THE GRAND (re)OPENING

» AFTER NINE MONTHS OF CONSTRUCTION, THE MAKEOVER AT MORETZ STADIUM IS COMPLETE WITH FOOTBALL SET TO BE PLAYED. THE S18M UPGRADE FEATURES A NEW PRESS BOX, HOME BLEACHERS WITH SEAT BACK SEATS IN THE BEARS CLUB SECTION AND TWO BRAND NEW VIDEOBOARDS. ADDITIONALLY, CORNER SUITES WERE INSTALLED, A NEW TEAM ENTRANCE TO THE FIELD AND LOCKER ROOM SPACES FOR MEN'S AND WOMEN'S LACROSSE WERE BUILT. ALREADY ONE OF THE BEST DIVISION II ATMOSPHERES IN THE NATION HAS ONLY GOTTEN BETTER.

PRESEASON POLLS

- » FOR THE THIRD STRAIGHT SEASON, LENOIR-RHYNE ENTERS THE REGULAR SEASON AS A RANKED TEAM. THE BEARS WERE RANKED NO. 19 IN THE AFCA PRESEASON COACHES' POLL AND CAME IN AT NO. 22 IN THE D2F00TBALL.COM MFDIA POLL.
- » LENOIR-RHYNE WAS PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN THE PRESEASON SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACHES POLL, TRAILING LAST YEAR'S CHAMPION NEWBERRY.

NON-CONFERENCE STREAK

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS WON EIGHT STRAIGHT GAMES AGAINST NON-CONFERENCE FOES IN THE REGULAR SEASON. THE BEARS LAST REGULAR SEASON LOSS TO A NON-CONFERENCE OPPONENT CAME BACK IN THE 2018 SEASON OPENER WHEN THEY TOOK A 36-32 DEFEAT AT WEST ALABAMA ON AUGUST 30.
- » THE BEARS AND TROJANS OPENED UP THE 2021 SEASON IN PETERSBURG, VA WITH LR COMING AWAY WITH A CONVINCING 48-7 VICTORY. THE BEARS HAVE WON THEIR PAST THREE STRAIGHT AGAINST CIAA TEAMS IN THE REGULAR SEASON.

BETWEEN THE BRICKS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS A 54-34-4 ALL-TIME RECORD IN HOME OPENERS DATING BACK TO 1924.
- » THE BEARS HAVE TON FOUR STRAIGHT HOME OPENERS WITH THE LAST LOSS COMING IN THE 2017 OPENER AGAINST WEST ALABAMA.
- » THIS WILL BE THE SECOND ALL-TIME HOME OPENER AGAINST VIRGINIA ST. WHO SPOILED THE 2016 DEBUT WITH A 34-9 VICTORY.

GRAYSON WILLINGHAM THREW THREE TOUCHDOWNS TO THREE DIFFERENCE RECEIVERS AND DWAYNE MCGEE HAD THREE TOTAL TDS (TWO RUSHING, ONE RECEIVING) IN THE VICTORY.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST THREE NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THIS SEASON.

STRONG IN SEPTEMBER

- » THE BEARS ARE NO STRANGER TO EARLY SEASON SUCCESS. SINCE THE START OF THE 2010 SEASON, LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS A 29-12 RECORD IN THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER.
- » LENOIR-RHYNE IS 2-1 IN THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER UNDER MIKE JACOBS.

HOME DOMINANCE

» SINCE THE START OF THE 2010 SEASON, LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS A RECORD OF 51-18 RECORD BETWEEN THE BRICKS AT MORETZ STADIUM. THE BEARS WILL LOOK FOR THEIR 52ND WIN IN THEIR PAST 70 HOME GAMES WHEN THE TROJANS COME TO TOWN ON SATURDAY.

PRESEASON ALL-LEAGUE

- » AFTER PLACING A PROGRAM-RECORD 16 PLAYERS ON THE ALL-CONFERENCE SQUAD IN 2021, THE BEARS HAD EIGHT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-SAC.
- » REIGNING SAC OFFENSIVE PLAYER AND FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR DWAYNE MCGEE LEADS THE LIST OF RETURNING ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS. IN ADDITION TO MCGEE, DEONDRE LESTER, BLAKE JEFFERSON, ANDRE JEFFERSON, JON ROSS MAYE AND BRYCE HEIDINGER WERE NAMED PRESEASON FIRST TEAM ALL-SAC.
- » KELIN PARSONS WAS NAMED A SECOND TEAMER AT WR AND RYAN CARTER EARNED A FIRST TEAM ALL-SAC RETURN SPECIALIST.

HOLES TO FILL

- » WHILE 8 RETURNING ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS FORM THE NUCLEUS OF THE 2022 SQUAD, LR HAS SOME BIG HOLES TO FILL. OB GRAYSON WILLINGHAM GRADUATES AS THE PROGRAM'S ALL-TIME RECORD LEADER IN JUST ABOUT EVERY PASSING CATEGORY. ONE OF HIS FAVORITE TARGETS IS PLAYING ON SUNDAY'S INSTEAD OF SATURDAY'S NOW WITH DAREKE YOUNG ON THE SEAHAWKS. ALONG THE OFFENSIVE LINE, IAN BRINSON STARTED 43 STRAIGHT GAMES AT RT,
- » DEFENSIVELY, LR HAS LOST THE SAC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN DT AMARI HOUSTON AND FELLOW DT DAN LOUBA ALSO GRADUATED. THE DUO FORMED PERHAPS THE BEST INTERIOR LINEMEN IN THE HISTORY OF LENOIR-RHYNE FOOTBALL. DO-EVERYTHING SAFETY ERIC JACKSON ALSO SAW HIS CAREER COME TO A CLOSE LAST YEAR AND HAS WON MULTIPLE RONNIE LOTT HEAVY HITTER OF THE YEAR AWARDS. STARTING LB PRESTON JOSEPH GRADUATED AND MADE THE MOST OF HIS ONE YEAR AS A STARTER AS HE LED THE BEARS WITH 72 TOTAL TACKLES IN 2021.
- » ON SPECIAL TEAMS, CHASE ALLBAUGH FINISHED HIS LR Career as the most prolific kicker in Team History and with a pair of SAC and NCAA records under his beit.

LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

A NEW ERA

- » SATURDAY WILL MARK THE FIRST SEASON-OPENER FOR THE BEARS WITHOUT GRAYSON WILLINGHAM UNDER CENTER (EXCLUDING THE COVID SEASON). WILLINGHAM SERVED AS THE STARTER FOR THE 2018, 2019 AND 2021 OPENERS AND SAW ACTION AS THE BACKUP IN THE INAGURUAL GAME OF 2017.
