THE OPENING TIP

- Off to their first 3-0 start in the Division I era, the Lancers return to Willett Hall Friday for their second home game of the season, taking on Delaware State at 7 p.m.
- The game will pit first-year Longwood head coach **Griff Aldrich** against his former UMBC benchmate Eric Skeeters. Both Aldrich and Skeeters coached together at UMBC during the 2016-17 and 2017-18 seasons.
- Aldrich has the Lancers off to their seventh 3-0 start in the program's 41 years of existence and the team's first such start since 2000-01.
- Leading the charge for Longwood is the Big South's third-leading scorer in **Isaiah Walton** (21.0 ppg.) and two of the league's top rebounders in Walton (8.0 rpg.) and **Jordan Cintron** (7.3).
- Friday's game will be Longwood's last at home before a four-game road trip that goes through the end of November.

LAST TIME OUT

- Backed by a third straight 20-point game from **Isaiah Walton** and a breakout 12-point night from junior transfer **Seán Flood**, Longwood outlasted UMES 66-63 Tuesday at Hytche Athletic Center to improve to 3-0 for the first time in the program's 15-year Division I era.
- Walton finished with 20 points on 7-of-12 shooting from the field, while Flood – who entered the night without a point in his fledgling Division I career – sank four three-pointers and added three assists in 20 minutes off the bench.
- Longwood needed five made free throws in the final 16 seconds from junior **Lorenzo Phillips** to survive the Eagles, who trimmed the Lancers' 12-point lead to 65-63 with a 14-4 run in the final 1:10 of the game.
- Lancer sophomore **Jordan Cintron** finished with a career-high 14 points and shot a perfect 7-of-7 from the free throw line.

LONGWOOD BASKETBALL COACH'S SHOW

The Longwood men's basketball coach's show, titled "Griff Aldrich Live at Effingham's" airs monthly at LongwoodLancers.com and re-airs 24 hours later on WVHL Kickin' Country 92.9 FM. The hour-long show takes place in front of a live audience at Effingham's, located in Hotel Weyanoke on High Street right across from Longwood's campus.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Longwood is 3-0 for the first time in the program's 15-year Division I era. The last time the Lancers started 3-0 was in 2000-01 when they finished the year 23-8 and reached the 2001 NCAA Division III Tournament. The 3-0 start of the seventh in program history.
- The Lancers surrender the fewest points per game (56.0) and have held opponents to the lowest field goal percentage (.363) in the Big South. No team has shot better than 40.0 percent against Longwood this season, while only UMES has scored more than 60 points.
- Guard **Isaiah Walton** has scored 20 points in all three games this season and ranks third in the Big South with 21.0 points per game. He has recorded those stats while averaging just 12.7 field goal attempts per game and shooting .579 (22-of-38) from the floor.
- Walton needs just 100 more points to become the sixth 1,000-point scorer in Longwood's 15-year Division I era and the 22nd in program history.
- Along with his 21.0 points per game, Walton also ranks second in the Big South with 8.0 rebounds per game. He has grabbed at least five rebounds in every game, including a career-high 12 against Richmond.
- Longwood has gotten balanced scoring from its frontcourt and backcourt, with the guards accounting for 58.7 percent of the team's total points and the forwards making up the other 41.3 percent.
- Point guard **Lorenzo "Shabooty" Phillips** leads Longwood with 11 assists this season, 10 of which have come on made three-pointers.
- Longwood's bench is contributing 28.3 points and 3.7 assists per game and has twice scored more than 20 points in a game. The leading bench scorers are sophomore guard **Kamil Chapman** (7.0 points per game) and **Gus Okafor** (6.3 points per game).

- Longwood and Delaware State meet for only the second time in series history Friday in Willett Hall.
- The first meeting between the teams took place during the 2008-09 season, which Longwood won 69-65 at the Las Vegas Invitational at Orleans Arena in Las Vegas.
- Delaware State will be the second straight Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference opponent Longwood has faced following the Lancers' 66-63 win over Maryland-Eastern Shore this past Tuesday.

