POSTSEASON PLAY

» LENOIR-RHYNE PUTS ITSELF IN THE NCAA PLAYOFFS FOR THE SEVENTH TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY, ALL SINCE 2012.

» LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS AN 8-6 MARK IN PLAYOFF GAMES BUT IS IN SEARCH OF ITS FIRST SINCE BEATING CARSON-NEWMAN ON NOV. 30, 2019.

» LR ADVANCED TO A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME IN THE 2013 SEASON UNDER MIKE HOUSTON, THE CURRENT HEAD COACH AT EAST CAROLINA. THAT YEAR, THE BEARS DROPPED A 43-28 CONTEST TO NORTHWEST MISSOURI STATE.

» THIS WILL BE THE SECOND MEETING BETWEEN LR AND A TEAM FROM SUPER REGION 1. DURING THE 2013 RUN, THE BEARS DEFEATED WET CHESTER 42-14 IN THE NATIONAL SEMIFINAL.

» ONLY FOUR OF THE BEARS 14 PLAYOFF GAMES HAVE COME ON THE ROAD. LR OWNS AN 8-2 MARK AT HOME IN NCAA PLAYOFF GAMES.

» THIS WILL BE THE FIRST APPEARANCE BY LR AS A NUMBER FOUR SEED IN THE PLAYOFFS. LR HAD BEEN A 1-SEED TWICE AND A 2-SEED ONCE. THEY ALSO HAVE BEEN A 3-SEED TWO TIMES AND WERE UNSEED IN THEIR MOST RECENT APPEARANCE, A 2021 LOSS AT BOWIE STATE.

FAMILIAR SPOT FOR SHEPHERD

» 2023 MARKS THE 15TH ALL-TIME NCAA PLAYOFF BERTH FOR THE RAMS AND FOURTH UNDER ERNIE MCCOOK WHO TOOK OVER IN 2019. MCCOOK OWNS A 7-3 MARK IN NCAA POSTSEASON PLAY WITH BACK-TO-BACK RUNS TO NATIONAL SEMIFINAL GAMES IN 2021 AND 2022. THE 15 PLAYOFF APPEARANCES RANK AS THE NINTH-MOST IN DIVISION II.

» IN TOTAL, SHEPHERD IS 20-14 ALL-TIME IN PLAYOFF GAMES. THE 20 PLAYOFF WINS RANK AS THE NINTH-MOST AMONG DIVISION II TEAMS, TIED WITH SAC RIVAL CARSON-NEWMAN.

HOME DOMINANCE

» NOT ONLY DID THE BEARS GO A PERFECT 5-0 BETWEEN THE BRICKS THIS SEASON, THEY DOMINATED OPPONENTS.

» IN MORETZ STADIUM THIS YEAR, LENOIR-RHYNE HAS OUTSCORED OPPONENTS BY A TOTAL OF 238-20, ALLOWING JUST TWO TOTAL TOUCHDOWNS. SHEPHERD WILL REPRESENT THE TOUGHEST TEST BY FAR.

» THE BEARS HAD A STRETCH WHERE THEY DIDN'T ALLOW A TOUCHDOWN AT HOME FOR 16 STRAIGHT QUARTERS FROM THE HOME OPENER AGAINST ST. AUGUSTINE'S TO THE HOME FINALE AGAINST CATAWBA.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SAC CHAMPIONSHIP X 2

- » THE BEARS WON THE PIEDMONT DIVISION WITH A WIN OVER CATAWBA IN WEEK 10 AND THEN SECURED THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP WITH A WIN OVER TUSCULUM IN THE TITLE GAME.
- » THE BEARS ABSOLUTELY DOMINATED TUSCULUM IN THAT GAME TO THE TUNE OF A 48-7 VICTORY. THE BEARS SCORED THE FIRST 48 POINTS OF THE GAME AND THE PIONEERS DIDN'T FIND THE END ZONE UNTIL THE FINAL DRIVE OF THE GAME.
- » LR OUT GAINED TUSCULUM 497-156 AND HAD A 29-5 EDGE IN FIRST DOWNS. THE PIONEERS FINAL DRIVE COVERED 53 YARDS AGAINST MUCH OF LR'S RESERVES.

