- » THIS WILL BE THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE OPENER FOR BOTH PROGRAMS
- » THE BEARS ARE COMING OFF A 7-2 RECORD IN SAC PLAY A SEASON AGO WHILE ERSKINE STRUGGLED TO AN 0-9 MARK.
- » THE BEARS AND FLYING FLEET HAVE MEET IN THE SAC OPENER EACH OF THE PAST TWO SEASONS. LR TOPPED ERSKINE 42-20 IN THE OPENER LAST YEAR IN DIJE WEST.
- » THE BEARS ARE 2-1 IN SAC OPENERS UNDER MIKE JACOBS WITH WINS OVER NEWBERRY (2020-21) AND ERSKINE (2022) BUT A LOSS AT NEWBERRY (2021).

UNCHARTED TERRITORY

- » WITH A WIN, LENOIR-RHYNE WOULD IMPROVE TO 3-0 FOR JUST THE SEVENTH TIME SINCE 1970.
- » THE BEARS ALSO STARTED 3-0 IN THE COVID-SHORTENED 2020-21 SEASON UNDER JACOBS.
- » THE OTHER 3-0 STARTS CAME IN 1987, 1993, 1999, 2014 AND 2019.
- » IN THE 104-YEAR HISTORY OF LENOIR-RHYNE FOOTBALL, THE PROGRAM HAS ONLY STARTED 3-0 17 TIMES.

WEEK 2 WRAPUP

- » LENOIR-RHYNE USED A 24-POINT FIRST HALF AND FIVE FORCED TURNOVERS TO OVERPOWER FAYETTEVILLE ST. LAST SATURDAY.
- » THE BEARS INTERCEPTED THREE PASSES AND RECOVERED A PAIR OF FUMBLES FOR THE MOST TURNOVERS IN A GAME SINCE FORCING SIX IN AN NCAA PLAYOFF WIN OVER FLORIDA TECH IN 2018.
- » ANDRE JEFFERSON HAD A PAIR OF FORCED FUMBLES AND RECOVERED ONE WHICH HE RETURNED 11 YARDS.
- » THE LR DEFENSE SET UP THE OFFENSE FOR ALL THREE OF THEIR TOUCHDOWN DRIVES. THE LR D SET UP THE OFFENSE AT THE FSU 20, 3 AND 4 AS THE OFFENSE TURNED THOSE IN TO 21 POINTS.
- » DWAYNE MCGEE MADE HIS RETURN TO THE LINEUP WITH A PAIR OF TOUCHDOWN RUNS AND FINISHED THE EVENING WITH 89 YARDS RUSHING ON HIS 23 CARRIES.
- » DEONDRE LESTER ALSO RETURNED AND HAD THREE GRABS FOR 33 YARDS WITH A LONG OF 24.
- » DEAREE ROGERS LED ALL PASS CATCHERS WITH HIS FOURT GRABS AND 34 YARDS.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

ABOUT THE FLYING FLEET

- » IT HAS BEEN A TOUGH START TO THE 2023 SEASON FOR THE ERSKINE FLYING FLEET AS THEY HAVE DROPPED EACH OF THEIR FIRST TWO CONTESTS.
- » IN THEIR SEASON OPENER, ERSKINE WAS HANDED A 24-17 SETBACK AT THE HANDS OF ALLEN. A WEEK LATER, SHORTER OUTSCORED THE FLYING FLEET 28-7 TO DROP ERSKINE TO 0-2.
- » ERSKINE HAS STRUGGLED OFFENSIVELY AND WILL HAVE A TOUGH TEST WITH THE LR DEFENSE. THE FLYING FLEET HAVE SCORED JUST 24 POINTS IN THEIR TWO GAMES AND HAVE AVERAGED JUST 244.5 YARDS OF TOTAL OFFENSE.
- » THE DEFENSE FOR ERSKINE HAS BEEN STRONG AGAINST THE RUN, ONLY ALLOWING 120 YARDS RUSHING PER GAME. HOWEVER, OPPONENTS HAVE HAD AN EASIER TIME THROUGH THE AIR. ERKSINE PERMITS 283.5 YARDS PASSING PER GAME, A FIGURE THAT RANKS 138TH OUT OF 161 RANKED DIVISION II TEAMS. OPPOSING QB'S OWN A PASSING EFFICIENCY OF 194.63 WHICH IS THE 10TH WORST ALLOWED IN DIVISION II THIS SEASON.
- » SINCE SHUTING DOWN THE PROGRAM IN THE 1950'S, ERSKINE HAS GONE 6-24 SINCE BRINGING THE FOOTBALL PROGRAM BACK IN 2020.

