QUARTERFINAL REMATCH

ONE YEAR LATER

It will be 364 days since these two teams met in the NCAA Quartefinal on May 16, 2021 on Sunday as the two will battle again with a trip to the NCAA Semifinal on the line. The difference in 2022 is that Tampa earned the right to host the game as the No. 1 team in the nation and region and undefeated on the season. The Bears came away with a dramatic 16–15 overtime victory on Colten McCracken's goal with nine seconds left in OT. The Bears erased a 10–5 second half deficit in that contest and beat Tampa in Rory Whipple's final game as the Spartans head coach.

GAME 2 IN 22

LR and Tampa will be meeting for the second time this season as Tampa came away with a 13-8 victory back on February 20. LR trailed by just one goal heading into the fourth quarter in Savannah, Ga. but the Spartans scored six times in the final frame to come away with the win. Kellen Hoke and Owen Miller had hat tricks for the Spartans and Daniel Fitzpatrick and Luke McAnaney each had two goals and an assist. LR was led by three points each from Evan Voss and Will Canata.

LAST 'L' TO AVENGE

The Bears have lost three times this season but have been able to avenge their first two losses. LR opened the season with a one-goal loss at home to UIndy but the Bears would get revenge in the first round of the NCAA Tournament with a narrow 11-10 win over the Greyhounds. LR also dropped to Limestone 13-3 in the regular season but rebounded to beat the Saints 14-11 in the South Atlantic Conference Tournament. Tampa is the third team LR has lost to in the regular season and have a chance to beat in postseason play. A win over Tampa would give the Spartans and first-year head coach J.B. Clarke their first defeat of the season as they own an 18-0 mark.

BIOGRAPHY

Greg Paradine started the Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Lacrosse program and has been the only coach in program history after his hiring in 2009. Paradine, a graduate and all-american at the University of North Carolina, has brought LR to unmatched heights during his tenure.

Paradine was named the 2018 USILA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading the Bears within one goal of advancing to the National Championship. Paradine earned his second National Coach of the Year honor in 2021 after he led the Bears to a National Championship game and the highest national ranking in program history (#2). Paradine has guided the Bears to five South Atlantic Conference Regular Season Championships, two SAC Tournament title and three NCAA Tournament appearances. He owns a 106–60 all-time record and is a four-time South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year.

Paradine's Bears won 24 straight SAC regular season games, going three straight seasons with a perfect 8-0 league mark. The Bears have been nationally ranked 71 times, including being as high as No. 2 in the nation and had a 27-week stretch of being ranked in the top 10. Paradine engineered two wins over Limestone when the Saints were ranked No. 1 in the nation, including an 18-16 win in 2020 which was nationally broadcast on the Lacrosse Sports Network.

In his tenure, 49 players have been selected to the All-Conference squad and 13 have been All-Americans. He had three players win SAC Player of the Year accolades and two others be named SAC Freshman of the Year. Academically, Paradine has had three players win SAC Scholar-Athletes of the Year awards and two been named the SAC Elite 20 Award Winner while Mitch Linklater earned the prestigious NCAA Elite 90 award.

Paradine came to LR after serving as an assistant coach for seven years at his alma mater, the University of North Carolina. He was a four-year member of the Tar Heels lax team and played on four ACC Championship teams and won a National Championship in 1991.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

NCAA TOURNEY HISTORY

This marks the fourth trip to the NCAA Tournament in the past five years for Lenoir-Rhyne who own a 4-3 all-time mark in NCAA postseason play, including last year's run to the NCAA Championship game. The Bears enter as the four seed which is the worst seed LR has ever had. In their prior three tournament appearances, the Bears were either the 1 or 2 seed.

STACKING WINS

Lenoir-Rhyne has the third-longest winning streak in all of Division II with 11 straight victories dating back to their 13-3 loss at Limestone on March 12. One of the only teams in the nation with a longer winning streak is Tampa who has won 18 straight this year.

LONG SPARTAN STREAK

That overtime loss to the Bears was a rare defeat that this Tampa squad has had to endure. To show just how rare it has been for the Spartans to lose, that loss at Lenoir-Rhyne is the only loss Tampa has suffered since the start of the 2020 season. The Spartans went 8-0 in 2020, 10-1 in 2021 and are 18-0 this season. The last team to beat Tampa that wasn't Lenoir-Rhyne in 2021 was Limestone back in the 2019 NCAA Tournament.

QUARTERFINAL HURDLE

Despite the amount of success Tampa has acheived, the Spartans have lost in the Quarterfinal round of the NCAA Tournament three striaght years. In 2018, Saint Leo knocked off Tampa 12-11 and Limestone did the same in 2019 by the same final score in double overtime. Tampa beat Lenoir-Rhyne 11-8 in the 2017 NCAA Quarterfinals but their last three losses have all come by one goal each with two coming in overtime.

RANKED HISTORY

Lenoir-Rhyne is 26-26 all-time against ranked opponents including a six-game winning streak to close out this year. Lenoir-Rhyne is 16-13 all-time at home against ranked opponents.

ATTENDANCE LEADERS

Lenoir-Rhyne leads all of Division II in total attendance and average attendance. The Bears total attendance of 5,773 is 1,800 more than any other school in Division II and the average attendance of 577 is 137 more per game than any other Division II team. The LR/Limestone SAC Championship game at Moretz Stadium was the second-most attended game on campus in Division II this season and LR holds the third, fourth and fifth most attended on campus games this year including the game with UIndy to start the season.

MOFFAT CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Senior Myles Moffat became one of just three players in Lenoir-Rhyne history to ever top 200 career points when he did so earlier this season.

BACK-TO-BACK

With a 14-11 win over No. 3 Limestone, the Lenoir-Rhyne Bears earned their second straight South Atlantic Conference Tournament title and the third in program history. The Bears and Saints also split the SAC Regular Season crown thanks to identical 9-1 records in the conference.

BREAKING THE ASSIST MARK

In a dominating 22-2 win over Coker, the Bears broke the program record for most assists in a game. LR handed out 19 helpers on those 22 goals, topping the previous mark of 18 assists set back in 2014. Myles Moffat led the way with a quartet of assists.

DR. JOHNSON

Goalie Noah Johnson was named the South Atlantic Conference Tournament Most Valuable Player after the win against Limestone as he recorded 14 saves in the victory.

EIGHT ON THE ALL-CONFERENCE LIST

For the second consecutive season, Lenoir-Rhyne placed eight players on the All-SAC team as announced by the league on Thursday. The Bears had three on the first team (Victor Powell, Mitchell Linklater and Toron Eccleston) and two more on the second team (Noah Johnson, Myles Moffat). Rounding out the selections were a trio of third teamers in John Paulus, James Brugger and Tommy Aguilar.
