RIVALRY RENEWED

- » FOR THE 66TH TIME IN THE HISTORY OF THIS RIVALRY, LENOIR-RHYNE AND CARSON-NEWMAN WILL SOUARE OFF.
- » CARSON-NEWMAN HOLDS A 44-21 EDGE IN THE ALL-TIME SERIES BUT IT HAS SWUNG LR'S WAY RECENTLY. THE BEARS HAVE WON FIVE STRAIGHT OVER THE EAGLES AND HAVE GONE 10-1 IN THE PAST 11 CONTESTS.
- » THE FIVE-GAME WINNING STREAK AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN IS TIED FOR THE LONGEST FOR LR IN THE SERIES HISTORY.
- » THE FIRST MEETING IN SERIES HISTORY CAME BACK IN 1927 AS THE TWO SQUADS MET FIVE TIMES BETWEEN 1927 AND 1936. HOWEVER, THE RIVALRY WOULD GO DORMANT UNTIL 1965. THE TWO HAVE MET EACH YEAR SINCE 1965 WITH THE EXCEPTION COMING IN THE 2020-21 COVID SEASON.
- » THIS WILL BE THE FIFTH TIME SINCE 2018 THAT LR WILL ENTER A GAME WITH CARSON-NEWMAN AS A NATIONALLY RANKED TEAM.

UNCHARTED TERRITORY

- » LENOIR-RHYNE IS 3-0 FOR JUST THE SEVENTH TIME SINCE 1970.
- $\,$ $\,$ The bears also started 3-0 in the covid-shortened 2020-21 season under Jacobs.
- » THE OTHER 3-0 STARTS SINCE 1970 CAME IN 1987, 1993, 1999, 2014 AND 2019.
- » IN THE 104-YEAR HISTORY OF LENOIR-RHYNE FOOTBALL, THE PROGRAM HAS ONLY STARTED 3-0 18 TIMES.
- » IF THE BEARS WIN ON SATURDAY, IT WOULD MARK JUST THE FOURTH 4-0 START SINCE 1970. (OTHERS: 2019, 2014, 1999)
- » ONLY 12 TEAMS HAVE STARTED 4-0 IN LR HISTORY.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE COMES INTO SATURDAY RANKED NO. 15 IN THE D2FOOTBALL. COM NATIONAL POLL AND NO. 17 IN THE AFCA POLL. THIS MARKS THE 70TH WEEK SINCE 2012 THAT LR HAS BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED.
- » THE BEARS ARE OWNERS OF A 50-12 RECORD WHEN THEY PLAY AS A NATIONALLY RANKED TEAM.
- » ON THE ROAD AS A NATIONALLY RANKED SQUAD, THE BEARS BOAST A RECORD OF 22-6.
- » LENOIR-RHYNE OWNS AN ALL-TIME RECORD OF 8-0 SINCE 2012 WHEN THEY PLAY AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN AS A RANKED TEAM.

LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

SAC DOMINANCE

- » THE BEARS COME INTO SATURDAY AS THE CLASS OF THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE SINCE 2010. THE BEARS HAVE SIX MORE OVERALL WINS THAN ANY OTHER TEAM IN THE LEAGUE DURING THAT TIME AND 10 MORE WINS IN SAC PLAY THAN ANY OTHER TEAM.
- » THE BEARS OWN 71 LEAGUE WINS, FOLLOWED BY WINGATE WITH 61. AFTER THE BULLDOGS, CARSON-NEWMAN IS THE NEXT HIGHEST WITH 52 AND NEWBERRY HAS 51.
- » THE BEARS HAVE WON EIGHT NCAA PLAYOFF GAMES SINCE 2010. TWICE AS MANY AS ANY OTHER PROGRAM IN THE LEAGUE.

QUICK STARTERS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS HAD THE BALL FIRST IN ALL THREE GAMES THIS SEASON.
- » IN THE FIRST TWO GAMES, LR WON THE TOSS AND ELECTED TO GET THE BALL FIRST.
- » THE BEARS HAVE ONLY SCORED ONCE ON THEIR OPENING DRIVE.
- » IN ALL THREE GAMES, THE BEARS HAVE SCORED FIRST. SINCE 2010. WHEN THE BEARS SCORE FIRST, THEY OWN A 79-12 RECORD.

ABOUT THE EAGLES

- » CARSON-NEWMAN GOT OFF TO A STRONG START WITH A DOMINATING 35-3 WIN IN THE SEASON OPENER ON AUGUST 31 AGAINST VIRGINIA LYNCHBURG. HOWEVER. IT HAS BEEN A STRUGGLE FOR THE EAGLES SINCE THEN.
- » IN THE NEXT TWO GAMES. THE EAGLES WENT SEVEN STRAIGHT QUARTERS WITHOUT SCORING A POINT. C-N WAS SHUT OUT BY EAST TENNESSEE ST. 42-0 IN WEEK TWO AND THEN DROPPED A 45-14 DECISION AT LIMESTONE. CARSON-NEWMAN MANAGED TO SCORE TWICE IN THE FINAL QUARTER BUT HAD BEEN OUTSCORED 80-0 IN THE SEVEN QUARTERS.
- » RUNNING THE BALL HASN'T BEEN AN ISSUE FOR THE EAGLES WHO AVERAGE 196 RUSHING YARDS PER GAME

