### **NATTY BOUND**

- » FOR THE SECOND TIME IN THREE YEARS, LENOIR-RHYNE IS HEADED TO THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME. AFTER DROPPING THE 2021 FINAL BY A SCORE OF 12-6 AGAINST LEMOYNE, THE BEARS ARE IN SEARCH OF THEIR FIRST NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP IN PROGRAM HISTORY.
- » IN THE 102-YEAR HISTORY OF LENOIR-RHYNE ATHLETICS, ONLY ONE OTHER MEN'S TEAM HAS WON A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. THE 1960 LR FOOTBALL TEAM BROUGHT HOME AN NAIA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. LR HAS ADVANCED TO TWO NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES PRIOR TO THIS ONE. THE 2013 FOOTBALL SQUAD LOST TO NORTHWEST MISSOURI ST AND MEN'S LAX DROPPED THE 2021 FINAL TO LEMOYNE.

#### **ROAD WARRIORS**

- » THE BEARS HAVE NAVIGATED A TOUGH TRAVEL SCHEDULE TO ADVANCE TO THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. THE TRIP FROM HICKORY TO TAMPA IS 630 MILES AND THE BEARS LEFT ON MONDAY FOR A WEDNESDAY GAME.
- » AFTER BEATING TAMPA, LR TRAVELED 101 MILES TO ORLANDO AND KNOCKED OFF THE TARS ON SUNDAY AFTERNOON AND THEN HIT THE ROAD FOR 571 MORE MILES FROM ORLAND BACK TO HICKORY TO PREPARE FOR THE NATIONAL SEMIFINAL.
- » LUCKILY FOR LR, THE TRIP TO LIMESTONE IS MUCH EASIER AT JUST A 69-MILE TRIP. IN TOTAL, LR ACCUMULATED 1,371 MILES TRAVELED TO ADVANCE OUT OF THE SOUTH REGION.
- » THE BUS TRIP FROM LR TO PHILADELPHIA IS 542 MILES TO MAKE IT 1,913 MILES TRAVELED IN TOTAL FOR THE BEARS.

#### FIRST FIVE-SEED

- » LENOIR-RHYNE IS THE ONLY FIVE SEED IN THE HISTORY OF THE NCAA DIVISION II MEN'S LACROSSE TOURNAMENT TO MAKE A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME APPEARANCE.
- » MERRIMACK MADE, AND WON, THE 2019 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AS A 6-SEED.
- » FIVE SEEDS HAD A 3-6 RECORD IN NCAA TOURNAMENTS HEADAING INTO THIS YEAR AND ADELPHI WENT 1-1 IN THE NORTH. THE FIRST YEAR THE TOURNAMENT EXPANDED TO MORE THAN FOUR TEAMS WAS BACK IN 2019.

# **BIOGRAPHY**

GREG PARADINE STARTED THE LENOIR-RHYNE MEN'S LACROSSE Program and has been the only coach in program history After his hiring in 2009. Paradine, a graduate and all-AMERICAN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA, HAS BROUGHT LR TO UNMATCHED HEIGHTS DURING HIS TENURE.

PARADINE WAS NAMED THE 2018 USILA NCAA DIVISION II NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR AFTER LEADING THE BEARS WITHIN ONE GOAL OF ADVANCING TO THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. PARADINE EARNED HIS SECOND NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR HONOR IN 2021 AFTER HE LED THE BEARS TO A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME AND THE HIGHEST NATIONAL RANKING IN PROGRAM HISTORY (#2). PARADINE HAS GUIDED THE BEARS TO FIVE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONSHIPS, TWO SAC TOURNAMENT TITLE AND THREE NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES. HE OWNS A 121-64 ALL-TIME RECORD AND IS A FOUR-TIME SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACH OF THE YEAR.

PARADINE'S BEARS WON 24 STRAIGHT SAC REGULAR SEASON GAMES, GOING THREE STRAIGHT SEASONS WITH A PERFECT 8-0 LEAGUE MARK. THE BEARS HAVE BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED 71

TIMES, INCLUDING BEING AS HIGH AS NO. 2 IN THE NATION AND HAD A 27-WEEK STRETCH OF BEING RANKED IN THE TOP 10. PARADINE ENGINEERED TWO WINS OVER LIMESTONE WHEN THE SAINTS WERE RANKED NO. 1 IN THE NATION, INCLUDING AN 18-16 WIN IN 2020 WHICH WAS NATIONALLY BROADCAST ON THE LACROSSE SPORTS NETWORK.

