- » LENOIR-RHYNE IS SET TO KICK OFF THE 104TH YEAR OF FOOTBALL IN PROGRAM HISTORY AND WILL LOOK TO CAPTURE THE 25TH CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP.
- » LR IS NATIONALLY RANKED TO START A SEASON FOR THE THIRD STRAIGHT SEASON AS THEY COME IN AT NO. 23 IN THE D2FOOTBALL.COM POLL AND NO. 25 IN THE AFCA NATIONAL POLL.
- » THE BEARS WENT 8-3 A SEASON AGO AND 7-2 IN LEAGUE PLAY TO EARN A SHARE OF THE PIEDMONT DIVISIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

NUMBER 2 AGAINST SAU

- » THIS WILL BE THE SECOND HOME OPENER AGAINST ST. AUGUSTINE'S IN PROGRAM HISTORY.
- » LR AND ST. AUGUSTINE MET TO OPEN THE 2019 SEASON WITH LR TAKING A COMMANDING 68-7 VICTORY.
- » THE BEARS SCORED 37 POINTS IN THE FIRST QUARTER AND CRUISED TO A SEASON-OPENING WIN.
- » THAT WAS THE ONLY OTHER TIME THESE TWO PROGRAMS MET.
- » KYLE DUGGER TOOK A PICK BACK TO THE HOUSE ON THE FIRST POSSESSION OF THE 2019 SEASON AND LR NEVER LOOKED BACK IN THE THUMPING. THE SEPCIAL TEAMS AND DEFENSIVE UNIT ACCOUNTED FOR 16 POINTS IN THE OPENING OUARTER.

HOME OPENING SUCCESS

- » THE BEARS ARE 55-34-4 ALL-TIME IN HOME OPENERS AND HAVE WON FIVE STRAIGHT
- » THE LAST LOSS IN A HOME OPENER WAS TO BEGIN THE 2017 CAMPAIGN WHEN WEST ALABAMA HANDED THE BEARS A 46-7 DEFEAT.
- » THE 68 POINTS AGAINST ST. AUGUSTINE IN THE 2019 HOME OPENER IS TIED FOR THE MOST POINTS IN A HOME OPENER IN PROGRAM HISTORY. THE BEARS ALSO DROPPED 68 POINTS IN A HOME-OPENING WIN OVER NEWPORT NEWS IN 1957.
- » THE BEARS HAVE NOT ALLOWED AN OPPONENT TO SCORE OF 20 POINTS IN AY OF THE PAST FOUR HOME OPENERS. LAST SEASON, LR CELEBRATED THE GRAND RE-OPENING OF MORETZ STADIUM WITH A 34-19 WIN OVER VIRGINIA STATE.

ABOUT ST. AUGUSTINE'S

- » NOT MUCH IS KNOWN OF THE 2023 FALCONS AS THEY BOAST A NEW COACHING STAFF.
- » HOWARD FEGGINS TOOK OVER THE PROGRAM IN MARCH OF 2023, HIS FIRST HEAD COACHING JOB AT THE COLLEGIATE IFVEL.
- » FEGGINS CAME TO ST. AUGUSTINE FROM FAYETTEVILLE STATE WHERE HE SERVED AS THE OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR FOR A YEAR AND HELPED THEM TO AN NCAA PLAYOFF APPEARANCE.
- » FEGGINS PLAYED HIS COLLEGE BALL AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND WENT ON TO PLAY IN THE NFL FOR THE NEW YORK GIANTS AND NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS BEFORE JOINING THE COACHING RANKS.
- » SAU WENT JUST 1-9 IN 2022 AND WENT 0-2 AGAINST SAC FOES. THE FALCONS OPENED THE 2022 CAMPAIGN WITH A 70-13 LOSS AGAINST TUSCULUM AND FOLLOWED THAT WITH A WEEK TWO LOSS TO LIMESTONE BY A FINAL SCORF OF 73-14.
- » ST. AUGUSTINE HAS LOST 10 STRAIGHT GAMES TO SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE FOES. THEIR LAST WIN OVER A SAC TEAM CAME OVER WINGATE BY A FINAL SCORE OF 28-10 ON SEPT. 1. 2012.