RECORDS FALL AGAINST TU

- » IN THE DOMINATING WIN, A COUPLE OF RECORDS WERE TIED OR BROKEN BY THE BEARS.
- » AS A TEAM, LR THREW SIX TOUCHDOWN PASSES, THE MOST IN A SINGLE GAME IN THE 104-YEAR HISTORY OF THE PROGRAM.
- » QB SEAN WHITE TOSSED FIVE OF THOSE TOUCHDOWNS, TIED FOR THE MOST IN A GAME IN LR HISTORY. NO LR QB HAD THROWN FIVE TOUCHDOWNS IN A GAME SINCE JOEL ROOPE DID SO IN THE 1990 SEASON.
- » WR SONGA YATES TIED A PROGRAM RECORD WITH HIS THREE TOUCHDOWN GRABS. YATES FINISHED WITH FOUR CATCHES FOR 100 YARDS.
- » WHITE WAS NAMED THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES MVP FOR HIS PERFORMANCE.

WHITE HOT

- » FILLING IN FOR JALEN FERGUSON, SEAN WHITE HAS BEEN OUTSTANDING IN THE BEARS LAST TWO GAMES.
- » AGAINST CATAWBA AND TUSCULUM, WHITE HAS CONNECTED ON 34 OF 53 ATTEMPTS AND THROWN FOR 495 YARDS. WHITE HAS EIGHT TOUCHDOWNS AND ZERO INTERCEPTIONS AND ADDED A RUSHING TOUCHDOWN AND 42 YARDS ON THE GROUND IN THOSE TWO GAMES COMBINED.

HISTORY WITH SHEPHERD

- » ITS BEEN SINCE THE 1996 AND 1997 SEASONS SINCE LENOIR-RHYNE AND SHEPHERD HAVE LOCKED UP.
- » SHEPHERD CAME OUT ON TOP IN BOTH OF THOSE CONTESTS, ONE AT EACH TEAMS HOME FIELD.
- » IN '96, SHEPHERD DEFENDED HOME TURF WITH A 32-20 VICTORY. THE FOLLOWING YEAR, THE RAMS CRUISED PAST LR 45-16 BETWEEN THE BRICKS.
- » IN THE 1997 MATCHUP, SHEPHERD HELD A 534-211 ADVANTAGE IN TOTAL YARDS AND THREW FOR 311 WHILE RUSHING FOR 223.
- » LR'S MIKE KETCHUM WENT JUST 10-FOR-23 IN PASSING FOR 98 YARDS AND THREW A PAIR OF INTERCEPTIONS. TONY POPE WAS HELD TO 66 YARDS RUSHING ON HIS 24 ATTEMPTS.

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS. HOWEVER, YOUNG IS ON IR CURRENTLY.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS. HE WAS SIGNED BY THE JETS AND IS A MEMBER OF THEIR PRACTICE SQUAD.

LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

» AIR ATTACK

- » THE COMBINATION OF JALEN FERGUSON AND SEAN WHITE AT QUARTERBACK HAVE PRODUCED SOLID RESULTS FOR LR.
- » AS A TEAM, THE BEARS HAVE THROWN FOR 2,369 YARDS WHICH IS THE SEVENTH-MOST IN A SINGLE SEASON IN PROGRAM HISTORY. WITH 202 MORE YARDS, LR CAN JUMP ALL THE WAY UP TO SECOND. THE MOST PASSING YARDS IN A SEASON CAME IN 2021 WHEN LR THREW FOR 2,759.
- » THE 28 PASSING TOUCHDOWNS ARE TIED FOR THE SECOND-MOST IN A SINGLE SEASON IN TEAM HISTORY AND ARE JUST TWO SHY OF TYING THE RECORD OF 30 SET IN 2018.
- » THE 65.8 PERCENT COMPLETION PERCENTAGE RANKS AS THE HIGHEST MARK IN TEAM HISTORY, SURPASSING THE 63.3 % MARK OF 2021.

