STORYLINE

After a 68-7 victory over Evangel in week one of the 2010 season, Lindenwood jumps into the toughest part of its regular season schedule this week with a road trip to Central Methodist. The Eagles are the first of three straight opponents that were picked to finish in the top four of the conference standings in the preseason coaches poll.

Lindenwood lived up to its billing as one of the top teams in the NAIA last week. The offense scored touchdowns the first nine times it touched the ball, and the defense did not allow a single point, with the lone Evangel touchdown coming on a defensive touchdown.

The passing game was the biggest story of game one as Lindenwood tossed the pigskin around for a school record 552 yards. Starter Philip Staback completed 19-of-21 passes for 385 yards and three touchdowns. Matt Bramow was the leading receiver with eight catches for 174 yards and two scores.

Defensively, the Lions forced two turnovers and allowed Evangel just 1.3 yards per rushing attempt.

Central Methodist also had fun in week one with a 40-0 shutout over Culver-Stockton. The Eagles are looking for a statement win to prove they belong among the HAAC leaders.

Radio

Every Lindenwood football game is broadcast on KCLC, 89.1 FM. Each broadcast will begin 30 minutes before kickoff. Travis Green is the play-by-play announcer, Katie Schuler provides color and analysis, and Keaghan Wolfe is the sideline reporter.

KCLC, which was named the best radio station in the St. Louis Metropolitan area by *The Riverfront Times* in 2006, is the state-of-the-art, student-run radio station at Lindenwood.

OUT OF THE ENDZONE

Going back to last season, the Lindenwood defense has gone nine straight quarters without allowing a touchdown drive longer than 30 yards.

Last week, the defense was on the field for 14 drives. The longest drive was just 43 yards and nine drives were 20 yards or less.

SCHOOL RECORDS

Lindenwood set several school records last week, including total offense (735), passing offense (552), and points in a half (49).

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Philip Staback was named the HAAC Offensive Player of the Week after last week's game. In just one half, he completed 19-of-21 passes for 385 yards and three touchdowns. Nine of his completions were for 20 yards or more and he had the fifth-highest passing day in Lindenwood history. The Lions scored touchdowns on all seven drives that he was under center

MULTIPLE WR OPTIONS

Nine different Lions caught at least one pass versus Evangel and three had 100-yard receiving games. Matt Bramow led the way with eight receptions for 174 yards and two touchdowns. The 174 yards tied for the third-highest mark in school history, and the most under head coach Patrick Ross. Jamere Holland had six receptions for 143 yards in his Lindenwood debut, and Andrew Helmick had four catches for 106 yards and one touchdown.

TACKLES FOR LOSS

The Lion defense recorded nine tackles for loss last week, including three sacks. Chris Howard had one of those sacks and led the team with 10 total tackles. The double-figure tackle game was the fourth of his career.

PICK SIX

For the third time in the last four years, Lindenwood recorded an interception return touchdown in its season opener. This year, Blake Conreux picked off a fourth quarter pass and returned it 42 yards for the score. Hakim Thomas also had an interception in the contest.

Last season, the Lions intercepted 1.6 passes a game and had four touchdowns off interceptions.

BIG PLAY PASSING

Lindenwood had seven pass plays last week that gained 25 yards or more, including three plays over 40 yards. Philip Staback threw six of those plays. Matt Bramow, Jamere Holland, and Andrew Helmick each had two receptions over 25 yards.

KICKING GAME

Lindenwood did not have to worry about inexperienced kickers last week, as it did not attempt a punt or field goal. James Neal was seven-of-seven on PAT attempts.

UP NEXT

Lindenwood returns home for a 6 p.m. contest against No. 10 Missouri Valley on Sept. 18.

HEAD COACH PATRICK ROSS

Patrick Ross is in his seventh season as the head coach of the Lindenwood football program and is the school's all-time leader in wins. In his first six years, he compiled a record of 57-17, won three HAAC Championships, and advanced to the NAIA Championship Series four times. Twice, Ross has been named the National Coach of the Year.

