Leading Off

Charleston Southern is 10-4 after the first three weeks of play at home as the Buccaneers won series over Delaware State, VCU, and Hofstra. The Bucs also took their midweek contests against USC Upstate and Winthrop.

CSU is off to its best start since the 2014 season when the Bucs also started the season with a 13-3 record. CSU posted a 30-26 record overall in 2014 and posted a CSU school record for wins against Division I opponents on the year.

The road trip to Longwood continues a stretch of eight of nine away from the Ballpark as CSU remains on the road through March 22. The Bucs continue on the road next week against USC Upstate (Mar. 21) and South Carolina (Mar. 22) before returning home on March 24-26 with a three-game series against Liberty.

Overall, CSU will host 19 more games at the Ballpark with home series against Liberty, Gardner-Webb, Radford, Presbyterian and Air Force still to come.

Charleston Southern has opened Big South Conference play with a win in two of the last three seasons, but it's been three years since the Bucs won their conference-opening series. Last time came on March 14-16 at UNC Asheville when the Bucs took the first two games against the Bulldogs.

CSU continues its trend of struggling on Friday nights with the Bucs posting an 0-3 record on the final day of the work week in the 2017 season. The Bucs are 10-1 on all other days of the week including sporting a perfect 4-0 record in Saturday competition and 2-0 record on Sundays.

Interim Head Coach

CSU Record: 10-4, 0-0 BSC

Career Record: 10-4, 0-0 BSC

Ward begins his sixth season with Buccaneers and his first as the Interim Head Coach. He previously served as the Associate Head Coach after receiving a promotion prior to the 2016 season. During his time at CSU, Ward has worked predominantly as the pitching coach and has helped the Bucs set numerous school records while evolving into one of the premiere staff in the Big South Conference year-in, year out.

For the third consecutive season, Ward and the Bucs' pitching staff were among the best in the Big South, finishing third in the conference in Team ERA. Evan Raynor was among the Big South leaders in strikeouts, innings pitched, and opp. batting average, while Wil Hartsell emerged as one of the top closers in the conference after missing the first half of the season.

Ward saw his pitching staff put together a school record 471 strikeouts during the 2015 season, culminating in LHP Andrew Tomasovich being drafted in the 21st round by the Oakland A's. The Bucs finished the season 10th-nationally with 8.8 Ks per nine innings.

The 2015 season was the second consecutive year the Bucs pitching staff contributed to rewriting the CSU record books.

Ward's staff posted a CSU record five shutouts during the Bucs' record-setting, 30-win season in 2014. He oversaw a staff that led the Bucs on a late-season run that saw them win 10 of their final 15 Big South games en route to earning a spot in the conference tournament. Tory Schroff enjoyed another excellent campaign under Ward's tutelage, going 5-4 with a 4.06 ERA while striking out 51 batters. Tomasovich also began to come into his own in 2014, upping his game during Big South play to finish as the staff leader in wins (7), innings pitched (82.1) and strikeouts (52).

Closer Austin Weekley provided another highlight for the CSU pitching staff in 2014, notching 11 saves to become the program's single-season and all-time leader in the category. Brother and freshman Tyler Weekley opened his CSU career with 24 scoreless innings to add another highlight to the Bucs' impressive 2014 season.

Ward joined the CSU family prior to the 2012 season from Big South foe Liberty, where he spent the past two seasons working as an assistant for the Flames. Ward also coordinated the Jim Toman Baseball Camps and field maintenance while in Lynchburg. In his first season, Ward helped guide Liberty to a school-record 42 victories and the runner-up position in the Big South Championship. Under his guidance, Flames player Curran Redal earned 2010 Big South All-Conference honors. Ward previously spent four years working with the North Charleston Dixie Youth Majors, piloting the team to state championships in 2007 and 2008 and World Series Championships in 2006 and 2009.

A former Hanahan High School standout, Ward played for Clemson University from 2007-09. He hit .375 for the Tigers in 2008 and was a two-time member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll. Ward graduated from Clemson in 2008 with a bachelor's of science in economics and a master's degree in economics, also from Clemson. Ward married the former Jessica Tuckman. The couple resides in Mount Pleasant.

About the Lancers

Longwood was picked fifth overall in the Big South Conference baseball preseason poll selected by the head coaches announced ahead of the season. The Lancers received a first place vote and 61 points overall. Longwood is coming off of a season that saw the Lancers post a 32-27 overall record and 14-10 mark in conference play, as well as an impressive 21-7 record at home in Bolding Stadium.

Buccaneers against Longwood

Charleston Southern as a program has posted a 3-5 record all-time against Longwood. The Bucs were swept in all three contests at the CSU Ballpark last season from April 2-4, 2016. CSU took the middle of the three-game series in their last trip to Farmville, topping the Lancers, 5-2, on March 21, 2015, behind Evan Raynor's complete game effort on the mound.

Last Out for Longwood

Longwood has dropped four of its past five outings with losses at USC Upstate, Wofford, and two of three last weekend at UNC Wilmington. The Lancers are coming off of a eight-game road trip that started with a series sweep over Savannah State on March 3-5. Longwood's Wednesday contest against St. Joseph's was canceled due to weather concerns in the Farmville, Va. area.

