#### **SCOUTING AUBURN**

- · Longwood and Auburn are set to meet for the first time in the history of the two programs to open up the 2018 season.
- . The games at Auburn are the first for Longwood against an SEC opponent since the Lancers played a three-game series at Georgia in 2015. Longwood took the first game of the series, 7-3.
- · Auburn was picked to finish fifth in the SEC East by the league's coaches, in the same spot as the Tigers finished in 2017.
- The SEC's preseason all-conference team, voted on by the league's 14 head coaches, features one Tiger, starting pitcher Casey Mize.
- Mize was named a preseason second team All-American by Collegiate Baseball and was selected to the D1Baseball All-American First Team.
- Mize finished third in the SEC with a 2.04 ERA and was eighth in the league with 109 strikeouts.
- . The top returning hitters for Auburn are senior infielders Josh Anthony and Dylan
- · Anthony hit .266 and is the leading returner with 14 doubles and had 39 RBI, tied for the most among Auburn returners.
- Ingram was a .258 hitter in 2017, picking up 13 doubles with a team-high eight doubles and had 39 RBI.

#### **FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS**

- · As a senior, Cody Wager impressed in the Friday night role in 2017, spinning his best career start with a complete game against Presbyterian on 4/13/17, tossing 9.0 innings with one unearned run allowed and 13 strikeouts.
- In his junior season, right-handed pitcher Starters Returning/Lost Zach Potojecki made his first-career Friday start at Savannah State on 3/4/17, striking out 13 batters, one shy of the school record, in 6.2 shutout innings of Longwood's win. It was Potojecki's second start of the season.
- · After an early-season shuffle, the Lancers went with Cody Wager, Steven Farkas, and Zach Potojecki for the final two months of the season.
- · Then a sophomore, Farkas returned to the rotation on a limited basis at Radford on 3/25/17, held to a 3.0 innings limit, but cleared for a full workload just two weekends later.
- The Lancers began the year with a rotation of Cody Wager, Devin Gould, and Tyler Wirsu, before making Gould the Friday night guy for three starts. Potojecki took over the Friday night role for one start before an injury forced him to miss his next turn in the rotation.
- As the Saturday guy, Wager won three of his four starts, striking out 10 in back-toback outings against UNC Wilmington and Charleston Southern. Against CSU, Wager had his best career start at the time taking a no-hitter to the eighth.

- Zach Potojecki struck out a careerbest 13 batters at Savannah State on 3/3/17, one shy of the school record for a single game. Potojecki was second on the team with three 10-strikeout games.
- Cody Wager struck out 10 batters at UNC Wilmington 3/11/17 and was magical hit .375 with two home runs, picked up again with 10 strikeouts in 8.1 shutout innings vs. Charleston Southern 3/18/17, • On 4/21/17 Tucker hit a game-tying taking a no-hitter two outs into the eighth. Wager then struck out a careerhigh 13 batters in a complete game win against Presbyterian 4/13/17. Wager led the squad with four 10-strikeout games.
- Longwood led the Big South with 511 punchouts, breaking the previous school D-I record of 440 in 2015.
- Wager led the Big South with 91 strikeouts and Potojecki was third with 82. Potojecki was 16th in the nation with 11.71 strikeouts per nine innings, right behind Auburn's Casey Mize (11.73).
- Longwood was 3rd in the country with 9.9 strikeouts per nine innings as a team. • On 4/13/17 against Presbyterian

· Senior outfielder Sammy Miller was great in the lead-off role in 2017, reaching base at a rate of .382 (26-for-68) when leading off an inning. Miller finished third in the conference with 22 steals.

- Longwood senior left-hander Michael Catlin returns as one of Longwood's goto arms, having served in virtually every role for the pitching staff in his career.
- In 2017 the bullpen ace tied for the team his with 22 appearances, which included to starts, two saves, and five relief outings that of at least 3.0 innings.

- Michael Osinski got off to a hot start and led the Big South in RBI for the first two months of 2017. Osinski led the team comeback victory against VMI on with 36 RBI last season.
- Osinski was the starting shortstop for three years before being selected by the Boston Red Sox in the 31st Round of the 2017 MLB Draft. Osinski is the 10th Longwood player drafted and first since Kyri Washington, who was taken by Boston in the 23rd round in 2015.

