LANCER LEADOFF

- Longwood enters the week after taking two of three against Charleston Southern in the first weekend of conference play.
- Longwood takes on VCU in Richmond Tuesday before playing at Radford for a weekend conference series, playing four straight games in state.
- Senior Cody Wager was named Big South pitcher of the week after coming within four outs of a no-hitter Saturday, striking out a career-high 10 batters.

- Longwood is led in hitting by Michael Osinski, who is batting .325 and leads the Big South in RBI (24). Osinski is third in conference with 27 hits, fourth with 16 runs scored, and sixth with 38 total bases.
- Justin Mitchell has reached base in all 20 games played, hitting .290 with a .440 on-base percentage. Mitchell is fourth in the Big South with 18 walks drawn.
- As a team Longwood leads the Big South in hits per game and is third in runs.

SCOUTING VCU

- Longwood meets VCU for the first of a home-and-home series Tuesday. VCU enters the week off a sweep at UNC Wilmington, a team Longwood won one game against earlier in the season.
- VCU has a pair of impressive wins this season, winning Friday games at Florida State and at Charleston Southern.
- The Rams finished second place in the Atlantic 10 in 2016 and return 23 letter winners from a team that split in two games with the Lancers a season ago.
- Freshman infielder Paul Witt leads the Big South in batting average, hitting .403 and has played in all 20 games.
- Four players are hitting better than .300 for VCU. Alex Gransback is hitting .356, while Daane Berezo is hitting .309, and Haiden Lamb is batting .303.
- Darian Carpenter is leading the team with three home runs and is tied for the team lead with 10 RBI, tied with Gransback, Zac Ching, and Logan Farrar.
- Sam Donko has made a team-high nine appearances out of the bullpen with a 1.15 ERA.

GOT HEEM

• Junior right-handed pitcher Zach Potojecki was brilliant at Savannah State on 3/4 and with 6.2 innings of shutout ball and finished one shy of the school record with 13 strikeouts.

• Senior right-hander Cody Wager spun a career-high 7.1 innings of two-run ball and struck out career-high 10 batters at UNC Wilmington 3/11.

• Wager was magical again with 10 strikeouts in 8.1 shutout innings vs. Charleston Southern 3/18 and came within four outs of a no-hitter.

• Longwood leads the Big South with 187 strikeouts on the season, 48 looking.

• Wager leads the Big South with 35 strikeouts and Potojecki is seventh at 28.

TOP FIVE

• After finishing with the most wins since becoming a full-time Division I participant in 2008 at 32-27, and finishing tied for second in the Big South at 14-10, Longwood was picked to finish fifth in the Big South in 2017. The Lancers return their top two hitters, senior designated hitter Alex Lewis and junior shortstop Michael Osinski, who were both named to the All-Big South preseason team by Perfect Game.

ALEX THE GREAT

• After a breakout 2016, senior Alex Lewis was named Big South All-Conference Second Team, First Team All-Region ABCA East, and All-State VaSID after hitting .369 with five home runs, 45 RBI, and 22 doubles, setting the school single-season record with 86 hits.

SAMMY THE SPARK

• Junior outfielder Sammy Miller has been great in the lead-off role, reaching base at a rate of .429 (12-for-28) when beginning an inning. Miller is third in the conference with 10 stolen bases and fourth with 16 runs scored. Miller stole a career high three bases in Friday's win vs. Charleston Southern.

• Miller was money as the lead-off man in 2016. Miller reached base at a rate of .440 when leading off an inning, and led the Lancers with 40 walks and 48 runs scored, along with 19 steals.

IRON MIKE

• Junior shortstop Michael Osinski leads the team in nearly every offensive category through 20 games, leading the conference with 24 RBI, third with 27 hits, fourth with 16 runs scored, and sixth with 38 total bases.

• Osinski has been the starting shortstop since early in his freshman year. Osinski started all 59 games for Longwood in 2016.

BRING HIM IN!

• Longwood is second in the Big South in hits (181), third in runs scored (110), third in RBI (98), and is fourth in total bases (254).

• As a team the Lancers have hit .269 (57-for-212) with runners in scoring position and four Lancers are hitting better than .300 with RISP in at least 10 at-bats.

• Michael Osinski is hitting .414 (12-for-29) with runners in scoring position while Justin Mitchell is at .409 (9-for-22).

• Joey Mendez (.364) and Sammy Miller (.313) are also batting better than .300 with RISP.

HE'S HEADED FOR THIRD!

• Longwood leads the Big South in triples with 10 triples as a team in 2017. Longwood finished 2016 with five triples.

• Longwood is led in triples by Antwaun Tucker, who has three. Alex Lewis and Sammy Miller are second on the squad with two each.

