POSTSEASON HISTORY

- » LENOIR-RHYNE WILL BE LOOKING FOR JUST THE FIRST NCAA PLAYOFF ROAD VICTORY IN PROGRAM HISTORY.
- » THE BEARS ARE 0-3 IN TRUE ROAD PLAYOFF GAMES AND 0-1 AT NEUTRAL VENUES.
- » LENOIR-RHYNE DROPPED ROAD GAMES AT CARSON-NEWMAN (38-35) IN 2012, AT VALDOSTA ST. (61-21) IN 2018 AND AT BOWIE STATE (31-10) IN 2021. THE BEARS ALSO DROPPED THE 2013 NCAA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP IN FLORENCE, ALA. IN 2013.
- » LR IS 9-2 IN HOME PLAYOFF GAMES IN PROGRAM HISTORY, INCLUDING LAST WEEK'S 63-17 DRUBBING OF SHEPHERD.
- » BENEDICT IS LOOKING FOR THEIR FIRST NCAA PLAYOFF VICTORY IN PROGRAM HISTORY. THE TIGERS ARE IN THE POSTSEASON FOR THE SECOND TIME IN TEAM HISTORY BUT FELL TO WINGATE IN THEIR FIRST GAME OF THE 2022 PLAYOFFS.
- » BENEDICT IS THE 1-SEED FOR THE SECOND STRAIGHT SEASON AND WILL BE PLAYING AT HOME FOR CONSECUTIVE SEASONS.

WEEK IN REVIEW

- » AS THE TOP SEED IN THE REGION, BENEDICT WAS OFF LAST WEEK AND EARNED A WEEK OF REST.
- » HOWEVER, THE BEARS HAD A RECORD-SETTING WEEK 12 GAME AGAINST SHEPHERD. MEETING THE RAMS FOR JUST THE THIRD TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY, LR TOOK THE OPENING KICK AND MARCHED DOWN THE FIELD FOR A TOUCHDOWN. THE BEARS WOULD GO ON TO SET A MARK FOR MOST TOTAL YARDS IN A PLAYOFF GAME IN PROGRAM HISTORY WITH 617 TOTAL YARDS OF OFFENSE.
- » SEAN WHITE BROKE THE PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST PASSING YARDS IN A GAME WITH 398, TOPPING BRIAN BRYSON'S MARK OF 392 WHICH STOOD SINCE 1992.
- » SONGA YATES BROKE THE TEAM RECORD FOR MOST RECEIVING YARDS IN AN NCAA PLAYOFF GAME WITH 141.
- » WHITE TIED HIS OWN PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST TD PASSES IN A GAME WITH FIVE AND LR TIED ITS OWN PROGRAM RECORD OF MOST TD PASSES AS A TEAM IN GAME WITH SIX. IN THE 104-YEAR HISTORY OF LR FOOTBALL, THE BEARS NEVER THREW FOR SIX TOUCHDOWNS AS A TEAM. HOWEVER, THE BEARS HAVE ACCOMPLISHED THAT FEAT IN EACH OF THE PAST TWO WEEKS WITH SIX AGAINST SHEPHERD AND TUSCULUM.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SAC CHAMPIONSHIP X 2

- » THE BEARS WON THE PIEDMONT DIVISION WITH A WIN OVER CATAWBA IN WEEK 10 AND THEN SECURED THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP WITH A WIN OVER TUSCULUM IN THE TITLE GAME.
- » THE BEARS ABSOLUTELY DOMINATED TUSCULUM IN THAT GAME TO THE TUNE OF A 48-7 VICTORY. THE BEARS SCORED THE FIRST 48 POINTS OF THE GAME AND THE PIONEERS DIDN'T FIND THE END ZONE UNTIL THE FINAL DRIVE OF THE GAME.
- » LR OUT GAINED TUSCULUM 497-156 AND HAD A 29-5 EDGE IN FIRST DOWNS. THE PIONEERS FINAL DRIVE COVERED 53 YARDS AGAINST MUCH OF LR'S RESERVES.

