SEEKING PAYBACK

- » GOING AGAINST ONE OF JUST TWO TEAMS WHO LENOIR-RHYNE HAS A CURRENT LOSING STREAK AGAINST, THE BEARS HEAD TO NEWBERRY LOOKING FOR A MEASURE OF REVENGE ON SATURDAY.
- » THE BEARS HAVE ACTUALLY DROPPED TWO STRAIGHT TO NEWBERRY. LR FELL AT SETZLER FIELD IN THE 2021 SEASON BY A FINAL OF 28-21 AND THEN NEWBERRY PULLED OUT A 38-24 WIN AT MORETZ STADIUM IN 2022.
- » LR'S LAST WIN OVER NEWBERRY WAS A DRAMATIC VICTORY IN THE SPRING SEASON OF 2020-21. THE BEARS SQUEAKED OUT A 27-20 WIN IN OVERTIME AS SEAN WHITE, MAKING HIS FIRST CAREER START, THREW A TOUCHDOWN PASS TO KELIN PARSONS IN OVERTIME. KEYGAN MAYFIELD MAKE THE GAMEWINNING INTERCEPTION ON NEWBERRY'S OFFENSIVE POSSESSION TO GIVE LR THE VICTORY.
- » NEWBERRY WON THE PAST TWO SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS, ENDING LR'S BACK-TO-BACK TITLE RUN IN 2018 AND 2019.

BISHOPS TROPHY

- » THE TWO SCHOOLS HAVE BEEN PLAYING FOR THE BISHOPS TROPHY SINCE 1987. THE BEARS HOLD A 19-17 EDGE IN THE TROPHY SERIES. OVERALL, LENOIR-RHYNE LEADS THE ALL-TIME SERIES 47-35-7.
- » HOWEVER, SINCE 2015, NEWBERRY HOLDS A 5-3 EDGE IN THE SERIES. THE WOLVES ARE THE ONLY TEAM THE BEARS HAVE A LOSING RECORD TO IN THAT TIME FRAME.
- » THE WINNER KEEPS THE BISHOPS' TROPHY FOR THE YEAR AND PUTS IT ON THE LINE THE FOLLOWING SEASON.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

- » FOR THE 33RD TIME IN THE NCAA ERA, THE LENOIR-RHYNE BEARS ARE RANKED IN THE TOP 10 IN THE NATION ACCORDING TO THE RECENTLY RELEASED AFCA NATIONAL POLL. THE BEARS CHECK IN AT NO. 10 IN THAT POLL AND ARE NO. 12 IN THE D2F00TBALL.COM POLL.
- » THE BEARS ARE OWNERS OF A 54-12 RECORD WHEN THEY PLAY AS A NATIONALLY RANKED TEAM.
- » ON THE ROAD AS A NATIONALLY RANKED TEAM, LENDIR-RHYNE OWNS A 24-6
- » ONE OF THOSE LOSSES AS A NATIONALLY RANKED SQUAD ON THE ROAD CAME IN THE 2021 MEETING AS THE BEARS ENTERED AS THE NO. 5 TEAM IN THE NATION.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SAC DOMINANCE

- » THE BEARS COME INTO SATURDAY AS THE CLASS OF THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE SINCE 2010. THE BEARS HAVE SEVEN MORE OVERALL WINS THAN ANY OTHER TEAM IN THE LEAGUE DURING THAT TIME AND 11 MORE WINS IN SAC PLAY THAN ANY OTHER TEAM.
- » THE BEARS OWN 75 LEAGUE WINS, FOLLOWED BY WINGATE WITH 64. AFTER THE BULLDOGS, CARSON-NEWMAN IS THE NEXT HIGHEST WITH 54.
- » THE BEARS HAVE WON EIGHT NCAA PLAYOFF GAMES SINCE 2010. TWICE AS MANY AS ANY OTHER PROGRAM IN THE LEAGUE.

