LAST TIME OUT

- The Dirtbags enter their weekend in North Carolina with a 4-3 record after their second straight series win to open the season. With a rain-modified schedule, they topped Seattle 11-5 in the opener on Sunday before splitting the Monday doubleheader to close the series.
- In game one, the 'Bags rode a seven-run eighth inning for an 11-5 win. Sending 10 batters to the plate, they had five straight reach including RBI doubles from Nick Marinconz and Jonathon Long as well as a two-run homer from Joey Walls Jr.
- Game two of the series was all Seattle, as two pitchers combined for a seven-hit shutout. Eddie Saldivar was the bright spot with a three-hit effort in the loss.
- After an hour long rain delay ahead of the winner-take-all series finale, the Long Beach offense exploded for 13 runs on 12 hits for a 13-2 victory. Rocco Peppi went 4-for-5 with three RBI while Eddie Saldivar and Walls each recorded two RBI.

NO FREE PASSES

- Nationally, Long Beach State's most notable stat through their first seven games is the pitching staff's strikeout-to-walk ratio. With 73 K's to just 20 free passes (3.85 K/BB), they rank 18th in the nation for the category. Their walks per nine innings also ranks among the best at 2.87 which is the 22nd best in the NCAA.
- They also rank in the Top 50 with a 1.28 team WHIP and sit at number 63 in the nation with a 10.5 strikeouts per nine.

SPEED KILLS

- Long Beach State had a lot of question marks with so many new faces, but one thing the coaching staff knew was how much faster this team would be than previous years.
- Through seven games, they are a perfect 13-for-13 in stolen bases which ranks 39th most in the NCAA. Only three teams in the country to this point have stole more bases without getting caught (West Virginia, South Carolina, Texas A&M).

AGAINST THE OPPONENTS

- This will be the first time Long Beach State has ever matched up with either Georgetown or East Carolina since the program began in 1954.
- Against Indiana, the Dirtbags are 3-3 all-time against the Hoosiers. Their first meeting was a three-game series at Blair, where LBSU won two of three in 2014. The following year, they played each other in Indiana where the Hoosiers took two of three.

SCOUTING THE HOYAS

- Georgetown is off to a 6-2 start this season, after having a five-game win streak snapped this past Sunday. They have two shutouts on the year and three games of 10-plus runs scored.
- Offensively, they are slashing .277/.373/.450 averaging just over seven runs per game. Ubaldo Lopez leads the way in almost every category with a .385 average, .543 on-base, and .808 slug with three home runs and nine RBI.
- The pitching staff sports a 3.80 ERA entering the weekend and have racked up 80 strikeouts to just 26 walks. Opponents are hitting .225 against the Hoyas' arms.

NEWS and NOTES

SCOUTING THE PIRATES

- Host East Carolina is the top name of the tournament, entering the weekend as a unanimous top 20 team and sitting as high as No. 9 in the rankings. They are 5-2 on the year, but coming off a midweek 9-0 loss at Duke.
- The Pirate offense is slashing .273/.366/.459 to start the year scoring 8.57 runs per game. Jacob Starlin paces the team with a .400 average, .531 on-base, and .680 slug to go along four extra-base hits and 11 RBI.
- The pitching staff has posted a 5.20 ERA to start the year with opponents hitting .249 against them. In 62.1 innings, they have 69 strikeouts to 32 walks.

SCOUTING THE HOOSIERS

- Indiana enters the weekend with a 4-4 record and are coming off a big 13-2 midweek win over Butler. Their two weekend series have come against Auburn and Texas.
- The Hoosier offense is slashing .254/.376/.386 to start the year averaging 5.5 runs per game. They have three players hitting over .340 led by Phillip Glasser's .375 with five steals along with Hunter Jesse's .346 with a team-leading .654 slugging percentage.
- On the mound, they have a tournament low 3.71 ERA and are holding hitters to a .245 average. In 68 innings of work, the Hoosier arms have 69 strikeouts to 37 walks.

