EPIC REMATCH

» MONDAY'S CHAMPIONSHIP GAME BETWEEN LR AND LIMESTONE WILL BE A REMATCH OF THE EPIC 18-17 LR OVERTIME VICTORY THAT TOOK PLACE JUST OVER TWO WEEKS AGO. THE SAINTS TRAILED BY THREE WITH 1:23 TO GO BUT SCORED THREE STRAIGHT TO FORCE OT. FUELED BY A SINGLE GAME RECORD OF 22 SAVES FROM ROB PENSABENE AND ONE HUGE STOP IN OT, THE BEARS GOT THE GAME WINNER FROM RILEY SEAY TO TOP THE SAINTS.

» IT ALSO WILL BE A REMATCH OF LAST YEAR'S SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT TITLE GAME. THE BEARS HANDLED LIMESTONE RELATIVELY EASILY LAST YEAR WITH A 14-11 VICTORY IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP. LR LED 14-7 BEFORE THE SAINTS SCORED THE FINAL FOUR GOALS OF THE GAME.

HEAD-TO-HEAD

» AFTER LOSING THE FIRST SIX MEETINGS IN THE SERIES, LENOIR-RHYNE HAS GONE 5-2 OVER THE LAST SEVEN AGAINST THE SAINTS, INCLUDING FOUR OF THE LAST FIVE.

» THE 18 GOALS SCORED BY THE BEARS AGAINST LIMESTONE ON APRIL 15 TIES FOR THE MOST GOALS IN A GAME AGAINST THE SAINTS IN SERIES HISTORY. LIMESTONE'S 23 GOALS BACK IN 2016 STAND AS THE MOST BETWEEN THE TWO PROGRAMS IN HEAD-TO-HEAD SITUATIONS.

SAC TOURNAMENT DOMINANCE

» LENOIR-RHYNE IS GUNNING FOR ITS THIRD STRAIGHT SAC TOURNAMENT TITLE AND PUTS A FIVE-GAME WINNING STREAK IN SAC TOURNAMENT PLAY ON THE LINE ON MONDAY.

» A WIN ON MONDAY WOULD NOT ONLY GIVE LR THREE STRAIGHT, IT WOULD MARK THE FOURTH SAC TOURNAMENT TITLE IN PROGRAM HISTORY. THE BEARS FIRST CHAMPIONSHIP CAME IN 2016.

» THIS WOULD ALSO BE THE SECOND STRAIGHT SEASON THAT LR WOULD WIN THE TITLE AS THE NUMBER 2 SEED, DOING SO IN 2022 WITH WINS OVER #3 SEED WINGATE (17-13) AND #1 SEED LIMESTONE (14-11) IN HICKORY.

» THIS IS THE FIRST SAC TOURNAMENT TO BE HELD AT A NEUTRAL SITE. PREVIOUSLY, THE TOURNAMENT ROTATED LEAGUE VENUES THAT HAD TURF AND LIGHTS TO ACCOMMODATE THE MEN'S AND WOMEN'S TOURNAMENTS. GOING FORWARD, THE LEAGUE AIMS TO MAKE THIS A NEUTRAL VENUE FOR FUTURE CHAMPIONSHIPS.

BIOGRAPHY

GREG PARADINE STARTED THE LENOIR-RHYNE MEN'S LACROSSE PROGRAM AND HAS BEEN THE ONLY COACH IN PROGRAM HISTORY AFTER HIS HIRING IN 2009. PARADINE, A GRADUATE AND ALL-AMERICAN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA, HAS BROUGHT LR TO UNMATCHED HEIGHTS DURING HIS TENURE.

PARADINE WAS NAMED THE 2018 USILA NCAA DIVISION II NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR AFTER LEADING THE BEARS WITHIN ONE GOAL OF ADVANCING TO THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. PARADINE EARNED HIS SECOND NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR HONOR IN 2021 AFTER HE LED THE BEARS TO A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME AND THE HIGHEST NATIONAL RANKING IN PROGRAM HISTORY (#2). PARADINE HAS GUIDED THE BEARS TO FIVE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONSHIPS, TWO SAC TOURNAMENT TITLE AND THREE NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES. HE OWNS A 121-64 ALL-TIME RECORD AND IS A FOUR-TIME SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACH OF THE YEAR.

PARADINE'S BEARS WON 24 STRAIGHT SAC REGULAR SEASON GAMES, GOING THREE STRAIGHT SEASONS WITH A PERFECT 8-0 LEAGUE MARK. THE BEARS HAVE BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED 71

TIMES, INCLUDING BEING AS HIGH AS NO. 2 IN THE NATION AND HAD A 27-WEEK STRETCH OF BEING RANKED IN THE TOP 10. PARADINE ENGINEERED TWO WINS OVER LIMESTONE WHEN THE SAINTS WERE RANKED NO. 1 IN THE NATION, INCLUDING AN 18-16 WIN IN 2020 WHICH WAS NATIONALLY BROADCAST ON THE LACROSSE SPORTS NETWORK.

IN HIS TENURE, 57 PLAYERS HAVE BEEN SELECTED TO THE ALL-CONFERENCE SQUAD AND 16 HAVE BEEN ALL-AMERICANS. HE HAD THREE PLAYERS WIN SAC PLAYER OF THE YEAR ACCOLADES AND TWO OTHERS BE NAMED SAC FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR. ACADEMICALLY, PARADINE HAS HAD FOUR PLAYERS WIN SAC SCHOLAR-ATHLETES OF THE YEAR AWARDS AND TWO BEEN NAMED THE SAC ELITE 20 AWARD WINNER WHILE MITCH LINKLATER EARNED THE PRESTIGIOUS NCAA ELITE 90 AWARD.

PARADINE CAME TO LR AFTER SERVING AS AN ASSISTANT COACH FOR SEVEN YEARS AT HIS ALMA MATER, THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA. HE WAS A FOUR-YEAR MEMBER OF THE TAR HEELS LAX TEAM AND PLAYED ON FOUR ACC CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS AND WON A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1991.

MAN-UP OFFENSE

THE BEARS ARE ONE OF THE MOST POTENT OFFENSES IN THE NATION WITH THE MAN ADVANTAGE. LR RANKS NO. 6 IN THE NATION IN CONVERTING AT A 50 PERCENT CLIP. ECCLESTON'S THREE MAN-UP GOALS IS A PROGRAM RECORD ITSELF. ON THE YEAR, ECCLESTON'S NINE MAN-UP GOALS RANK THE SENIOR SEVENTH IN THE NATION.

HELPER HELPER

LENOIR-RHYNE IS RANKED SIXTH IN THE NATION IN ASSISTS WITH 158 THROUGH THE FIRST 16 GAMES. THE AVERAGE OF 10.5 ASSISTS PER GAME RANKS THEM FIFTH IN THE NATION. WITH HIS STRONG GAME AGAINST NEWBERRY ON SATURDAY, TORON ECCLESTON CONTINUES TO CLIMB UP THE SCORING CHARTS FOR LENOIR-RHYNE. ECCLESTON'S 152 CAREER GOALS PLACE HIM SECOND IN PROGRAM HISTORY. ERIC DICKINSON'S 206 CAREER GOAL MARK WILL NOT BE TOUCHED. ECCLESTON HAS 198 CAREER POINTS WHICH PUTS HIM FOURTH IN TEAM HISTORY. WITH TWO POINTS, ECCLESTON WILL BE ONE OF JUST FOUR PLAYERS IN PROGRAM HISTORY WITH 200 CAREER POINTS.