Scouting the Lancers

Michael Osinski leads the Lancers lineup in multiple categories including batting average (.348), runs (14), hits (24), home runs (2), and RBI (20). Justin Mitchell has also connected on a pair of four-baggers in the 2017 season and has posted a .310 batting average and a team-high 16 walks on the season. Sammy Miller has been the speed threat on the bases for LWU with seven steals on the season. On the mound, Zach Potojecki has been the ace for the Lancers with a 26:5 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a 3.18 ERA.

Dominant Pitching CSU to weekend sweep over Hofstra

Tyler Weekley turned in a strong start for the Buccaneers and the combination of Wil Hartsell, Eddie Hiott, and Cody Smith completed the job for Charleston Southern on Wednesday afternoon as CSU took the 4-2 win over Winthrop. Weekley went 5.1 innings in his first start of the season and was in control throughout the afternoon allowing six hits and two runs (one earned) while striking out five in the contest. Hartsell excelled in the relief outing with the junior retiring the first four batters he faced on strikes. Hiott also retired four in a row before turning the ball over to Smith who retired the Eagles in order to close out the contest.

Bucs in Big South Openers

The Buccaneers have won their Big South opener in two of the past three years. CSU's lone blemish during the span came last season in a 5-4 loss at home to Campbell on March 24.

Bucs tabbed to finish Ninth in the Big South Preseason Poll

Charleston Southern was selected ninth overall in the Big South Conference Baseball Preseason Coaches' Poll as announced by the conference office on January 26. The Buccaneers received 19 votes overall in the poll and will begin the season under the tutelage of interim head coach Adam Ward. For the first time, High Point University has been voted the Big South Conference's preseason baseball favorite by the league's head coaches. In addition, the coaches voted Gardner-Webb senior infielder Collin Thacker the Conference's Preseason Player of the Year and Winthrop redshirt-junior Matt Crohan the league's Preseason Pitcher of the Year.

The Singleton Baseball Complex Expected to be Complete in Spring 2017

The Singleton Baseball Complex will celebrate the life and legacy of Singleton's mother, Sharonda Coleman-Singleton, one of nine victims in June 2015's shooting at Emanuel AME Church in downtown Charleston. The \$1.5M project will celebrate the life and legacy of Sharonda Coleman-Singleton, mother of current team member, Chris Singleton, who was killed in the Emanuel AME shooting. The facility will feature a two-story 3,500-square-foot building, a stadium courtyard, and a "Love is Stronger" memorial plaza. The site will also recognize CSU baseball Hall of Fame athletes and players who have played Major League Baseball. The first floor of the complex will house a locker room, training room, and the Sharonda Coleman-Singleton Enrichment Center. The second floor will include the head coach's office and conference space for team personnel.

Hits Come in Bunches

Nate Blanchard continues to provide a strong bat atop the CSU lineup this season as the senior recorded a pair of three-hit games on opening weekend against Delaware State. Blanchard leads the Bucs and sits among the Big South leaders with 20 hits over the first 14 games after connecting including a home run and a pair of doubles against VCU. The Loganville, Ga. native has a career .292 batting average with the Bucs over the past four seasons and leads CSU with 52 multi-hit games over the span, including 17 games with at least three hits during the stretch.

Power Packed Performance

Sophomore outfielder Cole German has provided punch to the CSU lineup in the 2017 season with the Newtown, Pa. native leading the Bucs with three home runs over the first two weekends. German connected on a walk-off home run in CSU's 3-2 win over Delaware State on February 18. He added a two-run shot in the Bucs' 11-9 win over VCU, and then hit a solo home run in the Bucs' 4-2 series finale win over the Rams.

Steal Master

Chris Singleton showcased his ability on the base paths in CSU's 11-9 win over Virginia Commonwealth on February 25. Singleton went 1-for-4 from the plate, but took advantage of his time on the bath paths with three stolen bases in the contest. He added two more stolen bases in CSU's 8-7 win over Hofstra. The junior centerfielder has already showcased his playing ability in the field with several run-saving diving catches, and his eight stolen bases in the contest put him among the conference leaders on the season.

Fireman of the Year

Cody Smith has already asserted himself as one of the top relievers in the Big South Conference over the first 14 games with the junior right-hander pacing the Buccaneers with five saves on the season. Smith has recorded 8.2 innings pitched on the season with a 16:4 strikeout-to-walk ratio in eight appearances.

Fridays are Unkind

Charleston Southern is currently winless in series openers in the 2017 season having dropped the opening games against both Delaware State and Virginia Commonwealth. The Buccaneers have rallied back to win the final two games in each of the series and improved to 8-4 overall in weekend series on the year. CSU looks to reverse that trend this weekend against Longwood in Big South Conference play.

Racking up the strikeouts

Twice this season the Buccaneers have had a reliever enter a game and retire the first four batters he faced on strikeouts. Eddie Hiott pitched the Bucs out of a bases-loaded jam against VCU with a pair of strikeouts in the fifth inning on February 26 and then retired the first two in the sixth on strikes. Wil Hartsell became the second Buccaneer to achieve the mark on Wednesday with the junior right-hander retired his first two batters in the sixth on strikes and the first two in the seventh in a successful hold.