#### SO FRESH AND SO CLEAN!

- Freshman outfielder Antwaun Tucker won two Big South Freshman of the Week Awards in 2017, the first on April 24. 2017 and the second on May 15.
- In the week starting 4/17/17, Tucker four RBI, and stole three bases.
- homer to lead off the bottom of the ninth inning in Longwood's walk-off win against Winthrop.
- In the week beginning 5/8 Tucker hit .400 with a 1.038 OPS and six runs

#### PLACE YOUR WAGER!

- Cody Wager was a two-time winner of the Big South Pitcher of the Week award in 2017, leading the Lancer pitching staff in 2017. Wager won his first of the season on March 20, 2017, and the second on April 17, 2017.
- Wager went the distance, spinning a complete game and picking up the win in Longwood's 2-1 walk-off victory. Wager struck out a career-high 13 batters and retired the final 11 hitters of the game. Wager did not allow an earned run.
- On 3/18/17 against Charleston Southern, Wager came within four outs of a no-hitter, striking out 10 batters in 8.1 innings of three-hit, shutout ball.

#### **OLD SCHOOL**

- · Longwood lost seven seniors in 2017: James Barry, Devin Gould. Brandon Harvell, Alex Lewis, Luke Simpson, Cody Wager, and Tyler Wirsu.
- James Barry appeared in 41 games as a two-year player at Longwood. The Blinn College transfer picked up a clutch pinch-hit infield single in the ninth inning to spark a four-run March 30, 2016.
- Devin Gould posted career highs with 50.2 innings pitched, 54 strikeouts, and 20 appearances in 2017. Gould finished his career with 164 strikeouts in 153.2 innings pitched and a .250 batting average against.

### **OLD SCHOOL (CONT.)**

- Brandon Harvell finished his career with a school record 210 games played and 203 starts. In 2017 he played in and started all 53 games, hitting a careerbest .258 in his final season with 22 RBI, four doubles, two triples, and two home runs. Harvell tied his career high with four hits in his final game, going 4-for-5 with two runs scored, one triple, and one RBI at Campbell on May 5, 2017.
- Alex Lewis finished his career as one of the top hitters in Longwood history, surpassing the 200-hit mark in four years with a career .281 average, 205 hits, and 101 RBI. Lewis was selected to the All-Big South Preseason Team by Perfect Game after an incredible 2016. Lewis was selected to the All-Big South Second Team, 2016 Big South All-Tournament Team, 2016 ABCA Division-I East All-Region First Team, and 2016 VaSID All-State First Team after hitting .369 with 45 RBI, 22 doubles, and a schol-record 86 hits.
- Luke Simpson left Longwood after a four-year career, tossing 132.2 innings in his four years. Simpson made 13 appearances out of the bullpen in his senior season.
- Cody Wager put together his best collegiate season in 2017, his second year with the program after transferring to Longwood from Pensacola State Community College. Wager was selected to the All-Big South Second Team after leading the Big South in strikeouts with 91 punchouts. Wager made 14 appearances with 13 starts and was the primary Friday night starter, finishing the season with two complete games. Wager finished with a 3.54 ERA and spun 76.1 innings, finishing with a .253 batting average against. Wager became Longwood's first-ever two-time Big South Pitcher of the Week honoree.
- Tyler Wirsu completed his second and final season at Longwood in 2017 after making 15 appearances with six starts and struck out 32 batters in 33.2 innings of work. Wirsu made four scoreless outings and two hitless appearances and putting together one quality start.

#### **#WINNING**

- Sophomores Nate Blakeney, Tyler Morgan, John Gregory, and Joey Mendez all won state championships in 2016, their senior seasons in high school.
- Blakeney led Wesleyan Christian Academy (High Point, N.C.) to the NCISAA 3-A State Championship with a 2-for-3 game and grand slam in the title game. Blakeney was an all-area first team selection by the Greensboro News & Record.
- Morgan picked up the save in Hanover's (Mechanicsburg, Va.) 13-12 title game win to clinch the Virginia 4A State Championship.
- Gregory, Morgan's teammate at Hanover, went 2-for-4 with an RBI in the title game and was an all-conference first team selection in the regular season.
- Mendez, an all-state preseason selection at Riverdale Baptist (Upper Marlboro, Md.), led the team to its second consecutive NACA Division I Championship.