In 2004, Ross led an amazing turnaround at Lindenwood. The Lions went 11-0 in the regular season, tying for the same number of wins the team earned in the previous four years combined, and won their first HAAC title.

The next two years, Lindenwood remained in the upper half of the conference standings with 7-3 and 5-5 conference marks.

Over the last three years, Lindenwood has become one of the elite NAIA programs, going 34-5 overall. In 2007, Lindenwood won its first 10 games, won the HAAC Championship, and

finished the year ranked ninth in the nation. In 2008, Lindenwood went 9-1 in the regular season. The Lions won the first two postseason games in school history and came within a play of the national championship game. Last year, Lindenwood went 13-1 with its only loss coming in the NAIA National Championship game.

Prior to coming to Lindenwood, Ross was the head coach at Ottawa (Kan.) for two seasons. He was 14-7 there, won one conference title and advanced to the 2003 playoffs. Before Ottawa, he was the defensive coordinator for four years at Kansas Wesleyan.

Ross has had five Lindenwood players sign NFL contracts. DeDe Dorsey, a Lindenwood All-American, and Derrick Ward, a former player for Ross at Ottawa, have both won a Super Bowl ring.

Patrick and his wife, Stacey, are the proud parents of three children, Peyton, Caden and Shaelene.

Series Notes

Lindenwood has won the last six meetings, matching its longest win streak in the series ... the Lions have scored over 60 points three times in the series, including a school record 76 in 1999 ... Lindenwood has won three straight in Fayette and is 5-1 there all-time ... in the current six-game winning streak, the Lions have won by an average of 30.2 points a game ... Lindenwood head coach Patrick Ross is 6-0 against Central Methodist ... Central Methodist head coach Alan Dykens is 0-2 versus the Lions.

ABOUT THE EAGLES

Central Methodist took a step forward last year with a 6-4 HAAC record. The Eagles are looking to take another step in 2010 and got off to a good start with a 40-0 season opening win over Culver-Stockton.

The top returning player is Matt Fraley, an honorable mention All-American last year after recording 18 tackles for loss and seven sacks. Also back on defense is Tim Cummins, last year's HAAC co-leader in tackles.

Offensively, Bryant Jackson returns under center after passing for 2,210 yards and 16 touchdowns last year, along with rushing for five touchdowns. Also back is their leading rusher in Caleb Haynes.

On special teams, Tyler Padgett was named to the preseason Fred Mitchell Award watch list.

LAST WEEK

Central Methodist opened the year with a 40-0 victory over Culver-Stockton. The defense allowed just 160 yards, while the offense rolled up nearly 500.

Bryant Jackson threw for 332 yards and three touchdowns. Stephone Allen was the leading rusher with 68 yards and caught a receiving touchdown. Bradley Carter had 10 catches for 209 yards.

Tyler Belt led the defense with nine tackles and had 2.5 tackles for loss. Bryan Plenge had an interception, and Trevor Robinson and Will Jackson had two sacks.

HEAD COACH ALAN DYKENS

Alan Dykens is in his third year as head coach of the Eagles. After a three-win season in 2008, Central Methodist improved to six victories last year.

LAST YEAR: LU 66, CMU 23

Lindenwood used numerous big plays to set a then school record for total offense in a 66-23 win over Central Methodist in 2009.

The first big play came on the opening kickoff when Denodus O'Bryant took the short kick and returned it 73 yards to give the Lions a 7-0 lead. O'Bryant wasn't finished there, scoring on touchdown runs of 59 and 58 yards, and just missing another touchdown on a 40-yard pass reception.

Lindenwood finished the game with a school record 640 yards of total offense, breaking the mark of 636 set last year against Evangel. The Lions had eight plays from scrimmage that went for 40 or more yards. Three of those plays were runs as Lindenwood rushed for 287 yards. The other 353 yards came through the air, including three first-down passes for 40 or more yards.

