

COVID-19 GAME DAY POLICIES

2020-21 LINCOLN MEMORIAL UNIVERSITY ATHLETICS COVID-19 PROTOCOL

ATTENDANCE POLICY

- Indoor athletic events will have a limited capacity of 10% in efforts of promoting and prioritizing the health and safety of the student-athletes and game day personnel. Please see the list below of all permitted attendees for these events:
 - Student-Athlete Pass List
 - L Club Members
 - o 50 students
 - o Dignitaries
 - Game Day Personnel

ARRIVAL AND GATE ENTRY

- Individuals will be given a specified entry time and gate from which to enter the venue.
- Masks/face coverings will be required for entry to all athletic facilities. Individuals must wear masks/face coverings while inside of the athletic facilities. Any individual that does not comply with this policy will be asked to leave the facility immediately.
- All game day personnel and spectators in attendance must follow the proper Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and LMU guidelines relating to physical distancing. Appropriate signage and other markings will be placed at entrances and other areas within athletic facilities for reference purposes.
- Temperature checks will be performed on all team personnel (coaches, players, staff, trainers, etc.) and fans upon arrival to any indoor athletic facility. Entry WILL NOT be permitted otherwise.
- It is imperative that we know how many staff members/administrators other than team personnel will be in attendance. This information needs to be communicated to the LMU athletics administrative staff no less than 24 hours in advance of the contest.

CLEANING AND SANITIZING MEASURES

- Each facility will be cleaned and sanitized prior to game days with the Clorox® Total 360™ System. This includes but is not limited to locker rooms, bleachers, bathrooms and hospitality areas.
 - *The Clorox® Total 360™ System utilizes innovative electrostatic spray technology to allow Clorox® disinfecting and sanitizing solutions to reach surfaces outside the line of sight, covering what conventional trigger sprays may miss, including the sides, underside and backside of surfaces. It works by using an electrode to introduce an attractive charge to the disinfecting or sanitizing product and atomizes the solution, using an air compressor to generate a quiet, but powerful liquid flow.
- Game day workspaces and equipment will be cleaned before and after each event throughout the season.
- Increased cleaning and sanitization processes throughout the venues prior to, during, and after all contests will be in effect for the 2020-21 athletic year. Sanitizer stations will be placed around each athletic facility for public use.


PHYSICAL DISTANCING/FACE COVERINGS

- Game day personnel and spectators will be required to wear face coverings (over the nose and mouth) during EVERY athletic event.
- Physical distancing of six feet or more will be required and clearly marked at all athletic facilities.
- Physical distancing will be maintained throughout each facility, which includes limited court/field access in compliance with the South Atlantic Conference and NCAA.
- Plexiglas shields will be installed in front of the scorer's tables inside Tex Turner Arena.
- Seating at all athletic venues will be arranged to ensure compliance of all Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) health and safety guidelines. This includes rows and seats clearly marked in efforts of creating six feet of separation between spectators not of the same party. Standing along the four courtside corridors of Tex Turner Arena and the two main entrances of Mary Mars Gymnasium, will not be permissible.
- Individuals who are non-compliant with the CDC, SAC, NCAA and LMU COVID-19 policies and procedures will be escorted out of the facility by athletic administration and/or campus police and security immediately.

Tex Turner Arena Upper Concourse Entrance


