RETRIBUTION WEEK

» LENOIR-RHYNE ENTERS WEEK FIVE OF THE 2022 SEASON LOOKING FOR A LITTLE RETRIBUTION. AFTER A 63-7 WIN OVER UVA WISE IN 2019, THE BEARS WERE STUNNED BY THE CAVALIERS IN 2021 BY A 35-28 DEFEAT. THAT LOSS COST LR AT LEAST A SHARE OF THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP AS THEY FINISHED ONE GAME BEHIND NEWBERRY IN THE FINAL STANDINGS.

» THAT WAS JUST THE SECOND ALL-TIME MATCHUP BETWEEN THE TWO SQUADS AND THE FIRST AT WISE IN THE HISTORY OF THE MATCHUP. UVA WISE ENTERED THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE PRIOR TO THE 2019 SEASON.

» THIS WILL BE THE SECOND STRAIGHT MEETING AT UVA WISE. LR ALSO TRAVELS TO BARTON FOR A SECOND STRAIGHT SEASON LATER THIS YEAR.

FRIDAY AFTERNOON FOOTBALL

» DUE TO IMPENDING WEATHER CONDITIONS FROM HURRICANE IAN THIS WEEKEND, THE GAME WAS MOVED FROM A SATURDAY CONTEST TO A FRIDAY GAME WITH A 3 PM KICKOFF.

» THE LAST TIME A GAME WAS MOVED MID-WEEK DUE TO WEATHER CAME BACK IN 2018 WHEN LR HOSTED MARS HILL ON A THURSDAY AFTERNOON WITH A 2 PM KICKOFF.

» LR HANDLED MARS HILL 59-27 THAT AFTERNOON AS A TROPICAL STORM WAS SCHEDULED TO HIT THE SOUTHEAST THAT WEEKEND.

» THIS IS THE FIRST KNOWN FRIDAY AFTERNOON GAME IN THE NCAA ERA FOR LR FOOTBALL.

OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS

» THE TWO TEAMS ARE HEADING IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS HEADING INTO FRIDAY'S MATCHUP. THE BEARS ARE 2-0 IN LEAGUE PLAY AND THEIR ONLY LOSS WAS TO #1 AND DEFENDING NATIONAL CHAMPION FERRIS STATE. LR HAS HANDLED ERSKINE AND CARSON-NEWMAN BY A COMBINED 43 POINTS IN THE PAST TWO WEEKS.

» UVA WISE HAS DROPPED THREE STRAIGHT SINCE A SEASON-OPENING WIN OVER DIVISION III FERRUM.

» IN THEIR LAST TWO GAMES, UVA WISE FELL TO SAC FOES BARTON AND LIMESTONE BY A COMBINED 34 POINTS.

» THIS WILL BE THE THIRD HOME GAME THIS SEASON FOR UVA WISE WHO HAVE GONE 1-1 IN THEIR FIRST TWO HOME CONTESTS.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST THREE NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THIS SEASON.

RANKED SUCCESS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE ENTERS THE WEEKEND RANKED NO. 19 IN THE MOST RECENT AFCA NATIONAL POLL. THE BEARS DROPPED ONE SPOT DESPITE BEATING CARSON-NEWMAN BY THREE TOUCHDOWNS.
- » LR IS 43-10 AS A NATIONALLY RANKED TEAM, DATING BACK TO THE START OF THE AFCA POLL IN 2000.
- » THE BEARS ARE 19-6 ON THE ROAD AS A NATIONALLY RANKED SQUAD ALTHOUGH ONE OF THOSE LOSSES CAME IN 2021 AT UVA WISE.
- » THE BEARS ENTERED LAST YEAR'S MATCHUP AS THE NO. 16 TEAM IN THE AFCA POLL BUT DROPPED OUT OF THE NATIONAL RANKINGS FOR THE REST OF THE SEASON WITH THE LOSS TO WISE.
- » THIS IS THE 64TH WEEK THAT LENOIR-RHYNE HAS BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED. THE BEARS WERE NEVER RANKED FROM 2000-12 BUT HAVE BEEN RANKED IN EIGHT OF THE PAST 10 SEASONS.