BACK BETWEEN THE BRICKS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS AN ALL-TIME RECORD OF 265-203-21 AT MORETZ STADIUM SINCE ITS OPENING. MORETZ IS THE FOURTH-OLDEST STADIUM ON RECORD IN NCAA DIVISION II.
- » THE BEARS SCORE 45 POINTS IN THEIR HOME OPENER ON SEPTEMBER 2 AND IMPROVED THEIR OVERALL RECORD IN HOME OPENERS TO 56-34-4 ALL-TIME.
- » ERSKINE HASN'T VISITED LENOIR-RHYNE IN HICKORY SINCE THE 1950 SEASON. LENDIR-RHYNE SHUT OUT ERSKINE 32-0 THAT YEAR AND PLAYED IN DUE WEST THE FOLLOWING YEAR BEFORE ERSKINE SHUT DOWN ITS PROGRAM. LAST YEAR'S MATCHUP TOOK PLACE IN DUE WEST AND LENOIR-RHYNE TOOK A 42-20 VICTORY IN WEEK THREE.

PRESEASON POLL

- » THE BEARS WERE PREDICTED TO FINISH IN THIRD PLACE IN THE PRESEASON SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACHES' POLL.
- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAD SEVEN PLAYERS SELECTED TO THE PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SOUAD.
- » ON THE OFFENSIVE SIDE, OL XAVIER JENNINGS, WR KELIN Parsons, RB dwayne mcGee and ol blake Jefferson Were selected to the preseason all-sac squad.
- » ON THE DEFENSIVE SIDE OF THE BALL, DL ANDRE JEFFERSON, LB JON ROSS MAYE AND DB C'DARIUS KELLEY EARNED ALL-LEAGUE ACCOLADES IN THE PRESEASON.

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS. HE WAS SIGNED BY THE JETS AND IS A MEMBER OF THEIR PRACTICE SQUAD FOR THE START OF THE 2023 SEASON.

- » LENOIR-RHYNE BOASTS A PAIR OF THE BEST OFFENSIVE LINEMEN IN THE LEAGUE.
- » CENTER BLAKE JEFFERSON HAS BEEN A STARTER SINCE STEPPING FOOT ON CAMPUS BACK IN 2019 AND HAS STARTED AT CENTER EVER SINCE.
- » JEFFERSON WAS A PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTION AND WAS NAMED ALL-SAC EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS.
- » XAVIER JENNINGS ALSO HAS STARTED AT LT SINCE STEPPING ON CAMPUS. JENNINGS' FIRST SEASON WAS THE COVID-SHORTENED 2020-21 SPRING SEASON AND HE HAS STARTED EVERY GAME AT LT SINCE THAT YEAR.

- » ON TOP OF HAVING THREE QUARTERBACKS THAT SAW ACTION, THE BEARS HAVE A GLUT OF WR AND RB OPTIONS.

 » LESTER AND PARSONS SIT ATOP THE WR DEPTH CHART BUT DEAREE ROGERS (5 REC., 42 YDS.) AND SONGA YATES (6 REC., 67 YDS.) ARE DANGEROUS AS WELL AS JORDAN PAYNE (3 REC., 28 YDS.).
- » THE BEARS RUNNING BACK STABLE CONSISTS OF ALL-AMERICAN MCGEE AND ZYHEIR DILLARD WHO HAS OVER 100 YARDS RUSHING THIS SEASON. ZAYVION TURNER-KNOX EARNED THE WEEK ONE START AND AVERAGES 7.7 YARDS PER CARRY.

LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

DOMINATING D

- » THROUGH THE FIRST TWO WEEKS OF THE 2023 SEASON, THE BEARS CURRENTLY RANK SIXTH IN THE NATION WITH TOTAL DEFENSE. HAVING ONLY ALLOWED 155.5 YARD PER GAMF.
- » THEY ALSO RANK FIFTH IN THE NATION FOR SCORING DEFENSE HAVING ALLOWED ONLY 8.5 POINTS PER GAME.
- » WHEN IT COMES TO FIRST DOWN DEFENSE, LR RANKS SECOND IN THE NATION HAVING ALLOWED ONLY 15 FIRST DOWNS ALL SEASON. ONLY GLENVILLE STATE HAS A BETTER FIRST DOWN DEFENSE WITH SEVEN FIRST DOWNS ALLOWED.

CONTROLLING THE LINE

- » THE BEARS ARE SIXTH IN THE NATION AND FIRST IN THE SAC WHEN IT COMES TO TACKLES FOR LOSS, AVERAGING 10.5 PER GAME.
- » IN TERMS OF RUSHING DEFENSE, THE BEARS ARE THE SECOND BEST IN THE CONFERENCE BY ALLOWING ONLY 63.5 YARDS PER GAME.
- » IN THEIR SEASON OPENER AGAINST ST. AUGUSTINE'S. THE BEARS ALLOWED ONLY TWO RUSHING YARDS ON 27 ATTEMPTS.