BAGS IN THE BIGS

- Long Beach State has had 53 alumni reach the major leagues in their storied career. Jarren Duran and Darren McCaughan were the most recent debuts, coming within a week of each other during the 2021 season.
- With MLB Spring Training right around the corner, 10 Dirtbags alum find themselves in big league camp. Evan Longoria, Matt Duffy, and Garrett Hampson will be sporting new threads after signing with the Diamondbacks, Royals, and Marlins, respectively. Jeff McNeil is fresh off a batting title and new contract extension that keeps him in New York for at least four more seasons. Duran (Boston) and McCaughan (Seattle) have each earned spring invites.
- The new names among the higher ranks include Nick Avila, who was taken in the Rule 5 Draft by the Chicago White Sox, and Eli Villalobos who skyrocketed through the minors and was added to Miami's 40-man roster. David Baneulos (Minnesota) and Lucas Jacobsen (Texas) were also non-roster invitees for their respective clubs.

THE INTERNATIONAL SPOTLIGHT

- Long Beach State has a history on the international stage and they will add to that storied history in the upcoming World Baseball Classic. The 20-team premier international tournament will begin in March and feature four former Dirtbags.
- Vance Worley will play for Team Great Britain, Jeff McNeil will play for Team USA, Jarren Duran will play for Team Mexico, and Leonard "LJ" Jones will play for Team Panama giving Long Beach State a nation-leading four alum among all the Division 1 schools.
- The quartet joins Evan Longoria (Team USA, 2009) and Marco Estrada (Team Mexico, 2013) as alumni to compete in the World Baseball Classic.

SALDIVAR CAN SWING IT

- Sophomore infielder Eddie Saldivar was recruited as a sweet swinging lefty, who can spray the ball all over the field. After posting a .289 average in his rookie campaign, he has come out of the gates red hot this year.
- He has recorded multiple hits in three of the seven games thus far, helping him to a .423 batting average. Riding a three-game hit streak, he is coming off a 5-for-7 performance in Monday's doubleheader against Seattle.
- The draft-eligible sophomore is tied for the team lead in average, hits, total bases, slugging percentage, and steals.

JUICE HAS THE JUICE

- Rocco Peppi also referred to as "Juice" has become a staple in the heart of the Dirtbag lineup after earning a Big West Honorable Mention last year. He was also tabbed as the #94 outfielder in the nation by D1Baseball in their preseason positional rankings.
- The left fielder owns multi-hit and multi-RBI efforts in three of the seven games thus far. The series finale was one of the best of his career, going 4-for-5 with three RBI and two runs scored.
- The Huntington Beach native leads the team in RBI and on-base percentage and is tied for the team lead in average, hits, total bases, slugging percentage, and steals.

WIZARD OF OS

- Junior transfer Graham Osman came to Long Beach State after winning the ERA title in the California Collegiate League over the summer and was expected to immediately lock in as the Friday night starter for the Dirtbags.
- He lived up to any lofty expectations on opening night with seven shutout innings, allowing just two baserunners and striking out eight. He went on to earn the first Big West Pitcher of the Week award of the 2023 season.
- Although he didn't have his A-stuff in his second start, he still owns a 1.59 ERA which ranks eighth in the conference while his .156 opponent average ranks sixth.

JONNY LONG-BALL

- Jonathon Long is one of the best bats back in the lineup for the 2023 campaign. The junior is coming off an All-Big West Honorable Mention and has been a model of consistency, with a .321 career average in his two years with LBSU.
- Garnering national attention in the preseason, he was named the Preseason Big West Player of the Year by both D1Baseball and Perfect Game as well as earning a spot on the inaugural Big West Preseason Team.
- Despite a bit of a slow start at the plate, he leads the team with three doubles, four walks, and ranks second on the team with a home run and seven RBI.