PLACE YOUR WAGER!

• Cody Wager picked up Big South Pitcher of the Week honors March 20 after putting together his second straight start with 10 strikeouts.

• Wager had the game of his career 3/18 against Charleston Southern, coming within four outs of a no-hitter, striking out 10 batters in 8.1 innings of three-hit, shutout ball.

DO THE RUNNIN' MAN!

• Longwood is second in the Big South in steal attempts (35) and second in stolen bases (28). The Lancers are third in the league in runs scored (110).

SENIOR SEND-OFF

- Longwood graduated five seniors in 2016, Connor Bastaich, Travis Burnette, Allen Ellis, Colton Konvicka, and C.J. Roth.
- Bastaich started every game at first base and was second on the team with a .335 batting average and was named all-conference second team.
- Burnette was Longwood's Friday night starter and was named first team all-conference and second team all-state after spinning a 2.35 ERA in 99.2 innings with 85 strikeouts to 45 walks and an 8-2 record, all career bests.
- Roth, Longwood's starting second baseman, set the record for most games played in a career at Longwood and hit his first three career home runs at Longwood. Roth works in strength and conditioning at Longwood.
- Konvicka missed two months of the season with injuries. The converted infielder hit .276 in 34 games played.
- Ellis made just five appearances, but was heralded for his veteran leadership in the pitching staff.

CHAMPIONS FROM THE START

- Freshmen Nate Blakeney, Tyler Morgan, John Gregory, and Joey Mendez all won state championships in 2016, their senior seasons in high school.
- Blakeney led Wesleyan Christian Academy (High Point, N.C.) to the NCISAA 3-A State Championship with a 2-for-3 game and grand slam in the title game. Blakeney was an all-area first team selection by the Greensboro News & Record.
- Morgan picked up the save in Hanover's (Mechanicsburg, Va.) 13-12 title game win to clinch the Virginia 4A State Championship.
- Gregory, Morgan's teammate at Hanover, went 2-for-4 with an RBI in the title game and was an all-conference first team selection in the regular season.
- Mendez, an all-state preseason selection at Riverdale Baptist (Upper Marlboro, Md.), led the team to its second consecutive NACA Division I Championship.

BULLISH 'PEN

- The Longwood bullpen did its job in 2016, picking up 19 saves, topped only by the College World Series champion, Coastal Carolina, which ended its season with 21. Of 184 inherited base runners only 71 scored (61 percent stranded). Longwood had a bullpen ERA of 4.49 and had 192 strikeouts with 120 walks in 242.2 innings.
- As a sophomore, left-hander Michael Catlin made a team-high 25 appearances, tied with right-hander Cody Boydston, who was a freshman at the time. Catlin returns with the lowest ERA among pitchers with a 3.00 ERA and went 4-0 in 51.0 innings pitched.
- Boydston was the primary closer for the first half of the season, picking up five saves and had 24 strikeouts in 33.1 innings pitched.

I'LL BE GOOD BY THE WEEKEND

- Longwood put out a starting rotation of Cody Wager, Devin Gould, and Tyler Wirsu to begin the year. Those three combined started nine games in 2016. Longwood inserted Zach Potojecki in the series at Savannah State.
- Longwood could potentially add Steven Farkas and Mitchell Kuebbing to the rotation after both missed the first month due to injury. Farkas made his season debut at UNCW on 3/11. Kuebbing missed 2016 due to injury and has not yet appeared in 2017.

STAY RIGHT WHERE YOU ARE!

- Longwood led the Big South with 21 runners picked off in 2016, helping to control the running game. Ryan Jones led the league with eight pick-offs.

BREAKING RECORDS

- Longwood had a number of records set in 2016, winning 32 games, 14 in conference, and 21 at home, all the most since Longwood became a full-time Division I participant in 2008. Longwood's second-place finish is the best since joining the Big South in 2013.
- Alex Lewis set the record for hits in a season (86) in 2016.
- As a team Longwood set the records for hits (540) and fielding percentage (.966) in 2016.

KEEP IMPROVING

- Improvement was a key part of 2016 for Longwood baseball as the Lancers saw an increase of 10 wins overall and five conference victories.
- Senior pitcher Travis Burnette, a former outfielder at Longwood, made the biggest jump among pitchers in 2016, transforming from a swing man between the rotation and bullpen in 2015 into a bonafide ace as a senior.
- Burnette received first team All-Big South and second team all-region (ABCA East) and second team all-state (VaSID) honors. Burnette was third in the Big South with a 2.35 ERA and finished in the top 10 in batting average against, innings pitched, and strikeouts.
- As a junior, Alex Lewis made a jump of 176 points to his batting average, hitting .369 in 2016. Lewis was a second team all-conference selection and was first team all-state and all-region. Lewis made jumps in hits (86, +58), runs (35, +23), doubles (22, +12), home runs (5, +3), and RBI (45, +33) from his junior year. Lewis finished in the top five in the Big South in hits, average, and doubles.

