GAME 101

» AFTER LENOIR-RHYNE THUMPED CATAWBA 56-3 IN THE 100TH MEETING BETWEEN THE SCHOOLS LAST YEAR, THEY WILL RENEW THE RIVALRY AGAIN FOR THE 101ST TIME ON SATURDAY AT SHUFORD STADIUM IN SALISBURY.

» LENOIR-RHYNE HAS WON THREE STRAIGHT IN THE SERIES AND HAS SCORED 168 POINTS IN THAT TIME FRAME. IN THE LAST TWO MEETINGS, THE BEARS HAVE OUTSCORED THE INDIANS BY A COMBINED 99 POINTS.

» THIS IS THE SIXTH-MOST PLAYED RIVALRY IN DIVISION II HISTORY. LR HAS WON NINE OUT OF THE LAST 12 GAMES IN THE SERIES, AND TRAILS CATAWBA IN THE ALL-TIME SERIES BY JUST TWO GAMES, 47-49-4.

» CATAWBA HAS FARED SLIGHTLY BETTER AT HOME IN THE SERIES, HOLDING A 24-22-1 RECORD AGAINST LENOIR-RHYNE IN SALISBURY.

» THE SERIES IS DEAD EVEN IN HICKORY, TIED 25-25-1.

» THE TWO WINS FOR LENOIR-RHYNE OVER CATAWBA IN 2018 AND 2019 CLINCHED OUTRIGHT SAC CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR THE BEARS.

COMPLETE DOMINATION

» LENOIR-RHYNE SCORED 21 POINTS IN EACH OF THE FIRST TWO QUARTERS IN LAST YEAR'S GAME AND BLASTED CATAWBA 56-3 BETWEEN THE BRICKS, IN WHAT WAS THE FINAL FOOTBALL GAME IN MORETZ STADIUM BEFORE THE STADIUM RENOVATION.

» IN THAT GAME, DWAYNE MCGEE SET THE LR SINGLE-SEASON RECORD FOR RUSHING YARDS AFTER RUSHING FOR 206 YARDS IN THAT GAME, ONE OF 16 GAMES IN LENOIR-RHYNE FOOTBALL HISTORY WHERE THEY HAD A 200-YARD RUSHER.

» KELIN PARSONS, JORDAN PAYNE AND MALAKEI SUMNER EACH CAUGHT TOUCHDOWN PASSES FROM GRAYSON WILLINGHAM, WHO FINISHED UP HIS LR CAREER WITH A WIN OVER THE INDIANS.

» DEFENSIVE TACKLE DAN LOUBA ALSO HAD A RUSHING TOUCHDOWN LATE IN THAT GAME.

NOVEMBER SUCCESS

» SINCE THE 2018 SEASON, LENOIR-RHYNE BOASTS A 11-1 RECORD IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, WITH THE ONLY LOSS COMING IN LAST YEAR'S NCAA PLAYOFFS TO BOWIE STATE.

» IN THOSE 11 WINS, THE BEARS HAVE OUTSCORED THE OPPONENTS BY AN AVERAGE OF 37 POINTS.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

ABOUT CATAWBA

- » AFTER A 44-19 WIN OVER LIVINGSTONE IN THE FIRST GAME OF THE YEAR, THE INDIANS HAVE LIMPED THROUGH CONFERENCE PLAY. CATAWBA IS 1-8 OVERALL AND IS MOST RECENTLY COMING OFF A ROAD LOSS AT BARTON, 38-21.
- » CATAWBA IS 11TH IN THE SAC IN TOTAL OFFENSE PER GAME (288.2 YARDS PER GAME), AND ALLOWS THE MOST YARDS PER GAME IN THE CONFERENCE (462.9 YARDS PER GAME).
- » DESPITE THEIR STRUGGLES, THE INDIANS DID GIVE NEWBERRY A TOUGH GAME A COUPLE WEEKS AGO. THE WOLVES ONLY BEAT CATAWBA 34-27, AND QUARTERBACK KAMRON HILL THREW FOR 296 YARDS AND THREE TOUCHDOWNS IN THE LOSS FOR THE INDIANS.
- » HEAD COACH CURTIS WALKER IS IN HIS 10TH SEASON AT THE HELM FOR CATAWBA AND IS 3-6 AGAINST LENOIR-RHYNE AS THE CATAWBA HEAD COACH. WALKER WAS THE SAC COACH OF THE YEAR IN 2015, WHEN THE INDIANS WON THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP AND APPEARED IN THE NCAA PLAYOFFS.

ROAD WARRIORS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS BEEN AN EXCELLENT TEAM AWAY FROM MORETZ STADIUM THIS YEAR, GOING 3-0 ON THE ROAD.
- » THE BEARS HAVE WON EACH OF THEIR ROAD GAMES THIS YEAR BY AN AVERAGE OF 29 POINTS PER GAME, AND TWO OUT OF THE THREE BIGGEST OFFENSIVE OUTPUTS ON THE SEASON CAME AWAY FROM HOME.
- » THIS WEEK'S ROAD GAME AGAINST CATAWBA MARKS THE FINAL ROAD GAME OF THE REGULAR SEASON FOR LR.

SAC DOMINANCE

- » DESPITE BACK-TO-BACK LOSSES, LENOIR-RHYNE HAS STILL BEEN THE TOP TEAM IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE IN THE LAST FOUR SEASONS.
- » THE BEARS HAVE ONLY LOST TO THREE OTHER SAC SCHOOLS IN THAT TIME FRAME, AND HAD A 10-GAME CONFERENCE WINNING STREAK AT ONE POINT.

» THIS IS THE FIRST TIME SINCE 2017 LENOIR-RHYNE HAS LOST BACK-TO-BACK GAMES, AND THE FIRST TIME IN THE HEAD COACHING CAREER OF MIKE JACOBS THAT HE HAS LOST CONSECUTIVE GAMES.

