### MAY MADNESS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE KNOCKED OFF TOP-SEEDED ROLLINS WITH THEIR BEST ALL-AROUND EFFORT ON SUNDAY, HANDING THE TARS A 14-8 DEFEAT.
- » EVAN VOSS BROKE A PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST ASSISTS IN AN NCAA TOURNAMENT GAME WITH HIS FIVE HELPERS AND HIS SEVEN TOTAL POINTS TIED FOR THE MOST IN AN NCAA TOURNAMENT GAME BY A BEAR.
- » PRIOR TO KNOCKING OFF ROLLINS ON SUNDAY, THE BEARS BEAT NO. 4 SEED TAMPA ON WEDNESDAY, 10-9. ACCORDING TO SEEDING, LR HAS PULLED BACK-TO-BACK UPSETS.

### ROAD WARRIORS

- » THE BEARS HAVE NAVIGATED A TOUGH TRAVEL SCHEDULE TO ADVANCE TO THE THIRD NCAA SEMIFINAL IN PROGRAM HISTORY. THE TRIP FROM HICKORY TO TAMPA IS 630 MILES AND THE BEARS LEFT ON MONDAY FOR A WEDNESDAY GAME.
- » AFTER BEATING TAMPA, LR TRAVELED 101 MILES TO ORLANDO AND KNOCKED OFF THE TARS ON SUNDAY AFTERNOON AND THEN HIT THE ROAD FOR 571 MORE MILES FROM ORLANDO BACK TO HICKORY TO PREPARE FOR THE NATIONAL SEMIFINAL.
- » LUCKILY FOR LR, THE TRIP TO LIMESTONE IS MUCH EASIER AT JUST A 69-MILE TRIP. IN TOTAL, LR WILL ACCUMULATE 1,371 MILES TRAVELED.

### FIRST FIVE-SEED

- » LENOIR-RHYNE IS ATTEMPTING TO BE THE ONLY FIVE SEED IN THE HISTORY OF THE NCAA DIVISION II MEN'S LACROSSE TOURNAMENT TO MAKE A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME APPEARANCE.
- » THEY ARE ALREADY THE FIRST FIVE SEED TO MAKE IT TO THE NATIONAL SEMIFINAL GAME.
- » MERCYHURST MADE, AND WON, THE 2019 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AS A 6-SEED.
- » FIVE SEEDS HAD A 3-6 RECORD IN NCAA TOURNAMENTS HEADING INTO THIS YEAR AND ADELPHI WENT 1-1 IN THE NORTH. THE FIRST YEAR THE TOURNAMENT EXPANDED TO MORE THAN FOUR TEAMS WAS BACK IN 2019.

## BIOGRAPHY

GREG PARADINE STARTED THE LENOIR-RHYNE MEN'S LACROSSE PROGRAM AND HAS BEEN THE ONLY COACH IN PROGRAM HISTORY AFTER HIS HIRING IN 2009. PARADINE, A GRADUATE AND ALL-AMERICAN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA, HAS BROUGHT LR TO UNMATCHED HEIGHTS DURING HIS TENURE.

PARADINE WAS NAMED THE 2018 USILA NCAA DIVISION II NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR AFTER LEADING THE BEARS WITHIN ONE GOAL OF ADVANCING TO THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. PARADINE EARNED HIS SECOND NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR HONOR IN 2021 AFTER HE LED THE BEARS TO A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME AND THE HIGHEST NATIONAL RANKING IN PROGRAM HISTORY (#2). PARADINE HAS GUIDED THE BEARS TO FIVE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONSHIPS, TWO SAC TOURNAMENT TITLE AND THREE NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES. HE OWNS A 121-64 ALL-TIME RECORD AND IS A FOUR-TIME SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACH OF THE YEAR.

PARADINE'S BEARS WON 24 STRAIGHT SAC REGULAR SEASON GAMES, GOING THREE STRAIGHT SEASONS WITH A PERFECT 8-0 LEAGUE MARK. THE BEARS HAVE BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED 71

TIMES, INCLUDING BEING AS HIGH AS NO. 2 IN THE NATION AND HAD A 27-WEEK STRETCH OF BEING RANKED IN THE TOP 10. PARADINE ENGINEERED TWO WINS OVER LIMESTONE WHEN THE SAINTS WERE RANKED NO. 1 IN THE NATION, INCLUDING AN 18-16 WIN IN 2020 WHICH WAS NATIONALLY BROADCAST ON THE LACROSSE SPORTS NETWORK.