#### **BREAKING RECORDS**

- Longwood had a number of records set in 2016, winning 32 games, 14 in conference, and 21 at home, all the most since Longwood became a fulltime Division I participant in 2008.
   Longwood's second-place finish is the best since joining the Big South in 2013.
- Alex Lewis set the record for hits in a season (86) in 2016.
- As a team Longwood set the singleseason school records for hits (540) and fielding percentage (.966) in 2016.
- In 2017 Longwood set the school record with strikeouts, punching out 511 batters for the year.

#### **KEEPING UP WITH LONGWOOD**

• Longwood will play select home and road games on the Big South Network in 2018. Four regular season games and the entire conference tournament will be on radio on WVHL 92.9 FM Farmville, with third-year play-by-play man Darius Thigpen calling the action.

#### WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

- Former Lancer stars right-handed pitcher Aaron Myers, outfielder Kyri Washington, and Michael Osinski each left their marks on the Longwood baseball program with Osinski leading the 2017 team in hitting, Washington leading the Big South in home runs in 2015, and Myers setting the Longwood school records in strikeouts, saves, and innings pitched. Each player has moved on to play professional baseball, where they join former Lancer arm, right-handed pitcher Mark Montgomery.
- Myers was promoted prior to the start of the season and begins 2017 with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, the Class A (Low-A) affiliate of the Brewers.
- Myers is in his third season in the organization after signing as a nondrafted free agent in 2015. Myers pitched with the Rookie League AZL Brewers in 2015 and posted a 1.74 ERA in seven appearances out of the bullpen and picked up three saves in three opportunities with 14 strikeouts and no walks across 10.1 innings of work. In 2016 Myers went 4-1 with a 1.44 ERA across 43.2 innings pitched with 55 strikeouts to 11 walks. The right-hander began with the AZL Brewers and was called up to the Helena Brewers of the Pioneer League, where he spent the majority of his season. With the Helena Brewers Myers went 3-1 in 11 appearances with a 1.38 ERA and struck out 44 batters with seven walks in 32.2 innings pitched.
- The Newport News, Va., native finished his Longwood career with a 2.93 ERA across 338.0 career innings with 319 strikeouts to just 113 walks.
- Washington, the number 22 prospect in the Red Sox system according to MLB Pipeline, was promoted to the Class A Advanced Salem Red Sox before the start of the season and sits

one level below Double-A.

- Washington only played three years at Longwood, but made a strong impact and was drafted by the Boston Red Sox in the 23rd round of the 2015 draft. Washington began his pro career in Rookie Ball with the GCL Red Sox before making it to Short Season A-Ball with the Lowell Spinners. Between the two levels Washington hit .263 with nine doubles, one triple, 22 RBI, and his first professional home run in 2015.
- In 2016 Washington had massive success with the Greenville Drive of the South Atlantic League, where he spent the entire season. Washington was voted Greenville Drive player of the year after hitting .262 with 16 home runs, 45 extra-base hits, and 73 RBI in 103 games played. In his first full professional season Washington ended the season with a .487 slugging percentage and .810 OPS.
- The Prospect, Va., native hit .263 with 28 career home runs, 44 doubles, two triples and 123 career RBI for the Blue & White.
- Montgomery signed a minor league deal with the St. Louis Cardinals April 3 and begins the season in Triple-A with the Memphis Redbirds.
- Montgomery, a native of Williamsburg, Va., spent his first six years in the New York Yankees organization after the Yankees took him in the 11th round of the 2011 draft. Montgomery posted a 2.56 ERA in 33 appearances, all out of the bullpen, between Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Double-A Trenton in 2016 and owns a career 2.33 ERA. Montgomery struck out 63 batters with 22 walks in 45.2 innings of work in 2016 and was a part of the Triple-A Champion Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders.
- Osinski was drafted by the Boston Red Sox in 2017, Boston's 31st-round pick in the June First-Year Player Draft. After just three games in the Gulf Coast League, the rookie received his first professional advancement on July 2.
- Osinski was a consistent player at Longwood, hitting .298 in three seasons, playing 163 games with 161 starts as the everyday shortstop for the Lancers. Osinski made the 2016 Big South All-Tournament team and was

selected to Perfect Game's 2017 All-Big South Preseason Team. Osinski led Longwood with a .308 batting average, 14 doubles, and 36 RBI in his junior season.

In his first professional season,
 Osinski hit .259 in 44 games with 11 extra-base hits and 14 RBI. Osinski was a .261 hitter with Lowell after becoming an everyday player in the New York-Penn League.
