- » THE NO. 3 BEARS WASTED LITTLE TIME IN FLEXING THEIR MUSCLES IN THE 2023 SEASON OPENER LAST SATURDAY. THE BEARS USED A 16-1 SCORING SPURT TO DEFEAT MARYVILLE 19-4 AT MORETZ STADIUM.
- » LR WENT 6-FOR-6 WITH THE MAN ADVANTAGE AGAINST THE SAINTS, A PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST MAN-UP GOALS SCORED BY THE BEARS. LR HAD SCORED FOUR AGAINST WINGATE LAST SEASON BEFORE BREAKING THAT MARK A WEEK AGO.
- » LR IMPROVED TO 71-29 ALL-TIME AT MORETZ STADIUM ALTHOUGH THIS GAME MARKED THE FIRST IN THE RENOVATED MORETZ STADIUM. THE STADIUM WAS BEING UPGRADED DURING THE 2022 SPRING LAX SEASON AND WAS COMPLETED IN THE SUMMER.
- » THE WIN WAS THE 30TH STRAIGHT VICTORY OVER AN UNRANKED OPPONENT FOR THE BEARS.
- » 10 DIFFERENT PLAYERS SCORED AT LEAST ONE GOAL IN THE BLOWOUT VICTORY AND THREE PLAYERS HAD FIVE POINTS EACH. TORON ECCLESTON (4G, 1A), MYLES MOFFAT (3G, 2A) AND RILEY SEAY (3G, 2A) LED THE WAY FOR LR IN THE SCORING COLUMN.
- » IN HIS LR DEBUT, NOLAN HOFFMAN MADE SEVEN SAVES TO SECURE HIS FIRST CAREER VICTORY AT LENOIR-RHYNE. ROB PENSABENE CAME IN FOR THE FOURTH QUARTER AND POSTED A SHUTOUT WITH A PAIR OF SAVES.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS

- » AS HAS BEEN A TRADITION, THE BEARS ENTER THE SEASON WITH SOME BIG EXPECTATIONS. THE BEARS WERE TABBED AS THE PRESEASON FAVORITE IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACHES' POLL. LR WAS PICKED TO FINISH FIRST AND EARNED SEVEN OF THE 10 FIRST PLACE VOTES IN THE LEAGUE.
- » ADDITIONALLY, LR HAD NINE PLAYERS SELECTED TO THE PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM. MYLES MOFFAT, TORON ECCLESTON, VICTOR POWELL AND COLTEN MCCRACKEN WERE PICKED AS FIRST TEAMERS AND TOMMY AGUILAR, NATE ASHLEY AND JOHN PAULUS WERE PICKED TO THE SECOND TEAM. JOE VENAZIO AND BRYCE REECE ROUNDED OUT THE THIRD TEAM HONORS.
- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS WON BOTH THE REGULAR SEASON AND LEAGUE TOURNAMENT TITLES EACH OF THE PAST TWO SEASONS AND WOULD BE LOOKING TO MAKE IT THREE STRAIGHT REGULAR SEASON TITLES FOR THE SECOND TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY. LR ALSO WON THREE STRAIGHT FROM 2016-18.

BIOGRAPHY

GREG PARADINE STARTED THE LENOIR-RHYNE MEN'S LACROSSE Program and has been the only coach in program history After his hiring in 2009. Paradine, a graduate and all-AMERICAN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA, HAS BROUGHT LR TO UNMATCHED HEIGHTS DURING HIS TENURE.

PARADINE WAS NAMED THE 2018 USILA NCAA DIVISION II NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR AFTER LEADING THE BEARS WITHIN ONE GOAL OF ADVANCING TO THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. PARADINE EARNED HIS SECOND NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR HONOR IN 2021 AFTER HE LED THE BEARS TO A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME AND THE HIGHEST NATIONAL RANKING IN PROGRAM HISTORY (#2). PARADINE HAS GUIDED THE BEARS TO FIVE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONSHIPS, TWO SAC TOURNAMENT TITLE AND THREE NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES. HE OWNS A 121-64 ALL-TIME RECORD AND IS A FOUR-TIME SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACH OF THE YEAR.

PARADINE'S BEARS WON 24 STRAIGHT SAC REGULAR SEASON GAMES, GOING THREE STRAIGHT SEASONS WITH A PERFECT 8-0 LEAGUE MARK. THE BEARS HAVE BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED 71

TIMES, INCLUDING BEING AS HIGH AS NO. 2 IN THE NATION AND HAD A 27-WEEK STRETCH OF BEING RANKED IN THE TOP 10. PARADINE ENGINEERED TWO WINS OVER LIMESTONE WHEN THE SAINTS WERE RANKED NO. 1 IN THE NATION, INCLUDING AN 18-16 WIN IN 2020 WHICH WAS NATIONALLY BROADCAST ON THE LACROSSE SPORTS NETWORK.

IN HIS TENURE, 57 PLAYERS HAVE BEEN SELECTED TO THE ALL-CONFERENCE SQUAD AND 16 HAVE BEEN ALL-AMERICANS. HE HAD THREE PLAYERS WIN SAC PLAYER OF THE YEAR ACCOLADES AND TWO OTHERS BE NAMED SAC FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR, ACADEMICALLY. PARADINE HAS HAD FOUR PLAYERS WIN SAC SCHOLAR-ATHLETES OF THE YEAR AWARDS AND TWO BEEN NAMED THE SAC ELITE 20 AWARD WINNER WHILE MITCH LINKLATER EARNED THE PRESTIGIOUS NCAA ELITE 90 AWARD.

PARADINE CAME TO LR AFTER SERVING AS AN ASSISTANT COACH FOR SEVEN YEARS AT HIS ALMA MATER, THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA. HE WAS A FOUR-YEAR MEMBER OF THE TAR HEELS LAX TEAM AND PLAYED ON FOUR ACC CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS AND WON A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1991.


