• After posting a 5-0 record at its home tournament, Liberty (7-7) will compete at a tournament hosted by three-time defending national champion, No. 1 Oklahoma, Friday through Sunday. This is the opening weekend for Oklahoma's new stadium, Love's Field. The Lady Flames take on Tulsa (9-5) on Friday and face Oklahoma (14-0) and Louisiana (8-9) twice each.

• Liberty opened the 2023 season with a 1-0 setback in eight innings to Oklahoma, a game played in Irvine, Calif. Two out of Liberty's last three meetings with the Sooners have been decided by one run each. The Lady Flames will compete against Louisiana, receiving votes in two national polls this week.

• The Lady Flames run-ruled No. 25 (Softball America) Penn State on Friday, 9-1. Liberty is 1-2 against Top 25 teams this season after earning a program-record four wins over nationally-ranked programs last year. That was highlighted by a 2-1 win over No. 2 UCLA in the 2023 NCAA Los Angeles Regional.

• Liberty outscored opponents a combined 29-3 last weekend at the Liberty Softball Classic, hitting .297 while posting a 0.45 team ERA and .114 opponents batting average. After hitting a combined three homers over its first nine games, the Lady Flames connected for eight home runs during their 5-0 weekend. Brooke Roberts, Megan Fortner and Rachel Roupe all homered twice last weekend in Lynchburg.

• Kaylan Yoder was named CUSA Freshman of the Week on Monday. She went 2-0 with a 0.78 ERA and 17 strikeouts. That included a career-high 10 strikeouts against Morgan State, Sunday.

• The Lady Flames were chosen as the favorite in the 2024 Conference USA Preseason Poll in their first year in the conference. Additionally, junior outfielder Rachel Roupe was voted CUSA Preseason Player of the Year, while junior Paige Bachman was voted CUSA Preseason Pitcher of the Year.

• For the season, Rachel Roupe leads Liberty in batting average (.450), hits (18), runs (10), doubles (4), homers (4), RBI (10), slugging percentage (.900) and on base percentage (.522). Junior college transfer Brooke Roberts is second on the team in average (.318) and on base percentage (.444). Hailey Deter bats .269, while Sierra Kersten (.237) has posted nine RBI and Megan Fortner (.250), seven RBI.

• Liberty is 3-0 in games Elena Escobar (0.86 ERA) has started this season. Escobar struck out a career-high 10 batters in a two-hit shutout of Saint Francis, Friday. Tyler Oubre (1-2, 2.02 ERA), a transfer from Louisiana, pitched her first career shutout on Saturday, a three-hitter against Saint Francis. Freshman Kaylan Yoder (2-2, 3.61) ranks 17th nationally with 9.8 strikeouts per seven innings.

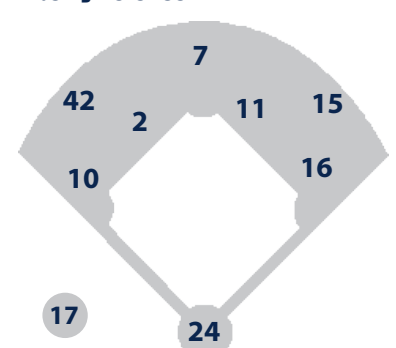

## Team Notes

- Liberty is off to a 5-0 or better start at home for the second year in a row, as the Lady Flames won each of their first 12 home games last year.

- The Lady Flames saw Brynn McManus hit her first career homer on Saturday against Penn. also, Brooke Roberts hit her first home run at the Division I level on Friday versus Penn State. Liberty has 11 players on its roster who have hit at least one career homer, led by Megan Fortner's 30 career round trippers between her time at Jacksonville State and Liberty.

- Liberty's last trip to Norman, Okla., came in Head Coach Dot Richardson's first season, 2014. The Lady Flames went 0-3 at the Oklahoma Tournament, falling to Tulsa, Oklahoma and Western Illinois. Liberty took a 3-0 lead over Oklahoma after a three-run homer from Kelby Allen in the first inning, but the Sooners scored 18 unanswered runs for the 18-3 win.

- In this weekend's tournament field in Norman, Liberty, Louisiana and Oklahoma are three out of the six NCAA Division I programs to win 40 or more games every full season since 2017. The remaining three teams on the list are Florida State, Tennessee and UCLA.

