HISTORIC START FOR THE BEARS

- » FOR JUST THE FOURTH TIME SINCE 1970, THE LENOIR-RHYNE BEARS HAVE STARTED A SEASON WITH A PERFECT 4-0 RECORD.
- » THE OTHER SEASONS THAT STARTED 4-0 FOR THE BEARS CAME BACK IN 1999, 2014 AND 2019.
- » THE 2023 VERSION OF THE BEARS BECAME JUST THE 12TH TEAM TO START 4-0 IN THE 104-YEAR HISTORY OF LR FOOTBALL.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE COMES INTO SATURDAY RANKED NO. 14 IN THE D2FOOTBALL.COM NATIONAL POLL AND NO. 15 IN THE AFCA POLL. THIS MARKS THE 71ST WEEK SINCE 2012 THAT LR HAS BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED.
- » THE BEARS ARE OWNERS OF A 51-12 RECORD WHEN THEY PLAY AS A NATIONALLY RANKED TEAM.
- » ON THE ROAD AS A NATIONALLY RANKED SQUAD, THE BEARS BOAST A RECORD OF 23-6.
- » AT MORETZ STADIUM, THE BEARS OWN A RECORD OF 28-5 WHEN THEY ARE NATIONALLY RANKED.

BRIEF HISTORY WITH THE CAVALIERS

- » THIS WILL BE JUST THE FOURTH ALL-TIME MEETING BETWEEN LENOIR-RHYNE AND UVA WISE WHO JOINED THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE PRIOR TO THE START OF THE 2019 SEASON.
- » HOWEVER, THERE HAS BEEN MANY NOTABLE PERFORMANCES IN THAT SHORT TIME.
- » IN THE FIRST MEETING, KYLE DUGGER ETCHED HIS NAME IN THE RECORD BOOKS. FOR THE SECOND TIME IN HIS CAREER, HE RETURNED TWO PUNTS FOR TOUCHDOWNS IN A SINGLE GAME. DUGGER TOOK HIS FIRST PUNT BACK 68 YARDS TO THE HOUSE. JUST 3:23 LATER, HE TOOK HIS SECOND PUNT BACK 67 YARDS AS LR JUMPED OUT TO A 49-0 LEAD AND NEVER LOOKED BACK.
- » HOWEVER, THE CAVALIERS WOULD EXACT SOME REVENGE IN 2021. IN THE FIRST MEETING AT WISE, THE CAVALIERS HANDED THE BEARS A 35-28 UPSET ON THE STRENGTH OF A STRONG DEFENSIVE EFFORT. THE BEARS, WHO ENTERED THAT GAME RANKED 16TH IN THE NATION, WERE PICKED OFF THREE TIMES AND THE UVA WISE PASS RUSH GENERATED SIX SACKS. LENDON REDWINE THREW FOR 299 YARDS IN THE UPSET VICTORY. DEONDRE LESTER DID RECORD THE SECOND-MOST PASSES CAUGHT IN A GAME WITH HIS 14 GRABS FOR 122 YARDS THAT DAY.

SAC DOMINANCE

- » THE BEARS COME INTO SATURDAY AS THE CLASS OF THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE SINCE 2010. THE BEARS HAVE SIX MORE OVERALL WINS THAN ANY OTHER TEAM IN THE LEAGUE DURING THAT TIME AND 10 MORE WINS IN SAC PLAY THAN ANY OTHER TEAM.
- » THE BEARS OWN 72 LEAGUE WINS, FOLLOWED BY WINGATE WITH 62. AFTER THE BULLDOGS, CARSON-NEWMAN IS THE NEXT HIGHEST WITH 52 AND NEWBERRY ALSO HAS 52.
- » THE BEARS HAVE WON EIGHT NCAA PLAYOFF GAMES SINCE 2010, TWICE AS MANY AS ANY OTHER PROGRAM IN THE LEAGUE.

QUICK STARTERS

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS HAD THE BALL FIRST IN ALL FOUR GAMES THIS SEASON.
- » IN THE FIRST TWO GAMES, LR WON THE TOSS AND ELECTED TO GET THE BALL FIRST.
- » THE BEARS HAVE SCORED TWICE ON THEIR OPENING DRIVE.
- » IN ALL FOUR GAMES, THE BEARS HAVE SCORED FIRST. SINCE 2010, WHEN THE BEARS SCORE FIRST, THEY OWN AN 80-12 RECORD.