- » JACOBS WINS 77.8 PERCENT OF HIS ROAD GAMES AND IS ONE OF JUST TWO ACTIVE DIVISION II HEAD COACHES WITH AT LEAST FIVE SEASONS COACHING TO HAVE A WINNING PERCENTAGE ABOVE .808 OVERALL.
- » AT LENOIR-RHYNE, JACOBS OWNS A MARK OF 7-3 RECORD IN HIS FIRST 10 ROAD GAMES.

LOOKING FOR NUMBER 15

- » MIKE JACOBS OWNS A 14-5 OVERALL RECORD IN HIS TIME AS LR HEAD COACH.
- » JACOBS IS LOOKING TO GARNER HIS 15TH WIN IN HIS 20TH GAME AS A HEAD COACH.
- » IN LR HISTORY, ONLY DREW CRONIC, IAN SHIELDS, MIKE HOUSTON AND HANLEY PAINTER HAVE WON 15 OF THEIR FIRST 20 GAMES AT LR.

- » SATURDAY AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN WAS THE 325TH SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE GAME IN LR'S HISTORY.
- » DESPITE RECENT SUCCESS, LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS AN ALL-TIME MARK OF 145-180 IN LEAGUE GAMES.
- » THE SAC DATES BACK TO 1975 WHEN IT WAS OFFICIALLY THE "SAC 8". THE BEARS WENT 6-0 THAT SEASON AND HAVE SIX UNDEFEATED SEASONS IN SAC HISTORY.
- » FIVE OF THOSE YEARS HAVE TAKEN PLACE SINCE 2013.
- » IN THE FIRST 47 SEASONS OF THE SAC, LR HAS CAPTURED EIGHT LEAGUE CROWNS AND HAVE FINISHED IN SECOND PLACE TWO TIMES, INCLUDING THEIR SECOND PLACE FINISH A SEASON AGO.

PASS PROTECTION KEY

- » IN LAST SEASON'S LOSS AT UVA WISE, THE CAVALIERS BROUGHT DOWN QB GRAYSON WILLINGHAM 6 TIMES WHICH COST THE LR OFFENSE 45 YARDS.
- » THE SIX SACKS WERE THE MOST ALLOWED BY LENOIR-RHYNE IN THE NCAA ERA UNTIL FERRIS STATE EXPLODED FOR SEVEN SACKS IN WEEK TWO OF THE 2022 SEASON.
- » PRIOR TO THOSE TWO GAMES, NO TEAM HAD SACKED LR MORE THAN FOUR TIMES IN A GAME.

ATTACK THROUGH THE AIR

- » WITH LR TRAILING UVA WISE LAST YEAR, THEY TURNED TO THE PASSING GAME.
- » LR ATTEMPTED 49 PASSES AGAINST WISE, THE SIXTH-MOST IN A SINGLE GAME DURING THE NCAA ERA.
- » THE 49 PASS ATTEMPTS WERE THE MOST SINCE LR ATTEMPTED 51 AT MARS HILL IN 2017 IN A 43-28 LOSS TO THE LIONS.
- » GRAYSON WILLINGHAM THREW THREE INTERCEPTIONS IN THE GAME, A CAREER HIGH.

LESTER CLIMBING THE CHARTS

- » DEONDRE LESTER MADE SEVEN GRABS AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN TO TOP 100 CAREER RECEPTIONS.
- » LESTER'S 102 CAREER GRABS PLACE HIM 10TH IN PROGRAM HISTORY AS HE PASSED NICK STUTTS' 99 CAREER GRABS TO MOVE INTO THE TOP 10.
- » LESTER STILL HAS ALL OF THIS YEAR AND NEXT YEAR TO MOVE UP THE CHARTS AND TRY TO CHASE DOWN TERENCE STEWARD'S MARK OF 247 CAREER CATCHES.