- WHICH RANKS 32ND IN DIVISION II.
- » THE EAGLES HAVE STRUGGLED THROUGH THE AIR WITH A COMPLETION PERCENTAGE OF 43.8 (149TH IN THE NATION). 136.0 YARDS PER GAME (144TH) AND A PASSING EFFICIENCY OF 90.65 (146TH). WITH THOSE STRUGGLES. THE C-N OFFENSE PRODUCES 16.3 POINTS PER GAME WHICH RANKS 134TH.
- » CARSON-NEWMAN HAS BEEN MUCH STRONGER AT HOME OF THE PAST YEAR PLUS. IN 2022. C-N AVERAGED 32.6 POINTS PER GAME AT HOME AND PUT UP 35 IN THE HOME OPENER THIS YEAR. THEY ALSO ALLOWED JUST 16.4 POINTS PER GAME AT HOME IN 2022 AND THREE SO FAR IN THEIR LONE HOME CONTEST.

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS. HOWEVER, YOUNG IS ON IR CURRENTLY.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS. HE WAS SIGNED BY THE JETS AND IS A MEMBER OF THEIR PRACTICE SQUAD FOR THE START OF THE 2023 SEASON.

- » PARSONS IS 12TH IN LR HISTORY ON THE ALL-TIME RECEPTIONS LIST.

DONT FORGET ABOUT DRE

- » DEONDRE LESTER MADE HIS SEASON DEBUT AGAINST FAYETTEVILLE ST. IN WEEK TWO AND HAULED IN A TRIO OF PASSES
- » LESTER IS NOW UP TO 117 CAREER GRABS WHICH PLACES HIM SEVENTH IN LR HISTORY.

- » LENOIR-RHYNE BOASTS A PAIR OF THE BEST OFFENSIVE LINEMEN IN THE LEAGUE.
- » CENTER BLAKE JEFFERSON HAS BEEN A STARTER SINCE STEPPING FOOT ON CAMPUS BACK IN 2019 AND HAS STARTED AT CENTER EVER SINCE.
- » JEFFERSON WAS A PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTION AND WAS NAMED ALL-SAC EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS.
- » XAVIER JENNINGS ALSO HAS STARTED AT LT SINCE STEPPING ON TO CAMPUS IN THE COVID SEASON OF 2020-21 BEFORE SHIFTING TO LG THIS YEAR. HE HAS STARTED EVERY GAME OF HIS CAREER AND HASN'T MISSED A SINGLE CONTEST.

- » ON TOP OF HAVING FOUR QUARTERBACKS THAT SAW ACTION, THE BEARS HAVE A GLUT OF WR AND RB OPTIONS.
 » LESTER AND PARSONS SIT ATOP THE WR DEPTH CHART BUT DEAREE ROGERS (5 REC., 42 YDS.) AND SONGA YATES (9 REC., 126 YDS.) ARE DANGEROUS AS WELL AS JORDAN PAYNE (3 REC., 28 YDS.). ADDED TO THE MIX IS HICKORY NATIVE MALAKEI SUMMNER WHO HAS THREE GRABS FOR 87 YARDS.
- » THE BEARS RUNNING BACK STABLE CONSISTS OF ALL-AMERICAN MCGEE AND ZYHEIR DILLARD WHO HAS OVER 100 YARDS RUSHING THIS SEASON. ZAYVION TURNER-KNOX EARNED THE WEEK ONE START AND AVERAGES 7.7 YARDS PER CARRY. MCGEE AND TURNER-KNOX EACH NOTCHED 100-YARD RUSHING GAMES AGAINST ERSKINE.

LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

GROUNDING THE FLEET

- » IN LAST WEEK'S CONFERENCE OPENER AGAINST ERSKINE, THE BEARS RECORDED THEIR FIRST SHUTOUT OF THE SEASON IN A 62-0 VICTORY.
- » IN THE CONTEST, ERSKINE RAN 57 PLAYS FOR 56 YARDS. LR HELD ERSKINE TO -20 RUSHING YARDS ON 28 RUSHING ATTEMPTS.

NO FLY ZONE

- » THE BEARS ARE COMING OFF A THREE-INTERCEPTION GAME AGAINST ERSKINE, THEIR BEST PERFORMANCE OF THE SFASON.
- » FIVE DIFFERENT BEARS HAVE PICKED OFF OPPOSING QUARTERBACKS THIS SEASON: JAMES USSERY, DEVIN HIBBITT, PERCY KING, DESHAUN WHITMIRE, AND JORDAN BURRELL.

HOLDING THE LINE

- » THE BEARS HAD 12 TACKLES FOR LOSS AND FOUR SACKS AGAINST THE FLYING FLEET LAST SATURDAY. THE FOUR SACKS FOR 31 YARDS FOR LOSS WERE BOTH TEAM-HIGHS IN THE 2023 SEASON.
