- » THE BRONCOS BECOME THE 102ND ALL-TIME OPPONENT FOR THE BEARS FOOTBALL TEAM.

## 2-0 HOPES

- » THE BEARS LOOK TO MOVE TO 2-0 ON THE YOUNG SEASON WITH A WIN OVER FAYETTEVILLE ST.
- » LR WILL LOOK TO MOVE TO 2-0 FOR THE SECOND TIME UNDER MIKE JACOBS. THE 2020-21 SPRING SQUAD WON THEIR FIRST TWO GAMES. HOWEVER, LR HAS FALTERED IN WEEK TWO EACH OF THE PAST TWO SEASONS.
- » LR DROPPED TO EVENTUAL NATIONAL CHAMPION FERRIS ST. IN 2022 BY A FINAL SCORE OF 27-5 AT MORETZ STADIUM.
- » IN 2021, LR DROPPED A WEEK TWO MATCHUP AT NEWBERRY BY A FINAL SCORE OF 28-21.
- » IN TOTAL, LR HAS ONLY BEEN 2-0 IN TWO OF THE PAST EIGHT SEASONS.
- » PRIOR TO A 2-0 START IN 2019, THE LAST 2-0 OPENING TO A CAMPAIGN CAME BACK IN 2014.
- » IN THIS CENTURY, THE BEARS HAVE ONLY STARTED 2-0 IN 2019, 2014, 2008 AND 2000 MEANING THIS WOULD BE THE FIFTH 2-0 START.

## WEEK 1 WRAPUP

- » LENOIR-RHYNE DOMINATED ST. AUGUSTINE'S 45-7 IN THE SEASON OPENER ON SATURDAY.
- » DEFENSIVELY, LR HELD THE FALCONS TO JUST THREE FIRST DOWNS -- ONE VIA A PENALTY -- AND 52 TOTAL YARDS. THE FALCONS RAN FOR TWO TOTAL YARDS AND THREW FOR 50 YARDS, DESPITE ONE 37-YARD CONNECTION.
- » ON SPECIAL TEAMS, LR'S DEAREE ROGERS RETURNED HIS FIRST CAREER PUNT 43 YARDS TO THE HOUSE.
- » LR WOULD ADD A SECOND SPECIAL TEAMS TOUCHDOWN IN THE FIRST QUARTER WHEN JAMES USSERY BLOCKED HIS SECOND CAREER PUNT AND TYE ROBERSON RECOVERED IT IN THE BACK OF THE END ZONE FOR A TOUCHDOWN. THE BEARS IMPROVE TO 19-4 SINCE 2010 WHEN SCORING A SPECIAL TEAMS TOUCHDOWN.
- » ON OFFENSE, LR DOMINATED THE BALL FOR OVER 36 MINUTES OF POSSESSION AND CHURNED OUT THE CLOCK IN A DOMINANT VICTORY.

## LENOIR-RHYNE NOTES

### ABOUT THE FALCONS

- » FAYETTEVILLE ST. WAS A CONTROVERSIAL SELECTION TO THE 2022 NCAA DIVISION II PLAYOFFS A SEASON AGO. THE BRONCOS EARNED A NOD OVER SAC CHAMPION NEWBERRY THANKS TO A 9-2 REGULAR SEASON.
- » HOWEVER, THE BRONCOS RAN UP AGAINST ONE OF THE TOP TEAMS IN THE REGION IN DELTA ST. IN THE OPENING ROUND OF THE PLAYOFFS AND WERE BESTED BY A FINAL SCORE OF 51-0.
- » THE FALCONS OPENED AGAINST UNC PEMBROKE FOR A SECOND CONSECUTIVE SEASON. HOWEVER, THIS YEAR FSU DROPPED THE SEASON OPENER AGAINST THE BRAVES. AFTER COMING AWAY WITH A TWO-POINT VICTORY (15-13) IN 2022, FSU WAS ON THE WRONG END OF A TWO-POINT RESULT (19-17) IN THE 2023 OPENER.
- » THE BRONCOS ACCOUNTED FOR JUST 258 TOTAL YARDS OF OFFENSE AND HAD NINE PENALTIES FOR 70 YARDS. THEY TURNED THE BALL OVER TWICE IN THE LOSS.
- » DEFENSIVELY, FSU HELD PEMBROKE TO JUST 42 YARDS RUSHING ON 31 ATTEMPTS BUT WERE GASHED IN THE PASSING GAME. THE BRAVES THREW FOR 259 YARDS AND 15.2 YARDS PER PASS.
- » A 24-YARD FIELD GOAL WITH NINE SECONDS LEFT IN THE GAME OFF THE LEG OF TY WOODS GAVE PEMBROKE THE COME-FROM-BEHIND VICTORY.
- » KENTRELL CALDWELL AND CAMERON MERRELL WERE NAMED TO THE PRESEASON WATCH LIST FOR THE BLACK COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD. THE DUO ANCHOR ONE OF THE BEST DEFENSIVE UNITS IN THE REGION.
- » FSU WAS PREDICTED TO FINISH FIRST IN THE PRESEASON CIAA COACHES POLL. MERRELL AND CALDWELL WERE JOINED BY TYLER FLEMING AND MICHAEL TODD ON THE ALL-CIAA PRESEASON TEAM.

