Game Day Story Lines

- > Southeastern and Louisiana College meet for the 50th time on the hardwood (dating back to the 1947-48 season) with the Lions holding a 33-16 lead.
- > Southeastern is 6-1 overall in home openers under Jim Yarbrough.
- > Southeastern has won 30 consecutive games against non-conference opponents at home since the 2006-07 season. Under head coach **Jim Yarbrough**, Southeastern is 35-2 in non-conference games in the University Center.
- > Southeastern's 0-3 record to start the season equals the Lions' worst start since the 2002-03 season (Vanderbilt, Troy, Auburn). The Lions have not started 0-4 since the 1986-87 season.
- > Senior **Brandon Fortenberry** is 74 points shy of becoming the 17th player in school history to record 1,000 career points.
- > Junior **Quin Cooper** and freshman **Avery Woodson** are expected to redshirt the 2012-13 season.

In seven seasons as head coach at Southeastern Louisiana University, Jim Yarbrough has helped make Southeastern not just one of the top programs in the Southland Conference, but one of the top Division I programs in the state of Louisiana.

Yarbrough has kept the Lions on a consistent course during his tenure, producing winning campaigns in five of his seven years and advancing to the Southland Conference Tournament six times. Since the 2003-04 season, Southeastern has been a model of consistency among Division I programs in the state of Louisiana winning 141 games (second behind LSU) and producing more winning seasons (7) than any other school.

Replacing Southeastern graduate Billy Kennedy (currently the head coach at Texas A&M) in May of 2005, Yarbrough has done an excellent job of keeping the program very competitive. His 108 wins in Hammond are the third-most in school history and his .527 winning percentage is the best for a program that was looking for a solid foundation.

The program has taken on schools from the power conferences and competed well with the likes of Ole Miss, Minnesota and Alabama. More importantly under Yarbrough's leadership, the Lions have posted victories over Mississippi State, Oregon State and Penn State, and although the Lions have not recaptured the historic ride of the 2005 NCAA season, they have stayed in the upper echelon of the rugged Southland Conference.

Yarbrough has viewed every coaching stop in the last 24 seasons as an opportunity. He brought his high energy level to his very first position at The Bolles School in Jacksonville, Florida (1987-1993) as the Boy's 8th grade coach and assistant to the Varsity. That led to stops as an assistant coach at the collegiate level beginning in 1993 at West Florida before six seasons as an assistant at the College of Charleston.

During his tenure at CofC, Yarbrough would be part of unprecedented success – a 153-28 record with two trips to the NIT, three to the NCAA Tournament and historic battles against college basketball's elites with wins over UAB, Arizona State, Stanford, Maryland, Massachusetts and North Carolina.

His success as the top assistant in Charleston led to his first head coaching job in 2000 – rebuilding a once-proud men's basketball program at Valdosta State. And it didn't take long before Yarbrough built the Blazers into one of the top Division II programs in the country.

Winning came natural for Yarbrough from his first year in coaching in the Florida high school ranks. While his junior high team didn't fare as well as expected, the Varsity team was one of the best in the state of Florida going to three state final fours in six years and winning a pair of state championships.

Yarbrough's passion and teaching ability would take form there and lead him to several great friendships important to his career. His first, was Buddy Ward (Head Coach at Bolles), whom Yarbrough credits with modeling the art of teaching the game of basketball. His second, was Dr. Harvey Bernhardt, who was not just a mere friend, but as passionate about hoops as was Yarbrough.

During Yarbrough's six-year stint at Bolles, which included four summers with Team Jacksonville AAU, he made important contacts at the next level. One was a young assistant at Davidson College named Don Hogan.

Hogan was recruiting several players from the Bolles School and got to know Yarbrough. Later he would be named head coach at the University of West Florida and asked Yarbrough to help him get

things started.

Yarbrough was not destined to be in Pensacola long. In the Summer of 1994, Yarbrough bumped into a coaching acquaintance from his years on the high school and AAU scene – legendary College of Charleston coach, John Kresse.

Back in the Summer of 1989, while Yarbrough was coaching Team Jacksonville, Kresse sat in on several practices watching future player Rusty Palmer and admiring the young coach running practice. Palmer would go from Team Jax to being one of the Cougar captains during their first NCAA appearance ever.

In 1994, Yarbrough would be asked to join the Cougar coaching staff. Indeed, Yarbrough learned Cougar-style basketball so well that John Kresse named him Associate Head Coach in 1998, the only one Kresse ever had.

At 36, Yarbrough, who had been maximizing his coaching and recruiting efforts in Charleston, was ready to put his own 'blueprint' into motion. In 2000 Valdosta State was searching for a new head coach to reinvigorate and restore its program's sagging tradition. When Yarbrough arrived in 2000, the Division II school had not participated in an NCAA Tournament in over 20 years.

