NOTES

- Rain switched around the weekend series between the Bears and Warriors which will now take place in Hickory. The weekend was originally schedule to take place in Central, S.C. but weather and LR's turf field brought the 3-game set back to Durham Field.
- Lenoir-Rhyne is searching for a historic weekend. The Bears currently sit at 1,398 all-time wins and can reach the 1,400 mark this weekend with a pair of victories.
- Southern Wesleyan has never scored a run against LR in the two prior meetings in the matchups history. LR has won by counts of 3-0 and 4-0 in the two prior meetings, both at neutral sites.
- LR is coming off a huge comeback victory over Catawba on Wednesday afternoon. The Bears trailed heading into the eighth inning but put a 3-spot on the board. Gavin Marley earned the win and Braden Houston slammed the door shut as the LR bullpen tossed five scoreless innings.
- Blake Bean had himself a game against Catawba, homering in his first two at bats of the day. In total, Bean has hit LR's last four home runs and also leads the squad with five stolen bases (without a caught stealing).
- Coach Ramirez can also grab his 50th win at Durham Field this weekend with a pair of victories. In his time, Ramirez has posted a 48-18 mark at home.
- Joshua Lanham will get the ball on Friday night and has 237 career strikeouts to his ledger. Lanham needs 11 more punchouts to move into sole possession of third place in program history.
