#### Game Day Story Lines

- Southeastern Louisiana (6-4, 6-2 Southland) will look to close out its regular season with its sixth win in its last seven games when it travels to face Southland Conference rival Nicholls (5-5, 5-3 Southland) for the River Bell Classic on Thursday at 6 p.m.

- The Lions clinched their third winning season in the past four years with a 31-19 win over Abilene Christian on Saturday. SLU posted 445 total yards on offense, while the defense recorded two turnovers and four sacks in the Senior Day victory.

- Nicholls will be looking to bounce back from a narrow 31-24 loss to Southland Conference co-leader Central Arkansas last Saturday in Conway, Arkansas. The Colonels head into the regular season finale with a 3-1 home record with its only loss at home coming to top-ranked Sam Houston State.

## What to Watch For - Southeastern at Nicholls

### • On the Lion Offense

Southeastern racked up 445 total yards on offense in last Saturday's 31-19 win over Abilene Christian. Returning to the starting lineup after missing the Lions' 30-10 victory at Incarnate Word, senior quarterback **Justin Alo** threw for 293 yards and two touchdowns in Saturday's win. Alo's top targets were senior **Brandon Acker** (five catches, 103 yards, 1 TD), junior **Juwan Dickey** (5-89) and senior **Juwaan Rogers** (3-65-1 TD). Sophomore **Julius Maracalin** topped 100 yards rushing for the second straight game, finishing with 123 yards and a touchdown on 22 carries. Despite missing two games and only playing partially in three others, Alo has thrown for 1,655 yards and 14 touchdowns this season. Dickey (39 catches, 701 yards, 6 TD) and Acker (30-666-7 TD) have provided Alo with a prolific receiving tandem, while Rogers has also caught three touchdowns and established himself as one of FCS' top fullbacks. Maracalin leads the team with 617 yards rushing and five touchdowns.

### • On the Lion Defense

The Lion defense limited ACU to 29 rushing yards, forced two turnovers and recorded four sacks in a 31-19 victory last Saturday. Junior **Javon Tillman** led Southeastern with eight tackles. Junior **Lee Spight** forced a fumble that junior **Jake Jiannoni** returned for a touchdown. Junior **Mayori Ellison** recorded his first interception as a Lion in the win. Spight, Jiannoni, senior **Miki Fangatua** and freshman **Kurrell Vaughn** each had sacks in Saturday's win. On the season, opponents are averaging 385.4 yards and 28.6 points per game versus Southeastern. Tillman leads the Lions with 79 tackles, followed by junior **Max Lyons** (73), junior **Torrance Mosley** (73), Spight (57) and junior **Ryan Sigers** (54). Junior **Sione Teuhema** leads Southeastern with 8.5 tackles for loss and four sacks. Tillman leads the team with three forced fumbles, while Lyons has a team-high three fumble recoveries. Tillmans, Mosley, Ellison, senior **Tre' Bennett**, sophomore **Sean Clavelle**, freshman **Jacorey Fuller** and junior **Demarayeh Lane** have each recorded interceptions. Senior **Will Hines** has broken up a team-high eight passes.

### • About Nicholls

Nicholls will be looking to bounce back from a 31-24 loss at Southland Conference co-leader Central Arkansas last Saturday. Behind quarterback **Chase Fourcade** (2,227 passing yards, 15 TD, 11 INT), the Colonels are averaging 370.9 yards and 29.1 points per contest. Fourcade's top receivers in his arsenal are **C.J. Bates** (49 catches, 704 yards,

7 TD) and **Damon Jeanpierre** (34-481-5 TD). **C.J. Okpalobi** leads the team with 587 rushing yards, while Fourcade has rushed for a team-high seven touchdowns. Nicholls is on the verge of earning a winning season thanks in large part to a defense that is yielding 383.2 yards and 28.4 points per outing. **Allen Pittman** leads the team with 88 tackles, while **Sully Laiche** paces the squad with 13 tackles for loss and 9.5 sacks. **Jeff Hall** tops Nicholls with four interceptions.

### • Southeastern Looking For Another Perfect Pelican State Season

A win on Thursday over Nicholls would mark the fourth season during head coach **Ron Roberts'** five-year tenure that Southeastern will have defeated all three Southland Conference in-state opponents (McNeese, Northwestern State and Nicholls). Southeastern accomplished the feat in 2012, 2013 and 2014.

### • Series versus Nicholls - River Bell Classic

In the Fall of 1972, Southeastern Louisiana University was looking for a new rivalry to replace its discontinued Gulf State Conference annual football clash with the University of Southwestern Louisiana (now Louisiana-Lafayette) for the Cypress Mug. The alumni of Sigma Tau Gamma Fraternity felt Nicholls State University, on the Lions schedule for the '72 season, was a natural choice given the close proximity of the two new Gulf South Conference members, and suggested the River Bell – symbolic of the Mississippi River separating the two schools -- as a trophy to be presented the victorious team. The concept was approved and Sigma Tau Gamma Alumni volunteered to create the trophy.

From the Yellow Pages, the Sig Tau alumni located a marine supply store in Metairie and purchased a suitable bell. The trophy base was designed by Hammond Cabinet Works however time didn't permit the trophy to be completed before the first game.

