NOTES

- Expect both offenses to have a big impact in the series as each program ranks in the Top 5 for batting average; LR sit in second with a .318 mark and UVA-Wise come in fifth with a .294 mark.
- In addition to having some success with making contact, LR is second in the conference with a .421 OBP with UVA-Wise sitting just behind them with a .412 OBP.
- Watch out for some souvenirs! These two teams sit 1-2 at the top of the conference with home runs. LR leads the SAC with 50 while UVA-Wise has 37.
- Andrew Patrick became the first LR pitcher this season to earn the SAC Pitcher of the Week award on March 28; the senior went 7.0 scoreless innings pitched with 12 strikeouts to earn the win in a 4-0 result.
- LR pitching continues to hold onto its lead at the top of the SAC with a 3.58 ERA; UVA-Wise has had more struggles on the mound with second-lowest ERA in the conference with an 8.49 total.
- The Cavaliers have been sloppy on the field this season with a conference-most 66 errors; LR has had their fair share, but the Bears have only committed 41 errors, which is tied for the fifth fewest in conference.
- LR might want to watch out on the base paths as UVA-Wise has thrown out 18 runners on the base paths, which is good enough to be the second most in the conference; they have a 27.3% RCS.
- Speaking about stolen bases, UVA-Wise is not very aggressive out on the base paths with only 19 stolen bases this season, with only two of them coming during conference play.
- The player to watch out for on UVA-Wise is Cole Harness. The junior leads the conference with 51 RBIs and is tied for second in the SAC with 11 home runs.
- In the four-conference series that the Bears have played, each set has ended in a sweep. LR swept Anderson, Emory & Henry, and Mars Hill. However, they got swept by Wingate.