OVER THE WALL(S)

- Grad transfer, Joey Walls, joins the Dirtbags after an unreal season at UNLV last year. Slashing .350/.444/.614, he led the entire nation in doubles with 26 two-baggers to go along with eight homers and 48 RBI.
- While he has had struggles at the plate average-wise, the power has been there with four of his five hits on the year going for extra-bases including three home runs thus far. He leads the team with six runs scored and ranks second with 15 total bases.

FEEL THE BURN

- Junior Connor Burns is very well known as one of the best defensive catchers in the nation and is coming off a year where he earned the Big West Defensive Player of the Year as well as being a finalist for the Rawlings Gold Glove Award.
- After making huge offensive strides during the fall, he is expected to skyrocket up the draft projections this year. Along with earning a spot on the inaugural Big West Preseason All-Conference Team, he is noted as the #2 draft prospect in the conference by D1Baseball.

PLAYER NOTES

GENERAL PATTON

- Myles Patton is arguably the most notable of the incoming freshman class after a remarkable career at Millikan High School. The lefty is coming off back-to-back seasons where he was the 2022 Moore League Player of the Year, 2021 Moore League Pitcher of the Year, and 2021 CIF Player of the Year.
- After a limited (and rocky) collegiate debut against Wichita State as he finished recovering from some discomfort, he bounced back against Seattle with five strong innings, allowing just an unearned run and three hits while striking out three Redhawks. With help from an offensive outburst, he earned the first win of his young college career.

DALTON'S DEALINGS

- Senior Dalton Ponce reunited with Coach Valenzuela last year after a tough sophomore season at Saint Mary's College and went on to post a sub-3.00 ERA out of the bullpen in 2022.
- This year, he has been dealing with 5.2 innings of near-perfect work. In his two appearances, he has yet to issue a hit while striking out seven and walking just one batter.

NASTY NICO

- Nico Zeglin transferred from Gonzaga with one more year of eligibility, where he struck out 71 in just 56 innings as a Zag. He would then excel during the fall and earn a spot in the starting rotation with the Dirtbags.
- In his Long Beach debut against Seattle, he threw five innings allowed just one unearned run while striking out eight. While he struggled in his second start, he still managed six punch outs in 4.1 innings.
- His 14.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio currently ranks 59th in the nation and second in the conference.

THE FRESHMEN DEBUTS

- Thus far, Long Beach State has had 11 freshmen make their collegiate debuts and most have proved to have a ton of potential.
- On the mound, Kellan Montgomery has been tremendous in his quick two innings of work. In two innings, he has already racked up five strikeouts and allowed just one hit in two appearances.
- Ty Borgogno has showed off his tremendous defensive abilities, but even moreso has reached base in four of his six plate appearances while scoring a pair of runs.
- Bryan Martinez has just one at-bat on the year, but it was a missile off the wall in left field against Seattle. He would end up on second and eventually come around to score his first collegiate run.
- Raoul Fabian has already registered his first collegiate hit, run, and RBI in just four plate appearances early on.
- Julian Orozco had a fantastic debut on the mound against the Redhawks, retiring the side in order on just seven pitches in his first ever collegiate inning.

Eric Valenzuela was named the eighth head coach of the Long Beach State baseball program in June of 2019. After two successful seasons leading the Dirtbags, he signed a contract extension in July of 2021 keeping him at the helm through the 2026 season.

The 2022 season was full of ups and downs, ultimately ending with a 29-27 overall record and finishing fourth place in the Big West at 17-13 in league play. The bright spot of the season was Valenzuela's pitching staff improving on their 2021 NCAA statistical rankings by ranking fifth in WHIP, sixth in shutouts, seventh in ERA, 13th in hits per nine, 18th in strikeouts per nine, and 22nd in walks per nine.

After a season of "what could have been" in 2020 due to the premature ending, Valenzuela's Dirtbags came back and put together a dominant 2021 season. Despite not having a fall season of workouts and not being allowed to practice as a team until February, Long Beach State went 28-15 overall, finishing third in the Big West going 26-14 in conference play.

