SEMIFINAL SATURDAY

» DECEMBER FOOTBALL IS BACK FOR LENOIR-RHYNE AND HARDING WHO ARE EACH SEMIFINAL BOUND FOR THE SECOND TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

» FOR HARDING, THE PREVIOUS NATIONAL SEMIFINAL APPEARANCE CAME IN 2017 WHILE THE BEARS MADE IT TO THIS ROUND IN 2013. LR IS 1-0 IN NATIONAL SEMIFINAL GAMES WHILE THE BISONS ARE IN SEARCH FOR THE FIRST SEMIFINAL VICTORY IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

» IN 2017, THE BISONS FELL TO TEXAS A&M COMMERCE IN THE SEMIFINAL BY A SCORE OF 31-17. THE LIONS WENT ON TO WIN THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP THE NEXT WEEK, TOPPING WEST FLORIDA 37-27.

» THE BEARS DEFEATED WEST CHESTER 42-14 IN THE 2013 SEMIFINALS AT MORETZ STADIUM BUT THEN DROPPED A 43-28 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME AGAINST NORTHWEST MISSOURI ST.

PLAYOFF HISTORY

» THE TWO PROGRAMS HAVE NEVER MET EACH OTHER BUT HAVE HAD PLENTY OF HISTORY IN THE NCAA PLAYOFFS.

» THE BEARS ARE 11-6 IN THE PLAYOFFS, ALL 17 GAMES OCCURRING SINCE 2012.

» HARDING HAS ALSO SEEN ITS PLAYOFF SUCCESS START IN 2012 WITH THE BISONS OWNING AN 8-7 ALL-TIME RECORD IN THE NCAA POSTSEASON.

COACHING CLASH

» MIKE JACOBS AND PAUL SIMMONS HAVE BEEN TWO OF THE MOST SUCCESSFUL COACHES IN THE NATION. SINCE TAKING OVER AT NOTRE DAME COLLEGE IN 2016, JACOBS HAS WON 82.2 PERCENT OF HIS GAMES AND HAS WON 80.0 PERCENT OF HIS GAMES AT LR.

» SIMMONS HAS GONE 63-13 SINCE TAKING OVER HARDING IN 2016 AND OWNS A 82.9 CAREER WINNING PERCENTAGE.

» JACOBS AND SIMMONS ARE TWO OF JUST THREE COACHES AT THE DII LEVEL WHO OWN A CAREER WINNING PERCENTAGE ABOVE 80.0.

» EACH COACH HAS ALSO FOUND A HIGH LEVEL OF SUCCESS IN NCAA POSTSEASON GAMES. IN HIS 10 CAREER NCAA PLAYOFF CONTESTS, JACOBS HAS GONE 7-3 OVERALL AND 3-1 AT LENOIR-RHYNE. SIMMONS OWNS A 6-4 ALL-TIME MARK IN NCAA PLAYOFF GAMES.

» THE ONLY OTHER COACH WHO HAS A CAREER WINNING PERCENTAGE OVER 80.0 AND HAS BEEN AT THE HELM FOR AT LEAST FIVE YEARS IS TONY ANNESE AT FERRIS ST. WITH HIS 123-20 ALL-TIME MARK AND HIS 86.0 CAREER WINNING PERCENTAGE.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

UNSTOPPABLE FORCE VS. IMMOVABLE OBJECT

» SATURDAY WILL FEATURE A WAR IN THE TRENCHES AS EACH TEAM'S STRENGTHS WILL FACE OFF.

» HARDING ENTERS THE CONTEST WITH THE NUMBER 1 RUSHING ATTACK IN ALL OF NCAA DIVISION II. THE BISONS ENTER THE GAME WITH AN AVERAGE OF 402.3 RUSHING YARDS PER GAME WHICH IS TOPS IN THE NATION AND THE 68 RUSHING TDS ARE ALSO NUMBER 1.

» DEFENSIVELY, THE BEARS STOP THE RUN LIKE FEW TEAMS IN THE NATION. THE BEARS RANK NO. 5 IN DII BY ALLOWING JUST 73.1 RUSHING YARDS PER GAME AND HAVE GIVEN UP JUST SIX TOUCHDOWNS ON THE GROUND ALL YEAR.

» THE RUSHING DEFENSE HAS STEPPED UP IN THE POSTSEASON. IN THREE PLAYOFF GAMES, LR HAS ALLOWED OPPONENTS TO RUN FOR JUST 161 TOTAL YARDS ON 80 CARRIES, GOOD FOR 2.0 YARDS PER CARRY. MOST RECENTLY, LR HELD VALDOSTA ST. TO JUST TWO YARDS RUSHING ON 18 ATTEMPTS.

