BARTON WEEK

- » THE TWO TEAMS WITH THE BEST OVERALL RECORD IN THE SAC MATCHUP ON SATURDAY AS THE BARTON BULLDOGS COME TO HICKORY TO TAKE ON THE BEARS.
- » BARTON WILL BRING A 5-1 RECORD TO MORETZ STADIUM AND THE BEARS WILL PUT THEIR PERFECT 6-0 MARK ON THE LINE.
- » BARTON IS JUST ONE GAME BEHIND THE BEARS IN THE SAC STANDINGS AT 3-1 WITH THE LONE LOSS COMING AT MARS HILL.
- » A WIN FOR THE BEARS WOULD GO A LONG WAY TO CLINCHING THE PIEDMONT DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIP BUT THE BULLDOGS COULD TAKE THE DRIVERS SEAT WITH A WIN AND THE TIEBREAKER OVER LR.

STREAKS ON THE LINE

- » LR WON THE FINAL TWO GAMES OF THE 2022 SEASON AND HAVE RATTLED OFF SIX STRAIGHT WINS TO START 2023. THE EIGHT GAME WINNING STREAK IS TIED FOR THE SECOND LONGEST IN ALL OF NCAA DIVISION II.
- » THE BEARS TRAIL ONLY HARDING (10 IN A ROW) FOR THE LONGEST CURRENT WINNING STREAK IN DIVISION II. WESTERN COLORADO HAS ALSO WON EIGHT STRAIGHT.
- » FOR JUST THE THIRD TIME SINCE 1970, THE LENOIR-RHYNE BEARS HAVE STARTED A SEASON WITH A PERFECT 6-0 RECORD.
- » THE OTHER SEASONS THAT STARTED 6-0 FOR THE BEARS CAME BACK IN 2014 AND 2019.
- » NOT ONLY ARE THE BEARS PUTTING THE SECOND-LONGEST OVERALL WINNING STREAK ON THE LINE, LR HAS ALSO NEVER LOST TO BARTON (FORMERLY ATLANTIC CHRISTIAN) IN HISTORY. THE BEARS ARE A PERFECT 12-0 AGAINST THE BULLDOGS.
- » LR ALSO HAS WON SEVEN STRAIGHT CONFERENCE GAMES, THE EIGHTH-LONGEST STRING IN DII.

- » LENOIR-RHYNE COMES INTO SATURDAY RANKED NO. 12 IN THE AFCA NATIONAL POLL AND NO. 13 IN THE D2FOOTBALL.COM POLL.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SAC DOMINANCE

- » THE BEARS COME INTO SATURDAY AS THE CLASS OF THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE SINCE 2010. THE BEARS HAVE SEVEN MORE OVERALL WINS THAN ANY OTHER TEAM IN THE LEAGUE DURING THAT TIME AND 11 MORE WINS IN SAC PLAY THAN ANY OTHER TEAM.
- » THE BEARS OWN 74 LEAGUE WINS, FOLLOWED BY WINGATE WITH 63. AFTER THE BULLDOGS, CARSON-NEWMAN IS THE NEXT HIGHEST WITH 53.
- » THE BEARS HAVE WON EIGHT NCAA PLAYOFF GAMES SINCE 2010, TWICE AS MANY AS ANY OTHER PROGRAM IN THE LEAGUE.

QUICK STARTERS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS HAD THE BALL FIRST IN ALL SIX GAMES THIS SEASON.
- » IN THE FIRST TWO GAMES, LR WON THE TOSS AND ELECTED TO GET THE BALL FIRST.
- » THE BEARS HAVE SCORED TOUCHDOWNS ON THEIR OPENING POSSESSION IN EACH OF THE PAST FOUR GAMES.
- » IN ALL SIX GAMES, THE BEARS HAVE SCORED FIRST. SINCE 2010, WHEN THE BEARS SCORE FIRST, THEY OWN AN 82-12 RECORD.