See Ball...Crush Ball

Brandon Gragilla has come alive over the last three weeks in the designated hitter role for the Buccaneers with the senior designated hitter jumping among the conference leaders in multiple offensive categories. Gragilla currently leads the Big South in batting average (.432), is third in slugging percentage (.659), and second in on-base percentage (.519). He added a season-best four RBI in the Bucs' 9-3 series-opening win against Hofstra, and added his first home run in the Bucs' midweek win over USC Upstate.

Home Field Advantage

Charleston Southern won the weekend series against Delaware State and continued to assert its dominance at the CSU Ballpark as the Buccaneers topped VCU, 2-1, this past weekend. CSU has posted a .500 record or better at home since the 2013 season and will look to continue the trend this year with a schedule featuring 29 home contests. In each of the past two seasons the Bucs have posted 14 wins (14-13, 2016 and 14-14, 2015), while CSU recorded a 20-win season at the Ballpark in 2014. The Bucs started the trend in 2013 with a 17-12 record at home.

Thornburg on the Move

Charleston Southern alum Tyler Thornburg was on the move this offseason with the 28 year old right-hander traded to the Boston Red Sox this winter during the MLB winter meetings. Thornburg, projected as the Red Sox eighth-inning reliever for the 2017 season, was traded by the Brewers for three prospects including first baseman/third baseman Travis Shaw, infield prospect Mauricio Dubon, and Single-A pitcher Josh Pennington. Thornburg posted a 2.15 ERA, 13 saves and 12.1 strikeouts per nine innings in 67 appearances last season, taking over as Milwaukee's closer after Jeremy Jeffress was dealt to Texas at the trade deadline. Red Sox manager John Farrell cited a lower arm slot as the primary reason for Thornburg's breakthrough as a power pitcher, while president of baseball operations Dave Dombrowski called Thornburg's curveball a "dominant pitch."

Familiar Faces, New Roles

Charleston Southern has several familiar faces in the dugout and in the coaching boxes this season as all three assistant positions are occupied by CSU alum. Zack Hagaman (CSU '15), George Schaefer (CSU '13) and Nick Chinnners (CSU '11) will all be on interim head coach Adam Ward's coaching staff in the 2017 season. Hagaman (Outfielders/Hitters), Schaefer (Pitching), and Chinnners (Infielders) will all help the Bucs on the sideline this season.

Hagaman is a former All-Big South selection and two-year starter for the Buccaneers, is in his second season with the Bucs. For his career, the versatile Buc starter 108 games, batting .285 with 111 hits and 67 RBI. He also made 54 career appearances out of the bullpen, with a 5-1 career record and three saves.

Schaefer was a four-year pitcher for the Buccaneers from 2009-2013 and was named co-captain his senior year. While at CSU, Schaefer served as President of the Student-Athlete Advisory Council (SAAC). A four-time member of the Big South Academic Honor Roll, Schaefer graduated with a double major in Political Science and Communications. In December 2014, Schaefer completed a Master's degree in Politics and Policy from Lehigh University.

Chinnners finished up his playing career with the Buccaneers after five years with CSU lining up at first base and catcher. A switch hitter in the lineup, Chinnners is ranked among the all-time record holders at CSU in career hits (2nd), hits in a season (3rd), career games played (3rd), career doubles (4th), Career RBI (4th), season RBI (4th), career home runs (5th), and career walks (5th). He was a two-time All-Conference member, a team captain, and a Big South Scholar-Athlete.

Night Games back at the Ballpark

Since the installation of lights at the CSU Ballpark in the 2013 season, the Buccaneers have taken full advantage of night baseball. This season is no different with the Bucs expected to host 12 games under lights including midweek contests against USC Upstate, Winthrop, Savannah State, The Citadel, and College of Charleston. The Bucs' home weekend openers will also take advantage of the light banks with all Friday games set for a 6 p.m. first pitch. The addition is a result of the "Building Buccaneer Baseball Light Campaign" which was started in 2011.

Catch the Bucs at home on the Big South Network

Charleston Southern released its spring home streaming schedule this week with Buccaneers baseball team to be featured heavily in March and April. The Bucs will make their season debut on BSN on March 4-5 against Hofsta. CSU's series against Liberty on March 24-26 will be streamed, as well as midweek matchups against The Citadel (Apr. 4) and CofC (Apr. 12). CSU's weekend series against Radford (Apr. 21-23) and Air Force (May 18-20) are also scheduled to be showcased.

Sunshine State-Bound

Charleston Southern will make one of its longest road trips in recent history this season as the Buccaneers make the trip down I-95 to Florida International University for a three-game set on March 9-11. The Bucs will make the 617 mile trip down the coast over Spring Break to take on the Panthers. The Bucs made one trip to the Sunshine State in the 2017 season with CSU traveling to Jacksonville on March 22 for a midweek matchup. CSU fell to the Dolphins, 4-1, at Sessions Stadium.
