BIOGRAPHY

GREG PARADINE STARTED THE LENOIR-RHYNE MEN'S LACROSSE Program and has been the only coach in program history After his hiring in 2009. Paradine, a graduate and all-AMERICAN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA, HAS BROUGHT LR TO UNMATCHED HEIGHTS DURING HIS TENURE.

PARADINE WAS NAMED THE 2018 USILA NCAA DIVISION II NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR AFTER LEADING THE BEARS WITHIN ONE GOAL OF ADVANCING TO THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. PARADINE EARNED HIS SECOND NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR HONOR IN 2021 AFTER HE LED THE BEARS TO A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME AND THE HIGHEST NATIONAL RANKING IN PROGRAM HISTORY (#2). PARADINE HAS GUIDED THE BEARS TO FIVE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONSHIPS, TWO SAC TOURNAMENT TITLE AND THREE NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES. HE OWNS A 121-64 ALL-TIME RECORD AND IS A FOUR-TIME SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACH OF THE YEAR.

PARADINE'S BEARS WON 24 STRAIGHT SAC REGULAR SEASON GAMES, GOING THREE STRAIGHT SEASONS WITH A PERFECT 8-0 LEAGUE MARK. THE BEARS HAVE BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED 71

TIMES, INCLUDING BEING AS HIGH AS NO. 2 IN THE NATION AND HAD A 27-WEEK STRETCH OF BEING RANKED IN THE TOP 10. PARADINE ENGINEERED TWO WINS OVER LIMESTONE WHEN THE SAINTS WERE RANKED NO. 1 IN THE NATION, INCLUDING AN 18-16 WIN IN 2020 WHICH WAS NATIONALLY BROADCAST ON THE LACROSSE SPORTS NETWORK.

IN HIS TENURE, 57 PLAYERS HAVE BEEN SELECTED TO THE ALL-CONFERENCE SQUAD AND 16 HAVE BEEN ALL-AMERICANS. HE HAD THREE PLAYERS WIN SAC PLAYER OF THE YEAR ACCOLADES AND TWO OTHERS BE NAMED SAC FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR, ACADEMICALLY. PARADINE HAS HAD FOUR PLAYERS WIN SAC SCHOLAR-ATHLETES OF THE YEAR AWARDS AND TWO BEEN NAMED THE SAC ELITE 20 AWARD WINNER WHILE MITCH LINKLATER EARNED THE PRESTIGIOUS NCAA ELITE 90 AWARD.

PARADINE CAME TO LR AFTER SERVING AS AN ASSISTANT COACH FOR SEVEN YEARS AT HIS ALMA MATER, THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA. HE WAS A FOUR-YEAR MEMBER OF THE TAR HEELS LAX TEAM AND PLAYED ON FOUR ACC CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS AND WON A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1991.



NATIONALLY RANKED. THE BEARS COME INTO SUNDAY RANKED
NO. 3 IN THE NATION FOR A SECOND CONSECUTIVE WEEK.

AGAINST RANKED FOE

THE BEARS HAVE A 26-27 MARK AGAINST NATIONALLY RANKED TEAMS. LENOIR-RHYNE IS 3-4 IN NUETRAL SITE GAMES AGAINST NATIONALLY RANKED FOES AS SUNDAY WILL BE THE 8TH SUCH CONTEST.

LAST TIME AGAINST TAMPA

LENOIR-RHYNE MOUNTED A FURIOUS COMEBACK ATTEMPT IN THE FOURTH QUARTER AND SCORED THREE STRAIGHT GOALS TO CUT A FIVE-GOAL DEFICIT TO 13-11 WITH 3:16 TO PLAY BUT LR WOULD PULL NO CLOSER IN A LOSS TO TAMPA IN THE NCAA QUARTERFINALS. THE BEARS DEFEATED TAMPA IN THIS ROUND ALMOST EXACTLY ONE YEAR AGO (MAY 16, 2021) IN OVERTIME BUT THE SPARTANS AVENGED THAT LOSS AND STAYED UNDEFEATED ON THE SEASON.

STATS OF THE GAME

THE SPARTANS JUMPED OUT EARLY, SCORING THE FIRST TWO GOALS OF THE GAME BUT LR WOULD ANSWER TO EVEN IT AT TWO WITH GOALS FROM BRYCE REECE AND WILL CANATA. TAMPA GRABBED THREE STRAIGHT TO MOVE UP 5-2 WITH 3:56 TO GO BUT AGAIN LR WOULD ANSWER. A 3-0 RUN FROM THE BEARS WOULD TIE THE GAME AT FIVE JUST 54 SECONDS INTO THE SECOND QUARTER.

DANIEL FITZPATRICK (TAMPA) AND TOMMY AGUILAR WOULD TRADE GOALS BEFORE TAMPA TOOK THE 7-6 ADVANTAGE ON A COLIN WHITE GOAL, A SCORE THAT STOOD TO THE HALFTIME BREAK.