After dropping the first series of the season, they did not lose a single one after including four-straight series wins to end the 2021 campaign. The Dirtbags ended the season as one of the hottest teams in the country winning 15 of their final 17 games outscoring opponents 119-42, but unfortunately were not granted an at-large bid for the NCAA postseason.

Under Valenzuela's leadership, the Dirtbag pitching staff ranked 15th in shutouts (6), 20th in hits allowed per nine (7.76), 21st in ERA (3.75), 27th in WHIP (1.27), and 50th in K/9 (9.5) in the nation. The Friday night ace, Johnathan Lavallee, was named Big West Co-Pitcher of the Year and earned All-America honors while closing pitcher Devereaux Harrison was named Big West Freshman Pitcher of the Year also earning All-America honors.

His first year at the helm ended prematurely due to the COVID-19 pandemic, but despite the shortened season, the Dirtbags had a very successful 2020. Long Beach State quickly became one of the best stories in all of college baseball winning all four of their weekend series.

In his 15 games leading Long Beach State, he led the program to a 10-5 record and finished the shortened season as high as No. 12 in the rankings. Among the series wins that Valenzuela's Dirtbags picked up was a pair of top 25 teams in then No. 6 Mississippi State and a sweep of No. 17 Wake Forest.

A well-regarded pitching coach recruiter, Valenzuela's pitching staff was dominant in 2020. Under

his mentorship, the Dirtbags finished 4th in the nation in WHIP at 0.99 and 12th in the nation with a 2.38 ERA.

Valenzuela joined Long Beach State after six successful seasons at St. Mary's, bringing unprecedented success to the Gaels program with a 180-156 record from 2014-19.

Under Valenzuela's leadership, St. Mary's recorded four consecutive 30-win seasons after recording just three seasons at .500 or better in the 22 years preceding his arrival. In three seasons, Valenzuela led St. Mary's to their first ever West Coast Conference title and the program's first NCAA Regional appearance in 2016 and has gone on to record 136 wins over the last four seasons.

In 2019, the Gaels came up just one game short, falling in the WCC Tournament championship game and finishing just outside of at-large consideration. It was the fourth straight 30-win season for the program, however, capping a run of success that saw not only saw the team perform well but had four players selected in the Top 5 rounds of the MLB draft, including Corbin Burnes who made his debut with the Milwaukee Brewers in 2018.

Valenzuela was tabbed for the top job with the Gaels after serving for four seasons as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator for Tony Gywnn at San Diego State. While with the Aztecs, Valenzuela was responsible for bringing in a pair of recruiting classes ranked in the Top 25 by Baseball America, classes that would help San Diego State go on to win the 2013 Mountain West Championship and advance to the NCAA Regionals.

Prior to working at San Diego State, Valenzuela spent six seasons across town at San Diego, helping the Toreros reach the NCAA postseason on three occasions, lastly in 2008 when San Diego visited the Long Beach Regional after winning a program-high 44 games. Valenzuela also led the recruiting efforts to secure the No. 1 recruiting class in the nation as ranked by Baseball America in 2007.

Being hired at St. Mary's brought Valenzuela full circle, as he made his collegiate coaching start with the Gaels, serving as the recruiting coordinator for the Gaels starting in 2001. As a player, Valenzuela was a High School All-American at Bishop Amat HS before reaching the College World Series with Arizona State in 1998. He would go on to transfer to Pepperdine, where he was the captain on the 2001 team that went 42-18 and won the WCC title before graduating from Pepperdine and turning to coaching.

Valenzuela comes from an athletic family, as his father, Victor, was an assistant boxing coach for the United States in the 1984 Los Angeles Olympics. He continues to train boxers at the Duarte Boxing Club in Duarte, Calif. Valenzuela's sister, Nichole, was also an accomplished softball player at San Diego from 2005-08. Valenzuela and his wife Betty have three children, daughter Catalina Esmie and twin sons Benjamin Evan and Noah Matthew.
