BIOGRAPHY

Greg Paradine started the Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Lacrosse program and has been the only coach in program history after his hiring in 2009. Paradine, a graduate and all-american at the University of North Carolina, has brought LR to unmatched heights during his tenure.

Paradine was named the 2018 USILA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading the Bears within one goal of advancing to the National Championship. Paradine earned his second National Coach of the Year honor in 2021 after he led the Bears to a National Championship game and the highest national ranking in program history (#2). Paradine has guided the Bears to five South Atlantic Conference Regular Season Championships, two SAC Tournament title and three NCAA Tournament appearances. He owns a 106–60 all-time record and is a four-time South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year.

Paradine's Bears won 24 straight SAC regular season games, going three straight seasons with a perfect 8-0 league mark. The Bears have been nationally ranked 71 times, including being as high as No. 2 in the nation and had a 27-week stretch of being ranked in the top 10. Paradine engineered two wins over Limestone when the Saints were ranked No. 1 in the nation, including an 18-16 win in 2020 which was nationally broadcast on the Lacrosse Sports Network.

In his tenure, 49 players have been selected to the All-Conference squad and 13 have been All-Americans. He had three players win SAC Player of the Year accolades and two others be named SAC Freshman of the Year. Academically, Paradine has had three players win SAC Scholar-Athletes of the Year awards and two been named the SAC Elite 20 Award Winner while Mitch Linklater earned the prestigious NCAA Elite 90 award.

Paradine came to LR after serving as an assistant coach for seven years at his alma mater, the University of North Carolina. He was a four-year member of the Tar Heels lax team and played on four ACC Championship teams and won a National Championship in 1991.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

BEARS IN FEBRUARY

Lenoir-Rhyne owns a 16-24 all-time record in the month of Feburary. The Bears went 2-0 in February during the 2021 season, picking up wins over North Greenville and No. 13 Belmont Abbey.

BEARS AT HOME

Lenoir-Rhyne had won six straight at home dating back to April 9 of last season which matched the record for the longest home win streak in program history before falling to Indianapolis on Saturday.

HIGHEST RANKING

Never in program history has Lenoir-Rhyne ranked as high in a preseason ranking than they did this year. With the Bears slotting in at No. 2 in the USILA National Poll, the Bears topped their previous best ranking of No. 4 heading into the 2019 season.

LAST 25

Lenoir-Rhyne has been on a tremendous run since the start of the 2020 season. In the 25 games since the '20 season started, Lenoir-Rhyne is 21-4 with losses to No. 1 Le Moyne, No. 6 Belmont Abbey, No. 6 Wingate and No. 8 UIndy. During that span, Lenoir-Rhyne has beaten nine ranked teams including five wins over teams inside the top five.

DEFENDING CHAMP

For only the second time in program history, Lenoir-Rhyne swept the

SAC Regular Season and Conference Tournament titles in 2021 and look to do the same in back-to-back years for the first time in program history.

KEY PIECES GONE

The Bears are looking to replace three of the best players in program history from a season ago. Eric Dickinson finished as the program's all-time leader in almost every offensive category and finished in the top 10 in NCAA Division II history in career points. Dickinson has remained part of the program and has served as an assistant coach this season. Zach Bodeau made the most of his one season at LR and earned All-American status at the face off. Bodeau also remains as part of the coaching staff. Connor Stanley graduated as a multi-year starter on defense.

NEW FACES

The Bears looked all over to find replacements for the three key losses. In-conference transfers from Coker will look to make up for two of the losses. LR added Coker's second alltime leading scorer in Joe Venazio on attack and defender James Brugger has 48 career starts in the SAC under his belt. Freshman Evan Voss not only dons Dickinson's jersey number but the staff is excited to see what the young man from Powder Springs, Ga. can bring to the offensive end. At faceoff, the Bears will turn to a depth of returners to fill Bodeau's absence. John Paulus, Patrick Sullivan and Macon Sumner all return

after getting experience at the spot a season ago.

AROUND THE LEAGUE

Every SAC team is in action this week, highlighted by a matchup between Wingate and Mercyhurst. The Bulldogs moved into the spot LR previously held in the national rankings (2) while Mercyhurst sits at No. 4. Queens takes on Lynn who sits just outside the top 20 in the nation and Limestone battles Saint Leo.

PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS

North Greenville was predicted to finish third in the preseason Conference Carolinas Coaches' Poll, slotting behind Belmont Abbey and Mount Olive. In 2021, NGU finished 4-1 in league play and 7-7 overall which was good enough for a third-place finish in the conference.