IN HIS TENURE, 68 PLAYERS HAVE BEEN SELECTED TO THE All-conference squad and 16 have been all-americans. He had THREE PLAYERS WIN SAC PLAYER OF THE YEAR ACCOLADES AND TWO OTHERS BE NAMED SAC FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR, ACADEMICALLY. PARADINE HAS HAD FOUR PLAYERS WIN SAC SCHOLAR-ATHLETES OF THE YEAR AWARDS AND TWO BEEN NAMED THE SAC ELITE 20 AWARD WINNER WHILE MITCH LINKLATER EARNED THE PRESTIGIOUS NCAA

PARADINE CAME TO LR AFTER SERVING AS AN ASSISTANT COACH FOR SEVEN YEARS AT HIS ALMA MATER, THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA. HE WAS A FOUR-YEAR MEMBER OF THE TAR HEELS LAX TEAM AND PLAYED ON FOUR ACC CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS AND WON A NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1991.

THE BEARS AND SAINTS MET AS TWO OF THE THREE PROGRAMS FROM THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE TO MAKE THE 2023 NCAA TOURNAMENT. WINGATE WAS ELIMINATED BY UINDY IN THE FIRST ROUND OF THE TOURNAMENT. THIS MARKS THE THIRD STRAIGHT YEAR THAT AT LEAST ONE SAC TEAM HAS MADE THE NATIONAL SEMIFINAL. LR BEAT WINGATE IN THE NATIONAL SEMIFINAL IN 2021 AND LIMESTONE FELL TO TAMPA IN THE 2022 SEMIFINAL.

### **COMING HOME**

LR TEAMMATES ROB PENSABENE AND BRYCE REECE ARE HEADING HOME. THE MOUNT LAUREL, N.J. NATIVES GREW UP TOGETHER AND LIVED JUST 25 MINUTES OUTSIDE OF PHILADELPHIA. THE DUO PLAYED HIGH SCHOOL TOGETHER AT LENAPE HS JUST OVER THE BEN FRANKLIN BRIDGE.

### **ACTIVE SCORERS**

LENOIR-RHYNE HAS THREE PLAYERS AMONG THE ACTIVE NCAA DIVISION II LEADERS IN GOALS SCORED. MYLES MOFFAT RANKS FIFTH AMONG ACTIVE PLAYERS WITH 171 GOALS, ONE SPOT AHEAD OF TEAMMATE TORON ECCLESTON WHO HAS 161. JOE VENAZION HAS 154 CAREER GOALS BUT TORE HIS ACL AFTER THE BEARS' NINTH GAME OF THE SEASON. MOFFAT ALSO RANKS FOURTH IN ACTIVE CAREER ASSISTS WITH 122 IN HIS 81 GAMES PLAYED.

### HELPER HELPER

LENOIR-RHYNE IS RANKED FOURTH IN THE NATION IN ASSISTS WITH 203 THROUGH THE FIRST 20 GAMES. THE AVERAGE OF 10.05 ASSISTS PER GAME RANKS THEM FIFTH IN THE NATION. THE BEARS TIED THE PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST ASSISTS IN A GAME WITH 18 ON 20 GOALS IN A WIN OVER CATAWBA EARLIER THIS SEASON. THE BEARS ALSO BROKE THE SINGLE-SEASON PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST ASSISTS IN A SEASON WHICH WAS SET IN THE 2021 NATIONAL RUNNER-UP SEASON. LR'S 12 ASSISTS IN THE WIN OVER LIMESTONE ON SUNDAY WAS THE MOST ASSISTS IN AN NCAA TOURNAMENT GAME IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

### OTHER PROGRAM MARKS TOPPLE

ON TOP OF BREAKING THE RECORD FOR MOST ASSISTS IN A SEASON. LR ALSO BROKE THE RECORD FOR MOST POINTS IN A YEAR. WITH 25 POINTS AGAINST ROLLINS, LR TOPPED THE 478 THEY HAD IN 2021 AND ARE UP TO 497 THIS YEAR. LR ALSO TOPPED THE PRORAM RECORD FOR MOST GOALS IN A SEASON WITH 306 WITH 14 MORE AGAINST ROLLINS. LR SCORED 303 TIMES IN 2021.

### STINGY D

TWO OF THE BEST DEFENSES IN THE NATION WILL BE SHOWCASED ON SUNDAY. MERCYHURST ALLOWS 8.22 GOALS PER GAME WHICH RANKS FOURTH IN THE NATION. ONLY FIVE OF LR'S OPPONENTS HAVE MANAGED TO REACH DOUBLE DIGITS IN GOALS. THE BEARS ALLOW JUST 8.25 GOALS PER GAME WHICH RANKS FIFTH IN THE NATION AND IS THE TOP MARK IN THE SAC. NEITHER OF THE BEARS TWO NCAA TOURNAMENTS REACHED DOUBLE FIGURES IN SCORING WITH TAMPA HAVING NINE AND ROLLINS TOTALING EIGHT. LIMESTONE GOT TO 11 GOALS BY SCORING TWICE IN THE FINAL 23 SECONDS WHEN THE GAME WAS DECIDED.