AVOID THREE STRAIGHT

- » LENOIR-RHYNE IS LOOKING TO AVOID ITS FIRST THREE-GAME LOSING STREAK SINCE THE BEARS DROPPED THE FINAL THREE CONTESTS TO CLOSE OUT THE 2017 SEASON.
- » CATAWBA ALSO SECURED THAT THIRD STRAIGHT LOSS FOR LR IN 2017 WITH A 24-20 DEFEAT ON NOV. 11. PRIOR TO THAT GAME, LENOIR-RHYNE LOST GAMES AT UNC PEMBROKE AND HOME AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN.

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST THREE NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THIS SEASON.

» **LIMIT THE TURNOVERS**

- » THE BEARS SHOT THEMSELVES IN THE FOOT IN A LOSS AGAINST WINGATE LAST WEEK WITH THREE TURNOVERS, ALL COMING AS INTERCEPTIONS.
- » SEAN WHITE THREW A COSTLY INTERCEPTION FROM HIS OWN END ZONE LATE IN THE FOURTH QUARTER WHICH SET UP THE EVENTUAL GAME-WINNING TOUCHDOWN PLAY FOR THE BULLDOGS.
- » THE THREE INT'S ARE THE MOST THROWN BY WHITE IN A GAME IN HIS CAREER.

» **THROUGH THE AIR**

- » DESPITE TOSsing THREE INTERCEPTIONS, SEAN WHITE MANAGED A CAREER-HIGH 292 PASSING YARDS AGAINST WINGATE.
- » WHITE HIT JUST 18 OF 35 PASSES BUT WAS BOOSTED BY A 70-YARD TOUCHDOWN COMPLETION TO TE MALIK SIMMONS AT THE END OF THE FIRST HALF.
- » IN TOTAL, WHITE HOOKED UP WITH EIGHT DIFFERENT RECEIVERS IN THE GAME.
- » PARSONS IS THIRD IN THE CONFERENCE WITH 566 YARDS RECEIVING THIS SEASON AND IS TIED FOR THE LEAGUE LEAD WITH FIVE TOUCHDOWN CATCHES.

» **100 CLUB**

- » BEFORE THIS SEASON, ONLY NINE PLAYERS IN THE FIRST 102 YEARS OF LENOIR-RHYNE FOOTBALL HAD REACHED 100 CAREER CATCHES.
- » DEONDRE LESTER TOPPED THE MARK IN A HOME WIN OVER CARSON-NEWMAN AND RYAN CARTER ACCOMPLISHED THE FEAT AGAINST WINGATE LAST WEEK.
- » THE DUO IS SET TO BE JOINED BY KELIN PARSONS IN THE NEAR FUTURE. PARSONS IS SITTING ON 90 CAREER RECEPTIONS IN JUST 24 CAREER GAMES.

» **SIMMONS STANDS OUT**

- » WITH HIS 70-YARD TOUCHDOWN GRAB TO CLOSE OUT THE FIRST HALF, REDSHIRT FRESHMAN MALIK SIMMONS NOW HAS FOUR TOUCHDOWNS ON THE SEASON FROM THE

TIGHT END POSITION.

- » FOUR OF HIS NINE GRABS HAVE RESULTED IN TOUCHDOWNS ON THE YEAR.

» **SHUT DOWN THE RUSHING GAME**

- » WINGATE CAME IN WITH A REPUTATION OF A STRONG DEFENSE AND THEY BACKED THAT UP IN THE RUN DEFENSE ON SATURDAY.

LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

LIMITING THE BULLDOGS

- » DESPITE COMING OUT ON THE LOSING END, THE LR DEFENSE HELD WINGATE' OFFENSE IN CHECK MOST OF THE GAME.
- » WINGATE RAN THE BALL 53 TIMES FOR 178 YARDS WHICH CAME OUT TO JUST 3.4 YARDS PER CARRY.
- » THROUGH THE AIR, WINGATE WENT JUST 8-OF-17 FOR 72 YARDS AND THREW A PAIR OF INTERCEPTIONS.
- » IN TOTAL, THE BULLDOGS HAD 70 OFFENSIVE PLAYS THAT NETTED 250 YARDS OF OFFENSE, JUST 3.6 YARDS PER PLAY. LR ALSO HAD A PAIR OF SACKS.

BIG PERFORMANCE FROM HIBBITT

- » DEVIN HIBBITT WAS NAMED THE SAC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK IN THE LOSING EFFORT AGAINST WINGATE.
- » HIBBITT HAD A CAREER-HIGH 13 TACKLES AND A PAIR OF INTERCEPTIONS ON THE DAY.
- » IT WAS THE FIRST DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD FOR HIBBITT THIS SEASON.

JR ON FIRE

- » LINEBACKER JON ROSS MAYE HAS BEEN THE ANCHOR OF THE DEFENSE SO FAR THIS YEAR FOR LR.
- » AGAINST WINGATE, MAYE TIED A CAREER HIGH WITH 15 TACKLES AND WAS ONE OF THE MAIN REASONS THAT WINGATE STRUGGLED TO MOVE THE BALL.
- » MAYE LEADS THE BEARS IN TACKLES WITH 60, HE'S RECORDED 5.5 TACKLES-FOR-LOSS, HALF A SACK, AND HAS PICKED OFF TWO PASSES.
- » MAYE HAS ADDED A FUMBLE RECOVERY AND A PAIR OF QB HURRIES.

ANDRE THE GIANT

- » ANDRE JEFFERSON HAS BEEN HUGE ON THE DEFENSIVE LINE DURING HIS SOPHOMORE SEASON FOR THE BEARS.
