THE OPENING TIP

- A new era of Longwood men's basketball begins Tuesday as first-year head coach **Griff Aldrich** makes his debut on the sidelines in the season opener against Randolph.
- Aldrich, who was appointed Longwood's ninth head coach this past March, comes to Farmville from UMBC where he was Director of Recruiting and Program Development for a Retrievers' team that went 25-11, won the America East Conference and made history by upsetting No. 1 national seed Virginia in the first round of the 2018 NCAA Tournament.
- Aldrich's first Longwood team features eight returning letterwinners and two starters, including leading returning scorer **Isaiah Walton** and sixth-year senior **Damarion Geter**.
- Aldrich's first recruiting class features seven players, including four freshmen and three juniors.
- The Lancers return 59.3 percent of their scoring from a year ago, the bulk of which comes from Walton whose 15.6 points per game ranked 10th in the Big South last season and makes him the No. 5 returning scorer in the conference.
- Geter, who enters his sixth year in the program and fifth as team captain, is Longwood's active leader in rebounds (470), rebounding average (4.8), blocks (85), games played (98) and games started (67). A graduate student studying counseling, his additional eligibility stems from a medical hardship waiver brought on by back-to-back season-ending injuries he suffered in 2015-16 and 2016-17.
- Longwood is 5-10 in season-openers in the Division I era, dating back to the 2004-05 campaign. Longwood's last season-opening win came against Randolph, 69-49, at the start of the 2015-16 season.

The hour-long show takes place in front of a live audience at Effingham's, located in Hotel Weyanoke on High Street right across from Longwood's campus.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Longwood men's basketball opens its 12th season as a Division I program Tuesday and will do so under first-year head coach **Griff Aldrich**, the ninth head coach in the program's 41 seasons of basketball.
- Longwood returns 59.3 percent of its scoring and 59.9 percent of its rebounding from one year ago with two players — redshirt senior **Isaiah Walton** and graduate student **Damarion Geter** — individually accounting for 20 percent of those statistics in 2017-18.
- Walton accounted for more than 20 percent of Longwood's scoring last season, averaging a career-high 15.6 points per game to rank 10th in the Big South in that category.
- Geter accounted for 20 percent of Longwood's rebounding last season and ranked fifth in the Big South with a career-high 7.3 rebounds per game last season.
- Of Longwood's 15 players, nine have never taken the court in a Longwood uniform. Seven of those are part of first-year head coach **Griff Aldrich**'s first recruiting class, while two others — redshirt junior **Pernell Adgei** and redshirt sophomore **Juan Munoz** — return to the roster after redshirting this past season. Munoz has been on the roster since 2016-17 but has yet to see the court due to back-to-back season-ending injuries.
- Despite the wealth of newcomers, Longwood's roster boasts plenty of collegiate experience this season with nine players in at least their third year of college basketball. Of those, the three-man senior class of Geter, Walton and **Spencer Franklin** has combined to play 12 years of college basketball entering 2018-19.
- Six of Longwood's first eight games will be on the road. The Lancers' two home games in November are Tuesday's opener against Randolph and a Nov. 16 matchup against Delaware State.

- Longwood and Randolph meet for the second time in program history Tuesday in Willett Hall.
- The first meeting between the teams took place in the 2015-16 season-opener and saw Longwood run up a 20-point win, 69-49, in Willett Hall. That game saw former Lancer Khris Lane tie Longwood's Division I single-game rebounding record with a 16-point, 20-rebound double-double. Kanayo Obi-Rapu also scored 22 points and hit six three-pointers in the win.
- The only member of this year's team remaining from that last matchup against Randolph is graduate student **Damarion Geter**, who missed the game and the rest of that season with a shoulder injury.

NEW COACH ON THE BLOCK

- Longwood men's basketball head coach **Griff Aldrich** took over the Lancer program in March of 2018, becoming the ninth coach in Longwood men's basketball history.
- A 1996 graduate of neighboring Hampden-Sydney, Aldrich came to Longwood from UMBC where in just two years he helped head coach and former Hampden-Sydney teammate Ryan Odom turn a perennial America East bottom-dweller into a conference champion and history-making NCAA Tournament darling that defeated No. 1 national seed Virginia in the first round of the 2018 tournament.
- In eight years prior to Odom and Aldrich's arrival at UMBC, the Retrievers endured eight consecutive losing seasons and an average of 24 losses per year during that span. In two years under Odom and Aldrich, UMBC went 46-24, logged back-to-back 20-win seasons and won the America East Championship in 2018.
- Prior to returning to the college coaching ranks at UMBC, Aldrich enjoyed a successful career as an attorney and chief financial officer in the energy industry in Texas. During that time, he also coached at the AAU level at several elite programs for high school players. That dual career followed a one-year stint on the sidelines at Hampden-Sydney under now-William & Mary head coach Tony Shaver where he helped the Tigers to a perfect 24-0 regular season and the No. 1 national ranking at the Division III level.
- Aldrich is one of four new head coaches in the Big South for 2018-19.

