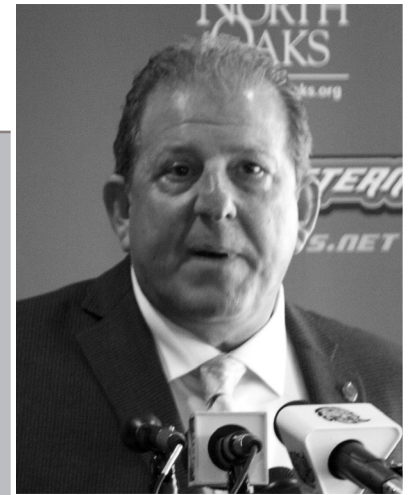

A veteran coach and Louisiana native, **Frank Scelfo** was named the 16th head football coach in Southeastern history on January 30, 2018.

Scelfo's charges in his debut season included 10 All-Southland Conference players. **Juwan Petit-Frere**, **Bransen Schwebel** and **Devonte Williams** were all named to the first team, while Petit-Frere also earned All-American honors from the AFCA as an all-purpose player. Schwebel, **Isaac Adeyemi-Berglund** and **Jon Miller** also represented SLU on the Southland All-Academic Team with Adeyemi-Berglund claiming CoSIDA Academic All-District 6 accolades.

Scelfo's inaugural season at the helm of the program saw his Lions play a part in the department's Southland Strong Community Service Award for the 2018-19 campaign. Prior to the 2018 season, Scelfo announced the program's partnership with CASA (Court-Appointed Special Advocates) in the Hammond area.

Scelfo comes to Hammond with over 30 years of coaching experience. Scelfo takes over the SLU program after spending the past two seasons as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at UTSA. In 2016, his offense set 15 school records and helped the Roadrunners to their first-ever bowl game, the Gildan New Mexico Bowl.

Prior to his time in San Antonio, Scelfo coached for three seasons with the NFL's Jacksonville Jaguars as an offensive assistant working with the quarterbacks. In his final season in Jacksonville, quarterback **Blake Bortles** threw for 4,428 yards and 35 touchdowns under Scelfo's tutelage.

In 2010 and 2011, Scelfo was the quarterbacks coach at the University of Arizona. During his tenure with the Wildcats, he tutored future NFL quarterbacks **Nick Foles** and **Tom Savage**. Foles, a third-round draft pick in 2012, was the Super Bowl LII MVP after leading the Philadelphia Eagles to a 41-33 victory.

The three seasons prior saw Scelfo serve as the offensive coordinator at Louisiana Tech. Scelfo's stint in Ruston included a 2008 Independence Bowl victory – the Bulldogs' first bowl win in three decades.

Before heading to north Louisiana, Scelfo spent 11 seasons on the staff at Tulane, including the final eight as the Green Wave's offensive coordinator. Scelfo was the recruiting coordinator and tight ends coach for a 1998 TU squad that was one of two FBS teams to finish undefeated that season, recording a 12-0 mark and a Liberty Bowl victory.

Scelfo's Green Wave offenses were ranked among the national passing leaders in five different seasons and four Tulane quarterbacks – **Patrick Ramsey**, **J.P. Losman**, **Lester Ricard** and **Shaun King** – went on to play in the NFL. A total of eight Tulane players were selected in the NFL Draft during Scelfo's time in the Big Easy, highlighted by two-time Pro Bowl running back **Matt Forte**.

Scelfo's Tulane offenses produced the school's all-time passing leader in Ramsey, the program's all-time rushing and all-purpose yardage leader in **Mewelde Moore** and **Roydell Williams**, who set the school's career record for touchdown receptions. Moore was only the second player in NCAA history to top both 4,000 rushing and 2,000 receiving yards under Scelfo's guidance.

Scelfo's coaching career began at Prairie View High School in Bastrop, where he served as head coach for the 1982-83 seasons. He also coached at Jesuit High School (1984), River Oaks High School (1985-86), Vidor High School (1987), Orangefield High School (1988), Chapel Hill School (1989-91), Kilgore College (1992-94) and Galena Park North Shore High School (1995).