- This year, Liberty will face the former teams of current Lady Flames Tyler Oubre (Louisiana, March 2-3), Megan Fortner (Jax State, March 15-17), Madi Bachman (UTEP, April 26-28) and KK Madrey (LSU, May 3-5). The Lady Flames will also face former teammate Karlie Keeney this weekend in Oklahoma. She won 68 games as a Lady Flame, including a personal-best 27 victories in 2023.

- Oklahoma brings an NCAA-record 67-game winning streak into the weekend. The Sooners' last loss was Feb. 19, 2023 at Baylor.

- Liberty's 2024 schedule features 12 teams which competed in the 2023 NCAA Division I Softball Championship, including three-time defending national champion Oklahoma, 2023 Super Regional participants Clemson, Duke, Louisiana and Oregon, 2023 Regional finalists Charlotte, LSU, Middle Tennessee and Virginia Tech and Regional teams Missouri, Notre Dame and UCF.

- Liberty holds a 22-113 all-time record against nationally-ranked opponents, including 16-73 under Coach Richardson and 1-2 this year. Liberty set program records for wins over Top 25 opponents (4) and meetings with nationally-ranked teams (16) last year.

- On Feb. 9 against St. John's, Liberty posted its first season-opening walk-off win since 2003. That year, Amanda Goc hit a walk-off RBI single in the eighth inning to beat Charlotte, 2-1. This season, Rachel Roupe became the first Lady Flame to hit a walk-off homer in a season opener, as her two-out, two-run walk-off homer sealed Liberty's 3-1 win over St. John's.

- After turning a program-record 31 double plays last season, Liberty has fashioned five double plays so far this season. That included a season-high two double plays on Feb. 16 against Iowa.

- Liberty started a different pitcher in each of its first five games this season. In three straight games (Katie Love vs. No. 5 Clemson, Kaylan Yoder vs. Missouri, Tyler Oubre vs. Notre Dame), the Lady Flames' starting pitcher made her first career collegiate start in the circle.

- The Lady Flames have also seen the first collegiate starts from redshirt sophomore Hailey Deter (DP vs. No. 3 Clemson), freshmen JaMaya Byrum (2B vs. Missouri) and Kerissa Howell (3B vs. Iowa) and first Division I start from junior college transfer Brooke Roberts (2B vs. St. John's).

- This is the sixth year in a row in which Liberty has been picked as the preseason favorite in its conference's coaches poll. The Lady Flames were voted No. 1 all five years in which they played in the Atlantic Sun, and is No. 1 in this year's Conference USA preseason coaches poll.

- Liberty has competed in NCAA Regionals in four out of the last five full seasons, including Regional finals appearances in 2018 (Columbia, SC), 2021 (Knoxville) and 2023 (Los Angeles).

- Liberty posted an 8-8 record in one-run games last year, including 4-5 in one-run contests against teams who competed in the 2023 NCAA Division I Softball Championship. So far this season, Liberty is 1-0 in one-run contests.

- Liberty received its first at-large berth in 2023, competing in Regionals for the third year in a row. The Lady Flames eliminated No. 2 UCLA and Grand Canyon before falling to San Diego State in the Los Angeles Regional final.

- Caroline Hudson (15 homers), Rachel Roupe (15) and Megan Fortner (10) gave Liberty three players with 10 or more home runs last year. The only other time that Liberty had three 10-homer hitters was in 2007 (Liberty Athletics Hall of Famer Jessica Moore, Dawn Jeffs, Ashley Williams).

- KK Madrey's run-saving catch on April 29 against Austin Peay made SC Top 10 that night. Madrey is the seventh Lady Flame all-time to have a play featured on SC Top 10. Rachel Roupe has had two home run saving catches (versus Ole Miss, at Charlotte) featured on SC Top 10 last season.

- In 2023, Liberty posted its 17th 30-win season in a row and seventh straight full season with 30 wins or more. The previous program record for consecutive 30-win years was five, from 1996-2000.

- Liberty went 4-5 in extra-inning games last season. The Lady Flames' nine extra-inning games were their most since having nine (6-3) in 2006.

