THE FIRST ROAD TEST

» AFTER TWO HOME GAMES TO START THE 2022 CAMPAIGN, LENOIR-RHYNE HITS THE ROAD FOR THE FIRST TIME THIS YEAR TO GREENWOOD, S.C. TO TAKE ON ERSKINE FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 1951, AND THE FIRST TIME AS A CONFERENCE FOES.

» LR IS COMING OFF A 27-5 HOME LOSS TO DEFENDING NATIONAL CHAMPION AND NO. 1 TEAM IN THE NATION FERRIS STATE, BUT WILL TURN THE PAGE TO CONFERENCE PLAY AGAINST THE FLYING FLEET, WHO HAS JOINED THE SAC IN FOOTBALL STARTING THIS YEAR. ERSKINE AND LR ARE IN OPPOSITE DIVISIONS, THE BEARS ARE IN THE PIEDMONT DIVISION AND THE FLYING FLEET ARE IN THE MOUNTAIN DIVISION.

» LR WAS 4-3 IN ROAD GAMES LAST YEAR. THE TEAM PLAYED SEVEN OUT OF ITS 11 TOTAL GAMES AWAY FROM MORETZ STADIUM A YEAR AGO.

» THE BEARS ARE ALSO 6-3 OVERALL AWAY FROM MORETZ STADIUM UNDER HEAD COACH MIKE JACOBS.

UNFAMILIAR FOE

» AS MENTIONED ABOVE, THIS IS THE FIRST MEETING BETWEEN THE PROGRAMS SINCE 1951. LR HOLDS AN 8-4 EDGE IN THE OVERALL SERIES, BUT ERSKINE JUST RE-STARTED THE FOOTBALL PROGRAM IN 2020, SO THE 2022 SEASON IS THE THIRD YEAR OF THE PROGRAM'S EXISTENCE AFTER SEVERAL DECADES OF NOT HAVING A FOOTBALL TEAM.

» THE FLYING FLEET ARE 2-0 AND COMING OFF A NAIL-BITING WIN OVER CLARK ATLANTA UNIVERSITY BY A SCORE OF 23-19. ERSKINE'S FIRST GAME AGAINST NAIA FORT LAUDERDALE ENDED IN THE 2ND QUARTER WITH THE FLYING FLEET UP 49-2 AFTER FORT LAUDERDALE DIDN'T HAVE ENOUGH HEALTHY PLAYERS TO CONTINUE THE GAME.

» ERSKINE IS 6-13 IN 19 GAMES SINCE RESTARTING THE PROGRAM IN 2020.

» HEAD COACH SHAP BOYD TOOK OVER THE FLYING FLEET PROGRAM WHEN IT RESTARTED AFTER SPENDING THE PREVIOUS THREE SEASONS AS THE DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR AT UVA WISE, WHERE THE CAVALIER DEFENSE WAS RANKED 161ST OUT OF 167 IN THE COUNTRY WHEN HE ARRIVED, AND WHEN HE DEPARTED, UVA WISE WAS A TOP-30 DEFENSE IN THE NATION.

## LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

### NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST THREE NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THIS SEASON.

### CONFERENCE OPENER SUCCESS

- » THIS IS THE CONFERENCE OPENER FOR BOTH TEAMS IN 2022, AND LR HAS HAD A LOT OF SUCCESS IN CONFERENCE OPENERS OVER THE PAST 10 YEARS.
- » SINCE 2012, LENOIR-RHYNE HAS AN 8-2 RECORD IN CONFERENCE OPENING GAMES.

### HELD IN CHECK

- » LAST YEAR, LENOIR-RHYNE WAS THE TOP RUSHING OFFENSE IN THE SAC AND ONE OF THE BEST ON THE GROUND IN THE ENTIRE NATION. SO FAR IN 2022, THE BEAR OFFENSE HAS STRUGGLED TO FIND ITS FOOTING ON THE GROUND.
- » THROUGH THE FIRST TWO GAMES, THE BEARS HAVE ONLY RUSHED FOR A NET 110 YARDS, AND HAVE AVERAGED ONLY 1.7 YARDS PER CARRY. LAST YEAR, THE BEARS AVERAGED NEARLY SIX YARDS PER CARRY EN ROUTE TO A 2,600+ YARD RUSHING SEASON AS A TEAM.