IN HIS TENURE, 68 PLAYERS HAVE BEEN SELECTED TO THE ALL-CONFERENCE SQUAD AND 16 HAVE BEEN ALL-AMERICANS. HE HAD THREE PLAYERS WIN SAC PLAYER OF THE YEAR ACCOLADES AND TWO OTHERS BE NAMED SAC FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR. ACADEMICALLY, PARADINE HAS HAD FOUR PLAYERS WIN SAC SCHOLAR-ATHLETES OF THE YEAR AWARDS AND TWO BEEN NAMED THE SAC ELITE 20 AWARD WINNER WHILE MITCH LINKLATER EARNED THE PRESTIGIOUS NCAA ELITE 90 AWARD.

PARADINE CAME TO LR AFTER SERVING AS AN ASSISTANT COACH FOR SEVEN YEARS AT HIS ALMA MATER, THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA. HE WAS A FOUR-YEAR MEMBER OF THE TAR HEELS LAX TEAM AND PLAYED ON FOUR ACC CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS AND WON A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1991.

### ALL SAC SEMI

THE BEARS AND SAINTS MEET AS TWO OF THE THREE PROGRAMS FROM THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE TO MAKE THE 2023 NCAA TOURNAMENT. WINGATE WAS ELIMINATED BY UNIDY IN THE FIRST ROUND OF THE TOURNAMENT. THIS MARKS THE THIRD STRAIGHT YEAR THAT AT LEAST ONE SAC TEAM HAS MADE THE NATIONAL SEMIFINAL. LR BEAT WINGATE IN THE NATIONAL SEMIFINAL IN 2021 AND LIMESTONE FELL TO TAMPA IN THE 2022 SEMIFINAL.

### MAN-UP OFFENSE

THE BEARS ARE ONE OF THE MOST POTENT OFFENSES IN THE NATION WITH THE MAN ADVANTAGE. LR RANKS NO. 5 IN THE NATION IN CONVERTING AT A 46.4 PERCENT CLIP. THE BEARS TIED A PROGRAM RECORD -- WHICH THEY SET EARLIER THIS SEASON -- WITH SIX MAN-UP GOALS AGAINST FLORIDA TECH WITH THREE COMING FROM TORON ECCLESTON. ECCLESTON'S THREE MAN-UP GOALS IS A PROGRAM RECORD ITSELF. ON THE YEAR, ECCLESTON'S NINE MAN-UP GOALS RANK THE SENIOR SEVENTH IN THE NATION.

### ACTIVE SCORERS

LENOIR-RHYNE HAS THREE PLAYERS AMONG THE ACTIVE NCAA DIVISION II LEADERS IN GOALS SCORED. MYLES MOFFAT RANKS FIFTH AMONG ACTIVE PLAYERS WITH 168 GOALS, ONE SPOT AHEAD OF TEAMMATE TORON ECCLESTON WHO HAS 158. JOE VENAZION HAS 154 CAREER GOALS BUT TORE HIS ACL AFTER THE BEARS' NINTH GAME OF THE SEASON. MOFFAT ALSO RANKS FOURTH IN ACTIVE CAREER ASSISTS WITH 120 IN HIS 80 GAMES PLAYED.

### HELPER HELPER

LENOIR-RHYNE IS RANKED FOURTH IN THE NATION IN ASSISTS WITH 191 THROUGH THE FIRST 19 GAMES. THE AVERAGE OF 10.1 ASSISTS PER GAME RANKS THEM SIXTH IN THE NATION. THE BEARS TIED THE PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST ASSISTS IN A GAME WITH 18 ON 20 GOALS IN A WIN OVER CATAWBA EARLIER THIS SEASON. THE BEARS ALSO BROKE THE SINGLE-SEASON PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST ASSISTS IN A SEASON WHICH

WAS SET IN THE 2021 NATIONAL RUNNER-UP SEASON.