- Liberty went over a month (Feb. 19 to March 21, 2023) between losses, as its 15-game winning streak was the third-longest winning streak to date in program history. Each of the five longest winning streaks in program history have come under current Head Coach Dot Richardson.

- Savannah Woodard (2/25/2023 vs. Princeton), Rachel Roupe (2/26/2023 vs. Marshall, 2/29/2024 vs. St. John's), Megan Fortner (4/15/2023 vs. Stetson) and Rachel Craine (4/26/2023 vs. Clemson) are current Lady Flames with a game-winning walk-off hit at the NCAA Division I level.

## Player Quick Hits

- **Rachel Roupe** entered this season with four career three-hit games. On Sunday against Morgan State, she went 3-for-4 with three runs scored, four RBI and two homers. It was her third three-hit game of the season and she ended the 10-1 run-rule win with a two-run homer in the fifth inning.

- Roupe got a hit in 10 of her first 12 at bats this season at the NFCA Division I Leadoff Classic. That included a combined 5-for-5 showing against Oregon and Missouri on Feb. 10.

- Roupe is quickly scaling the program's record lists. She is now tied with Kelby Allen (2012-15) for seventh in program history with 27 career homers and is just the fifth player in program history to reach 25 career homers and 100 career RBI during their junior season.

- **Rachel Craine** is tied for fifth nationally with three sacrifice flies this season and is tied with Kaylee West (2009-12) for fourth in program history with eight career sacrifice flies.

- Craine provided a game-winning, two-run single in the seventh inning, clinching a 5-4 come-from-behind win over No. 6 Clemson and All-American pitcher Valerie Cagle on April 26, 2023.

- **Megan Fortner** has recorded 10 doubles, 12 homers and 39 RBI since joining Liberty from Jacksonville State last season. She leads all active Lady Flames with 43 career doubles, 30 home runs and 111 RBI overall.

- Fortner batted .400 (6-for-15) with two doubles, two homers, four RBI and five runs scored at the Liberty Softball Classic, launching her first two homers of the season.

- Batting leadoff for the first time in her career, senior **Mary Claire Wilson** has led off six out of 14 games this season (.428) with a base hit.

- Wilson's leadoff triple against Saint Francis on Saturday moved her into a tie for eighth place in program history with seven career triples.

- On March 9 against Sacred Heart, Wilson became the first Lady Flame all-time to record four hits and three stolen bases in the same game against a Division I opponent.

- **Sierra Kersten** has started at catcher for the first time in her career, this season. She has already matched her season total from last year in doubles with three in 2024. Kersten hit her first homer of the season, Friday against Penn State.

- Kersten's four RBI versus Penn State were her most as a Lady Flame and tied her career high, set against Elon on Feb. 28, 2022 when Kersten played for Michigan.

- **KK Madrey** joined the Lady Flames from LSU, where she scored 14 runs as a freshman in 2022.

- Madrey batted a team-best .449 (22-for-49) with 17 runs scored in 19 games played in April, 2023.

- Madrey's 26 steals were the most by a Lady Flame since Tori Zavodny's 29 steals in 2016.

- **Raigan Barrett** returns for her second full season as a Lady Flame after missing a majority of the 2023 season due to injury. Barrett was named to the 2022 ASUN All-Freshman Team, excelling at shortstop in her first year at Liberty after redshirting at Washington in 2021.

- Barrett batted a team-best .375 (3-for-8) at the 2022 NCAA Durham Regional.

- **Hailey Deter** is Liberty's second hottest batter in the last 10 games, batting .318 (7-for-22) with three doubles during that span.

- **Savannah Jessee** returns at catcher after missing a majority of the 2023 season due to injury.

- Jessee is ranked third on the team with a .400 on base percentage this season.

- **Brynn McManus** was named to the 2023 ASUN All-Freshman Team. She was Liberty's top pinch hitter, batting .313 (for-16) as a pinch hitter, including 4-for-9 during ASUN play.

- McManus hit her first career home run on Saturday against Penn.

- **Brooke Roberts** joins Liberty from College of Central Florida. Roberts recorded 23 homers and 87 RBI as a sophomore and holds College of Central Florida's career records for homers (33), RBI (154) and slugging percentage (.780).

