINIA STATE AND WENT 10-FOR-11 PASSING.
- » WHITE IS ONE TOUCHDOWN PASS AWAY FROM TYING FOR FOURTH IN PROGRAM HISTORY FOR TOUCHDOWN PASSES IN A SINGLE SEASON, AND CAN MOVE INTO FOURTH PLACE BY HIMSELF WITH MULTIPLE TOUCHDOWN TOSSES.

### » **100 CLUB**

- » BEFORE THIS SEASON, ONLY NINE PLAYERS IN THE FIRST 102 YEARS OF LENOIR-RHYNE FOOTBALL HAD REACHED 100 CAREER CATCHES.
- » DEONDRE LESTER TOPPED THE MARK IN A HOME WIN OVER CARSON-NEWMAN AND RYAN CARTER ACCOMPLISHED THE FEAT AGAINST WINGATE.
- » THE DUO IS SET TO BE JOINED BY KELIN PARSONS IN THE NEAR FUTURE. PARSONS IS SITTING ON 94 CAREER RECEPTIONS IN JUST 25 CAREER GAMES.

- » PARSONS IS ALSO TIED FOR 2ND IN THE SAC WITH FIVE RECEIVING TOUCHDOWNS THIS YEAR.

### » **ANOTHER FOR MALIK**

- » ALSO TIED FOR 2ND IN THE SAC IN RECEIVING TOUCHDOWNS FOR THE BEARS IS REDSHIRT FRESHMAN TIGHT END MALIK SIMMONS.
- » SIMMONS HAS 10 TOTAL RECEPTIONS ON THE YEAR, AND FIVE OF THEM HAVE FOUND PAYDIRT.
- » FOUR OUT OF HIS FIVE SCORES HAVE BEEN HIS ONLY RECEPTION IN THAT PARTICULAR GAME, INCLUDING CATAWBA LAST SATURDAY. HE CAUGHT A SEVEN-YARD SCORE FROM SEAN WHITE IN THE FIRST HALF IN SALISBURY.

### » **CENTURY MARK IS KEY**

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS BEEN PRACTICALLY UNBEATABLE THIS YEAR WHEN REACHING THE 100-YARD RUSHING MARK AS A TEAM.
- » THE BEARS ARE 6-1 THIS YEAR WHEN REACHING 100 YARDS RUSHING AS A TEAM, WITH THE ONLY LOSS COMING TO NEWBERRY.
- » HOWEVER, IN THAT NEWBERRY GAME, THE BEARS ONLY RUSHED FOR 103 YARDS, THE SMALLEST NUMBER IN THE SEVEN TIMES THEY'VE REACHED THE CENTURY MARK.
- » THE BEARS HAVE BEEN HELD TO 16 YARDS AND 12 YARDS RUSHING RESPECTIVELY IN TWO OUT OF THEIR THREE LOSSES (FERRIS STATE AND WINGATE).

### » **EARLY SCORING**

- » A KEY TO THE LENOIR-RHYNE SUCCESS THIS YEAR HAS BEEN TO GRAB AN EARLY LEAD.
- » THE BEARS ARE 5-1 WHEN SCORING FIRST BUT JUST 2-2 WHEN THE OPPONENT SCORES FIRST.
- » LR IS 7-0 WHEN LEADING AFTER THE FIRST QUARTER BUT 0-3 WHEN TRAILING AFTER ONE.

### » **THIRD DOWN AND RED ZONE**

- » TWO AREAS WHERE LENOIR-RHYNE'S OFFENSE EXCELLED IN 2021 - ON 3RD DOWN AND IN THE RED ZONE - HAVE NOT BEEN AS STRONG IN 2022.
- » THE BEARS ARE SIXTH IN THE SAC AND 82ND IN THE NATION IN 3RD DOWN CONVERSION OFFENSE (38%), AND 3RD IN THE SAC AND 33RD IN THE NATION IN RED ZONE OFFENSE (86% SCORE RATE).

## LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

### SHUT DOWN CATAWBA

- » LR'S DEFENSE PUT TOGETHER ONE OF ITS BEST PERFORMANCES OF THE SEASON ON SATURDAY IN SALISBURY, FORCING NINE PUNTS AND ALLOWING JUST 149 YARDS OF TOTAL OFFENSE.
- » THAT WAS THE SECOND-FEWEST YARDS LR'S DEFENSE HAS ALLOWED ALL SEASON.
- » THE BEARS ONLY ALLOWED 141 TOTAL YARDS AGAINST BARTON.

### MORE HARDWARE