ABOUT THE CAVALIERS

- » OVER THE LAST TWO GAMES, UVA WISE HAS AVERAGED 201.5 RUSHING YARDS PER CONTEST.
- » DEFENSIVE BACK PATRICK TAYLOR POSTED SIX SOLO TACKLES LAST WEEK, IT WAS THE MOST FOR THE REDSHIRT JUNIOR SINCE TALLYING EIGHT AGAINST EAST TENNESSEE STATE IN 2021.
- » DORIE GODDARD'S 6.2 RECEPTIONS PER GAME RANKS SECOND IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE AND RANKS 21ST NATIONALLY.
- » KELLAN DALTON REMAINS PERFECT IN KICK ATTEMPTS. THE REDSHIRT JUNIOR IS 4-FOR-4 IN FIELD GOAL TRIES WHILE BEING 11-FOR-11 IN POINT AFTER ATTEMPTS.
- » THE CAVALIERS HAVE FORCED A LEAGUE-LEADING NINE

TURNOVERS THIS SEASON.

- » UVA WISE RANKS SECOND IN THE SAC AND 21ST NATIONALLY IN AVERAGE TIME OF POSSESSION AT 32:59 PER GAME.
- » ZAVIER LOMAX HAS SCORED A RUSHING TOUCHDOWN IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES.
- » OPPONENTS ARE CONVERTING JUST 31.1 PERCENT OF THIRD DOWN ATTEMPTS AGAINST THE CAVS SO FAR THIS SEASON. THAT IS ALSO AN AREA WHERE LR HAS STRUGGLED AT THIS THIS SEASON. SO FAR IN 2023, THE BEARS HAVE CONVERTED AT A 37.5 PERCENT RATE.

NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS. HOWEVER, YOUNG IS ON IR CURRENTLY.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS. HE WAS SIGNED BY THE JETS AND IS A MEMBER OF THEIR PRACTICE SQUAD FOR THE START OF THE 2023 SEASON.

LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

» **MCGEE RUNNING WILD**

» DWAYNE MCGEE HAS RECORDED THREE STRAIGHT GAMES OF 100+ RUSHING YARDS TO START HIS SEASON AFTER MISSING THE SEASON OPENER VS. ST. AUGUSTINE'S
 » MCGEE HAS MOVED INTO THE TOP 5 FOR THE ALL-TIME RUSHING LEADERS WITH 3366 YARDS, HE IS CURRENTLY 17 YARDS BEHIND JAMEIL SURRATT FOR THE FOURTH-MOST RUSHING YARDS IN LR HISTORY.
 » AFTER NOT SCORING A RUSHING TOUCHDOWN AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN ON SEPT. 23, MCGEE IS STILL TIED FOR FOURTH-MOST RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS WITH 37. WITH ANOTHER TOUCHDOWN, MCGEE WOULD BECOME THE FIRST RUNNING BACK TO RECORD 38+ CAREER RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS SINCE LEONARD DAVIS IN 1994.

» **NEW QB1**

» JALEN FERGUSON RECORDED HIS FIRST COLLEGIATE START ON SATURDAY AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN AND RECORDED THREE TOTAL TOUCHDOWNS AND 18-26 PASSING THROUGH THE AIR.
 » FERGUSON'S TWO PASSING TOUCHDOWNS CAME IN THE SECOND QUARTER WITH A COUPLE OF 15+ YARD CONNECTIONS; THE FIRST ONE WAS A 29-YARD CONNECTION TO MALIK SIMMONS WHILE HIS SECOND WAS A 16-YARD CATCH FROM KELIN PARSONS.

» **PARSONS CLIMBS THE CHARTS**

» AFTER HAULING IN HIS 15TH CAREER RECEIVING TOUCHDOWN AGAINST CARSON-NEWMAN, PARSONS IS NOW TOP FOR 10TH WITH T.J. SMITH FOR MOST RECEIVING TOUCHDOWNS AT LENOIR-RHYNE.
 » PARSONS ALSO MOVED INTO THE TOP 10 LIST FOR MOST CAREER RECEPTIONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE WITH HIS 108TH CAREER CATCH; THE JUNIOR IS TIED WITH KENNARD FRANCE.