PROTECTING THE RECORD

» THE BEARS WILL ALSO NEED TO CURTAIL THE HARDING RUSHING ATTACK TO STAY IN THE D2 RECORD BOOK.

» THE 2013 VERSION OF THE BEARS OWN THE RECORD FOR MOST RUSHING YARDS IN A SEASON. THAT YEAR, LR RAN FOR 5,563 YARDS AND THE 2014 TEAM RAN FOR A RECORD 416.3 YARDS PER GAME. CURRENTLY, THE BISON ARE JUST 335 YARDS SHY OF BREAKING THE BEARS TOTAL YARDS RECORD.

CHAMPIONSHIPS X3

» THE BEARS WON THE PIEDMONT DIVISION WITH A WIN OVER CATAWBA IN WEEK 10 AND THEN SECURED THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP WITH A WIN OVER TUSCULUM IN THE TITLE GAME.

» THE BEARS ADDED A REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP IN A 35-7 DEFEAT OF VALDOSTA ST. THIS IS JUST THE 2ND REGIONAL TITLE IN LENOIR-RHYNE HISTORY AND THE FIRST TIME IN TEAM HISTORY THAT LR HAS CAPTURED THREE TITLES.

EARLY STARTERS

» LENOIR-RHYNE HAS SCORED FIRST 13 TIMES THIS SEASON AND HAVE GONE 13-0 IN THOSE GAMES. THE ONLY

TIME LR FAILED TO SCORE FIRST CAME AGAINST WINGATE IN THE ONLY LOSS OF THE YEAR.

» LR HAS ALSO WON THE TOSS NINE TIMES THIS YEAR INCLUDING SEVEN IN A ROW IN THE MIDDLE PART OF THE YEAR.

ALL REGION SELECTIONS

» THE BEARS WERE WELL REPRESENTED ON THE ALL-REGION SQUAD WHICH WAS ANNOUNCED ON LAST WEEK. DEAREE ROGERS (RETURN SPECIALIST), SHANE WELLS (OL) AND JON ROSS MAYE (LB) WERE SELECTED TO THE FIRST TEAM ALL-REGION AND ARE NOW ELIGIBLE FOR ALL-AMERICAN STATUS. DWAYNE MCGEE (RB) AND ANDRE JEFFERSON (DL) WERE SELECTED TO THE SECOND TEAM.

NFL-R

» LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.

» KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.

» DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS. HOWEVER, YOUNG SPENT MOST OF THE YEAR ON IR.

» THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.

» UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS. HE WAS SIGNED BY THE JETS AND IS A MEMBER OF THEIR PRACTICE SQUAD.

» ANDRE JEFFERSON MAY BE THE NEXT BEAR TO JOIN THE LIST. ALL 32 NFL ORGANIZATIONS HAVE BEEN TO HICKORY TO SEE THE DEFENSIVE LINEMEN WORK OUT OR PLAY. THE JUNIOR COULD STAY FOR ONE MORE YEAR AND BUILD HIS STOCK OR LEAVE FOR THE PROS AFTER THE SEASON.

LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

» GROUND AND POUND

» IN A DRIVING RAIN THAT STARTED WELL BEFORE THE GAME AND WENT THROUGH THE ENTIRETY OF THE VALDOSTA ST CONTEST, LR RELIED ON A GROUND HEAVY ATTACK. THE BEARS GAINED 307 YARDS ON 52 CARRIES AND RAN FOR FIVE TOUCHDOWNS IN A WIN OVER THE BLAZERS. THAT WAS THE THIRD-MOST YARDS RUSHING IN A GAME THIS SEASON.

» FOR THE SECOND TIME THIS YEAR, LR HAD TWO BACKS TOP 100 YARDS RUSHING. ZAYVION TURNER-KNOX HAD 145 YARDS ON 15 CARRIES AND DWAYNE MCGEE HAD 22 CARRIES FOR 102 YARDS.

» TURNER-KNOX SET A PROGRAM RECORD WITH AN 87 YARD TOUCHDOWN RUN, THE LONGEST RUN IN AN NCAA PLAYOFF GAME IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

» MCGEE HAS RUN FOR 414 YARDS IN HIS THREE PLAYOFF GAMES THIS YEAR WITH THREE RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS. TURNER-KNOX HAS ADDED 202 YARDS RUSHING AND FIVE RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS IN PLAYOFF GAMES.

» TURNER-KNOX HAS ALSO GONE FOUR STRAIGHT GAMES WITH A RUSHING TOUCHDOWN.