YATES CAREER GAME

- » SONGA YATES PICKED A PRIME TIME FOR HIS BEST GAME AS A BEAR.
- » THE SOPHOMORE HAULED IN FOUR GRABS FOR 100 YARDS AND THREE TOUCHDOWNS.
- » PRIOR TO THAT GAME, HIS CAREER-BEST YARDAGE WAS 58 YARDS IN THE SEASON OPENER AGAINST ST. AUGUSTINE'S AND HE HAD JUST TWO TOUCHDOWN GRABS IN HIS CAREER.
- » YATES' TD GRABS COVERED 44, 33 AND 20 YARDS FROM SEAN WHITE.

WELCOME BACK

- » KELIN PARSONS SUFFERED AN INJURY AT CARSON-NEWMAN IN THE THIRD GAME OF THE SEASON. HE WAS INACTIVE UNTIL THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME WHERE HE WENT OFF AGAINST TUSCULUM FOR FIVE CATCHES FOR 99 YARDS.
- » DESPITE JUST PLAYING FOUR GAMES ALL SEASON, PARSONS HAS THREE TOUCHDOWN CATCHES. FOR HIS CARER, PARSONS HAS 113 GRABS WHICH RANKS HIM NINTH IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

DON'T FORGET ABOUT DRE

- » WITH THE RETURN OF PARSONS, TWO OF THE MOST

DYNAMIC PASS CATCHERS IN LR HISTORY WILL BE IN THE SAME LINEUP.

- » LESTER ENTERS SATURDAY WITH 139 CAREER GRABS WHICH PLACES HIM THIRD IN PROGRAM HISTORY, JUST THREE GRABS SHY OF MOVING INTO SECOND PLACE.
- » LESTER'S 1,904 CAREER YARDS RECEIVING RANK HIM FIFTH IN PROGRAM HISTORY, JUST 52 SHORT OF PASSING CHIP SHEFFIELD FOR FIFTH.

DEEWEE

- » DWAYNE MCGEE (NICKNAMED DEEWEE) ALREADY OWNS THE SINGLE-SEASON RECORD FOR MOST RUSHING YARDS IN 2021. THAT YEAR, MCGEE ERUPTED FOR 1,669 YARDS TO BREAK LEONARD DAVIS' RECORD OF 1,559 WHICH STOOD SINCE 1994.
- » THIS SEASON, MCGEE SURPASSED 1,000 YARDS AGAIN AND SITS AT 1,117. HIS 6.9 YARDS PER ATTEMPT RANK IN THE TOP 10 IN DIVISION II THIS SEASON.
- » MCGEE IS SECOND IN LR HISTORY WITH 4,158 CAREER RUSHING YARDS AND HIS 43 RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS PLACE HIM IN A TIE FOR THIRD PLACE.

O-LINE STRENGTH

- » LENOIR-RHYNE IS LED BY FIRST TEAM ALL-SAC LINEMEN SHANE WELLS WHO EARNED HIS FIRST ALL-SAC SELECTION. WELLS WAS ALSO THE BEARS NOMINEE FOR THE JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY.
- » XAVIER JENNINGS AND BLAKE JEFFERSON EARNED ALL-PIEDMONT DIVISION OFFENSE SELECTIONS TO GIVE LR THREE ALL-CONFERENCE LINEMEN.
- » FOUR OFFENSIVE LINEMEN HAVE STARTED EVERY GAME THIS YEAR. BLAKE JEFFERSON MISSED A PAIR OF GAMES WITH INJURY BUT HAS RETURNED AS LR HAS BEEN STEADY ALONG THE LINE THIS YEAR, A KEY FACTOR IN THEIR OFFENSIVE SUCCESS.
- » BOTH JENNINGS AND JEFFERSON EARNED ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS LAST YEAR AND WENT BACK-TO-BACK WITH ALL-LEAGUE PICKS.
- » THE BEARS HAVE HAD AT LEAST ONE OFFENSIVE LINEMEN SELECTED TO THE ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM EACH YEAR SINCE 2015.
