NOTES

- It's the beginning of conference action for both the Bears and the Trojans; in the pre-season poll, the Bears were picked to finish second in the standings with the Trojans coming a little further down the standings at seventh.
- The Bears have been rolling in weekend series this season, starting off the year with a 4-0 record in series victories, which include one on the road against Auburn University at Montgomery in Feb. 4-5.
- Anderson is on an upswing of momentum right now with their five-game winning streak coming into Saturday; the Trojans only won four games before this winning streak began.
- LR has struggled with their bats in the last couple of road games against North Greenville and Coker, failing to reach a .200 batting average in each contest with a .179 and .194 average, respectively.
- Blake Bean continues to be the best bat for the Bears with a team-best .361 batting average; in conference ranks, his six home runs lead the league while his 18 RBIs have him tied for fourth.
- Watch for plenty of pitching duels between these two programs as they have the best two ERAs in the conference with LR leading with its 3.53 ERA and Anderson coming in second with its 3.86 ERA
- Nathan Sanders has had a great start to the season for the Trojans with the second-best ERA in the conference with a 1.02 ERA; in his last outing against Lincoln (Pa.), he went 7.0 innings and only allowed two hits and one run.
- The Bears have two of the best strikeout pitchers in the SAC with Josh Lanham sitting second in the conference ranks with 33 strikeouts while Andrew Patrick is tied for fifth with 26 strikeouts.
- Using their power at the plate has not been a problem for the Bears this season with 46 extra-base hits, which is third-best in the SAC; however, for the Trojans, they have struggled to make significant contact with 21 extra-base hits, which is tied for last in the conference.