### POTENT O

THE DEFENSE ISN'T THE ONLY UNIT PUTTING UP IMPRESSIVE NUMBERS. COMING INTO SUNDAY'S GAME, THE BEARS OFFENSE AVERAGES 16.2 GOALS PER GAME. THE BEARS RANK FIGHTH IN THE NATION.

### BIG ROB STEPS UP

ROB PENSABENE HAS BEEN TERRIFIC SINCE BEING INSERTED IN THE LINEUP AT GOALIE. HE BROKE THE SINGLE-GAME RECORD WITH 22 SAVES AGAINST LIMESTONE IN A HUGE OVERTIME VICTORY. HE MADE 15 STOPS, INCLUDING THE GAME-WINNER WITH 45 SECONDS LEFT, IN A VICTORY OVER TAMPA IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT'S FIRST ROUND GAME AND ADDED 15 AGAINST ROLLINS. IN THE WIN OVER LIMESTONE, PENSABENE HAD 12 STOPS AND NEEDS 16 TO BREAK THE ALL-TIME DIVISION II MARK FOR MOST SAVES IN A TOURNAMENT WHICH HAS STOOD SINCE TIM HART STOPPED 57 SHOTS IN THE 1977

### TOURNAMENT.

### NICE TO HAVE #28 BACK

VICTOR POWELL WAS INJURED IN LR'S LOSS TO WINGATE IN LATE MARCH AND MISSED THE FINAL SIX GAMES OF THE REGULAR SEASON. HOWEVER, THE ALL-AMERICAN DEFENDER RETURNED FOR THE NCAA TOURNAMENT AND HAS BEEN A BIG REASON WHY TOURNEY OPPONENTS HAVE SCORED JUST 28 GOALS IN THREE GAMES.

### AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

NOT ONLY HAS LENOIR-RHYNE PLAYED AGAINST THE MOST RANKED OPPONENTS IN A SINGLE SEASON IN PROGRAM HISTORY, THEY HAVE BEEN HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL IN THOSE GAMES. LR COMES INTO SUNDAY WITH A 10-3 MARK AGAINST NATIONALLY RANKED PROGRAMS. COMING INTO THE SEASON, LR HAD PLAYED 53 GAMES AGAINST NATIONALLY RANKED OPPONENTS IN THE FIRST 12 SEASONS BUT THE 13 THIS YEAR ARE BY FAR THE MOST IN ONE YEAR.

### ATTENDANCE LEADERS

AFTER LEADING ALL OF NCAA DIVISION II IN ATTENDANCE LAST YEAR, LENOIR-RHYNE LEADS THE NATION AGAIN THIS YEAR. THE GAME BETWEEN LR AND LIMESTONE IN HICKORY WAS THE MOST ATTENDED DIVISION II LACROSSE GAME OF THE SEASON. 763 SPECTATORS TOPPED THE 740 HELD IN BALTIMORE, MD THAT SAW FROSTBURG ST. BEAT ST. ROSE 11-10. THE LR/ WINGATE GAME HAD 639 SPECTATORS, WHICH IS THE FIFTH-MOST ATTENDED GAME OF THE YEAR ACROSS DIVISION II. ON THE YEAR, LR HAS HAD 4,258 SPECTATORS ON THE SEASON, OVER 1,200 MORE THAN THE SECOND PLACE TEAM.

### AMONG THE BEST

LENOIR-RHYNE ENTERED THE 2023 SEASON AMONG THE MOST SUCCESSFUL DIVISION II MEN'S LACROSSE PROGRAMS IN THE NATION. THE BEARS ENTERED THE YEAR WITH AN ALL-TIME WINNING PERCENTAGE OF .654 WHICH IS THE 10TH BEST WINNING PERCENTAGE AMONG ALL DIVISION II PROGRAMS.

AFTER SPENDING MOST OF THE SEASON AS THE NUMBER 2 FACE OFF GUY, MATTHEW MANCINI STEPPED UP IN A MAJOR WAY IN A WIN OVER ROLLINS. THE FRESHMAN WONT 13-0F-25 FACE OFFS FOR LR AND SCOOPED UP 10 GROUND BALLS TO HELP KEY THE WIN OVER ROLLINS.

### **TOURNEY VETS**

THE BEARS PREPARE FOR THE 12TH ALL-TIME NCAA TOURNAMENT GAME IN PROGRAM HISTORY. INDVIDUALLY, MYLES MOFFAT HAS PLAYED IN 10 OF THOSE GAMES FOR THE BEARS.

### MAN OF MAY

KYLE HATCHER PLAYS HIS BEST WHEN THE LIGHTS ARE BRIGHTEST. THE JUNIOR HAS SCORED 35 CAREER GOALS WITH 13 OF THEM COMING IN NCAA TOURNAMENT GAMES. HATCHER SCORED FOUR TIMES IN A COMEBACK WIN OVER TAMPA IN THE 2021 NATIONAL QUARTERFINALS AND ADDED FOUR IN SUNDAY'S WIN OVER LIMESTONE.