WEEK 6 WRAPUP

- » THE BEARS WERE PUSHED TO THE LIMIT BY LIMESTONE LAST SATURDAY, ESCAPING BY A FINAL SCORE OF 31-28 IN OVERTIME.
- » JAKE BROWN KICKED A GAME-WINNING 20-YARD FIELD GOAL IN OT TO GIVE THE BEARS THEIR FIRST WALKOFF FIELD GOAL SINCE BRYCE RIEGER DID SO AGAINST PRESBYTERIAN ON SEPT. 25, 1999.
- » DESPITE BEING OUTGAINED 516-282, THE BEARS DID ENOUGH TO COME AWAY WITH THE WIN. THEY DID SO THANKS TO A BLOCKED FIELD GOAL WHICH WAS RETURNED 84 YARDS FOR A TOUCHDOWN BY T.J. BLANDING.
- » DWAYNE MCGEE RAN THE BALL 24 TIMES FOR 130 YARDS AND DEONDRE LESTER CAUGHT A TOUCHDOWN PASS ON THE OFFENSIVE SIDE OF THE BALL. DEFENSIVELY,

THE BEARS FORCED THREE LIMESTONE TURNOVERS, ALL ON INTERCEPTIONS, IN THE WIN. JON ROSS MAYE LED THE BEARS WITH 12 TOTAL TACKLES AND LR ACCOUNTED FOR THREE SACKS AS A TEAM.

BIG RETURN FOR BLANDING

- » ON OCTOBER 15, 2022, DEFENSIVE BACK T.J. BLANDING SUFFERED A GRUESOME BROKEN LEG AT BARTON WHICH LEFT HIS FOOTBALL PLAYING CAREER IN DOUBT.
- » NOT ONLY DID HE FIGHT HIS WAY BACK TO THE FIELD, BLANDING WAS A BIG REASON THE BEARS CAME AWAY VICTORIOUS ON SATURDAY. HE HAD AN INTERCEPTION IN THE SECOND HALF AND HAD THE GAME-TYING SCORE ON THE 84 YARD BLOCKED FIELD GOAL RETURN WHICH EARNED HIM SAC SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS.

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS. HOWEVER, YOUNG IS ON IR CURRENTLY.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS. HE WAS SIGNED BY THE JETS AND IS A MEMBER OF THEIR PRACTICE SQUAD FOR THE START OF THE 2023 SEASON.

LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

» **MCGEE RUNNING WILD**

- » DWAYNE MCGEE IS COMING OFF ANOTHER STRONG PERFORMANCE THAT SAW HIM FINISH WITH 24 CARRIES FOR 130 YARDS AT LIMESTONE AND A TOUCHDOWN
- » THE RUSHING TOUCHDOWN BOOSTS HIS CAREER TOTAL TO 41 WHICH MAKES HIM ONE OF JUST FOUR PLAYERS IN LR HISTORY TO TOP 40 CAREER RUSHING TDS.
- » MCGEE IS FOURTH IN PROGRAM HISTORY AND TRAILS HAROLD BULLARD (43), STEVE TRUDNAK (47) AND LEONARD DAVIS (58) ON THE ALL-TIME LIST.
- » IN TOTAL, MCGEE HAS 44 TOUCHDOWNS WITH THREE COMING THROUGH THE AIR. HE IS THIRD ALL-TIME IN TOTAL TOUCHDOWNS AND TRAILS TRUDNAK (47) AND DAVIS (59) IN THAT CATEGORY.
- » MCGEE PASSED CARL BARTLES FOR SECOND PLACE ON THE ALL-TIME RUSHING LIST. HE ENTERED THE GAME NEEDING 111 YARDS TO MOVE INTO SECOND PLACE AND NOW TRAILS JUST LEONARD DAVIS.

ZTK STEPPING UP

- » ZAYVION TURNER-KNOX HAS SEEN HIS ROLE EXPAND WITH THE BEARS AND IS AVERAGING 8.6 YARDS PER CARRY FOR LR THIS YEAR.
- » TURNER-KNOX HAS FOUR RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS AND HAS 276 YARDS RUSHING ON HIS 32 CARRIES WITH A LONG OF 43.
- » AGAINST LIMESTONE, THE BACKUP RB HAD SEVEN CARRIES FOR 45 YARDS AGAINST LIMESTONE WITH MANY COMING DOWN THE STRECH IN REGULATION AND IN OVERTIME.