For the inaugural River Bell game, September 30, 1972, the "trophy" to the winner was simply the bell itself. At the presentation were Southeastern President **Dr. Clea Parker**, Student Body Presidents from both universities, and Sigma Tau Gamma alumni. The Lions defeated the Colonels 31-9 in that first game of the River Bell series and the two Southeastern football captains happily received the Bell. After photographs, the captains were congratulated and asked to share the bell with the rest of the team, but have it back in the Athletic Director's office on Monday. The players enthusiastically took off for the locker room, down the entire length of the football field, clanging the bell the entire way.

It was clear to everyone present the new rivalry was off to a great start. The bell was

returned to the A.D.'s office on Monday as promised, and the trophy was subsequently completed.

That original trophy has continued to serve as recognition for the annual victor of the River Bell Classic, as the contest has become known over the past 40 years.

The coveted trophy returned home to Hammond following the Lions win over the Colonels to close out the 2011 season. That provided the perfect opportunity for the Sigma Tau Gamma alumni -- with the support of officials at Southeastern -- to begin planning for the retirement and replacement of the historic trophy.

**Wes Koon**, a local glass artist, Southeastern and Sigma Tau Gamma alumnus, was commissioned to design an appropriate replacement. After some consideration, Wes enlisted the talents of **John K. Sammons**, a Nicholls graduate, for his craftsmanship with wood. Later, the two approached **Bruce Caliva**, yet another Sig Tau and Southeastern alum, for his skill with some final woodwork detail.

The redesigned trophy has specific elements representing the colors and geographic location of both universities as well as the legendary river separating the two, yet maintains the tradition of the rivalry – the River Bell. Furthermore, the trophy's constructed of rich cypress indigenous to the unique region of the proud universities.

The beautifully fabricated new trophy was first awarded on November 15, 2012 to Southeastern after their victory over Nicholls, 35-16, in Thibodaux. The positive reception the trophy received demonstrated to everyone present the significance of the rivalry to both universities. In many ways it had the same feel as the original presentation in 1972 to those who were witness to both games.

Nicholls senior kicker **Francisco Condado** knocked in the game-winning 40-yard field goal as time expired as the Colonels earned the River Bell for the first time in five years with a 27-24 victory over Southeastern Louisiana in the 2015 season finale for both teams on Nov. 19, 2015 in Strawberry Stadium.

The Lions (4-7, 3-6 Southland) had a 17-3 lead at halftime, but Nicholls (3-8, 3-6 Southland) scored on its first three drives of the second half to take a 24-17 lead on a two-yard touchdown run by senior running back **Michael Henry** on the first play of the fourth quarter.

The Colonels would maintain that lead until Southeastern's final drive. Junior quarterback **D'Shaie Landor** took over with the Lion offense at its own 44-yard line with no timeouts and 2:23 left in the game. The Lafayette native went 6-for-9 on the final drive, allowing SLU to march 56 yards on 10 plays in 1:24. Junior wide receiver **Brandon Acker** hauled in a quick slant from four yards out to cap the drive and tie the score at 24-24 with 59 seconds remaining.

But Nicholls senior quarterback **Landry Klann** and the Colonels weren't to be denied. Klann found junior wide receiver **C.J. Bates** on passes of 23 and 15 yards to move NSU down to the SLU 23-yard line with three seconds left. Condado's game-winner split the uprights to give Nicholls its first win over the Lions since 2010.

It was a disappointing way to send out the 28 members of the Southeastern senior class, who played a large part in the Lions winning Southland Conference championships in 2013 and 2014. Some of the greatest players in school history – running back **Xavier Roberson**, defensive back **Harlan Miller**, wide receiver **Jeff Smiley**, among others – all saw their collegiate careers end on Thursday night.

Landor finished 19-for-38 for 186 yards, two touchdowns and an interception. Acker was the recipient of both touchdown throws, finishing with a team-high seven catches for 88 yards. Freshman running back **Julius Maracalin** finished with a season-high 121 yards on 21 carries to lead SLU.

Klann was 6-for-15 for 88 yards and a touchdown, as Nicholls did most of its dam-

age on the ground. Senior running backs **Tobias Lofton** (17 carries, 147 yards, 1 TD) and **Henry** (22-81-1 TD) led the Colonels rushing attack.

On the defensive side, SLU was led by senior linebacker **Herbert Harris**, who finished with a career-high 16 tackles and three tackles for loss. Senior defensive back **Micah Eugene** added 13 stops, while Miller recorded his team-high fourth interception of the season. The Kentwood, Louisiana native finished his time in the green and gold fourth on the school's career list with 11 interceptions.

## SLU's Wall Claims LSWA Weekly Honors

After helping the Southeastern Louisiana football team to a 30-10 Southland Conference victory at Incarnate Word, Lion freshman punter **Ivy Wall** was named the Louisiana Sports Writers Association Special Teams Player of the Week, the LSWA announced on Tuesday.

Wall averaged 47.0 yards per punt with a long of 55 yards in SLU's fourth win in five games. Wall's punting was key to field position, as three of the Amite, Louisiana native's punts were downed inside the 10-yard line.

Since taking over the starting punting job early in the season, Wall has developed into a steady performer for a Southeastern team that has already clinched its fourth Southland Conference winning record in the past five seasons. The Oak Forest Academy product has averaged 42.7 yards per punt on his 28 punts in 2016.

Wall is the first Lion to earn Louisiana Player of the Week honors this season.
