#### **INSIDE THE WEEKEND**

**HPU vs Longwood:** The Panthers open up conference play with a three-game series against Longwood in Farmville, Va. This is the third straight season in which High Point has opened up the Big South slate away from Williard Stadium. Both teams dropped mid-week contests entering this weekend set.

**History vs. Longwood:** HPU is 12-7 all-time against the Lancers, but are making their first trek to Farmville since 2015. High Point is 7-1 all-time at Buddy Bolding Stadium, taking two of three in 2015 and sweeping the series in 2014.

The Panthers and Lancers did not meet last season and split four games against each other in 2016. HPU won two of three in the regular season but LU claimed a game in the conference tournament, 18-13. High Point has not dropped a series to Longwood since losing two of three in 2013.

**The Lancers:** Longwood comes in with a 5-10 mark on the campaign and have won a pair of home weekend series against Niagara and Iona. The Lancers were projected to finish 10th in the Big South preseason poll.

Longwood has struggled on the offensive end, ranking 9th in the league in average (.224) and runs per game (3.6) and last in hits (109). Additionally, LU is last in the league in team ERA (7.41). However, the Lancers pitching staff has found strikeouts to be their forte, ranking 19th in the NCAA in K/9 (10.4)

#### PROBABLE PITCHERS

• **Friday:** High Point goes with a different weekend rotation for the first time this season with southpaw Jordan Sergent earning the Friday night nod. In his last two starts, Sergent has allowed only four earned runs in 11 innings (3.27 ERA) and is coming off a career high six strikeouts last Friday against Ohio State.

The Lancers will counter with Steven Farkas, who is coming off his best outing of the season. Last Friday against lona, the southpaw went six scoreless and struck out 12 in a no-decision.

• **Saturday:** Senior Andrew Gottfried bumps up to the Saturday start in search of his second straight win. Last Saturday against Ohio State, Gottfried struck out the last five hitters he faced in his five-inning outing, striking out six overall in the 8-4 triumph.

Cody Boydstun gets the ball for the Lancers on Saturday after a complete game performance against lona last week. In his first win of the year, Boydstun limited lona to two runs on three his with six strikeouts in an 11-2 victory.

• **Sunday:** Junior Cooper Jeffers gets his first start of the year and 10th of his career following an award-winning relief appearance last week. Jeffers was named the Big South Relief Pitcher of the Week after throwing 4.1 scoreless innings in the comeback win over No. 21 Coastal Carolina on Sunday.

The Lancers have yet to announce a starter for Sunday.

The Last One: High Point dropped its mid-week contest to Ohio, 11-7, on a windy Wednesday afternoon. The Bobcats launched five home runs and used a pair of five-run innings to pick up the victory. Junior JJ Woodard and senior Jordan Sergent blasted their first home runs of the year.

For Openers: HPU looks to get back to its winning ways in conference play, where the Panthers have posted five straight campaigns above .500. Last season, High Point dropped two of three to begin the conference year at Liberty, the first time since 2013 that HPU was not victorious in its first conference series.

**Crown 'Em:** The Panthers claimed the Environmental Staffing Chanticleer Classic with a 3-1 record against Ohio State and #21 Coastal Carolina last weekend. HPU dropped the opening game to Ohio State (8-6) on Friday before rebounding with victories over the Chanticleers (8-5, 3-2) and the Buckeyes (8-4). All three wins for High Point were comeback triumphs.

Senior Hunter Lee led the offense with eight hits and collected the game-winning RBI's in both wins over Coastal. All five RBI's from the senior came in the eighth inning or later. Seniors **Carson** Jackson and Blake Schunk and freshman Tanner Wells all posted seven hits in the four games.

On the mound, HPU got great relief performances from freshman Jacob Kates, redshirt-junior Jonny Vizcaino, and junior Cooper Jeffers, among others. Kates gave up just one run in four innings on Friday against Ohio State, Vizcaino earned the victory Friday evening by allowing only one unearned run in 3.1 frames, and Jeffers capped off the weekend with 4.1 scoreless innings while picking up the win over Coastal Carolina.

Players of the Week: High Point earned its first weekly conference honors on Monday with junior Cooper Jeffers being named the Big South Relief Pitcher of the Week and freshman **Tanner Wells** garnering Freshman of the Week.

Jeffers coaxed a pair of double plays and picked off two runners in his 4.1 innings of scoreless relief against Coastal Carolina. Its the first honor of his career. Wells picked up one RBI in each of the four games, going 7-for-17 with his first career homer on Sunday against Coastal Carolina, tying the game in the fourth inning.

The Bats Awaken: After a slow start in the opening weekend against JMU (.182 team average), High Point's offense has clicked on all cylinders for the most part. HPU has a team average of .284 in the last 13 games and has posted double-digit hits nine times, including four of the last five. The Panthers are second in the league in batting average (.266) and third in runs per game (5.8).

Lean on Lee: Senior Hunter Lee enters the weekend on a team season-best eight-game hitting streak. During the stretch, Lee is 12-for-33 (.364) with four multi-hit games and 10 RBI. Last or later with two being game-winning RBI.

Comeback Kings: High Point used three straight comebacks to post a 3-1 record last weekend. Overall, six of the Panthers eight wins have come in comeback fashion, including overcoming a pair of four-run deficits. Through 16 games, HPU has scored the first run in only two contests.