RECORD-BREAKING START

- Longwood is off to its best start of the Division I era under first-year head coach **Griff Aldrich**, staking a 3-0 record out of the gate for the first time since the Lancers began the transition in 2004-05.
- The last time Longwood started 3-0 was in 2000-01 as part of a 7-0 start that eventually yielded a final record of 23-8. That team, led by head coach Mike Leeder, was ranked as high as No. 21 in the Division III poll, won the Carolinas-Virginia Athletic Conference and reached the 2001 NCAA Division II Tournament.
- Longwood's longest undefeated start to a season came in 1979-80 — only the fourth year of the program's existence — as part of a 28-3 season under head coach Dr. Ron Bash. That team finished 28-3 and reached the NCAA Division III Final Four.
- In the six previous seasons Longwood opened the year 3-0, the Lancers finished with winning records four times and reached the NCAA Tournament in 1979-80 and 2000-01.

NEW COACH ON THE BLOCK

- Longwood men's basketball head coach **Griff Aldrich** took over the Lancer program in March of 2018, becoming the ninth coach in Longwood men's basketball history.
- Aldrich is one of four new head coaches in the Big South for 2018-19 and leads all of those newcomers with a 3-0 record through the first two weeks of the season.
- A 1996 graduate of neighboring Hampden-Sydney, Aldrich came to Longwood from UMBC where in just two years he helped head coach and former Hampden-Sydney teammate Ryan Odom turn a perennial America East bottom-dweller into a conference champion and history-making NCAA Tournament darling that defeated No. 1 national seed Virginia in the first round of the 2018 tournament.
- Prior to returning to the college coaching ranks at UMBC, Aldrich enjoyed a successful career as an attorney and chief financial officer in the energy industry in Texas. During that time, he also coached at the AAU level at several elite programs for high school players. That dual career followed a one-year stint on the sidelines at Hampden-Sydney under now-William & Mary head coach Tony Shaver where he helped the Tigers to a perfect 24-0 regular season and the No. 1 national ranking at the Division III level.

FRESH FACES

- Nearly half of Longwood's roster in 2018-19 includes newcomers who will make their debut in a Lancer uniform this season.
- That group includes head coach **Griff Aldrich** and his staff's first signing class, which features three juniors and four freshmen.
- Additionally, redshirt junior **Pernell Adgei**, who sat out last season at Longwood while taking a developmental redshirt, and Juan Munoz, who missed his first two seasons with back-to-back season-ending injuries, are also eligible to play their first seasons as a Lancers in 2018-19.

EMPHASIS ON DEFENSE

- Key to Longwood's 3-0 start has been a stifling defense built on preventing easy layups and forcing teams to settle for contested three-pointers.
- That strategy has allowed the Lancers to hold each of their first three opponents under 40 percent shooting from the field and 32 percent shooting from three-point range.
- The Lancers lead the Big South in scoring defense with an opponent scoring average of 59.0 points per game. Only UMES, which Longwood defeated 66-63 Tuesday, has topped the 60-point plateau.
- Longwood has also generated a Big South-leading 23 steals through the first two games, tied for 17th nationally at an average of 11.5 per game.
- Longwood is tied for the Big South lead with 20.0 opponent turnovers per game, which has led to 14.0 points per game off turnovers.

WALTON AMONG BIG SOUTH'S TOP SCORING THREATS

- **Isaiah Walton** has picked up where he left off last season, ranking among the Big South's most productive and versatile scorers.
- Walton is currently the No.3 scorer in the Big South with 21.0 points per game while also ranked second with 8.0 rebounds and among the top five in field goal percentage (.579) and steals (2.3).
- Walton entered the year as the Big South's No. 5 returning scorer, trailing only Big South Preseason Player of the Year Chris Clemons and fellow Preseason All-Big South selections Christian Keeling and David Efanayi and Jahaad Proctor.
- Walton has amassed 900 career points and would be the 22nd 1,000-point scorer in school history.
- Walton's scoring at Longwood has been balanced, with 47.8 percent of his points coming on two-point field goals, 31.3 percent on threes and 20.1 percent on free throws.

On and off the basketball court, the career of new Longwood men's basketball coach Griff Aldrich has been marked by two constants: a passion for transforming lives, and success at every step.

Standout prep and college player. Partner in a top-tier international law firm, and CFO of an investment company. High-level AAU coach who helped develop players including NBA and NFL standouts, and community leader who founded an elite, faith-based basketball program for at-risk youth.

The most recent stop: leaving the business world to follow his passion for coaching, and helping orchestrate one of the biggest recent turnarounds in Division I basketball. When Aldrich joined the staff at University of Maryland-Baltimore County (UMBC) in 2016, the program had endured eight straight losing seasons and averaged 24 losses per season. During Aldrich's two seasons on the bench with head coach Ryan Odom, the Retrievers enjoyed the best two-year stretch in program history, which included back-to-back 20-win seasons and this year's America East Conference title.