- » THE BEARS ARE ABOUT TO STRAP UP FOR THE 1,035TH GAME IN PROGRAM HISTORY.
- » LR HAS WON 536 OF THEIR FIRST 1,034 GAMES AS THE OUEST FOR WIN 550 CONTINUES.
- » THE 1,000TH GAME IN PGORAM HISTORY CAME IN THE 2019 SEASON WHEN LR DEFEATED TUSCULUM BY A FINAL SCORE OF 38-14.

- » THE BEARS WERE PREDICTED TO FINISH IN THIRD PLACE IN THE PRESEASON SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACHES' POLL.

- » ON THE OFFENSIVE SIDE, OL XAVIER JENNINGS, WR KELIN PARSONS, RB DWAYNE MCGEE AND OL BLAKE JEFFERSON WERE SELECTED TO THE PRESEASON ALL-SAC SQUAD.
- » ON THE DEFENSIVE SIDE OF THE BALL, DL ANDRE JEFFERSON, LB JON ROSS MAYE AND DB C'DARIUS KELLEY EARNED ALL-LEAGUE ACCOLADES IN THE PRESEASON.

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS.

» YEAR TWO FOR QB1

- » SEAN WHITE IS ENTERING HIS SECOND SEASON AS THE STARTING QUARTERBACK FOR THE BEARS.
- » WHITE ACTUALLY ENTERED LAST SEASON AS THE BACKUP BUT TOOK THE STARTING JOB AND RAN WITH IT.
- » WHITE ENTERED THE SEASON-OPENER AT HALFTIME AND CONNECTED ON HIS FIRST 10 PASSES TO HELP LEAD LR PAST VIRGINIA ST.
- » SINCE THEN, WHITE HAS STARTED 10 STRAIGHT GAMES.
- » WHITE FINISHED THE YEAR WITH 2,321 YARDS PASSING, THE FOURTH-MOST IN A SINGLE SEASON IN PROGRAM HISTORY
- » WHITE ADDED SEVEN RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS.

DEEP RUNNING ATTACK

- » AS IS OFTEN THE CASE IN A LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE, THE BEARS HAVE A STABLE OF STRONG RUNNING BACKS WHO ARE READY TO CARRY THE BALL IN 2023.
- » RETURNING ALL-AMERICAN DWAYNE MCGEE LEADS THE RUNNING BACK ROOM AND OWNS THE SINGLE-SEASON RECORD FOR RUSHING YARDS OF 1,669 WHICH HE RAN FOR IN 2021.
- » BEHIND MCGEE, ZYHEIR DILLARD REALLY STEPPED UP IN HIS FIRST YEAR FOR LR. DILLARD FINISHED THE 2022 CAMPAIGN WITH 426 YARDS, 7 TOUCHDOWNS AND A 6.1 YARD PER CARRY AVERAGE.
- » JADUS DAVIS IS ANOTHER TALENTED BACK AND 197 YARDS AND THREE TOUCHDOWNS IN 2022.
- » ZAYVION KNOX-TURNER RAN FOR 7.0 YARDS PER CARRY WHEN HE SAW ACTION AS WELL.

100 CLUB

- » BEFORE LAST SEASON, ONLY NINE PLAYERS IN THE FIRST 102 YEARS OF LENOIR-RHYNE FOOTBALL HAD REACHED 100 CAREER CATCHES.
- » DEONDRE LESTER TOPPED THE MARK IN A HOME WIN OVER CARSON-NEWMAN IN 2022 AND RYAN CARTER ACCOMPLISHED THE FEAT AGAINST WINGATE LATER THAT YEAR.
- » THE DUO IS SET TO BE JOINED BY KELIN PARSONS THIS YEAR. PARSONS IS SITTING ON 97 CAREER RECEPTIONS IN JUST 26 CAREER GAMES.

» PARSONS ALSO TIED FOR 2ND IN THE SAC WITH FIVE RECEIVING TOUCHDOWNS LAST YEAR.

- » MALIK SIMMONS IS RETURNING AFTER A SEASON THAT SAW HIM EMERGE AS A TOP RED ZONE THREAT IN THE REGION.
- » SIMMONS HAD 10 TOTAL RECEPTIONS ON THE YEAR, AND FIVE OF THEM FOUND PAYDIRT.
- » THANKS TO HIS EMERGENCE, SIMMONS WENT ON TO BE NAMED THE DIVISION'S FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR.

