#### **RIVALRY WEEK**

- » LENOIR-RHYNE RETURNS HOME FOR THE THIRD TIME IN THE FIRST FOUR WEEKS AND HOSTS RIVAL CARSON-NEWMAN.
- » THE HEAD-TO-HEAD SERIES IS LOPSIDED IN THE EAGLES FAVOR BUT THE TABLES HAVE TURNED LATELY.
- » C-N WON A DIVISION II RECORD 31 STRAIGHT GAMES OVER LENOIR-RHYNE, SPANNING FROM NOVEMBER 1979 TO OCTOBER 2009.
- » SINCE SNAPPING THAT STREAK WITH A 52-14 WIN IN JEFFERSON CITY IN 2010. LR HAS WON 11 OF THE LAST 14 MATCHUPS WITH CARSON-NEWMAN.
- » OVER THE LAST 10 GAMES OF THE SERIES, THE BEARS HAVE GONE 9-1 WHICH WAS CAPPED BY LAST YEAR'S 59-0 WIN.
- » THE 59-POINT VICTORY OVER C-N WAS THE LARGEST MARGIN OF VICTORY FOR LR IN THE HEAD-TO-HEAD SERIES.
- » DWAYNE MCGEE TIED AN LR RECORD WITH FIVE RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS IN THAT GAME, THE MOST A C-N DEFENSE HAS EVER GIVEN UP TO A SINGLE RUSHER IN PROGRAM HISTORY.
- » MCGEE FINISHED WITH 200 YARDS ON THE GROUND, TIED FOR THE MOST IN A SINGLE GAME AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN IN THE NCAA ERA. 162 OF HIS YARDS AND FOUR OF HIS TOUCHDOWNS CAME IN THE FIRST HALF.
- » A WIN ON SATURDAY WOULD TIE THE LONGEST WINNING STREAK (5 GAMES) FOR LENOIR-RHYNE OVER CARSON-NEWMAN. LR ALSO WON FIVE STRAIGHT FROM 2013-2016.

#### **DIFFERENT DIVISIONS, SAME RIVALRY**

- » FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE INCEPTION OF THE SAC, THE LEAGUE HAS SPLIT INTO TWO DIVISIONS.
- » WHILE THE BEARS AND EAGLES ARE IN OPPOSITE DIVISIONS, THE TWO WILL MEET FOR THE 57TH CONSECUTIVE SEASON.
- » THE BEARS AND EAGLES HAVE MET EVERY YEAR SINCE 1965 BUT THE RIVALRY BEGAN BACK IN 1927 WITH A 12-O LENOIR-RHYNE VICTORY.

### **POSTSEASON PLAY**

- » THE TWO TEAMS HAVE MET IN THE NCAA PLAYOFFS IN 2012, 2013 AND 2019. LENOIR-RHYNE IS 2-1 IN THE PLAYOFFS AGAINST C-N.
- » THE MOST RECENT PLAYOFF BATLTLE WAS IN HICKORY IN 2019 WITH THE BEARS COMING AWAY WITH A 49-21 VICTORY. THE PREVIOUS TWO PLAYOFF BATTLES WERE DECIDED BY ONE POSSESSION.

#### RECAP

JEFFERSON CITY, TENN. – DWAYNE MCGEE RAN FOR 162 YARDS AND FOUR TOUCHOOWNS IN THE FIRST HALF AS LENOIR-RHYNE CRUISED TO A 59-0 VICTORY ON SATURDAY AFFENTOON. THREE OF MCGEE'S FOUR TOUCHDOWNS CAME IN THE FIRST QUARTER AS LR RAN OUT TO A 28-0 LEAD AFFER ONE QUARTER AND A 35-0 ADVANTAGE AT THE BREAK. THE 59-POINT WIN WAS THE LARGEST MARGIN OF VICTORY FOR THE BEARS IN THE ALL-TIME SERIES WITH CARSON-NEWMAN.