Scelfo was a four-year letter winner on the baseball diamond at ULM from 1978-81, earning the school's Athlete of the Year award as a senior. He earned his bachelor's degree from his alma mater in 1981, before completing his graduate studies in 1983. He was inducted to the New Iberia High School Hall of Fame in September 2018.

He and his wife, Holly, are the parents of two sons, Anthony and Jordan. Anthony, who is currently the quarterbacks coach at Northwestern State, played both football and baseball at Tulane and was selected in the 2008 MLB Draft by the Tampa Bay Rays. Jordan was on the baseball and football teams at SLU's Southland Conference rival Incarnate Word from 2012-15.

About Southeastern

The Lions opened Southland Conference play with a victory for the first time since 2016 on Saturday, besting 2018 FCS playoff participant Lamar, 45-34. SLU trailed by three at the half, but outscored the Cardinals, 21-3, in the third quarter to take command for good.

In the win over the Cardinals, **Chason Virgil** (26-for-34, 307 yards, 4 TD) engineered a Lion offense that amassed 502 total yards. **Austin Mitchell** and **Javon Conner** each caught two touchdown passes, while **CJ Turner** also snagged a scoring grab of his own.

The SLU defense sacked Lamar quarterback **Jordan Hoy** five times in Saturday's victory. **Josh Carr Jr.** led Southeastern with 4.0 tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks, while **Isaac Adeyemi-Berglund** added 1.5 sacks of his own. **Mike Mason** led SLU with 10 tackles, while **Xavier Lewis** was credited with an interception and a forced fumble.

Virgil (780 yards, 7 TD, 3 INT) is the leader of a Southeastern offense that is averaging 36.3 points and 420.3 yards per game. Virgil and **Cole Kelley** have found 11 different receivers on the year with Mitchell (15 catches, 289 yards, 3 TD) and **Devonte Williams** (15-155-1 TD) serving as the top targets. Williams also leads the team with 150 rushing yards and three ground scores.

The Southeastern defense is allowing 29.3 points and 458.7 yards per game. Mason leads the team with 30 tackles and is joined in the top five by **Donniel Ward-Magee** (20), **Alexis Ramos** (20), Carr Jr. (20) and **Tre' Spann** (18).

The Lions are currently leading FCS with 35 tackles for loss and are second nationally with 14 sacks. Carr Jr. (8.5 TFL, 3.5 sacks) and Adeyemi-Berglund (6.0 TFL, 3.5 sacks) fuel the SLU pass rush.

Dejion Lynch and Carr Jr. lead SLU with three pass breakups each, while Lewis, **Ferlando Jordan** and **Shawntrez Spates** have one interception apiece.

About Northwestern State

The Demons will be looking for their first win of the season when Southeastern comes to town on Saturday. NSU dropped its league opener at Houston Baptist, 48-21.

Northwestern State is averaging 15.5 points and 362.8 yards per game heading into Saturday's contest. **Shelton Eppler** (118-for-184, 1,076 yards, 7 TD, 5 INT) has handled the majority of the work under center for NSU.

Quan Shorts (35 catches, 284 yards, 3 TD) is Eppler's favorite target, while **Jared West** (42 carries, 142 yards, 2 TD) leads the Demon ground game.

Opponents are averaging 47.0 points and 469.0 yards per game versus Northwestern State.

Series Vs. Northwestern State

Southeastern is 33-29 all-time versus the Demons. The series has turned towards the Lions' favor in recent years, as SLU has won the last seven meetings between the in-state rivals.

- A sack by senior linebacker **Tamarcus Russell** on the final play clinched the win for the Lions (2-3, 2-1 Southland). The victory was the first at home and second straight overall for SLU under first-year head coach Frank Scelfo and the seventh straight for Southeastern versus the in-state rival Demons (2-2, 1-1 Southland).