» **SCORING WITH EASE**

» THE BEARS ARE CURRENTLY RANKED NO. 1 IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE FOR AVERAGING 38.8 POINTS PER GAME; THE NUMBER IS ALSO GOOD ENOUGH FOR 19TH MOST IN DIVISION II
 » IN ADDITION TO SCORING WELL, LR ALSO HAS HAD

SUCCESS AT MOVING THE FOOTBALL WITH 81 FIRST DOWNS THIS SEASON, WHICH IS TIED WITH CATAWBA AND LIMESTONE FOR THE MOST IN THE SAC.

» **IMPROVING PASSING GAME**

» LR CURRENTLY RANKS SEVENTH IN THE SAC WITH 169.2 PASSING YARDS PER GAME, WHICH ALSO PUTS THE BEARS OUTSIDE THE TOP 100 IN THAT CATEGORY.
 » THE BEARS ALSO RANK EIGHTH IN THE CONFERENCE AND 115TH IN DIVISION II WITH 11.10 YARDS PER COMPLETION.

» **O-LINE STRENGTH**

» LENOIR-RHYNE BOASTS A PAIR OF THE BEST OFFENSIVE LINEMEN IN THE LEAGUE.
 » CENTER BLAKE JEFFERSON HAS BEEN A STARTER SINCE STEPPING FOOT ON CAMPUS BACK IN 2019 AND HAS STARTED AT CENTER EVER SINCE.
 » JEFFERSON WAS A PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTION AND WAS NAMED ALL-SAC EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS.
 » XAVIER JENNINGS ALSO HAS STARTED AT LT SINCE STEPPING ON TO CAMPUS IN THE COVID SEASON OF 2020-21 BEFORE SHIFTING TO LG THIS YEAR. HE HAS STARTED EVERY GAME OF HIS CAREER AND HASN'T MISSED A SINGLE CONTEST.

» **SKILL POSITION DEPTH**

» ON TOP OF HAVING FOUR QUARTERBACKS THAT SAW ACTION, THE BEARS HAVE A GLUT OF WR AND RB OPTIONS.
 » LESTER AND PARSONS SIT ATOP THE WR DEPTH CHART BUT DEAREE ROGERS (7 REC., 95 YDS.) AND SONGA YATES (14 REC., 166 YDS.) ARE DANGEROUS AS WELL AS JORDAN PAYNE (3 REC., 28 YDS.). ADDED TO THE MIX IS HICKORY NATIVE MALAKEI SUMMNER WHO HAS FOUR GRABS FOR 89 YARDS.
 » THE BEARS RUNNING BACK STABLE CONSISTS OF ALL-AMERICAN MCGEE AND ZYHEIR DILLARD WHO HAS OVER 100 YARDS RUSHING THIS SEASON. ZAYVION TURNER-KNOX EARNED THE WEEK ONE START AND AVERAGES 7.7 YARDS PER CARRY. MCGEE AND TURNER-KNOX EACH NOTCHED 100-YARD RUSHING GAMES AGAINST ERSKINE.

LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

- » THE BEARS HAVE ONLY ALLOWED 34 FIRST DOWNS ALL SEASON, WHICH IS THE BEST AMONGST ALL DIVISION II PROGRAMS.
- » LR HAS THE SECOND-BEST TOTAL DEFENSE IN DIVISION II WITH ALLOWING ONLY 144.5 YARDS PER GAME.
- » OPPONENTS HAVE HAD THEIR DIFFICULTY THROUGH THE AIR WITH ONLY AVERAGING 107.2 PASSING YARDS PER GAME. THAT IS GOOD ENOUGH FOR THIRD BEST IN DIVISION II.

LOW SCORING

- » LR RANKS SECOND IN DIVISION II BY ALLOWING AN AVERAGE OF SIX POINTS PER GAME. THE BEARS ONLY TRAIL BENEDICT FROM THE SIAC, WHO ALLOWS AN AVERAGE 2.5 POINTS PER GAME.
- » THROUGH THE FIRST FOUR GAMES OF THE SEASON, THE BEARS HAVE ONLY ALLOWED 24 POINTS ALL YEAR. IT IS THE LOWEST NUMBER OF POINTS GIVEN UP THROUGH THE FIRST FOUR GAMES SINCE THE 1958 SEASON (20).

HOLDING THE LINE