### OTHER PROGRAM MARKS TOPPLE

ON TOP OF BREAKING THE RECORD FOR MOST ASSISTS IN A SEASON, LR ALSO BROKE THE RECORD FOR MOST POINTS IN A YEAR. WITH 25 POINTS AGAINST ROLLINS, LR TOPPED THE 478 THEY HAD IN 2021 AND ARE UP TO 497 THIS YEAR. LR ALSO TOPPED THE PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST GOALS IN A SEASON WITH 306 WITH 14 MORE AGAINST ROLLINS. LR SCORED 303 TIMES IN 2021.

### STINGY D

ONE OF THE BEST DEFENSES IN THE NATION RESIDES IN HICKORY. ONLY FOUR OF LR'S OPPONENTS HAVE MANAGED TO REACH DOUBLE DIGITS IN GOALS. THE BEARS ALLOW JUST 8.1 GOALS PER GAME WHICH RANKS FOURTH IN THE NATION AND IS THE TOP MARK IN THE SAC. NEITHER OF THE BEARS TWO NCAA TOURNAMENTS REACHED DOUBLE FIGURES IN SCORING WITH TAMPA HAVING NINE AND ROLLINS TOTALING EIGHT.

### POTENT O

THE DEFENSE ISN'T THE ONLY UNIT PUTTING UP IMPRESSIVE NUMBERS. COMING INTO SUNDAY'S GAME, THE BEARS OFFENSE AVERAGES 16.1 GOALS PER GAME. THE BEARS RANK NINTH IN THE NATION.

### BIG ROB STEPS UP

ROB PENSABENE HAS BEEN TERRIFIC SINCE BEING INSERTED IN THE LINEUP AT GOALIE. HE BROKE THE SINGLE-GAME RECORD WITH 22 SAVES AGAINST LIMESTONE IN A HUGE OVERTIME VICTORY AND MADE 15 STOPS, INCLUDING THE GAME-WINNER WITH 45 SECONDS LEFT, IN A VICTORY OVER TAMPA IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT'S FIRST ROUND GAME. HE ALSO HAD 15 SAVES IN A WIN OVER ROLLINS.

### NICE TO HAVE #28 BACK

VICTOR POWELL WAS INJURED IN LR'S LOSS TO WINGATE IN LATE MARCH AND MISSED THE FINAL SIX GAMES OF THE REGULAR SEASON. HOWEVER, THE ALL-AMERICAN DEFENDER

RETURNED FOR THE NCAA TOURNAMENT AND HAS BEEN A BIG REASON WHY TOURNEY OPPONENTS HAVE SCORED JUST 17 GOALS IN TWO GAMES.

### AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

NOT ONLY HAS LENOIR-RHYNE PLAYED AGAINST THE MOST RANKED OPPONENTS IN A SINGLE SEASON IN PROGRAM HISTORY, THEY HAVE BEEN HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL IN THOSE GAMES. LR COMES INTO SUNDAY WITH A 9-3 MARK AGAINST NATIONALLY RANKED PROGRAMS. COMING INTO THE SEASON, LR HAD PLAYED 53 GAMES AGAINST NATIONALLY RANKED OPPONENTS IN THE FIRST 12 SEASONS BUT THE 12 THIS YEAR ARE BY FAR THE MOST IN ONE YEAR.

### ATTENDANCE LEADERS

AFTER LEADING ALL OF NCAA DIVISION II IN ATTENDANCE LAST YEAR, LENOIR-RHYNE LEADS THE NATION AGAIN THIS YEAR. THE GAME BETWEEN LR AND LIMESTONE IN HICKORY WAS THE MOST ATTENDED DIVISION II LACROSSE GAME OF THE SEASON. 763 SPECTATORS TOPPED THE 740 HELD IN BALTIMORE, MD THAT SAW FROSTBURG ST. BEAT ST. ROSE 11-10. THE LR/ WINGATE GAME HAD 639 SPECTATORS, WHICH IS THE FIFTH-MOST ATTENDED GAME OF THE YEAR ACROSS DIVISION II. ON THE YEAR, LR HAS HAD 4,258 SPECTATORS ON THE SEASON, OVER 1,200 MORE THAN THE SECOND PLACE TEAM.

### AMONG THE BEST