TAMPA AND LR SAW DEFENSES TIGHTEN IN THE THIRD QUARTER WITH JUST THREE GOALS BEING SCORED. REECE ADDED HIS SECOND FOR THE BEARS BUT TAMPA WOULD OUTSCORE LR 2-1 IN THE PERIOD AND GO UP 9-7 AFTER THREE.

THE TURNING POINT OF THE GAME WAS A QUICK START TO THE FOURTH QUARTER FOR TAMPA. THE SPARTANS SCORED

THREE TIMES IN THE FIRST 58 SECONDS OF THE QUARTER TO PUSH AHEAD 12-7. THIS MARKED THE SECOND STRAIGHT TOURNAMENT THAT TAMPA LED LR BY FIVE IN THE SECOND HALF OF A TOURNAMENT GAME AS LR ERASED A 10-5 DEFICIT IN LAST YEAR'S WIN.

THE BEARS WOULD TRADE A GOAL WITH TAMPA AND STARED A 13-8 DEFICIT DOWN WITH 8:58 TO GO. JOE VENAZIO, TORON ECCLESTON AND AGUILAR FOUND THE BACK OF THE NIGHT IN THE 3-O SPURT FOR LR AS 3:16 REMAINED.

THE BEARS WENT MAN-UP WITH JUST OVER TWO MINUTES TO PLAY BUT AGUILAR'S TWO SHOTS WERE SAVED AS TAMPA RAN OUT THE CLOCK DOWN THE STRETCH.

CANATA FINISHED THE GAME WITH A TEAM-HIGH FIVE POINTS ON THREE GOALS AND TWO ASSISTS. REECE, ECCLESTON AND AGUILAR EACH NETTED TWO GOALS.

WHITE LED TAMPA WITH FIVE GOALS AND FITZPATRICK HAD TWO GOALS AND AN ASSIST.

HUNTER TURNER WON 14-0F-27 FACE OFFS BUT WENT 10-FOR-13 IN THE SECOND HALF TO SWING MOMENTUM. TURNER FINISHED WITH NINE GROUND BALLS.

TAMPA DOMINATED THE GROUND BALL CATEGORY, GRABBING 37 TO JUST 25 BY THE BEARS.

THE PLAYER OF THE GAME FOR TAMPA WAS GOALIE BLAKE ULMER WHO MADE 21 SAVES. NOAH JOHNSON HAD 12 STOPS FOR THE BEARS.

BEYOND THE BOX SCORE

NEW KEEPER

FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE BEGINNING OF THE 2020 SEASON, NOAH JOHNSON WASN'T IN GOAL FOR LR. JOHNSON HAD STARTED 40 STRAIGHT GAMES IN NET BUT NOLAN HOFFMAN DIDN'T MISS A BEAT. IN HIS FIRST LR GAME SINCE TRANSFERING IN FROM COLORADO MESA, THE JUNIOR ALLOWED JUST FOUR GOALS IN THREE QUARTERS AND MADE SEVEN SAVES TO EARN THE WIN OVER MARYVILLE.

GOING BACK TO JOHNSON, ONE OF HIS MOST MEMORABLE PLAYS CAME AGAINST NORTH GREENVILLE WHEN HE SCORED A FIRST-HALF GOAL AGAINST THE CRUSADERS FOR HIS ONLY CAREER GOAL. EVENTUALLY, LR WOULD BEAT NORTH GREENVILLE 9-8 IN THE 2021 SEASON OPENER ON THEIR WAY TO ADVANCING TO A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME.

ON TOP OF JOHNSON IN GOAL, LR ALSO LOST ALL-AMERICAN MITCHELL LINKLATER BUT MANY PLAYERS ARE READY TO STEP INTO HIS SPOT. JAMES BRUGGER WAS ALSO LOST TO GRADUATION AND HE STARTED 17 OF 19 GAMES AT D.

ATTENDANCE LEADERS

LENOIR-RHYNE LED ALL OF NCAA DIVISION II IN ATTENDANCE LAST YEAR, DRAWING 6,430 FANS TO THEIR 11 HOME GAMES. IN TERMS OF CUMULATIVE ATTENDANCE, THE BEARS DWARFED THE REST OF THE NATION. FINISHING SECOND WAS ALABAMA HUNTSVILLE WHO HAD 3,906 CUMULATIVE FANS FOR THE YEAR. NOT COUNTING THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP OR THE CROWN CLASSIC PLAYED AT A NEUTRAL VENUE, THE BEARS HAD THREE OF THE TOP FOUR HIGHEST ATTENDED GAMES IN THE NATION AND FIVE OF THE TOP NINE HIGHEST ATTENDED ON-CAMPUS GAMES WERE IN HICKORY.

SCHEDULING THE BEST

ACCORDING TO OPPONENTS WIN/LOSS RECORD, LENOIR-RHYHE HAD THE THIRD TOUGHEST STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE IN 2022. OPPONENTS HAD A 204-99 MARK AND A .673 WINNING PERCENTAGE AS LR TRAILED ONLY LEMOYNE AND FLORIDA TECH IN THAT CATEGORY.
