TWO OF THE ELITE

» LENOIR-RHYNE AND VALDOSTA ST. HAVE ADVANCED TO THE ELITE 8 (NCAA QUARTERFINAL) AND WILL PLAY FOR THE SUPER REGION 2 CHAMPIONSHIP ON SATURDAY.

» THE TWO PROGRAMS WILL MEET IN THE NATIONAL QUARTERFINAL ROUND FOR THE SECOND TIME IN FIVE YEARS. BACK IN 2018, VALDOSTA ST. PUT A 61-21 THUMPING ON THE BEARS ON THEIR WAY TO A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

» EACH TEAM EARNED AN IMPRESSIVE ROAD WIN TO GET TO THIS ROUND. VALDOSTA ST. TOOK CARE OF NUMBER 2 SEED DELTA ST. 38-31 ON A TOUCHDOWN WITH SEVEN SECONDS LEFT IN REGULATION. THE BEARS WENT TO NO. 1 SEED BENEDICT AND HANDED THE TIGERS THEIR FIRST LOSS OF THE YEAR WITH A 35-25 DEFEAT.

» THIS WILL BE THE THIRD MEETING BETWEEN THE TWO TEAMS IN THE PLAYOFFS. ON TOP OF THE 2018 WIN, THE BLAZERS KNOCKED OFF THE NO. 1 SEEDED BEARS BACK IN THE 2014 PLAYOFFS AT MORETZ STADIUM BY A FINAL SCORE OF 23-21. THOSE ARE THE ONLY TWO MEETINGS IN MATCHUP HISTORY AS THE SCHOOLS HAVE NEVER PLAYED IN A REGULAR SEASON CONTEST.

WEEK IN REVIEW

» LR SHOOK OFF A SLOW START IN COLUMBIA, S.C. TO TAKE DOWN THE TOP SEED IN THE REGION BY A FINAL COUNT OF 35-25.

» AFTER LR SCORED FIRST, A PAIR OF DEFENSIVE BREAKDOWNS GAVE THE TIGERS A 19-14 LEAD GOING INTO THE BREAK. THE BEARS WOULD SHUT DOWN THE TIGERS OFFENSE IN THE THIRD QUARTER AND LR OUTSCORED THE HOSTS 21-6 IN THE SECOND HALF TO EARN THE WIN.

» SEAN WHITE THREW FOR 310 YARDS AND A PAIR OF TOUCHDOWNS AND DWAYNE MCGEE RAN FOR AN LR NCAA PLAYOFF RECORD 216 YARDS ON HIS 21 CARRIES. BENEDICT CAME IN WITH THE TOP DEFENSE IN DIVISION II IN POINTS AND YARDS ALLOWED BY LR HAD LITTLE TROUBLE MOVING THE BALL AGAINST THE TIGERS.

» LENOIR-RHYNE WOULD CONCLUDE THE GAME WITH 560 YARDS OF TOTAL OFFENSE. KELIN PARSONS WOULD HAUL IN SIX GRABS FOR 103 YARDS IN THE GAME AS WELL.

» THE WIN WAS THE FIRST ROAD WIN IN THE NCAA PLAYOFFS IN PROGRAM HISTORY AS LR HAD BEEN 0-3 ON THE ROAD PRIOR TO LAST WEEK AND 0-1 AT A NEUTRAL SITE.

» BENEDICT WAS THE HIGHEST RANKED OPPONENT LR HAS BEATEN IN THE AFCA POLL ERA (2000-PRESENT). THE TIGERS CAME IN RANKED NO. 4 IN THE NATION.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

PLAYOFF SUCCESS

- » THE BEARS HAVE FOUND ANOTHER GEAR SINCE THE PLAYOFFS HAVE STARTED.
- » IN THE OPENING ROUND, LR BEAT SHEPHERD 63-17 AND SEAN WHITE BROKE THE PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST PASSING YARDS IN A GAME WITH 398.
- » IN HIS TWO PLAYOFF GAMES, WHITE HAS THROWN SEVEN TOUCHDOWN PASSES TO JUST ONE INTERCEPTION AND HAS THROWN FOR 708 YARDS IN THOSE TWO CONTESTS.
- » DEFENSIVELY, LR HAS ONLY ALLOWED OPPONENTS TO RUSH FOR 159 YARDS IN TWO GAMES AND ARE GIVING UP JUST 2.6 YARDS PER CARRY.