YATES BREAKING OUT

» SONGA YATES HAS SEEN HIS NUMBERS INCREASE IN A MAJOR WAY THE PAST FOUR WEEKS.

» WORKING WITH SEAN WHITE THE PAST FOUR WEEKS, YATES HAS EXPLODED FOR SIX TOUCHDOWN CATCHES AND TWO 100-YARD GAMES.

» AGAINST TUSCULUM TWO WEEKS AGO, YATES HAD FOUR GRABS FOR 100 YARDS AND TIED A SINGLE-GAME TEAM RECORD WITH THREE TOUCHDOWNS. IN THE FIRST TWO ROUNDS OF THE PLAYOFFS, YATES HAD 10 CATCHES FOR 189 YARDS AND THREE MORE TOUCHDOWNS. IN THE RAIN FEST ON SATURDAY, THE BEARS WERE LIMITED TO 51 YARDS PASSING BUT YATES HAD TWO GRABS FOR EIGHT YARDS.

WELCOME BACK

» KELIN PARSONS SUFFERED AN INJURY AT CARSON-NEWMAN IN THE THIRD GAME OF THE SEASON. HE WAS INACTIVE UNTIL THE SAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME WHERE HE WENT OFF AGAINST TUSCULUM FOR FIVE CATCHES FOR 99 YARDS.

» IN HIS FIRST THREE GAMES SINCE RETURNING FROM THE INJURY, PARSONS HAS 16 CATCHES FOR 286 YARDS AND A TOUCHDOWN. UNFORTUNATELY, WEATHER PREVENTED MUCH HAPPENING THROUGH THE AIR AND PARSONS WAS

HELD WITHOUT A CATCH AGAINST VSU.

DON'T FORGET ABOUT DRE

» WITH THE RETURN OF PARSONS, TWO OF THE MOST DYNAMIC PASS CATCHERS IN LR HISTORY WILL BE IN THE SAME LINEUP.

» WITH HIS SEVEN CATCHES AGAINST BENEDICT, DEONDRE LESTER MOVED INTO SOLE POSSESSION OF SECOND PLACE ON THE ALL-TIME RECEPTIONS LIST AT LR.

» LESTER'S 2,052 CAREER YARDS RECEIVING RANK HIM FOURTH IN PROGRAM HISTORY AS HE PASSED CHIP SHEFFIELD FOR FIFTH TWO WEEKS AGO.

DEEWEE

» DWAYNE MCGEE (NICKNAMED DEEWEE) ALREADY OWNS THE SINGLE-SEASON RECORD FOR MOST RUSHING YARDS IN 2021. THAT YEAR, MCGEE ERUPTED FOR 1,669 YARDS TO BREAK LEONARD DAVIS' RECORD OF 1,559 WHICH STOOD SINCE 1994.

» THIS SEASON, MCGEE SURPASSED 1,000 YARDS AGAIN AND SITS AT 1,531 HIS 6.9 YARDS PER ATTEMPT RANKS SEVENTH IN DIVISION II THIS SEASON.

» MCGEE IS SECOND IN LR HISTORY WITH 4,572 CAREER RUSHING YARDS AND HIS 46 RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS PLACE HIM IN THIRD PLACE, ONE SHY OF TYING STEVE TRUDNAK (1949-52) FOR SECOND PLACE. MCGEE NEEDS 281 YARDS TO BREAK LEONARD DAVIS' CAREER MARK OF 4,853.

O-LINE STRENGTH

» LENOIR-RHYNE IS LED BY FIRST TEAM ALL-SAC LINEMEN SHANE WELLS WHO EARNED HIS FIRST ALL-SAC SELECTION.

» XAVIER JENNINGS AND BLAKE JEFFERSON EARNED ALL-PIEDMONT DIVISION OFFENSE SELECTIONS TO GIVE LR THREE ALL-CONFERENCE LINEMEN.

» FOUR OFFENSIVE LINEMEN HAVE STARTED EVERY GAME THIS YEAR. BLAKE JEFFERSON MISSED A PAIR OF GAMES WITH INJURY BUT HAS RETURNED AS LR HAS BEEN STEADY ALONG THE LINE THIS YEAR, A KEY FACTOR IN THEIR OFFENSIVE SUCCESS.

» BOTH JENNINGS AND JEFFERSON EARNED ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS LAST YEAR AND WENT BACK-TO-BACK WITH ALL-LEAGUE PICKS.

» THE BEARS HAVE HAD AT LEAST ONE OFFENSIVE LINEMEN SELECTED TO THE ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM EACH YEAR SINCE 2015.