### PRESEASON ALL-LEAGUE

- » AFTER PLACING A PROGRAM-RECORD 16 PLAYERS ON THE ALL-CONFERENCE SQUAD IN 2021, THE BEARS HAD EIGHT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-SAC.
- » REIGNING SAC OFFENSIVE PLAYER AND FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR DWAYNE MCGEE LEADS THE LIST OF RETURNING ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS. IN ADDITION TO MCGEE, DEONDRE LESTER, BLAKE JEFFERSON, ANDRE JEFFERSON, JON ROSS MAYE AND BRYCE HEIDINGER WERE NAMED PRESEASON FIRST TEAM ALL-SAC.
- » KELIN PARSONS WAS NAMED A SECOND TEAMER AT WR AND RYAN CARTER EARNED A FIRST TEAM ALL-SAC RETURN SPECIALIST.

### HOLES TO FILL

- » WHILE 8 RETURNING ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS FORM THE NUCLEUS OF THE 2022 SQUAD, LR HAS SOME BIG HOLES TO FILL. QB GRAYSON WILLINGHAM GRADUATES AS THE PROGRAM'S ALL-TIME RECORD LEADER IN JUST ABOUT EVERY PASSING CATEGORY. ONE OF HIS FAVORITE TARGETS IS PLAYING ON SUNDAY'S INSTEAD OF SATURDAY'S NOW WITH DAREKE YOUNG ON THE SEAHAWKS. ALONG THE OFFENSIVE LINE, IAN BRINSON STARTED 43 STRAIGHT GAMES AT RT,
- » DEFENSIVELY, LR HAS LOST THE SAC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN DT AMARI HOUSTON AND FELLOW DT DAN LOUBA ALSO GRADUATED. THE DUO FORMED PERHAPS THE BEST INTERIOR LINEMEN IN THE HISTORY OF LENOIR-RHYNE FOOTBALL. DO-EVERYTHING SAFETY ERIC JACKSON ALSO SAW HIS CAREER COME TO A CLOSE LAST YEAR AND HAS WON MULTIPLE RONNIE LOTT HEAVY HITTER OF THE YEAR AWARDS. STARTING LB PRESTON JOSEPH GRADUATED AND MADE THE MOST OF HIS ONE YEAR AS A STARTER AS HE LED THE BEARS WITH 72 TOTAL TACKLES IN 2021.
- » ON SPECIAL TEAMS, CHASE ALLBAUGH FINISHED HIS LR CAREER AS THE MOST PROLIFIC KICKER IN TEAM HISTORY AND WITH A PAIR OF SAC AND NCAA RECORDS UNDER HIS BELT.

## LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

### SHUTDOWN BY THE 'DOGS

- » FOR THE FIRST TIME IN THE LAST 10 YEARS, LENOIR-RHYNE'S OFFENSE WAS HELD TO LESS THAN 100 TOTAL YARDS AGAINST THE #1 FERRIS ST. BULLDOGS.
- » LR MANAGED JUST 16 YARDS RUSHING ON 32 CARRIES AND ONLY THREW THE BALL FOR 78 TOTAL YARDS.
- » THE BULLDOGS WERE CONSTANTLY PRESSURING SEAN WHITE, BRINGING DOWN THE QB SEVEN TIMES FOR A TOTAL OF 43 YARDS LOST.

### THIRD DOWN STRUGGLE

- » DESPITE BEING ONE OF THE BEST TEAMS IN DIVISION II IN THIRD DOWN CONVERSION PERCENTAGE IN 2021, THE BEARS WERE HELD TO JUST 1 OF 16 ON THIRD DOWNS AGAINST FERRIS STATE.
- » LAST YEAR, THE BEARS CONVERTED 52.7% OF THEIR THIRD DOWNS, FIFTH IN THE NATION AND BY FAR THE BEST MARK IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE.
- » IN THE SEASON OPENER AGAINST VIRGINIA STATE, LR STAYED ON PAR WITH THE 2021 SUCCESS, CONVERTING SIX OUT OF 12 THIRD DOWNS, INCLUDING FOUR CONVERSIONS IN THE 4TH QUARTER.

### WHITE EARNS THE START

- » SEAN WHITE EARNED HIS FIRST START OF 2022 AND JUST THE SECOND OF HIS CAREER. WHITE'S FIRST CAREER START CAME IN THE COVID-SPRING SEASON OF 2021 WHEN STARTING QB GRAYSON WILLINGHAM AND BACKUP QB GUNNAR ANDERSON WERE UNAVAILABLE AT NEWBERRY.
- » WHITE WENT 9-OF-24 FOR 78 YARDS AND AN INTERCEPTION AGAINST FERRIS ST.
- » IN HIS FIRST ACTION OF THE SEASON, WHITE CAME OFF THE BENCH IN THE SEASON OPENER AGAINST VIRGINIA ST. AND WENT 10-FOR-11. WHITE MISFIRED ON HIS FIRST PASS OF THE GAME BUT THEN REELED OFF 10 CONSECUTIVE COMPLETIONS.