SAC CHAMPIONSHIP X 2

- » THE BEARS WON THE PIEDMONT DIVISION WITH A WIN OVER CATAWBA IN WEEK 10 AND THEN SECURED THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP WITH A WIN OVER TUSCULUM IN THE TITLE GAME.
- » THE BEARS ABSOLUTELY DOMINATED TUSCULUM IN THAT GAME TO THE TUNE OF A 48-7 VICTORY. THE BEARS SCORED THE FIRST 48 POINTS OF THE GAME AND THE PIONEERS DIDN'T FIND THE END ZONE UNTIL THE FINAL DRIVE OF THE GAME.
- » LR OUT GAINED TUSCULUM 497-156 AND HAD A 29-5 EDGE IN FIRST DOWNS. THE PIONEERS FINAL DRIVE COVERED 53 YARDS AGAINST MUCH OF LR'S RESERVES.

REMEMBER NOVEMBER

- » THE BEARS HAVE BEEN NEARLY UNSTOPPABLE IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER IN THE PAST 13 YEARS.
- » SINCE 2010, LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS A RECORD OF 33-7 IN THE MONTH.
- » HOWEVER, ONCE THE CALENDAR HAS FLIPPED TO DECEMBER, THE BEARS ARE JUST 2-3 SINCE THE 2010 SEASON.

ALL REGION SELECTIONS

- » THE BEARS WERE WELL REPRESENTED ON THE ALL-

REGION SQUAD WHICH WAS ANNOUNCED ON WEDNESDAY MORNING. DEAREE ROGERS (RETURN SPECIALIST), SHANE WELLS (OFFENSIVE LINE) AND JON ROSS MAYE (LINEBACKER) WERE SELECTED TO THE FIRST TEAM ALL-REGION AND ARE NOW ELIGIBLE FOR ALL-AMERICAN STATUS. DWAYNE MCGEE (RUNNING BACK) AND ANDRE JEFFERSON (DEFENSIVE LINE) WERE SELECTED TO THE SECOND TEAM.

PLAYOFF HISTORY

- » THIS IS THE SEVENTH NCAA PLAYOFF APPEARANCE FOR LR, ALL COMING SINCE 2012.
- » THE BEARS OWN A 10-6 MARK IN PLAYOFF GAMES AND ARE 9-2 AT MORETZ STADIUM IN THE PLAYOFFS. ONE OF THE TWO LOSSES AT HOME IN THE PLAYOFFS CAME AT THE HANDS OF VALDOSTA ST.

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS. HOWEVER, YOUNG IS ON IR CURRENTLY.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS. HE WAS SIGNED BY THE JETS AND IS A MEMBER OF THEIR PRACTICE SQUAD.

LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

» AIR ATTACK

- » WITH A MONSTER SHOWING IN WEEK 1 OF THE PLAYOFFS, LR SET A NEW PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST PASSING YARDS IN A SINGLE SEASON.
- » AS A TEAM, THE BEARS HAVE THROWN FOR 3,140 YARDS WHICH IS THE MOST IN A SINGLE SEASON IN PROGRAM HISTORY. THE PREVIOUS MARK IN A SEASON CAME IN 2021 WHEN LR THREW FOR 2,759.
- » THE BEARS ALSO BROKE THE RECORD FOR MOST PASSING TOUCHDOWNS IN A SEASON AGAINST SHEPHERD. WITH TWO MORE STRIKES AGAINST BENEDICT, LR TOTALED 36 PASSING TOUCHDOWNS. THE PREVIOUS MARK WAS 30 SET IN 2018.
- » THE 68.3 PERCENT COMPLETION PERCENTAGE RANKS AS THE HIGHEST MARK IN TEAM HISTORY, SURPASSING THE 63.3 % MARK OF 2021.