O-LINE STRENGTH

- » LENOIR-RHYNE BOASTS A PAIR OF THE BEST OFFENSIVE LINEMEN IN THE LEAGUE.
- » CENTER BLAKE JEFFERSON HAS BEEN A STARTER SINCE STEPPING FOOT ON CAMPUS BACK IN 2019 AND HAS STARTED AT CENTER EVER SINCE.
- » JEFFERSON WAS A PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTION AND WAS NAMED ALL-SAC EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS.
- » LEFT TACKLE XAVIER JENNINGS ALSO HAS STARTED AT LT SINCE STEPPING ON CAMPUS. JENNINGS' FIRST SEASON WAS THE COVID-SHORTENED 2020-21 SPRING SEASON AND HE HAS STARTED EVERY GAME AT LT SINCE THAT YEAR.

LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

JEFFERSON GETS NATIONAL ATTEN-TION

- » PRIOR TO THE START OF THE 2023 SEASON, ANDRE JEFFERSON WAS NAMED TO THE REESE'S SENIOR BOWL WATCH LIST. THE DEFENSIVE LINEMAN WAS IDENTIFIED AS ONE OF THE "BEST" PROSPECTS ACROSS ALL LEVELS OF COLLEGE FOOTBALL.
- » THE FOURTH-YEAR STUDENT-ATHLETE LED THE SAC WITH 13 SACKS DURING THE 2022 SEASON, WHICH INCLUDED A 5.5-SACK PERFORMANCE AGAINST TUSCULUM IN THE FINAL GAME OF THE REGULAR SEASON.
- » JEFFERSON WAS ALSO SELECTED TO THE SAC PRESEASON ALL-PIEDMONT DEFENSE TEAM.

ALL PIEDMONT D

» IN ADDITION TO ANDRE JEFFERSON RECEIVING SAC PRESEASON ALL-PIEDMONT HONORS, JON ROSS MAYE AND C'DARIUS KELLEY WERE ALSO ANNOUNCED AS MEMBERS.

» ROSS MAYE LED THE BEARS WITH 75 TACKLES WHICH WAS GOOD ENOUGH FOR 12TH-MOST IN THE CONFERENCE. MEANWHILE FOR KELLEY, THE JUNIOR HAD FOUR BROKEN UP PASSES FOR THE BEARS IN THE 2022 SEASON.

GROUND THE FALCONS

- » IN THE FIRST MEETING BETWEEN THESE TWO PROGRAMS, THE LR DEFENSE HELD ST. AUGUSTINE TO SEVEN POINTS AND 107 TOTAL YARDS.
- » THE BEARS FORCED A FUMBLE AND A COUPLE OF INTERCEPTIONS, WHICH INCLUDED A 30-YARD INTERCEPTION RETURN FOR THE OPENING TOUCHDOWN BY KYLE DUGGER.

STOPPING THE RUN

- » THE LR DEFENSE LOOKS TO RE-CREATE ITS DOMINANT RUSH DEFENSE IN 2023 AFTER ONLY ALLOWING 114.6 YARDS ON THE GROUND LAST SEASON, GOOD ENOUGH FOR THIRD BEST IN THE CONFERENCE.
- » THE GOOD NEWS FOR THE BEARS IS THAT THEY HAVE PLENTY OF RETURNERS IN THE "FRONT 7" WITH ANDRE JEFFERSON, JON ROSS MAYE, ZEKE NANCE, RASHAD YIELDING, AND TONEY BLACK. ALL FIVE OF THESE PLAYERS HAD FIVE OR MORE TACKLES FOR LOSS.
- » THE BEARS HAD SIX GAMES LAST SEASON WHEN

THEY WERE ABLE TO HOLD THEIR OPPONENTS TO 100 RUSHING YARDS OR LESS. THEY ARE LOOKING TO PICK UP RIGHT WHERE THEY LEFT OFF AFTER GIVING UP ONLY TWO RUSHING YARDS IN THE SEASON FINALE AGAINST TUSCULUM.

BUILDING OFF LAST YEAR

- » NEW DEFENSIVE BACKS COACH CHRIS VEGA JOINED THE STAFF THIS SUMMER AND WILL WORK WITH A TALENTED DB GROUP INCLUDING C'DARIUS KELLEY, ONE OF THE TOP CORNERBACKS IN THE LEAGUE.
- » CALEB PADILLA IS THE LINEBACKER COACH FOR THE SECOND SEASON AND HAS BEEN ELEVATED TO THE POSITION OF CO-DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR.