### GAME 1,035

- » THE BEARS STRAPPED UP FOR THE 1,035TH GAME IN PROGRAM HISTORY IN THE WIN OVER ST AUGUSTINE'S.
- » LR HAS WON 537 OF THEIR FIRST 1,035 GAMES AS THE QUEST FOR WIN 550 CONTINUES.
- » THE 1,000TH GAME IN PGORAM HISTORY CAME IN THE

2019 SEASON WHEN LR DEFEATED TUSCULUM BY A FINAL SCORE OF 38-14.

### PRESEASON POLL

- » THE BEARS WERE PREDICTED TO FINISH IN THIRD PLACE IN THE PRESEASON SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACHES' POLL.
- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAD SEVEN PLAYERS SELECTED TO THE PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SQUAD.
- » ON THE OFFENSIVE SIDE, OL XAVIER JENNINGS, WR KELIN PARSONS, RB DWAYNE MCGEE AND OL BLAKE JEFFERSON WERE SELECTED TO THE PRESEASON ALL-SAC SQUAD.
- » ON THE DEFENSIVE SIDE OF THE BALL, DL ANDRE JEFFERSON, LB JON ROSS MAYE AND DB C'DARIUS KELLEY EARNED ALL-LEAGUE ACCOLADES IN THE PRESEASON.

### NFL-R

- » LENOIR-RHYNE HAS CREATED A PIPELINE FROM HICKORY TO THE NFL AND IS THE ONLY NCAA DIVISION II PROGRAM WITH TWO PLAYERS DRAFTED IN THE PAST FOUR NFL DRAFTS.
- » KYLE DUGGER IS A STARTING SAFETY WITH THE NEW ENGLAND PATRIOTS AND WAS TAKEN IN THE SECOND ROUND OF THE 2020 NFL DRAFT.
- » DAREKE YOUNG WAS SELECTED IN THE 7TH ROUND BY THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS IN THE 2022 DRAFT AS A WIDE RECEIVER AND MADE THE OPENING 53-MAN ROSTER.
- » THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN LR FOOTBALL HISTORY THAT TWO LR ALUMS HAVE BEEN ON ACTIVE NFL ROSTERS AT THE SAME TIME.
- » UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT JASON POE SPENT THREE SEASONS AT LENOIR-RHYNE AND GRADUATED FROM LR BEFORE PLAYING ONE SEASON AT MERCER. POE WAS A TWO-TIME JACOBS BLOCKING TROPHY WINNER AND WAS AMONG THE FINAL CUTS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS THE PAST TWO SEASONS.

## LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE NOTES

### » PAIR FOR PARSONS

» KELIN PARSONS SCORED A PAIR OF TOUCHDOWNS IN THE SEASON OPENER ALTHOUGH THEY ACCOUNTED FOR JUST THREE TOTAL YARDS.

» PARSONS TOOK A PAIR OF SWING PASSES -- ONE BEING FOR ONE YARD AND THE SECOND FOR TWO -- TO PUT 12 POINTS ON THE BOARD BY HIMSELF.

» PARSONS ALSO TOPPED 100 CAREER CATCHES WITH HIS SECOND RECEPTION OF THE EVENING TO BECOME JUST THE 13TH PLAYER IN LR HISTORY TO REACH 100 CAREER RECEPTIONS.

### DEEP RUNNING ATTACK

» AS IS OFTEN THE CASE IN A LENOIR-RHYNE OFFENSE, THE BEARS HAVE A STABLE OF STRONG RUNNING BACKS WHO ARE READY TO CARRY THE BALL IN 2023.

» RETURNING ALL-AMERICAN DWAYNE MCGEE LEADS THE RUNNING BACK ROOM AND OWNS THE SINGLE-SEASON RECORD FOR RUSHING YARDS OF 1,669 WHICH HE RAN FOR IN 2021.