And that was before the 2018 NCAA Tournament, and the stunning 20-point win over No. 1 national seed Virginia in the NCAA Tournament that made UMBC a household name across the country.

In March of 2018, Aldrich returned home to Virginia, and a community he loves and knows well from his days as a player and assistant coach on a string of dominant teams under Tony Shaver at nearby Hampden-Sydney College.

Troy Austin, Longwood athletics director from 2006-18, appointed Aldrich as Longwood's new men's basketball head coach, making him the ninth coach in program history.

"From the start of this process, Griff established himself as a unique candidate who will be an outstanding fit for our community, for our program and for Longwood's citizen-leadership mission," Austin said. "President Reveley and I knew entering this search that we needed a coach who placed an emphasis on building a culture of success through selective recruiting, player development and engagement with the community. Griff, with his strong ties to Farmville and the Commonwealth, meets all those criteria, and he has demonstrated his ability to run a program in a very unique, 'Chief of Staff' role at UMBC.

"Honestly, we have been excited about Griff as a candidate from our earliest conversations with him at the beginning of this process. It just took a little while to get him to campus after UMBC won the America East and then made NCAA Tournament history. It was a pretty good reason for a short delay, and we're glad we can now call him a Lancer."

As UMBC's Director of Recruiting and Program Development from 2016-18, Aldrich acted as chief of staff for Odom — his college teammate and son of legendary college coach

Dave Odom — and was involved in all aspects of UMBC's turnaround from NCAA cellar-dweller to America East Champion and NCAA Tournament giant-killer.

"I am extremely excited about joining the Longwood basketball program and broader Longwood community," said Aldrich, a 1996 graduate of Hampden-Sydney College and a 1999 graduate of the University of Virginia School of Law. "Returning to Farmville is personally significant as it is connected to a tremendous opportunity while allowing me to return to my home state and to a town where I spent my most formative years. My family and I could not be happier about this new

chapter, and we are eager to become integrated into the community — both at Longwood and the greater Farmville area.

“I look forward to getting to work at Longwood and building off the foundation that has been established. In addition, we expect to hit the recruiting trail immediately to secure this year’s class and add outstanding young men to our existing program.”

At UMBC, Aldrich oversaw the recruiting and program development efforts and helped bring in a wealth of talent that included AEC Defensive Player of the Year K.J. Maura and AEC All-Rookie Teamers Daniel Aiken and Arkel Lamar. He was involved in all aspects of the program from recruiting and scouting, to quality control and campus and community engagement.

“Longwood University hit it out of the park with the hiring of Griff Aldrich,” said UMBC head coach Ryan Odom, who went 46-24 in two seasons with Aldrich at his side. “Griff was a vital part of our historic run this season at UMBC. Aldrich’s success at UMBC is the most recent chapter in a diverse career in which winning has consistently followed the 1996 magna cum laude Hampden-Sydney graduate and Phi Beta Kappa inductee.

As a player he helped lead the Tigers to a 79-31 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances, and was team captain his senior year. After earning his Juris Doctorate from the Univer-

sity of Virginia School of Law, Aldrich rejoined his former college coach Tony Shaver on the Hampden-Sydney bench for the 1999-2000 season. That year, Aldrich helped Shaver lead the Tigers to their best season in school history with a 24-0 record in the regular season, a No. 1 Division III national ranking, the Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) Championship and a trip to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

After that championship season at Hampden-Sydney, Aldrich shifted his professional sights to the private sector where he began a successful 16-year career in law and business. He became a partner at Vinson & Elkins, a leading international law firm, working in Houston and London. Later, he established and built a private oil and gas company in Texas, and held the position of Managing Director & Chief Financial Officer in a national energy-focused private investment firm.

But even as his professional resume grew, Aldrich’s heart remained in coaching, and he never stepped out of the elite coaching ranks. While at Vinson & Elkins, he served as head coach at several elite-level AAU basketball programs for high school players. He went on to found the HIS Hoops program in Houston’s Third Ward where his work with students focused on faith, academics and basketball. Several of his players there and at other AAU programs advanced to the college and professional ranks, including L.A. Clippers forward DeAndre Jordan, international professionals Jay Cousinard, P.J. Cousinard and Brandon Peters, and NFL linebacker Orie Lemon.

Aldrich and his wife, Julie, have three children — Scott, Ford, and Laura Lee.