- Roberts leads Liberty with a .438 average (7-for-16) over the team's last 10 games, hitting two doubles and two homers while diriving in five runs.

- **Elena Escobar's** eight strikeouts against St. John's on Feb. 9 were the most strikeouts by a Liberty pitcher in a season opener since Julia DiMartino's 10 against Fairleigh Dickinson in 2018

- Escobar set a new career high with 10 strikeouts on Friday against Saint Francis, tossing a two-hit shutout. It was the junior's fourth career shutout and first as a Lady Flame.

- Escobar went 11-5 with three shutouts in 2023, her final season at North Alabama.

- Freshman **Kaylan Yoder** struck out three batters in her first inning pitched, Feb. 9 against Oregon.

- Yoder is the first Lady Flame in their Division I era with three strikeouts in her first collegiate inning.

- Yoder struck out 10 batters in just four innings of work on Sunday against Morgan State, becoming the first Liberty freshman since Julia DiMartino in 2016 to post double-digit strikeouts in a game.

- **Paige Bachman** went 6-2 with a 1.65 ERA in ASUN play last season, fourth in ASUN-only ERA.

- Bachman tossed a two-hit shutout in her first career start, Feb. 10, 2023 versus San Jose State. She is the first Lady Flame since Ali Thompson in 2001 to pitch a shutout in her first career start.

- Louisiana transfer **Tyler Oubre** has made her first three career starts in the circle this season and ranks second on the team with a 2.02 ERA.

- Oubre pitched her first collegiate shutout on Saturday against Saint Francis, a three-hitter.

- Freshman **Katie Love** started in the circle against No. 5 Clemson on Feb. 10, becoming the first Lady Flame since Karlie Keeney (vs. Kentucky, 2020) whose first collegiate pitching start came against a Top 25 opponent.

# HEAD COACH DOT RICHARDSON

**351-239, 140-61 CONF.**

Two-time Olympic Gold medalist, Dr. Dot Richardson has led the Liberty softball program to new heights.

Liberty has made four NCAA Regional appearances under Coach Richardson, earning the program's first-ever NCAA postseason wins in 2018 to advance to the Columbia Regional final. The Lady Flames then won twice in the 2021 Knoxville Regional, advancing to their second Regional final with a 6-4 win over Tennessee on May 22.

Liberty eliminated No. 2 national seed UCLA from the 2023 Los Angeles Regional with a dramatic 2-1 win before beating Grad Canyon to advance to its third Regional final.

She has led the Lady Flames to 40 or more wins in each of the last six seasons, something only seven NCAA Division I teams have done during that span.

During the 2018 season, Richardson's Lady Flames won a program-record 49 games (49-14), taking a 19-game winning streak into the NCAA Columbia Regional Final. She led the team to its first-ever NCAA Regional Final appearance, being named Big South and VaSID State Coach of the Year.

In 2017, she led Liberty to its first-ever postseason championship, as the Lady Flames captured the National Invitational Softball Championship title with a 3-1 win over Lamar. The Lady Flames returned to the NISC in 2019, winning the Lynchburg Regional and finishing with a season record of 40-22.

- Coach Richardson has guided Liberty to 15 wins over nationally-ranked opponents, including wins No. 6 Michigan (2/23/20), No. 6 Clemson (4/26/23) and No 2 UCLA (5/20/23).

- Five out of the top seven winningest seasons in program history, including each of the top four, have come under Coach Richardson.

- Liberty finished the 2021 season with a program-record RPI of 19 and earned its first ever end-of-season national ranking, appearing 25th in three major polls.

- Richardson and her staff were named the 2018 NFCA Mid-Atlantic Regional Coaching Staff of the Year.

- Richardson was instrumental in the planning for the state-of-the-art Liberty Softball Stadium, a 1,000-seat structure, which opened March 19, 2015.

- Liberty's 2-0, 10-inning win over No. 24/24 Hofstra in the first round of the 2018 NCAA Columbia Regional on May 18, 2018, was Liberty's first win over a ranked opponent since the 2007 season.

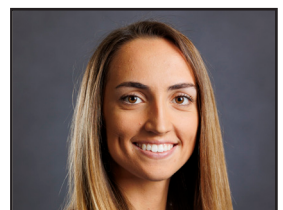