### LESTER'S STREAK

- » WITH HIS FIRST-HALF RECEPTION AGAINST FERRIS

ST., WR DEONDRE LESTER EXTENDED HIS STREAK OF CONSECUTIVE GAMES WITH AT LEAST ONE RECEPTION TO 19 STRAIGHT GAMES.

- » HOWEVER, LESTER HAS BEEN HELD TO JUST ONE GRAB IN EACH OF THE FIRST TWO GAMES OF THE SEASON FOR JUST 23 YARDS.

### RUSHING SUCCESS

- » AS HAS BEEN A STAPLE OF THE LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE SINCE THE PROGRAM REACHED NEW HEIGHTS SINCE 2010, THE RUSHING GAME ONCE AGAINST RANKED AMONGST THE BEST.
- » LR FINISHED THE 2021 CAMPAIGN AS THE NINTH-BEST RUSHING OFFENSE WITH 237.9 YARDS RUSHING PER GAME.
- » LR LED THE NATION IN RUSHING OFFENSE FOR THREE STRAIGHT YEAR AND OWNS THE DIVISION II SINGLE-SEASON RECORD WITH 5,563 TARDS IN 2013.
- » LR WAS THE NATIONAL LEADER IN RUSHING YARDAGE PER GAME IN 2010, 2013, 2014 AND 2015.
- » PART OF THE REASON THE BEARS HAVE BEEN SO SUCCESSFUL ON THE GROUND IS DUE TO THE CONTINUITY UP FRONT. HEADING INTO THIS WEEK'S GAME WITH ERSKINE, THE BEARS HAVE 74 COMBINED STARTS ON THE PROJECTED STARTING OFFENSIVE LINE, INCLUDING RETURNING FOUR OUT OF THE FIVE STARTERS FROM LAST SEASON.

### HELD OUT OF THE ENDZONE

- » LR'S FIVE-POINT PERFORMANCE AGAINST FERRIS ST. CONSISTED OF A SAFETY AND A FIELD GOAL. THE BEARS WERE HELD OUT OF THE END ZONE OFFENSIVELY.
- » THE LAST GAME LENOIR-RHYNE WENT WITHOUT AN OFFENSIVE TOUCHDOWN WAS ON OCTOBER 22, 2016 WHEN THE BEARS WERE SHUT OUT BY MARS HILL BY A FINAL SCORE OF 49-0.
- » THAT SEASON, LR WENT BACK-TO-BACK GAMES WITHOUT AN OFFENSIVE TD AS THEY LOST TO WINGATE THE WEEK PRIOR 49-6 WITH A PAIR OF FIELD GOALS.

## LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

### SACK STREAK REACHES 56

- » IT HAS BEEN AN IMPRESSIVE RUN FOR THE LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSIVE UNIT, A UNIT THAT HAS RECORDED AT LEAST ONE SACK IN 56 CONSECUTIVE GAMES.
- » THE STREAK STARTED IN THE 2016 SEASON FINALE WITH A 3-SACK PERFORMANCE AGAINST CATAWBA AND HASN'T STOPPED.
- » 35 DIFFERENT PLAYERS HAVE RECORDED A SACK DURING THE STRETCH, LED BY 29 FROM JAQUAN ARTIS AND 25.5 FROM DAN LOUBA.
- » LR HAD TWO SACKS AGAINST NO. 1 FERRIS STATE, ONE COMING FROM ANDRE JEFFERSON AND ONE FROM WILLIE LANE.

### NEW LEADER

- » DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR JAHMAL BROWN LEFT FOR YOUNGSTOWN STATE FOLLOWING THE 2021 SEASON, LEAVING LR WITH A NEW DEFENSIVE LEADER.
- » SHAWN CHAFFEE WILL STEP UP AND AARON FOSTER WILL SERVE AS THE CO-DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR. CHAFFEE WAS THE DEFENSIVE LINE COACH SINCE HE CAME TO LR AND FOSTER WORKS WITH THE DEFENSIVE BACKS.

### CAN'T MOVE THE CHAINS

- » IT WAS INCREASINGLY DIFFICULT FOR OPPOSING OFFENSES TO SUSTAIN DRIVES AGAINST THIS LR DEFENSE A SEASON AGO, AND THAT TREND HAS CONTINUED IN 2022.
- » THE BEARS WERE FOURTH IN ALL OF DIVISION II IN THIRD DOWN CONVERSION DEFENSE AS THEY PERMITTED OPPONENTS TO CONVERT ON JUST 27.9 PERCENT OF THEIR THIRD DOWNS IN 2021.