In only his second season in south Georgia, Yarbrough was able to establish his vision and traditions for success. The Blazers went 24-8 and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tourney. For his efforts, Yarbrough was one of eight finalists for national coach of the year and was named South Region Coach of the Year.

VSU kept winning and Yarbrough kept fine-tuning his blueprint, leading the Blazers to a No. 3 national ranking in 2003-04, hosting the NCAA's South regional and finishing the year with a 25-4 record. Again, Yarbrough would be named South Region and Gulf South Conference Coach of the Year.

His success at Valdosta State centered on a staple of Southeastern basketball the last few years - defense.

Emphasizing a tough, pressure defense, Yarbrough's teams were consistently ranked among the national leaders in scoring defense and field goal percentage defense.

During his five-year tenure at VSU, Yarbrough's teams finished the season in the top 10 in scoring defense four times while finishing in the top-10 in field goal defense twice. Even in Yarbrough's inaugural season at VSU, the Blazers finished 18th among Division II schools in scoring defense despite an 11-14 record.

Interestingly, some of the coaching opportunities Yarbrough has been offered over the last 24 seasons have been questioned by colleagues and others.

Confident and a builder by nature, Yarbrough can't help but see the value in each player he coaches and each person he works with, and he realizes every 'big' win for the program, in conference or out, and every drop of sweat gets the Lions closer to their desire for ultimate respect and the joy it brings for everyone involved.

Named as Southeastern's 11th head basketball coach on June 23, 2005, Yarbrough brings tremendous energy and a wealth success to the Florida Parishes as both a head coach and assistant after averaging nearly 22 wins per season and earning post-season berths seven times in an 11-year span.

A native of Tampa, Fla., and a 1987 graduate of Florida State University, Yarbrough is married to the former Glynda Burton and they are the parents of two children, daughter Samantha and son Jack.

Since the 2003-04 season, Southeastern has been very successful in defending its home floor. YARBROUGH EARNS SLU WIN NO. 100

In Southeastern's 72-69 overtime win over Louisiana Tech on Nov. 30, 2011, head coach **Jim Yarbrough** became the third coach in school history to record 100 wins in Hammond. Yarbrough joins **Luther Marler** (223 wins) and **Ken Fortenberry** (128 wins) as the only hardwood coaches to reach the 100-win barrier.

... AND REACHES NO. 200 OVERALL

Yarbrough earned career victory No. 200 on Jan. 14 against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi as the Lions posted a 67-55 win in the University Center ... Yarbrough is currently 205-142 in 12 years as a head coach, including a 97-42 record in five seasons at Division II Valdosta State. He led the Blazers to a pair of conference titles and two berths in the NCAA Division II Basketball Championships.

A CINCH FOR THE ALL-NAME TEAM

People have a hard time pronouncing Southeastern Louisiana University sophomore **Onochie Ochie's** name ... His name, pronounced "O-know-chee O-chee" has special meaning in Nigeria's Ibo tribe ... The name Onochie is the equivalent to the name Junior in the United States. According to Ochie's father, the basic English translation of Onochie is "to replace."

BF5 NAMED TO ALL-SLC TEAM

Despite missing the final 22 games of the 2011-12 season with a foot injury, Southeastern Louisiana University guard **Brandon Fortenberry** was one of five players named to the Preseason All-Southland Conference Men's Basketball Team, the conference office ... Fortenberry, a 6-foot-3 senior, led the Lions in scoring, averaging 17.6 points per game, before suffering a season-ending foot injury in practice on Dec. 11.

LIONS PICKED SIXTH IN SLC POLLS

Southeastern, coming off a 12-17 record, was picked to finish sixth in the preseason poll by the league's head coaches while the league's sports information directors picked the Lions to finish seventh ... The Lions, under eighth-year coach Jim Yarbrough, were picked to finish ahead of Sam Houston State, Nicholls State, Central Arkansas and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in the Coaches' Poll. In the SID Poll, Southeastern was picked ahead of Nicholls State, UCA and A&M-Corpus Christi ... League newcomer Oral Roberts, which posted a 27-7 record and advanced to the National Invitation Tournament, was picked to

finish first in both polls followed by Stephen F. Austin.

Fans can watch home and select road contests in baseball, men's and women's basketball, football, softball and volleyball. The All-Access Showcase will also provide game highlights and an archive of classic Lion action ... Three different packages provide multiple pricing options. A single 24-hour pass costs \$6.95 while a re-occurring monthly subscription is available for \$10.95 per month. Fans will also have the option to purchase a yearly pass at \$89.95 ... A non-conference schedule that features three teams that finished in the Associated Press Top 25, six games against teams that appeared in the NCAA Championships and a revamped Southland Conference schedule that includes newcomer Oral Roberts highlight the 2012-13 Southeastern Louisiana University men's basketball schedule ...
