SERIES PREVIEW

- Campbell (20-17, 12-3 Big South) most recently fell in the midweek at Elon, 11-1. Junior first baseman **Zach Minnick** accounted for CU's only run with a solo shot, good for his fifth homer and 19th RBI of the season.
- Senior infielder Christian Jones continues to lead the Big South with 11 homers and 41 RBI on the season.
- Redshirt-sophomore outfielder **Matthew Barefoot** tops the Camels in batting average (.326), hits (42), doubles (8), on-base percentage (.470), steals (22) and HBP (14). His 22 steals rank ninth in all of NCAA Division I, while the 14 HBP rank 13th in the country.
- Campbell's pitching unit owns the best ERA in the Big South at 4.46. The Camels also lead the league in opposing batting average (.242) and strikeouts (354). CU right-handers **Allan Winans** (2.78) and **Michael Horrell** (3.09) rank second and fourth in ERA among the conference's starting pitchers.
- Longwood (13-22, 6-9 Big South) ranks seventh in the current Big South standings. The Lancers fell to James Madison 5-10 in midweek after sweeping Big South foe UNC Asheville in a three-game set last weekend.
- Right-handed pitcher **Tyler Morgan** projected to start Sunday is the reigning Big South Starting Pitcher of the Week. The sophomore from Ashland, Va. tossed a complete game shutout to complete Longwood's sweep over UNC Asheville, dealing 13 strikeouts while allowing just three hits and two walks.
- The Lancers rank last in the league as a team in batting average (.229), but have had three players hit above .300 in the month of April. **Sammy Miller** (.424), **Grant Keller** (.320) and **Ryan Shull** (.306) have helped pick up the slack for Longwood over the last 10 games.

CAMELS GO K-LESS AT ELON

- Campbell's piching staff came up empty in the strikeout column in Tuesday's 11-1 loss at Elon.
- It was the first time the Camels went without a K since March 5, 2015 in a 9-4 win at East Carolina.

CAMELS SWEEP PC, RECLAIM TOP SPOT IN BSC

- Campbell most recently swept the Presbyterian Blue Hose in a three-game conference road series, moving its record in conference action to a Big South-leading 12-3 this season.
- The Camels took the series opener 6-3 in 10 innings for CU's first extra-inning win of the season. Freshman DH **Ty Babin** came off the bench and hit two RBI singles, including a knock to left center that put CU up 4-3 in the top of the 10th.
- Campbell swept a doubleheader to complete the three-game sweep of the Blue Hose, earning two come-from-behind victories Saturday afternoon.
- Senior infielder **Christian Jones** cranked a goahead two-run blast in the first game of the DH, notching his 39th and 40th RBI of the season.
- The Camels erased a three-run deficit in the series finale, scoring four runs on six hits in the top of the eighth on the way to a 4-3 victory. **Luis Gimenez**, **Ty Babin**, **Christian Jones** and **Zach Minnick** posted RBI singles as Campbell completed the sweep over PC.
- It was CU's third sweep in conference play this year. Campbell won all three games at Charleston Southern to open the Big South slate (3/16-18) before claiming three-straight at home against Gardner-Webb (3/23-25).

JENKINS DEAL 10 K'S AT PRESBYTERIAN

• Freshman right-hander Brandon Jenkins tallied a career-high 10 strikeouts in Saturday's series final at Presbyterian. Additionally, the Glendora, N.J. native tossed 6.0 innings with one earned run for his second quality start of the season.

BAREFOOT'S LEADOFF DINGER FIRST FOR CU SINCE 2012

- Redshirt-sophomore **Matthew Barefoot** launched a leadoff homer in Campbell's 7-6 win against Presbyterian on April 14, good for his second of the season and 10th as a Camel.
- It was the first leadoff home run by a Campbell player since March 5, 2012, when Jimmy Brenneman cranked a homer in an 8-0 win against Holy Cross.

HAIRE JOINS CENTURY CLUB AT N.C. CENTRAL

- Head coach **Justin Haire** earned his 100th win at the helm of the Campbell baseball program as the Fighting Camels defeated the N.C. Central Eagles 3-1 on Tuesday, April 10.
- The Campbell skipper joins **Greg Goff** (224 wins, 2008-14), **Chip Smith** (267 wins, 1996-2006) and **Cal Koonce** (174 wins, 1980-86) as the only head coaches in program history to reach triple-digit wins with the Camels.

"JOHNNY WHOLESTAFF" RACKS UP 15 K'S AT NCCU

- 11 Campbell pitchers combined for 15 strikeouts and just one earned run as CU defeated N.C. Central 3-1 on Tuesday, April 10.
- Eight of those 11 recorded at least one K on the night, including **Matthew Barefoot** (2), **Jordan Montgomery** (1), **Wyatt Tyson** (1), **Logan Bender** (2), **Harry Thomas** (4), **Logan Heintzman** (2), **Phil Simpson** (10) and **Tyson Messer** (2).
- Campbell is one of three NCAA Division I programs to have eight pitchers record at least one strikeout in a single game this season. Western Kentucky (2/20 vs. Belmont) and SIUE (4/11 vs. Western Illinois) are the other two teams to accomplish the feat.