FRESH FACES

- Nearly half of Longwood's roster in 2018-19 includes newcomers who will make their debut in a Lancer uniform this season.
- That group includes head coach **Griff Aldrich** and his staff's first signing class, which features three juniors and four freshmen.
- Additionally, redshirt junior **Pernell Adgei**, who sat out last season at Longwood while taking a developmental redshirt, is also eligible to play his first season as a Lancer in 2018-19.
- Longwood's seven-member signing class is the third-largest crop of newcomers in the Big South.

WALTON AMONG BIG SOUTH'S TOP SCORING THREATS

- Isaiah Walton** enters his redshirt-senior season as one of the top returning scorers in the Big South after averaging 15.6 points per game in 2017-18.
- Walton, a Preseason All-Big South second team selection, finished last season among the conference's top 10 in scoring, free throw percentage (.840) and made three-pointers per game (2.1).
- Despite missing six games, Walton accounted for 20 percent of Longwood's total scoring and amassed a team-high 22 double-figure scoring games.
- Walton is the Big South's No. 5 returning scorer, trailing only Big South Preseason Player of the Year Chris Clemons, Preseason All-Big South first-team selections Christian Keeling and David Efanayi, and fellow second-team pick Jahaad Proctor.
- In just two years at the Division I level, Walton has already amassed 837 career points and is on the verge of becoming the 22nd 1,000-point scorer in school history.

VETERAN GETER ENTERS SIXTH YEAR AS A LANCER

- Longwood graduate student **Damarion Geter** is the most veteran player in the Big South, entering his sixth year as a Lancer and fifth as a team captain.
- Geter's extended eligibility stems from back-to-back season-ending injuries that robbed him of his 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons. The first of those was a shoulder injury that required surgery prior to his sophomore year in 2015-16, and the second was a broken foot he suffered three games into the 2016-17 season.
- Geter returned from both of those injuries to have the best year of his career last season, setting career highs in scoring (8.3 ppg.), rebounding (7.3 rpg.), assists (2.0 apg.), blocks (1.2 bpg.), made field goals (92), made free throws (55) and free throw percentage (.663).
- Geter was among the most heavily used players on Longwood's roster, ranking second on the team and 10th in the Big South with 32.4 minutes per game. He missed just three games (with an injury) and played at least 30 minutes 20 times, including in 10 of his final 11 games.
- Geter did not have a single double-digit scoring game in his career entering 2017-18 but amassed 12 last year, including the first two double-doubles of his college career.

POINT GUARD FLOOD BRINGS INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE

- New point guard **Seán Flood**, a transfer from Santa Fe College, brings extensive playing experience at the international level, having played with the Irish National Team as a member of the program's 16U, 18U, 20U and Senior Team levels.
- A native of Dublin, Ireland, Flood captained the Irish National Team's 16U, 18U and 20U squads and led the Templeogue Basketball Club to four National Cup Championships, including the Superleague, U20 and U18 trophies. He was named MVP of the 18U National Cup and Superleague Rookie of the Year in 2015-16.
- Flood comes to Longwood after a breakout sophomore campaign at Santa Fe College, during which he averaged 7.7 points, 3.0 assists, and 1.2 steals per game. He shot .533 (32-of-60) from three-point range and .576 (57-of-99) from the floor as Santa Fe went 21-11 overall. Santa Fe went 16-7 with him in the lineup and 5-4 in nine games without.

ASSISTANT COACH MCGILLAN RETURNS TO BIG SOUTH

- Longwood assistant coach **Marty McGillan** returned to the Big South as a member of head coach Griff Aldrich's first staff, coming back to a conference in which he won three championships as a member of Winthrop's staff from 2007-11 and 2012-17.
- As an assistant coach for those nine seasons with the Eagles, McGillan helped Winthrop post a 96-58 record in Big South play and reach the Big South Championship game six times, including 2017 when the Eagles finished 26-7 with a 15-3 record.