RECORDS FALL AGAINST TU

- » IN THE DOMINATING WIN, A COUPLE OF RECORDS WERE TIED OR BROKEN BY THE BEARS.
- » AS A TEAM, LR THREW SIX TOUCHDOWN PASSES, THE MOST IN A SINGLE GAME IN THE 104-YEAR HISTORY OF THE PROGRAM.
- » QB SEAN WHITE TOSSED FIVE OF THOSE TOUCHDOWNS, TIED FOR THE MOST IN A GAME IN LR HISTORY. NO LR QB HAD THROWN FIVE TOUCHDOWNS IN A GAME SINCE JOEL ROOPE DID SO IN THE 1990 SEASON.
- » WR SONGA YATES TIED A PROGRAM RECORD WITH HIS THREE TOUCHDOWN GRABS. YATES FINISHED WITH FOUR CATCHES FOR 100 YARDS.
- » WHITE WAS NAMED THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES MVP FOR HIS PERFORMANCE.

MORE HISTORY

- » SINCE THE AFCA POLL ORIGINATED IN 2000, LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS 13 WINS OVER NATIONALLY RANKED TEAMS.
- » HOWEVER, LR HAS NEVER BEATEN A TOP 10 TEAM IN THAT TIME.
- » THE HIGHEST RANKED OPPONENT LR HAS TAKEN DOWN WAS NO. 12 WINGATE 20-13 IN 2019. THE BEARS ARE 13-34 SINCE 2000 AGAINST NATIONALLY RANKED TEAMS.

HISTORY WITH BENEDICT

- » THIS WILL BE JUST THE FOURTH TIME THAT LENOIR-RHYNE AND BENEDICT HAVE HOOKED UP WITH THE BEARS HOLDING A 2-1 EDGE.
- » THE TEAMS MET IN 2006, 2007 AND 2008 WITH ONLY THE 2007 MATCHUP IN HICKORY. LR DOMINATED THE FIRST TWO MATCHUPS WITH WINS OF 17-0 AND 38-13 BUT DROPPED THE 2008 MEETING 17-13.

REMEMBER NOVEMBER

- » THE BEARS HAVE BEEN NEARLY UNSTOPPABLE IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER IN THE PAST 13 YEARS.
- » SINCE 2010, LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS A RECORD OF 32-7 IN THE MONTH.

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS. HOWEVER, YOUNG IS ON IR CURRENTLY.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS. HE WAS SIGNED BY THE JETS AND IS A MEMBER OF THEIR PRACTICE SQUAD.

LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

» AIR ATTACK

» WITH A MONSTER SHOWING LAST WEEK, LR SET A NEW PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST PASSING YARDS IN A SINGLE SEASON.

» AS A TEAM, THE BEARS HAVE THROWN FOR 2,830 YARDS WHICH IS THE MOST IN A SINGLE SEASON IN PROGRAM HISTORY. THE PREVIOUS MARK IN A SEASON CAME IN 2021 WHEN LR THREW FOR 2,759.

» THE BEARS ALSO BROKE THE RECORD FOR MOST PASSING TOUCHDOWNS IN A SEASON LAST WEEK. WITH SIX MORE STRIKES, LR TOTALED 34 PASSING TOUCHDOWNS BREAKING THE RECORD OF 30 SET IN 2018.

» THE 67.4 PERCENT COMPLETION PERCENTAGE RANKS AS THE HIGHEST MARK IN TEAM HISTORY, SURPASSING THE 63.3 % MARK OF 2021.

YATES BREAK OUT

» SONGA YATES HAS SEEN HIS NUMBERS INCREASE IN A MAJOR WAY THE PAST TWO WEEKS.

» WORKING WITH SEAN WHITE THE PAST TWO WEEKS, YATES HAS EXPLODED FOR FIVE TOUCHDOWN CATCHES AND BACK-TO-BACK 100-YARD GAMES.

» AGAINST TUSCULUM, YATES HAD FOUR GRABS FOR 100 YARDS AND TIED A SINGLE-GAME TEAM RECORD WITH THREE TOUCHDOWNS. IN THE FIRST ROUND MATCHUP WITH SHEPHERD, YATES HAD SIX CATCHES FOR 141 YARDS AND TWO MORE TOUCHDOWNS.

