SAC SUPREMACY ON THE LINE

TIED FOR FIRST

Lenoir-Rhyne and Wingate come into Wednesday's clash with one loss in conference play and both close out the regular season with very winnable games. That means that Wednesday's game will serve as a defacto South Atlantic Conference Regular Season Championship game. Limestone also has just one league loss this year so the loser will drop to third in the league standings which is important as only the top two teams earn byes to the SAC Tournament Semifinal round.

ROUND FOUR

For the fourth time in the past year plus (their first meeting was April 7, 2021) these two teams will meet with plenty on the line. Wingate grabbed the regular season victory a year ago but the Bears took postseason wins in the SAC and NCAA Tournaments. With LR hosting the SAC Tournament as well as the NCAA Tournament in 2021 and the regular season game being scheduled in Hickory, this is the first of the four matchups to take place in Wingate.

UNDER THE LIGHTS

This will be the fourth straight game that LR will be playing under the lights with a 7 p.m. face off. LR is 34-9 all-time in night games (games that start at 7 p.m. or later) in team history.

TOUGH SLEDDING

The matchup with No. 6 Wingate will be the sixth nationally-ranked opponent Lenoir-Rhyne has played this season with four of those teams being inside the top 10. The Bears have beaten two of the first five nationally ranked foes but are 0-3 against teams ranked in the top 10 with losses to UIndy, Tampa and Limestone on the year.



BIOGRAPHY

Greg Paradine started the Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Lacrosse program and has been the only coach in program history after his hiring in 2009. Paradine, a graduate and all-american at the University of North Carolina, has brought LR to unmatched heights during his tenure.

Paradine was named the 2018 USILA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading the Bears within one goal of advancing to the National Championship. Paradine earned his second National Coach of the Year honor in 2021 after he led the Bears to a National Championship game and the highest national ranking in program history (#2). Paradine has guided the Bears to five South Atlantic Conference Regular Season Championships, two SAC Tournament title and three NCAA Tournament appearances. He owns a 106–60 all-time record and is a four-time South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year.

Paradine's Bears won 24 straight SAC regular season games, going three straight seasons with a perfect 8-0 league mark. The Bears have been nationally ranked 71 times, including being as high as No. 2 in the nation and had a 27-week stretch of being ranked in the top 10. Paradine engineered two wins over Limestone when the Saints were ranked No. 1 in the nation, including an 18-16 win in 2020 which was nationally broadcast on the Lacrosse Sports Network.

In his tenure, 49 players have been selected to the All-Conference squad and 13 have been All-Americans. He had three players win SAC Player of the Year accolades and two others be named SAC Freshman of the Year. Academically, Paradine has had three players win SAC Scholar-Athletes of the Year awards and two been named the SAC Elite 20 Award Winner while Mitch Linklater earned the prestigious NCAA Elite 90 award.

Paradine came to LR after serving as an assistant coach for seven years at his alma mater, the University of North Carolina. He was a four-year member of the Tar Heels lax team and played on four ACC Championship teams and won a National Championship in 1991.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

RANKED HISTORY

Lenoir-Rhyne is 22-26 all-time against ranked opponents including a 6-2 mark in 2021. Lenoir-Rhyne is 6-9 on the road against ranked opponents.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bears blew out Catawba 16-4 on April 2 and have had 11 days between that game and the Wingate matchup to prepare for the Bulldogs. LR jumped out to an 11-1 lead and never looked back to win their fifth straight contest.

MOFFAT CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Senior Myles Moffat enters Wednesday's contest sitting on 199 career points. Moffat is looking to become just one of three players in LR history to top the 200 point mark for their career. Moffat's 117 career goals place him fourth in program history and his 82 career assists is second in team history.

POWELL ON D

Sophomore Victor Powell has made the most of his year-and-a-half at Lenoir-Rhyne. Powell has 49 career caused turnovers, including four against Newberry, which already has him tied for third in program history. With three more caused turnovers, Powell will move into second place but is still 62 behind the all-time leader in Collin Lett who has 111.

BREAKING THE ASSIST MARK

In a dominating 22-2 win over Coker, the Bears broke the program record for most assists in a game. LR handed out 19 helpers on those 22 goals, topping the previous mark of 18 assists set back in 2014. Myles Moffat led the way with a quartet of assists.

ECCLESTON JOINS 100 POINT CLUB

With his first half goal against Tusculum, Toron Eccleston became the ninth player in program history to recrod 100 career points. Eccleston has 91 goals and 20 career assists for his 111 points in his career.

DEFENDING CHAMP

For only the second time in program history, Lenoir-Rhyne swept the SAC Regular Season and Conference Tournament titles in 2021 and look to do the same in back-to-back years for the first time in program history.

SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

Wingate was tripped up by Anderson this season but control their own destiny when it comes to getting the No. 1 seed in the conference tournament. Wingate beat Limestone in overtime earlier this season and will be the top seed in the SAC Tournament by winning out. Wingate is fifth in the nation with 111 assists on the year and their 307 points as a team also ranks fifth. Wingate has a +7.50 scoring margin which ranks also places them fifth in the nation.

ACTIVE SCORERS

This game features four of the top 13 active goal scorers in all of Division II. Bobby Padden is seventh with 134 career goals while Joe Venazio is ninth with 132 and Moffat is 12th with 117. Wingate's Adam Vodovnik is 13th with 111 career scores.

GRIECO THE HELPER

Willie Grieco of Wingate is the national leader in assists per game with 3.58. Wingate also has Bobby Padden who ranks 10th in the nation in the same category with 2.42 helpers per contest. Grieco is the national leader in pointers per game at 6.58.

BIG GAME JOHNNIE

Noah Johnson has been a mainstay in goal for the Bears and is second in all of Division II in active career leaders with 555 career saves. Johnson has 28 career games with at least 10 saves, four shy of current assistant coach Ryan Crompton who had 32 such games.

PACKED HOUSE

Lenoir-Rhyne is one of the best gameday atmospheres in all of NCAA Division II desipte construction on the stadium going on during the season. The Bears own four of the top nine most attended games on campus sites so far this season. The game against UIndy had 784 spectators, the second-biggest on campus crowd this year in DII. The North Greenville game was the fourthhighest attended game and the games against Coker and Florida Tech come in at eighth and ninth respectively. Limestone owns the most attended game in all of 2022 so far as their game against Wingate brought in 1,900 fans but that game was in Charlotte, N.C. and not on a campus.