Despite the big offensive numbers, the game was close for the first part of the game. After O'Bryant's kickoff return, Central Methodist tied the game on a 14-yard interception return midway through the first quarter.

Lindenwood's offense finally started clicking late in the first quarter as it scored touchdowns on their final four possessions of the first half. The Lions continued to roll with three touchdowns and a field goal in the first four possessions in the third quarter. A final Lindenwood touchdown midway through the fourth was the final points of the contest.

Quarterback Philip Staback looked sharp in his second game behind center as he was involved in five touchdowns. He threw three touchdowns and rushed for two others. Staback completed 11-of-17 passes for 214 yards and three touchdowns, and rushed for 42 yards and two more scores.

O'Bryant finished with 119 rushing yards on just four carries and had 232 all-purpose yards. LeMarian Parson had 69 rushing yards and Zach Booker had the fifth rushing touchdown. Matt Angell went over the 100 yard receiving mark on just two receptions and had one score. Rudy Fleming caught three balls for 82 yards and a touchdown, and Marcel Thompson had 62 receiving yards and one trip to the endzone.

Defensively, Lindenwood held Central

Methodist to just 124 total yards of offense in the first-half, and the Eagles had just 91 yards rushing for the game. Parks Peterson led the team with 12 tackles, one sack and three tackles for loss. T.J. Prell also had a sack, and Brandon Gould and Jovan Alexander picked off passes.

2010 LINDENWOOD GAME RECAPS

#2 LINDENWOOD 68, EVANGEL 7

SEPT. 2 - ST. CHARLES, MO.

It took over four hours for the No. 2 Lindenwood football team to outlast the weather, but once the lightning cleared the area the Lions routed Evangel by a 68-7 score in the season opener for both teams.

Lightning delayed the game after just eight plays had been run in the first quarter. On the first play when action resumed, Denodus O'Bryant scored on a six-yard run. That set the tone for the first half which eventually ended with the Lions leading 49-0.

Seven different Lindenwood players scored in the first half as the Lions rolled up 569 yards of total offense. Philip Staback was 19-of-21 passing for 385 yards and three touchdowns and three of his receivers went over 100 yards receiving in the first two quarters. Matt Bramow, Andrew Helmick, and Donald Fusilier all caught touchdown passes, and Bramow, Helmick, and Jamere Holland were over 100 yards receiving. Other touchdowns came on the ground from Dominick Sherman, Nate Orlando, and Mike Bunton.

Lindenwood scored two more times in the third quarter to go up 56-0. Bramow caught his second touchdown pass and David Ortega threw a scoring pass to Terance Jackson. After the Jackson touchdown, the Lions had reached the end zone in each of their first nine possessions.

The lone bright spot for Evangel came late in the third quarter when it scored a defensive touchdown. Taylor Jasin threw an incomplete backwards pass and Evangel scooped up the live ball and returned it 55 yards. The scoring ended early in the fourth quarter when Blake Conreaux intercepted a pass and returned in 42 yards for a Lindenwood defensive touchdown.

Lindenwood's defense did not allow a point in the game and held Evangel to just 2.5 yards per play. The Crusaders had 53 rushing yards on 42 attempts, and just 116 passing yards. Lindenwood also held Evangel to just seven-of-20 on third and fourth downs.

Chris Howard led the defensive unit with 10 tackles, including a sack. Hakim Thomas had an interception, and Jason Young and Duke Middleton each had a sack.

Offensively, Lindenwood finished with school records of 735 yards of total offense and 552 passing yards. Another school mark broken was most points in a half (49) and the 68 total points tied for the third most in Lions history.

Bramow finished with 174 yards receiving on eight receptions. Holland had 143 receiving yards and Helmick collected 106. LeMarien Parson was the leading rusher with 64 yards, one more than O'Bryant.