- » DWAYNE MCGEE HAS RUSHED FOR 100 YARDS IN EACH OF THE BEARS LAST TWO GAMES, EACH COMING ON 20 CARRIES.
- » THIS GIVES MCGEE 13 CAREER 100-YARD RUSHING GAMES, TRAILING ONLY LEONARD DAVIS FOR THE MOST 100-YARD RUSHING GAMES.
- » MCGEE'S 100-YARD GAME AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN WAS THE 177TH 100-YARD GAME FOR A LENOIR-RHYNE RUNNING BACK DURING THE NCAA ERA.

- » THIS MARKED JUST THE 21ST TIME IN THE PAST 12 YEARS THAT LR WENT THROUGH A GAME WITHOUT TURNING THE BALL OVER ONCE.
- » THE BEARS ARE NOW 19-2 IN GAMES WHERE THEY DON'T GIVE THE BALL AWAY.
- » WHITE FINISHED THE AFTERNOON WITH A SOLID LINE OF 208 YARDS PASSING ON 17-OF-28 COMPLETIONS TO GO WITH A TOUCHDOWN STRIKE.

LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

SACK STREAK REACHES 58

» IT HAS BEEN AN IMPRESSIVE RUN FOR THE LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSIVE UNIT, A UNIT THAT HAS RECORDED AT LEAST ONE SACK IN 58 CONSECUTIVE GAMES.

» THE STREAK STARTED IN THE 2016 SEASON FINALE WITH A 3-SACK PERFORMANCE AGAINST CATAWBA AND HASN'T STOPPED SINCE.

» 37 DIFFERENT PLAYERS HAVE RECORDED A SACK DURING THE STRETCH, LED BY 29 FROM JAQUAN ARTIS AND 25.5 FROM DAN LOUBA.

» LR HAD TWO SACKS AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN LAST WEEK, ONE FROM ANDRE JEFFERSON AND ONE FROM DOMONIQUE DAVIS, WHO BECAME THE 37TH PLAYER TO ADD HIS NAME TO THE LIST.

» LR HAS HAD AT LEAST FIVE SACKS IN A GAME 12 TIMES DURING THE STREAK.

NEW LEADER

» DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR JAHMAL BROWN LEFT FOR YOUNGSTOWN STATE FOLLOWING THE 2021 SEASON, LEAVING LR WITH A NEW DEFENSIVE LEADER.

» SHAWN CHAFFEE WILL STEP UP AND AARON FOSTER WILL SERVE AS THE CO-DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR. CHAFFEE WAS THE DEFENSIVE LINE COACH SINCE HE CAME TO LR AND FOSTER WORKS WITH THE DEFENSIVE BACKS.

GROUNDING THE EAGLES

» CARSON-NEWMAN CAME INTO LAST WEEK'S MATCHUP LEADING THE SAC IN RUSHING, PUTTING UP 245 YARDS PER GAME.

» THE EAGLES WERE HELD TO JUST 104 RUSHING YARDS AGAINST THE BEAR DEFENSE, AVERAGING JUST 3.3 YARDS PER CARRY.

KING PERCY

» PERCY KING PICKED OFF TWO PASSES AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN, TAKING THE FIRST ONE BACK 31 YARDS TO THE END ZONE FOR A PICK-SIX AND THE FIRST DEFENSIVE TOUCHDOWN OF THE YEAR FOR LR. KING NOW HAS THREE PICK-SIXES IN HIS CAREER.

THE BIG MATCHUP

» UVA WISE QUARTERBACK LONDON REDWINE LEADS THE SAC IN PASSING YARDS PER GAME WITH 225.0, AND THE CAVALIERS AS A TEAM ARE SECOND IN THE SAC IN PASSING OFFENSE PER GAME (232.0). ONE YARD BEHIND LIMESTONE FOR THE TOP SPOT IN THE LEAGUE.

» LR'S DEFENSE IS 5TH IN THE SAC IN YARDS ALLOWED PER GAME THROUGH THE AIR, GIVING UP 161.0 PER GAME.

» LAST YEAR, THE BEARS HAD SIX TACKLES-FOR-LOSS AGAINST UVA WISE.