- A career night for sophomore wide receiver **Austin Mitchell** highlighted the Southeastern offensive effort. - SLU junior quarterback **Chason Virgil** threw for 316 yards on 19-of-28 passing. Virgil hooked up with Mitchell and freshman **C.J. Turner** on scoring tosses.

Junior **Tre' Spann** and Russell each recovered fumbles, while Adeyemi-Berglund and Lewis were credited with forced fumbles, as Southeastern held the Demons to a 2-for-6 success rate in the red zone.

Scelfo Bowl II

This will mark the second meeting between the Scelfos. Last season in Hammond, both held the same roles with SLU taking a 24-17 victory.

Adeyemi-Berglund Named LSWA Defensive Player of the Week

After being all over the field in Southeastern Louisiana's near upset at Ole Miss, Lion senior defensive end **Isaac Adeyemi-Berglund** was named the Louisiana Sports Writers Association Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 16.

The weekly honor was the first this season for a Lion and the second of Adeyemi-Berglund's career. The Dartmouth, Nova Scotia, Canada native was named Defensive Player of the Week by both the Southland and LSWA last November after his performance in the Lions' 23-6 win over McNeese.

On Saturday, Adeyemi-Berglund was dominant in SLU's 40-29 loss to the Rebels. He finished with 10 tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss, two sacks, three forced fumbles, a fumble recovery and a pass breakup in Oxford.

He forced and recovered a fumble in the first quarter that led to the Lions' first points. His strip sack in the third quarter was recovered inside the 10-yard line by teammate Feletoa Ailua and set up a touchdown pass from **Chason Virgil to Bransen Schwebel** that cut the lead to 34-29 heading into the final quarter.

Game Notes:

- Southeastern Louisiana jumped out to a 14-0 lead and never looked back on the way to a convincing 35-14 victory over No. 6 Jacksonville State in the 2019 football season opener for both teams in Strawberry Stadium.
- SLU (1-0) picked up its first win over a top 10 team since a 34-21 victory over No. 4 Sam Houston State on Nov. 16, 2013. The Lions jumped on the visiting Gamecocks (0-1) from the outset and sent the five-time defending Ohio Valley Conference champions to just its 13th loss since the start of the 2014 campaign.
- Jacksonville State, which has advanced to the FCS playoffs in each of the past six seasons, finished with 481 total yards, but the aggressive Lion defense's debut under new defensive coordinator Lance Guidry was opportunistic and keyed Thursday's victory. SLU sacked JSU quarterback preseason OVC Player of the Year **Zerrick Cooper** six times and intercepted the Gamecock junior twice.

- SLU senior **Shawntrez Spates** set up a touchdown with a first quarter pick, while sophomore **Ferlando Jordan** took back a third-quarter interception 65 yards back for a touchdown. **Mike Mason, Joshua Carr Jr., Dwaine Thomas, Alexis Ramos, Will Douglas, Ronald Cherry III** and **Fred Brown** each were credited with at least a partial sack, as SLU harassed Cooper throughout.

- Mason led SLU with 11 tackles, while **Tre' Spann** and **Donniel Ward-Magee** each finished with 10 stops apiece. Carr led the Lions with 2.5 tackles for loss and two pass breakups.

- The Lion offense was efficient with **Chason Virgil** (11-for-24, 164 yards, 1 TD) and **Cole Kelley** (5-for-9, 74 yards, 2 TD) splitting time under center. **Austin Mitchell** (four catches, 86 yards), **Devonte Williams** (4-76) and **Bransen Schwebel** (3-33) each caught touchdowns, while Williams also rushed for a score.

- The win matched the highest-ranked non-conference opponent Southeastern has defeated since the program returned in 2003. The Lions played as an independent in 2003 and 2004 and defeated future league foe and then-No. 6 McNeese, 51-17, on Sept. 11, 2004.

- As a result of the victory, Southeastern made its return to the STATS FCS Top 25, debuting at No. 23. The Lions are in the national poll for the first time since Oct. 12, 2015.