MALAKEI CAN

- » HICKORY NATIVE MALAKEI SUMNER HAS BEEN ONE OF THE MOST EXPLOSIVE RECEIVERS IN THE SAC THIS SEASON.
- » THE JUNIOR HAS EIGHT GRABS FOR 186 YARDS AND IS AVERAGING 23.3 YARDS PER CATCH TO GO WITH A PAIR OF TOUCHDOWNS.
- » SUMNER HAS A LONG OF 68 YARDS AND HIS YPC AVERAGE IS AMONG THE LEADERS IN THE CONFERENCE.

SCORING WITH EASE

- » THE BEARS ARE CURRENTLY RANKED NO. 1 IN THE SOUTH

ATLANTIC CONFERENCE FOR AVERAGING 42.2 POINTS PER GAME; THE NUMBER IS ALSO GOOD ENOUGH FOR 12TH MOST IN DIVISION II.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- » THE BEARS RANK 10TH IN ALL OF DIVISION II IN TURNOVERS LOST WITH JUST FOUR GIVEAWAYS.
- » LR HASN'T HAD A FUMBLE ALL SEASON AND HAD GONE FOUR STRAIGHT GAMES WITHOUT COMMITTING A TURNOVER BEFORE THROW A PAIR OF PICKS AT LIMESTONE.
- » AFTER THROWING TWO INTERCEPTIONS IN THE SEASON-OPENING WIN OVER ST. AUGUSTINE'S, LENOIR-RHYNE QUARTERBACKS WENT 118 STRAIGHT ATTEMPTS WITHOUT THROWING A PICK.
- » SINCE 2010, THE BEARS HAVE HAD 26 GAMES WHERE THEY DIDN'T TURN THE BALL OVER AND FOUR OF THOSE SUCH OCCASSIONS HAVE COME IN THE PAST FOUR WEEKS.
- » THE BEARS OWN A 24-2 RECORD IN THOSE 26 GAMES WHERE THEY DIDN'T TURN THE BALL OVER SINCE THE START OF THE 2010 SEASON.

X FACTOR

- » MALIK SIMMONS IS A TOUCHDOWN MACHINE FOR LR. THE TE, WHO WAS THE PIEDMONT DIVISION'S FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR LAST YEAR, HAS SEVEN RECEIVING TOUCHDOWNS IN HIS CAREER ON JUST 17 CAREER CATCHES.

O-LINE STRENGTH

- » LENOIR-RHYNE BOASTS A PAIR OF THE BEST OFFENSIVE LINEMEN IN THE LEAGUE.
- » CENTER BLAKE JEFFERSON HAS BEEN A STARTER SINCE STEPPING FOOT ON CAMPUS BACK IN 2019 AND HAS STARTED AT CENTER EVER SINCE.
- » JEFFERSON WAS A PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTION AND WAS NAMED ALL-SAC EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS.
- » XAVIER JENNINGS ALSO HAS STARTED AT LT SINCE STEPPING ON TO CAMPUS IN THE COVID SEASON OF 2020-21 BEFORE SHIFTING TO LG THIS YEAR. HE HAS STARTED EVERY GAME OF HIS CAREER AND HASN'T MISSED A SINGLE CONTEST.
- » THE ENTIRE STARTING LINE HAS HAD THE SAME STARTER AT EACH POSITION EVERY GAME THIS SEASON.

LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

CHALLENGE SCORING

- » THE BEARS CURRENTLY HAVE THE SECOND-BEST SCORING DEFENSE IN ALL OF DIVISION II WITH ALLOWING ON 9.2 POINTS PER GAME. THE ONLY PROGRAM THAT RANKS BETTER IS BENEDICT, WHICH AVERAGES 6.2 POINTS PER GAME.
- » IN OVERALL DEFENSE, THE BEARS HAVE THE FOURTH-BEST TOTAL DEFENSE BY ALLOWING ONLY 216 YARDS PER GAME. THAT NUMBER ONLY TRAILS BENEDICT, WHICH AVERAGES 164 YARDS PER GAME.

ATOP THE NATION

- » LR HAS THE SECOND-BEST RED ZONE DEFENSE IN DIVISION II BY ALLOWING POINTS ON ONLY HALF OF OPPONENTS' TRIPS INSIDE THE 20.