WELCOME BACK

» KELIN PARSONS SUFFERED AN INJURY AT CARSON-NEWMAN IN THE THIRD GAME OF THE SEASON. HE WAS INACTIVE UNTIL THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME WHERE HE WENT OFF AGAINST TUSCULUM FOR FIVE CATCHES FOR 99 YARDS.

» LAST WEEK, PARSONS HAD FIVE GRABS FOR 84 YARDS AND A TOUCHDOWN.

DON'T FORGET ABOUT DRE

» WITH THE RETURN OF PARSONS, TWO OF THE MOST DYNAMIC PASS CATCHERS IN LR HISTORY WILL BE IN THE SAME LINEUP.

» WITH HIS EIGHT CATCHES LAST WEEK, DEONDE LESTER

MOVED INTO SOLE POSSESSION OF SECOND PLACE ON THE ALL-TIME RECEPTIONS LIST AT LR.

» LESTER'S 1,993 CAREER YARDS RECEIVING RANK HIM FOURTH IN PROGRAM HISTORY AS HE PASSED CHIP SHEFFIELD FOR FIFTH LAST WEEK.

DEEWEE

» DWAYNE MCGEE (NICKNAMED DEEWEE) ALREADY OWNS THE SINGLE-SEASON RECORD FOR MOST RUSHING YARDS IN 2021. THAT YEAR, MCGEE ERUPTED FOR 1,669 YARDS TO BREAK LEONARD DAVIS' RECORD OF 1,559 WHICH STOOD SINCE 1994.

» THIS SEASON, MCGEE SURPASSED 1,000 YARDS AGAIN AND SITS AT 1,213. HIS 6.8 YARDS PER ATTEMPT RANK IN THE TOP 10 IN DIVISION II THIS SEASON.

» MCGEE IS SECOND IN LR HISTORY WITH 4,254 CAREER RUSHING YARDS AND HIS 43 RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS PLACE HIM IN A TIE FOR THIRD PLACE.

O-LINE STRENGTH

» LENOIR-RHYNE IS LED BY FIRST TEAM ALL-SAC LINEMEN SHANE WELLS WHO EARNED HIS FIRST ALL-SAC SELECTION.

» XAVIER JENNINGS AND BLAKE JEFFERSON EARNED ALL-PIEDMONT DIVISION OFFENSE SELECTIONS TO GIVE LR THREE ALL-CONFERENCE LINEMEN.

» FOUR OFFENSIVE LINEMEN HAVE STARTED EVERY GAME THIS YEAR. BLAKE JEFFERSON MISSED A PAIR OF GAMES WITH INJURY BUT HAS RETURNED AS LR HAS BEEN STEADY ALONG THE LINE THIS YEAR, A KEY FACTOR IN THEIR OFFENSIVE SUCCESS.

» BOTH JENNINGS AND JEFFERSON EARNED ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS LAST YEAR AND WENT BACK-TO-BACK WITH ALL-LEAGUE PICKS.

» THE BEARS HAVE HAD AT LEAST ONE OFFENSIVE LINEMEN SELECTED TO THE ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM EACH YEAR SINCE 2015.

WHITE HOT

» IN HIS LAST THREE GAMES, SEAN WHITE HAS THROWN 13 TOUCHDOWNS WITH ZERO INTERCEPTIONS AND AVERAGES 297.6 YARDS PER GAME. HIS COMPLETION PERCENTAGE IN THE THREE GAME STRETCH IS 70.2 PERCENT. HE ADDED THREE RUSHING TD'S IN THAT STRETCH.

LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

HISTORIC DEFENSE

» LENOIR-RHYNE HAS ONLY ALLOWED 960 YARDS RUSHING THIS SEASON. IN THE 104-YEAR HISTORY OF LENOIR-RHYNE FOOTBALL, THAT FIGURE REPRESENTS THE FIFTH-FEWEST YARDS RUSHING ALLOWED IN A SEASON.