PITCHING CAMELS ON PACE FOR RECORD-BREAKING SEASON

- Through 37 games in 2018, the Campbell pitching staff has totaled a Big South-leading 354 strikeouts.
- With a minimum of 19 games remaining (17 reg. season, 2 conf. tournament), CU is on pace for 536 K's that would shatter the Campbell record of 432 set in 2012.
- Campbell's current rate of 9.57 K's per nine innings would also break the school record of 8.24 set in 2000.

- Right-handed pitcher **Logan Bender** has been named the Big South Freshman of the Week, as announced by the conference office Monday afternoon (3/19).
- The redshirt-freshman from Dunn, N.C. made three appearances for the Camels over five games, tossing 4.2 scoreless frames of relief and allowing just one hit. Bender totaled eight strikeouts to just one walk on the week.

- Bender helped the Camels to a combined shutout against Rider on March 13, pitching one hitless, scoreless inning with two strikeouts.
- At Charleston Southern, Bender fanned five of six batters faced over 2.0 scoreless relief innings in the series opener. In Sunday's series finale, he held the Bucs scoreless for 1.2 innings as Campbell took the lead to notch his second win of the season.

CAMEL OFFENSE EXPLODES SATURDAY AT CSU (3/17)

- In an 18-2 victory at Charleston Southern, Campbell set season-highs in at-bats (48), runs scored (18), hits (21), RBI (18), doubles (5), home runs (6) and total bases (44).

WINANS, CAMELS DEAL BRONCS 17 K'S, NO WALKS

- Campbell's pitching staff posted one of its best performances in more than a decade against Rider (3/13). **Allan Winans, Alex Yarem, Logan Bender** and **Tyson Messer** combined for 17 strikeouts, no walks and no runs allowed as Campbell won 9-0.
- Winans totaled a career-high 12 K's over
 6.0 innings, the most by a Camel since
 Heath Bowers set the school record with 15 strikeouts against Bowling Green on March
 2015.
- Yarem collected one strikeout, while Bender and Messer posted two apiece.
 All three faced the minimum across 1.0 innings of relief.
- The 17 strikeouts were the most in a single game for Campbell since at least 2002. It was the first time Camels did not allow a walk since April 17, 2016, when Michael Horrell went walkless in a complete-game effort against Liberty.

HORRELL CLAIMS SECOND BSC WEEKLY HONOR (3/12)

- For the second time this season, junior right-hander Michael Horrell has been named the Big South Starting Pitcher of the Week, as announced by the conference office Monday afternoon.
- Horrell pitched 6.0 scoreless innings against the William & Mary Tribe, leading the Camels to their first combined shutout of the season as CU won 12-0. A native of Thomasville, N.C., Horrell collected six strikeouts and allowed just four hits on the way to his second quality start of the season.

JONES, BABIN GARNER BIG SOUTH WEEKLY HONORS (3/5)

- Senior infielder Christian Jones was selected as the Big South Player of the Week, while freshman catcher Ty Babin received Big South Freshman of the Week honors.
- Jones finished the week hitting 6-for-16

- (.375), crushing his first two home runs of the season in back-to-back games against Canisius and No. 10 NC State.
- The Jacksonville, Fla. native slugged a team-high .813 while posting a .474 on-base percentage over the last four games. Jones totaled eight RBI on the week, including a career-high tying four against Pepperdine and three against Canisius.
- Babin drove in a team-leading nine runs for the week, including a six-RBI performance in Campbell's 17-3 win over Bowling Green.
- The freshman from Jackson, N.J. went 3-for-4 against the Falcons with a two-RBI single, an RBI-groundout and a bases-clearing triple. Babin also knocked a two-RBI single against Canisius and drew an RBI-walk against Pepperdine earlier in the week.

HORRELL TABBED BSC STARTING PITCHER OF THE WEEK (2/26)

- Campbell junior Michael Horrell has been named the Big South Starting Pitcher of the Week, as announced by the conference office Monday afternoon.
- The Thomasville, N.C. native pitched a gem for the Fighting Camels Saturday, Feb. 24 as CU defeated Western Michigan 5-1. The righty dealt a career-high 10 strikeouts with no walks, allowing just four hits over 7.0 scoreless innings of work to earn his first win of the season.
- Horrell's 10 K's were the most by a Campbell pitcher since April 15, 2016 when Nick Thayer fanned 10 batters against Liberty. Horrell is one of three pitchers in the Big South to reach double-digit strikeouts in a single game this season, and the only one to accomplish the feat without allowing a walk or a run.
