- » THE BEARS LAST ROAD REGULAR SEASON LOSS CAME ON MARCH 12, 2022 WHEN THEY FELL AT LIMESTONE. OVERALL, THE LAST ROAD LOSS WAS THE NCAA OUARTERFINAL IN 2022 AT TAMPA BY A FINAL SCORE OF 13-11.
- » THE BEARS OWN A 48-27 ALL-TIME RECORD IN ROAD GAMES.
- » THIS WILL BE THE SEVENTH MEETING BETWEEN LR AND BELMONT ABBEY IN BELMONT WITH THE CRUSADERS OWNING A 4-2 EDGE AT HOME.

GAME 1 RECAP

- » IN THEIR FIRST GAME SINCE WINNING THE 2023 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP, THE NO. 1 LENOIR-RHYNE MEN'S LACROSSE TEAM DEFEATED BARTON ON SATURDAY AFTERNOON AT MORETZ STADIUM. 10 DIFFERENT PLAYERS SCORED A GOAL FOR LR IN THE WIN WHO USED A 6-0 RUN TO CLOSE THE SECOND HALF TO SEAL THE WIN.
- » THIS GAME WAS WIN NUMBER 140 FOR THE PROGRAM AND FOR HEAD COACH GREG PARADINE WHO HAS BEEN THE ONLY COACH IN PROGRAM HISTORY.
- » BARTON WOULD RALLY AND CUT THE LR LEAD TO 7-6 WITH 8:09 LEFT IN THE FIRST HALF BEFORE GREG PARADINE CALLED A TIMEOUT. FROM THAT POINT ON, LR CLOSED THE HALF ON A 6-0 RUN TO TAKE A 13-6 LEAD INTO THE BREAK.
- » FIVE DIFFERENT PLAYERS SCORED IN THE 6-0 RUN WITH TWO COMING FROM DONOVAN POWELL.
- » BARTON HAD A PAIR TO START THE SECOND HALF BEFORE JONATHAN BENDER, DUNCAN AND EVAN VOSS HAD THE ANSWER FOR LR.
- » BARTON MADE IT 16-10 WITH BACK-TO-BACK GOALS TO START THE FOURTH QUARTER BUT LANDON PARKER AND WILL CANATA MADE IT 18-19 WITH TWO GOALS IN A 28 SECOND SPAN.
- » DUNCAN FINISHED WITH A HAT TRICK IN HIS FIRST CAREER GAME WITH LR AND VOSS HAD TWO GOALS AND FOUR ASSISTS. IN TOTAL, SEVEN DIFFERENT PLAYERS HAD AT LEAST TWO GOALS FOR LR.

BIOGRAPHY

GREG PARADINE STARTED THE LENOIR-RHYNE MEN'S LACROSSE PROGRAM AND HAS BEEN THE ONLY COACH IN PROGRAM HISTORY AFTER HIS HIRING IN 2009. PARADINE, A GRADUATE AND ALL-AMERICAN AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA, HAS BROUGHT LR

TO UNMATCHED HEIGHTS DURING HIS TENURE. In 2023, Paradine Led Lenoir-Rhyne to its first national CHAMPIONSHIP IN PROGRAM HISTORY AND THE FIRST NCAA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP BY ANY PROGRAM AT LENOIR-RHYNE. HE TOOK THE BEARS TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP AS THE FIVE SEED AND THEY BECAME THE FIRST 5-SEED TO WIN IT ALL. TO DO SO, THE BEARS HAD TO WIN EVERY GAME ON THE ROAD AND TRAVELED OVER 2,000 MILES TO SECURE THOSE WINS AWAY FROM HICKORY. FOR HIS EFFORTS, PARADINE WAS NAMED THE USILA NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR FOR THE THIRD TIME.

PARADINE BROUGHT THE 2021 TEAM TO THE NATIONAL CHAM-PIONSHIP BEFORE FALLING TO LE MOYNE AND SECURED HIS SECOND NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR HONOR FOLLOWING THAT SEASON. HE WAS ALSO NAMED THE NATION'S TOP DII COACH BY USILA FOLLOWING THE 2018 SEASON WHERE HE HAD LENOIR-RHYNE IN THE FINAL FOUR FOR THE FIRST TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

PARADINE HAS GUIDED THE BEARS TO FIVE SOUTH ATLANTIC

CONFERENCE REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONSHIPS, TWO SAC TOURNAMENT TITLE AND FIVE NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES. HE OWNS A 139-67 ALL-TIME RECORD AND IS A FOUR-TIME SOUTH ATLANTIC CONFERENCE COACH OF THE YEAR.

PARADINE'S BEARS WON 24 STRAIGHT SAC REGULAR SEASON GAMES, GOING THREE STRAIGHT SEASONS WITH A PERFECT 8-0 LEAGUE MARK. THE BEARS HAVE BEEN NATIONALLY RANKED 101 TIMES, INCLUDING BEING AS HIGH AS NO. 2 IN THE NATION AND HAD A 27-WEEK STRETCH OF BEING RANKED IN THE TOP 10. PARADINE ENGINEERED TWO WINS OVER LIMESTONE WHEN THE SAINTS WERE RANKED NO. 1 IN THE NATION, INCLUDING AN 18-16 WIN IN 2020 WHICH WAS NATIONALLY BROADCAST ON THE LACROSSE SPORTS

IN HIS TENURE, 68 PLAYERS HAVE BEEN SELECTED TO THE ALL-CONFERENCE SQUAD AND 22 HAVE BEEN ALL-AMERICANS. HE HAD THREE PLAYERS WIN SAC PLAYER OF THE YEAR ACCOLADES AND TWO OTHERS BE NAMED SAC FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR. ACADEMICALLY, PARADINE HAS HAD SIX PLAYERS WIN SAC SCHOLAR-ATHLETES OF THE YEAR AWARDS AND TWO BEEN NAMED THE SAC ELITE 20 AWARD WINNER WHILE MITCH LINKLATER EARNED THE PRESTIGIOUS NCAA ELITE 90 AWARD.