QUICK STARTERS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS HAD THE BALL FIRST IN ALL SEVEN GAMES THIS SEASON.
- » IN THE FIRST TWO GAMES AND THEN THE MOST RECENT CONTEST, LR WON THE TOSS AND ELECTED TO GET THE BALL FIRST.
- » THE BEARS HAVE SCORED TOUCHDOWNS ON THEIR OPENING POSSESSION IN EACH OF THE PAST FIVE GAMES.
- » IN ALL SEVEN GAMES, THE BEARS HAVE SCORED FIRST. SINCE 2010, WHEN THE BEARS SCORE FIRST, THEY OWN AN 83-12 RECORD.

WEEK 7 WRAPUP

Catawba Tusculum

- » THE BEARS CRUISED PAST CATAWBA WITH A DOMINATING 47-3 VICTORY. AFTER ALLOWING BARTON TO KICK A FIELD GOAL ON THEIR OPENING DRIVE. THE BEARS KEPT THE BULLDOGS OFF THE SCOREBOARD THE REST OF THE GAME AND ENDED THE CONTEST BY SCORING 40 UNANSWERED POINTS.
- » THE BEARS DEFENSE ALLOWED JUST 148 YARDS OF OFFENSE AND EIGHT TOTAL FIRST DOWNS TO THE BULLDOGS WHO CAME INTO THE GAME WITH ONE OF THE TOP RUNNING BACKS IN THE NATION BUT WERE HELD TO JUST 69 YARDS RUSHING AND 2.5 YARDS PER ATTEMPT.
- » NEWBERRY IS COMING OFF A 38-31 WIN OVER CATAWBA ON HOMECOMING AS BOTH LR AND NEWBERRY CELEBRATED

HOMECOMING LAST WEEK. NEWBERRY RAN FOR 372 YARDS IN THE WIN WITH DWAYNE WRIGHT AND TRAKELL MURRAY COMBING FOR 238 AND THREE TOUCHDOWNS. OB JY TOLEN HAD 1184 TOTAL YARDS AND A RUSHING TOUCHDOWN.

BIG RETURN FOR BLANDING

- » ON OCTOBER 15, 2022, DEFENSIVE BACK T.J. BLANDING SUFFERED A GRUESOME BROKEN LEG AT BARTON WHICH LEFT HIS FOOTBALL PLAYING CAREER IN DOUBT.
- » NOT ONLY DID HE FIGHT HIS WAY BACK TO THE FIELD, BLANDING HAS PLAYED A BIG ROLE. HE HAS HAD INTERCEPTIONS IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES AND AN 84-YARD BLOCKED FIELD GOAL HE RETURNED FOR A TD AGAINST LIMESTONE.

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS. HOWEVER, YOUNG IS ON IR CURRENTLY.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS. HE WAS SIGNED BY THE JETS AND IS A MEMBER OF THEIR PRACTICE SQUAD FOR THE START OF THE 2023 SEASON.

LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

» MCGEE RUNNING WILD

- » DWAYNE MCGEE IS COMING OFF ANOTHER STRONG PERFORMANCE THAT SAW HIM FINISH WITH 15 CARRIES FOR 92 YARDS AGAINST BARTON AND A TOUCHDOWN THROUGH THE AIR AND ON THE GROUND.
- » THE RUSHING TOUCHDOWN BOOSTS HIS CAREER TOTAL TO 42 WHICH MAKES HIM ONE OF JUST FOUR PLAYERS IN LR HISTORY TO TOP 40 CAREER RUSHING TDS.
- » MCGEE IS FOURTH IN PROGRAM HISTORY AND TRAILS HAROLD BULLARD (43), STEVE TRUDNAK (47) AND LEONARD DAVIS (58) ON THE ALL-TIME LIST.
- » IN TOTAL, MCGEE HAS 46 TOUCHDOWNS WITH THREE COMING THROUGH THE AIR. HE IS THIRD ALL-TIME IN TOTAL TOUCHDOWNS AND TRAILS TRUDNAK (47) AND DAVIS (59) IN THAT CATEGORY.
- » MCGEE PASSED CARL BARTLES FOR SECOND PLACE ON THE ALL-TIME RUSHING LIST WITH 3,789 YARDS IN HIS 32 GAMES.