**Let's Play Two!:** Last Friday's twin-bill marked the fourth straight weekend High Point played a doubleheader to open its season. HPU was swept in a double-dip by JMU, took both games from Dayton, and has split the last two at William & Mary and against Ohio State/Coastal.

I'll Take This Thank You: The Panthers stole one base on Wednesday, increasing their season-long total to 22, the secondmost in the league. The Purple & White rank 43rd in the NCAA with their 23 steals in 16 games. Senior Austen Zente is tied for fourth in the league with six swipes.

Sit Down, Be Humble: Through 16 games, HPU's pitching staff has held its opponents to a .242 batting average, the best in the Big South by three points (Campbell, .245). Panther pitchers have allowed the fewest amount of hits (128) and struck out 167 batters in 16 games, the third-most in the conference.

HPU tied a school record with 17 punchouts against W&M on Mar. 3, the most for any Big South staff in a single game this year. Panther pitchers have accounted for the two highest single-game strikeout totals in the league, having also K'd 15 vs JMU on Feb. 18.

Junior Andrew Gottfried and sophomore Drew Daczkowski enter the weekend fourth and fifth, respectively, in the Big South in strikeouts. Both are among the nation's top 35 in K/9 (Daczkowski, 26th & Gottfried, 33rd)

**Bouncing Back:** High Point responded from getting swept in the first weekend of the season by sweeping Dayton at Williard Stadium from Feb. 23-24. It was the first home non-conference sweep for HPU since 3/11-13/2016 vs. Rider.

RISP-y Business: HPU has had little problem putting runners on base this season, but has struggled at times getting them home. The Panthers have had more at-bats with runners on base (288) than with no one on (269), including 188 at-bats with runners in scoring position. However, HPU is hitting only .245 (48-for-188) in those situations and has stranded 149 runners in 16 games.

Millwee's Big Week: Redshirt-junior Daniel Millwee took advantage of his first career start with four RBI on Feb. 21 at North Carolina A&T, the most for a Panther in that situation since JJ **Woodard** drove in four against UNCG on Feb. 21, 2016, exactly two years prior. Millwee then added seven RBI in his next two games to complete a three-game stretch where he was 6-for-9 with two doubles, two home runs, five runs scored, and 11 RBI.

Immediate Impact: Freshman Travis Holt saw himself inserted into the Panthers lineup for all three games of the opening series and made a difference in game one. Holt went 2-for-3 with a sac bunt in the opener, becoming the first HPU freshman to collect a multi-hit game in the season opener since Carson Jackson's fourhit outburst in 2015. Holt, a natural middle infielder, has now hit weekend, Lee collected five all RBI, all coming in the eighth inning safely in 10 of the first 16 games in his career. He recorded his first career three-hit game on Saturday against Ohio State.

> Murrah Picks Up Where He Left Off: Senior righthander **Rion Murrah** saw his streak of 28.1 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run snapped on Friday against Ohio State. He had not allowed an earned run in any of his previous 13 appearances since April 1, 2017 vs Gardner-Webb.

About Last Year: High Point posted its fourth straight winning campaign and fifth overall since moving to Div. I in the 2000 seasons. The Panthers finished 30-23 and 13-11 in the Big South, good for fourth in the league. HPU started out 1-5 in conference play before rattling off five straight league series victories, a span where the Purple & White went 11-4.

Panthers Picked Third: High Point was projected to finish third in the Big South standings this season. The Panthers were one of four teams to receive a first place vote in the crowded top half of the league that was separated by just 19 points. Defending regular season champion Winthrop was picked to repeat, followed by Liberty, HPU, and defending tournament champ Radford.

**Returning Depth:** The Panthers head into 2018 with a majority of last year's team in tact. HPU returns seven of its nine regulars in the starting lineup, tied for the most in the Big South. The Purple & White bring back 69 percent of games played and 75 percent of their starts in the lineup from a year ago. The numbers are similar for the pitching staff, with 75 percent of the innings pitched returning to the team. A combined 78 percent of the total appearances and 68 percent of games started come back.

**Up Next:** High Point stays on the road for a mid-week contest against NC Central in Durham, N.C. next Friday. First pitch is scheduled for 6 p.m. The Panthers then host Radford next weekend in the Big South home opening series.

# **HEAD COACH CRAIG COZART**

10th Season | Alma Mater: Central Florida '96

The 2018 season is head coach Craig Cozart's 10th at the helm of the High Point University baseball team. Cozart has a reputation for recruiting and developing pitching staffs. He has had 32 pitchers selected in the Major League Baseball draft under his guidance, including former Panther and current Cleveland Indian closer Cody Allen, who was drafted in 2011.

Cozart was named High Point baseball's fifth head coach in June 2008 and has led HPU to program records in wins and nearly every offensive category. He has helped guide the Panthers to their four-winningest seasons in the program's Div. I history and currently holds the HPU Div. I records for overall wins and conference wins. He has coached the team to its only six .500 or better seasons, including each of the last five.

With a great eye for talent and an outstanding ability to develop pitchers, 38 of Cozart's pitchers have signed professional contracts. Eleven players have been drafted to MLB in Cozart's nine years at HPU, headlined by an HPU-record four Panthers that were drafted in 2013.

HPU won 30 games in consecutive seasons for the first time in the Div. I era by finishing 30-23 in 2017. The Panthers won five consecutive conference series during the course of the year, compiling an 11-4 conference mark through the five-weekend stretch.