#### INSIDE THE MATCHUP:

FINAL: LENOIR-RHYNE 59, CARSON-NEWMAN O RECORDS: LENOIR-RHYNE (4-2, 3-2 SAC), CARSON-NEWMAN (0-6, 0-4 SAC)

#### STATS OF THE GAME

- MCGEE STARTED THE SCORING WITH A 5-YARD TOUCHDOWN RUN ON LR'S FIRST DRIVE OF THE GAME. AFTER FORCING A QUICK PUNT ON THE EAGLES' FIRST DRIVE, KELIN PARSONS TOOK A 40-YARD PASS FROM GRAYSON WILLINGHAM TO THE HOUSE.
- ON THAT CONNECTION, WILLINGHAM BECAME THE PROGRAM'S ALL-TIME LEADER IN CAREER PASSING YARDS. WILLINGHAM PASSED BRIAN BRYSON'S MARK OF 6,583 PASSING YARDS WHICH STOOD SINCE 1987.
- JUST OVER FIVE MINUTES LATER, MCGEE BROKE A 20-YARD RUN TO PUT THE BEARS UP 21-0 AND, WITH 14 SECONDS LEFT IN THE FIRST QUARTER, MCGEE BROKE FREE FOR 49 YARDS AS LR WENT UP 28-0.
- THE FINAL SCORE OF THE FIRST HALF CAME WITH 3:30 LEFT IN THE SECOND QUARTER AS MCGEE BURST THROUGH FOR 19 YARDS TO COMPLETE A HUGE FIRST 30 MINUTES.
- THE FIRST CARSON-NEWMAN DRIVE OF THE SECOND HALF
  RESULTED IN AN 85-YARD KICKOFF RETURN TO SET THE EAGLES UP AT
  THE EIGHT-YARD LINE. HOWEVER, THE BEARS HELD ON FOURTH DOWN

AND KEPT THE SHUTOUT INTACT.

- MCGEE EVENED THE SINGLE-GAME RECORD WITH HIS FIFTH RUSHING TD OF THE GAME ON THE ENSUING DRIVE, SCORING FROM FOUR YARDS OUT.
- LR WOULD EXTEND THE LEAD TO 49-0 WHEN WILLINGHAM HIT LESTER FOR A 38-YARD SCORE. THE CONNECTION GAVE WILLINGHAM A CAREER-HIGH 359 PASSING YARDS.
- GUNNAR ANDERSON SCORED ON A OB DRAW IN THE FOURTH QUARTER TO MAKE IT 56-0 AND A LATE CHASE ALLBAUGH FIELD GOAL WOULD BE THE FINAL SCORE FOR LR ON THE DAY.
- THE BEARS FINISHED WITH 750 TOTAL YARDS, THE MOST TOTAL YARDS BY A TEAM IN DIVISION II THIS YEAR. ALSO, THE 40 FIRST DOWNS ARE A SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE RECORD.

#### BEYOND THE BOXSCORE:

- · LENDIR-RHYNE HAS WON NINE OF THE LAST 10 HEAD-TO-HEAD MATCHUPS WITH CARSON-NEWMAN AND HASN'T LOST IN JEFFERSON CITY SINCE 2012.
- · JIMMY PALMER III HAD HIS FOURTH INTERCEPTION OF THE SEASON, PICKING OFF A PASS IN THE END ZONE.
- $\cdot$  McGee is just 27 yards shy of 1,000 on the season in the first six games of the year.
- MCGEE'S 200-YARD GAME IS JUST THE 15TH 200-YARD RUSHING GAME BY AN LR PLAYER IN THE NCAA ERA.
- · LENOIR-RHYNE RAN ITS STREAK OF CONSECUTIVE GAMES WITH AT LEAST ONE SACK TO 49 IN A ROW, THE LONGEST IN PROGRAM HISTORY.
- THE BEARS RECORDED THEIR FIRST SHUTOUT SINCE BLANKING BREVARD IN 2015. LR HANDED THE EAGLES THEIR FIRST SHUTOUT SINCE 1992, THE THIRD-LONGEST STREAK IN DII HISTORY.
- THE 59 POINTS SCORED WERE THE SECOND-MOST BY AN OPPOSING TEAM AT BURKE-TARR STADIUM.
- THIS WAS THE MOST YARDS A CARSON-NEWMAN TEAM EVER ALLOWED AND THE MOST YARDS PER PLAY EVER ALLOWED BY A CARSON-NEWMAN DEFENSE.



#### LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

#### **NFL-R**

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST THREE NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THIS SEASON.

#### **CONFERENCE OPENER SUCCESS**

- » LENOIR-RHYNE DEFEATED ERSKINE IN THE CONFERENCE OPENER LAST WEEK, 42-20.
- » SINCE 2012, LENOIR-RHYNE HAS A 9-2 RECORD IN CONFERENCE OPENING GAMES.

#### **BEAR TIES**

**Tusculum** 

- » TWO FORMER BEARS WILL BE ON THE VISITING SIDELINE ON SATURDAY.
- » ALL-AMERICAN OFFENSIVE LINEMAN AND JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY AWARD WINNER JOE RAY SERVES AS THE OFFENSIVE LINE COACH FOR THE EAGLES.
- » FORMER WR TRE LUTTRELL TRANSFERED TO CARSON-NEWMAN FROM LENOIR-RHYNE FOLLOWING THE 2021 SEASON. LUTTRELL JOINS HIS FATHER AND MOTHER WHO ALL WENT TO CARSON-NEWMAN. LUTTRELL'S BROTHER JACK PLAYS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE.

#### **RECENT STRUGGLES**

- » CARSON-NEWMAN SUFFERED A TOUGH 40-37 OVERTIME LOSS TO CONFERENCE FOE LIMESTONE LAST SATURDAY TO DROP TO 1-2 ON THE SEASON.
- » LIMESTONE WAS THE ONLY TEAM CARSON-NEWMAN BEAT IN A REBUILDING 2021 SEASON.
- » SINCE THE PLAYOFF RUN OF 2019, CARSON-NEWMAN HAS GONE 3-11 WITH WINS OVER UVA WISE, LIMESTONE AND FRANKLIN PIERCE.
- » HOWEVER, FEW DIVISION II PROGRAMS HAVE HAD THE ALL-TIME SUCCESS OF CARSON-NEWMAN. THE EAGLES WILL BE IN SEARCH OF ALL-TIME WIN 650. C-N OWNS A 649-354-32 ALL-TIME MARK WITH A .625 WINNING PERCENTAGE. THEY HAVE ALSO WON FIVE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS AND HAVE 16 NCAA PLAYOFF APPEARANCES.

#### **SAC MILESTONE**

- » THIS WILL BE THE 325TH SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE GAME IN LR'S HISTORY.
- » DESPITE RECENT SUCCESS, LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS AN ALL-TIME MARK OF 144-180 IN LEAGUE GAMES.
- » THE SAC DATES BACK TO 1975 WHEN IT WAS OFFICIALLY THE "SAC 8". THE BEARS WENT 6-0 THAT SEASON AND HAVE SIX UNDEFEATED SEASONS IN SAC HISTORY.
- » FIVE OF THOSE YEARS HAVE TAKEN PLACE SINCE 2013.
- » LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS A 12-35 ALL-TIME RECORD AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN IN SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE CONTESTS.
- » IN THE FIRST 47 SEASONS OF THE SAC, LR HAS CAPTURED EIGHT LEAGUE CROWNS AND HAVE FINISHED IN SECOND PLACE TWO TIMES, INCLUDING THEIR SECOND PLACE FINISH A SEASON AGO.
- » CARSON-NEWMAN HAS TAKEN HOME 21 SAC CHAMPIONSHIPS WITH THEIR LAST COMING IN 2009. C-N THREE-PEATED FROM 2007-2009 AND ALSO FROM 2002-04. THEY ALSO WON SEVEN IN A ROW FROM 1993-99.