FERG SHOWS OUT

» A GAME-TIME DECISION LAST WEEK, QB JALEN FERGUSON MADE THE START AFTER SUFFERING AN INJURY AT LIMESTONE THE WEEK BEFORE AND WAS EXTREMELY EFFICIENT. FERGUSON HIT 19-OF-24 PASSES FOR 241 YARDS AND THREE TOUCHDOWNS WITHOUT AN INTERCEPTION. FERGUSON CONNECTED ON A LONG BALL OF 48 YARDS TO LESTER WHO CAUGHT TWO OF HIS THREE TD'S ON THE DAY.
» FERGUSON STILL HASN'T THROWN AN INTERCEPTION IN HIS CAREER. HE HAS TOSSED 91 CAREER ATTEMPTS WITHOUT AN INTERCEPTION BUT HAS 10 TOUCHDOWNS.
» HE IS ALSO COMPLETING PASSES AT A 70 PERCENT CLIP WHICH WOULD SHATTER THE LR SINGLE SEASON RECORD CURRENTLY HELD BY GRAYSON WILLINGHAM IN 2021 WITH A 62.9 PERCENT COMPLETION PERCENTAGE.

- » IN HIS BEST CAREER PERFORMANCE, DEAREE ROGERS FINISHED THE BARTON WIN WITH 11 GRABS FOR 150 YARDS AND A TOUCHDOWN.
- » THE 11 CATCHES ARE THE THIRD-MOST IN A SINGLE GAME IN THE NCAA ERA AND HIS 150 YARDS WERE THE SEVENTH MOST.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- » THE BEARS RANK 10TH IN ALL OF DIVISION II IN TURNOVERS LOST WITH JUST FOUR GIVEAWAYS.
- » LR HASN'T HAD A FUMBLE ALL SEASON AND HAD Gone four straight games without committing a Turnover before throw a pair of picks at limestone.
- » AFTER THROWING TWO INTERCEPTIONS IN THE SEASON-OPENING WIN OVER ST. AUGUSTINE'S, LENOIR-RHYNE QUARTERBACKS WENT 118 STRAIGHT ATTEMPTS WITHOUT THROWING A PICK.
- » SINCE 2010, THE BEARS HAVE HAD 27 GAMES WHERE THEY DIDN'T TURN THE BALL OVER AND FIVE OF THOSE SUCH OCCASSIONS HAVE COME IN THE PAST SIX WEEKS.

- » LENOIR-RHYNE BOASTS A PAIR OF THE BEST OFFENSIVE LINEMEN IN THE LEAGUE.
- » CENTER BLAKE JEFFERSON HAS BEEN A STARTER
 SINCE STEPPING FOOT ON CAMPUS BACK IN 2019 AND
 HAS STARTED AT CENTER EVER SINCE. JEFFERSON WAS A
 PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTION AND WAS NAMED
 ALL-SAC EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS.
- » XAVIER JENNINGS ALSO HAS STARTED AT LT SINCE STEPPING ON TO CAMPUS IN THE COVID SEASON OF 2020-21 BEFORE SHIFTING TO LG THIS YEAR. HE HAS STARTED EVERY GAME OF HIS CAREER AND HASN'T MISSED A SINGLE CONTEST.

CHALLENGE SCORING

- » THE BEARS CURRENTLY HAVE THE SECOND-BEST SCORING DEFENSE IN ALL OF DIVISION II WITH ALLOWING ON 8.3 POINTS PER GAME. THE ONLY PROGRAM THAT RANKS BETTER IS BENEDICT. WHICH AVERAGES 6.1 POINTS PER GAME.
- » IN OVERALL DEFENSE, THE BEARS HAVE THE FOURTH-BEST TOTAL DEFENSE BY ALLOWING ONLY 206.4 YARDS PER GAME. BENEDICT LEADS THE WAY BY ALLOWING ONLY 174.1 YARDS PER GAME.