YATES BREAKING OUT

- » SONGA YATES HAS SEEN HIS NUMBERS INCREASE IN A MAJOR WAY THE PAST THREE WEEKS.
- » WORKING WITH SEAN WHITE THE PAST THREE WEEKS, YATES HAS EXPLODED FOR SIX TOUCHDOWN CATCHES AND TWO 100-YARD GAMES.
- » AGAINST TUSCULUM TWO WEEKS AGO, YATES HAD FOUR GRABS FOR 100 YARDS AND TIED A SINGLE-GAME TEAM RECORD WITH THREE TOUCHDOWNS. IN THE FIRST TWO ROUNDS OF THE PLAYOFFS, YATES HAD 10 CATCHES FOR 189 YARDS AND THREE MORE TOUCHDOWNS.

WELCOME BACK

- » KELIN PARSONS SUFFERED AN INJURY AT CARSON-NEWMAN IN THE THIRD GAME OF THE SEASON. HE WAS INACTIVE UNTIL THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME WHERE HE WENT OFF AGAINST TUSCULUM FOR FIVE CATCHES FOR 99 YARDS.
- » IN HIS THREE GAMES SINCE RETURNING FROM THE INJURY, PARSONS HAS 16 CATCHES FOR 286 YARDS AND A TOUCHDOWN.

DON'T FORGET ABOUT DRE

- » WITH THE RETURN OF PARSONS, TWO OF THE MOST DYNAMIC PASS CATCHERS IN LR HISTORY WILL BE IN THE SAME LINEUP.
- » WITH HIS SEVEN CATCHES LAST WEEK, DEONDRE LESTER

MOVED INTO SOLE POSSESSION OF SECOND PLACE ON THE ALL-TIME RECEPTIONS LIST AT LR.

- » LESTER'S 2,035 CAREER YARDS RECEIVING RANK HIM FOURTH IN PROGRAM HISTORY AS HE PASSED CHIP SHEFFIELD FOR FIFTH LAST WEEK.

DEEWEE

- » DWAYNE MCGEE (NICKNAMED DEEWEE) ALREADY OWNS THE SINGLE-SEASON RECORD FOR MOST RUSHING YARDS IN 2021. THAT YEAR, MCGEE ERUPTED FOR 1,669 YARDS TO BREAK LEONARD DAVIS' RECORD OF 1,559 WHICH STOOD SINCE 1994.
- » THIS SEASON, MCGEE SURPASSED 1,000 YARDS AGAIN AND SITS AT 1,429 HIS 7.1 YARDS PER ATTEMPT RANK IN THE TOP 10 IN DIVISION II THIS SEASON.
- » MCGEE IS SECOND IN LR HISTORY WITH 4,470 CAREER RUSHING YARDS AND HIS 44 RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS PLACE HIM IN A TIE FOR THIRD PLACE.

O-LINE STRENGTH

- » LENOIR-RHYNE IS LED BY FIRST TEAM ALL-SAC LINEMEN SHANE WELLS WHO EARNED HIS FIRST ALL-SAC SELECTION.
- » XAVIER JENNINGS AND BLAKE JEFFERSON EARNED ALL-PIEDMONT DIVISION OFFENSE SELECTIONS TO GIVE LR THREE ALL-CONFERENCE LINEMEN.
- » FOUR OFFENSIVE LINEMEN HAVE STARTED EVERY GAME THIS YEAR. BLAKE JEFFERSON MISSED A PAIR OF GAMES WITH INJURY BUT HAS RETURNED AS LR HAS BEEN STEADY ALONG THE LINE THIS YEAR, A KEY FACTOR IN THEIR OFFENSIVE SUCCESS.
- » BOTH JENNINGS AND JEFFERSON EARNED ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS LAST YEAR AND WENT BACK-TO-BACK WITH ALL-LEAGUE PICKS.
- » THE BEARS HAVE HAD AT LEAST ONE OFFENSIVE LINEMEN SELECTED TO THE ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM EACH YEAR SINCE 2015.

WHITE HOT

- » IN HIS LAST FOUR GAMES, SEAN WHITE HAS THROWN 15 TOUCHDOWNS WITH ONE INTERCEPTION AND AVERAGES 301.6 YARDS PER GAME. HIS COMPLETION PERCENTAGE IN THE THREE GAME STRETCH IS 69.2 PERCENT. HE ADDED THREE RUSHING TD'S IN THAT STRETCH.