- In his past four seasons in the Big South — all at Winthrop — McGillan has reached the Big South Championship game every time, winning in 2017 and finishing as runner-up in 2014, 2015 and 2016.

On and off the basketball court, the career of new Longwood men's basketball coach Griff Aldrich has been marked by two constants: a passion for transforming lives, and success at every step.

Standout prep and college player. Partner in a top-tier international law firm, and CFO of an investment company. High-level AAU coach who helped develop players including NBA and NFL standouts, and community leader who founded an elite, faith-based basketball program for at-risk youth.

The most recent stop: leaving the business world to follow his passion for coaching, and helping orchestrate one of the biggest recent turnarounds in Division I basketball. When Aldrich joined the staff at University of Maryland-Baltimore County (UMBC) in 2016, the program had endured eight straight losing seasons and averaged 24 losses per season. During Aldrich's two seasons on the bench with head coach Ryan Odom, the Retrievers enjoyed the best two-year stretch in program history, which included back-to-back 20-win seasons and this year's America East Conference title.

And that was before the 2018 NCAA Tournament, and the stunning 20-point win over No. 1 national seed Virginia in the NCAA Tournament that made UMBC a household name across the country.

In March of 2018, Aldrich returned home to Virginia, and a community he loves and knows well from his days as a player and assistant coach on a string of dominant teams under Tony Shaver at nearby Hampden-Sydney College.

Troy Austin, Longwood athletics director from 2006-18, appointed Aldrich as Longwood's new men's basketball head coach, making him the ninth coach in program history.

"From the start of this process, Griff established himself as a unique candidate who will be an outstanding fit for our community, for our program and for Longwood's citizen-leadership mission," Austin said. "President Reveley and I knew entering this search that we needed a coach who placed an emphasis on building a culture of success through selective recruiting, player development and engagement with the community. Griff, with his strong ties to Farmville and the Commonwealth, meets all those criteria, and he has demonstrated his ability to run a program in a very unique, 'Chief of Staff' role at UMBC.

"Honestly, we have been excited about Griff as a candidate from our earliest conversations with him at the beginning of this process. At UMBC, Aldrich oversaw the recruiting and program development efforts and helped bring in a wealth of talent that included AEC Defensive Player of the Year K.J. Maura and AEC All-Rookie Teamers Daniel Aiken and Arkel Lamar. He was involved in all aspects of the program from recruiting and scouting, to quality control and campus and community engagement.

"Griff was a vital part of our historic run this season at UMBC. Aldrich's success at UMBC is the most recent chapter in a diverse career in which winning has consistently followed the 1996 magna cum laude Hampden-Sydney graduate and Phi Beta Kappa inductee.

As a player he helped lead the Tigers to a 79-31 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances, and was team captain his senior year. After earning his Juris Doctorate from the University of Virginia School of Law, Aldrich rejoined his former college coach Tony Shaver on the Hampden-Sydney bench for the 1999-2000 season. That year, Aldrich helped Shaver lead the

Tigers to their best season in school history with a 24-0 record in the regular season, a No. 1 Division III national ranking, the Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) Championship and a trip to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

After that championship season at Hampden-Sydney, Aldrich shifted his professional sights to the private sector where he began a successful 16-year career in law and business. He became a partner at Vinson & Elkins, a leading international law firm, working in Houston and London. Later, he established and built a private oil and gas company in Texas, and held the position of Managing Director & Chief Financial Officer in a national energy-focused private investment firm.

But even as his professional resume grew, Aldrich's heart remained in coaching, and he never stepped out of the elite coaching ranks. While at Vinson & Elkins, he served as head coach at several elite-level AAU basketball programs for high school players. He went on to found the HIS Hoops program in Houston's Third Ward where his work with students focused on faith, academics and basketball. Several of his players there and at other AAU programs advanced to the college and professional ranks, including L.A. Clippers forward DeAndre Jordan, international professionals Jay Cousinard, P.J. Cousinard and Brandon Peters, and NFL linebacker Orie Lemon.

In 2016, Aldrich committed himself full time to his passion, moving to Baltimore with his wife Julie and their three children — Scott, Ford, and Laura Lee — to join Odom in rebuilding the Retrievers' program.