» BEHIND MCGEE, ZYHEIR DILLARD REALLY STEPPED UP IN HIS FIRST YEAR FOR LR. DILLARD FINISHED THE 2022 CAMPAIGN WITH 426 YARDS, 7 TOUCHDOWNS AND A 6.1 YARD PER CARRY AVERAGE.

» JADUS DAVIS IS ANOTHER TALENTED BACK AND 197 YARDS AND THREE TOUCHDOWNS IN 2022.

» ZAYVION KNOX-TURNER RAN FOR 7.0 YARDS PER CARRY WHEN HE SAW ACTION AS WELL.

### ACCURACY FOR WHITE

» SEAN WHITE WENT 16-FOR-21 IN THE SEASON OPENER AND BOOSTED HIS COMPLETION PERCENTAGE TO 76.2 FOR THE GAME.

» WHITE FINISHED THE 2022 CAMPAIGN WITH A COMPLETION PERCENTAGE OF 60.3 PERCENT WHICH RANKED AS THE SECOND BEST IN A SINGLE SEASON IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

» FOR HIS CAREER, WHITE IS CONVERTING 60.9 PERCENT OF HIS PASSES, A FIGURE THAT IS THE HIGHEST IN THE 104-YEAR HISTORY OF LR FOOTBALL.

» THE PREVIOUS RECORD HOLDER WAS TOMMY LAURENDINE WHO HIT ON 58.3 PERCENT OF HIS ATTEMPTS.

### ANOTHER FOR MALIK

» MALIK SIMMONS IS RETURNING AFTER A SEASON THAT SAW HIM EMERGE AS A TOP RED ZONE THREAT IN THE REGION.

» SIMMONS HAD 10 TOTAL RECEPTIONS ON THE YEAR, AND FIVE OF THEM FOUND PAYDIRT.

» THANKS TO HIS EMERGENCE, SIMMONS WENT ON TO BE NAMED THE DIVISION'S FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR.

### O-LINE STRENGTH

» LENOIR-RHYNE BOASTS A PAIR OF THE BEST OFFENSIVE LINEMEN IN THE LEAGUE.

» CENTER BLAKE JEFFERSON HAS BEEN A STARTER SINCE STEPPING FOOT ON CAMPUS BACK IN 2019 AND HAS STARTED AT CENTER EVER SINCE.

» JEFFERSON WAS A PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTION AND WAS NAMED ALL-SAC EACH OF THE PAST TWO YEARS.

» LEFT TACKLE XAVIER JENNINGS ALSO HAS STARTED AT LT SINCE STEPPING ON CAMPUS. JENNINGS' FIRST SEASON WAS THE COVID-SHORTENED 2020-21 SPRING SEASON AND HE HAS STARTED EVERY GAME AT LT SINCE THAT YEAR.

## LENOIR-RHYNE DEFENSE NOTES

### JEFFERSON GETS NATIONAL ATTENTION

- » PRIOR TO THE START OF THE 2023 SEASON, ANDRE JEFFERSON WAS NAMED TO THE REESE'S SENIOR BOWL WATCH LIST. THE DEFENSIVE LINEMAN WAS IDENTIFIED AS ONE OF THE "BEST" PROSPECTS ACROSS ALL LEVELS OF COLLEGE FOOTBALL.
- » THE FOURTH-YEAR STUDENT-ATHLETE LED THE SAC WITH 13 SACKS DURING THE 2022 SEASON, WHICH INCLUDED A 5.5-SACK PERFORMANCE AGAINST TUSCULUM IN THE FINAL GAME OF THE REGULAR SEASON.
- » JEFFERSON WAS ALSO SELECTED TO THE SAC PRESEASON ALL-PIEDMONT DEFENSE TEAM.

### EARLY STATEMENT

- » LR ALLOWED ONLY TWO NET RUSHING YARDS TO ST. AUGUSTINE IN THE SEASON OPENER.
- » THE BEARS HALTED THE FALCONS TO ONLY THREE FIRST DOWNS.
- » THE LR DEFENSE FORCED ST. AUGUSTINE TO LOSE 44 YARDS ON THE GROUND.
- » LR ALLOWED ONLY 5.6 YARDS PER COMPLETION IN THEIR SEASON OPENER AGAINST ST. AUGUSTINE. IT WAS THE SECOND LOWEST YARDS PER COMPLETION ALLOWED BY THE BEARS IN THEIR NCAA HISTORY.
- » IN ADDITION, LR ONLY ALLOWED 52 TOTAL YARDS IN THE CONTEST. THAT ALSO HAPPENS TO BE THE SECOND-FEWEST YARDS ALLOWED IN THEIR NCAA HISTORY.

### VETERANS SHOWING OUT