YEAR NUMBER THREE

- Ryan Mau returns for his third season as Longwood's head baseball coach in 2017. Longwood finished 22-34 in Mau's first season, stepping up to a 32-27 mark in year two. The Lancers made it to the Big South tournament for the second consecutive year in 2016, playing their way to the championship semifinals before falling to the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers, who went on to win the College World Series.
- Longwood returns 18 letter winners, 10 pitchers, and five starting position players from last year's squad, while adding 13 players, eight freshmen.

KEEPING UP WITH LONGWOOD

- Longwood will play select home and road games on the Big South Network in 2017. Five regular season games and the entire conference tournament will be on radio on WVHL 92.9 FM Farmville, with second-year play-by-play man Darius Thigpen calling the action.

WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

- Former Lancer stars right-handed pitcher Aaron Myers and outfielder Kyri Washington left their marks on the Longwood baseball program with Washington leading the Big South in home runs in 2016 and Myers setting the Longwood school records in strikeouts, saves, and innings pitched. Both players have moved on to play professional baseball, where they join former Lancer arm, right-handed pitcher Mark Montgomery.
- Myers is slated to attend Minor League Spring Training in Arizona for the Milwaukee Brewers, his third season in the organization after signing with as a non-drafted free agent in 2015. Myers pitched with the Rookie League AZL Brewers in 2015 and posted a 1.74 ERA in seven appearances out of the bullpen and picked up three saves in three opportunities with 14 strikeouts and no walks across 10.1 innings of work. In 2016 Myers went 4-1 with a 1.44 ERA across 43.2 innings pitched with 55 strikeouts to 11 walks. The right-hander began with the AZL Brewers and was called up to the Helena Brewers of the Pioneer League, where he spent the majority of his season. With the Helena Brewers Myers went 3-1 in 11 appearances with 11.38 ERA and struck out 44 batters with seven walks in 32.2 innings pitched. Myers is on pace to begin his 2017 season in Single-A.
- The Newport News, Va., native finished his Longwood career with a 2.93 ERA across 338.0 career innings with 319 strikeouts to just 113 walks.
- Washington only played three years at Longwood, but made a strong impact and was drafted by the Boston Red Sox in the 23rd round of the 2015 draft. Washington began his pro career in Rookie Ball with the GCL Red Sox before making it to Short Season A-Ball with the Lowell Spinners. Between the two levels Washington hit .263 with nine doubles, one triple, 22 RBI, and his first professional home run in 2015.
- In 2016 Washington had massive success with the Greenville Drive of the South Atlantic League, where he spent the entire season. Washington

was voted Greenville Drive player of the year after hitting .262 with 16 home runs, 45 extra-base hits, and 73 RBI in 103 games played. In his first full professional season Washington ended the season with a .487 slugging percentage and .810 OPS.

- The Prospect, Va., native hit .263 with 28 career home runs, 44 doubles, two triples and 123 career RBI for the Blue & White.
- Montgomery, a native of Williamsburg, Va., has spent his entire six-year career in the New York Yankees organization since the Yankees took him in the 11th round of the 2011 draft. Montgomery posted a 2.56 ERA in 33 appearances, all out of the bullpen, between Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Double-A Trenton in 2016 and owns a career 2.33 ERA. Montgomery struck out 63 batters with 22 walks in 45.2 innings of work in 2016 and was a part of the Triple-A Champion Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders.

WE'LL SEE YOU NEXT YEAR!

- Ryan Mau announced the signing of seven recruits to their national letters of intent during the early signing period.
- Mau's third full recruiting class features three players from the Virginia and Washington, D.C., area including the top player from the D.C. area, right-hander Maceo Campbell. Right-handed pitchers Tommy Green and Tyler Knapp round out the haul of local talent, while left-handed pitcher Daniel Brandon (West Virginia), outfielder Jack Schnell (New York), Todd Moxey (Pennsylvania), and infielder Kaleb Fold (Ohio) represent four other states to bring a larger national presence to the signing class.

BLUE COLLAR LANCERS

- Longwood gritted out tough wins in 2016, finishing with an 11-4 record in one-run games, a 4-2 record in extra-innings, and won 17 games when the other team scored first.
- This season Longwood is 2-4 in one-run games, is 0-10 when the opponent strikes first, and is 0-1 in extra-inning games.
