THE OPENING TIP

- Coming off its best non-conference performance of the Division I era, Longwood opens its seventh Big South slate Saturday against Commonwealth rival Radford in Radford, Va.
- The Lancers went 5-3 in November and 5-2 in December en route to reaching 10 wins faster than any team in the program's 15-year Division I history. The last time Longwood won 10 games before the start of conference play came in 2000-01 when the Lancers were part of the Division II CVAC.
- Saturday's game will mark the Big South debut for Longwood head coach **Griff Aldrich**, who led the Lancers to a 10-5 non-conference record that secured the Lancers' best non-conference winning percentage since making the jump to the Division I level in 2004-05.
- With Liberty's exit from the Big South in July, Radford is Longwood's closest conference foe with just 140 road miles separating the two campuses.

LAST TIME OUT

- Backed by a near triple-double from **Shabooty Phillips** and a season-high 29 points from **Isaiah Walton**, Longwood punctuated a historic 2018 with yet another milestone, reaching 10 wins faster than any team in the program's Division I era with a 110-94 takedown of The Citadel Saturday afternoon at McAlister Fieldhouse.
- Phillips finished with 23 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists, while Walton's 29 points sparked a season-best 57-point effort from Longwood's bench.
- The Citadel entered the matchup as the nation's highest-scoring team, but Longwood snapped the Bulldogs' seven-game winning streak and hand them their first home loss of the season.
- The 110 points marked Longwood's highest-scoring game since Dec. 12, 2011 when the Lancers routed VMI 110-89 in their final year as a Division I Independent.

LONGWOOD BASKETBALL COACH'S SHOW

The Longwood men's basketball coach's show, titled "Griff Aldrich Live at Effingham's" airs monthly at LongwoodLancers.com and re-airs 24 hours later on WVHL Kickin' Country 92.9 FM. The hour-long show takes place in front of a live audience at Effingham's, located in Hotel Weyanoke on High Street right across from Longwood's campus.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Longwood is 5-0 this season and 11-8 all-time when **Isaiah Walton** scores at least 20 points. Walton has scored at least 20 points in five of his seven games this season.
- After scoring a season-high 29 points at The Citadel a week ago, Walton is just 33 points away from becoming the 22nd 1,000-point scorer in program history. Originally a transfer from UC Davis and Iowa Western, he has done so in just three seasons at Longwood and would be only the seventh player in Longwood's 15-year Division I era to reach that mark.
- Longwood ranks second in the Big South in both percent of field goal attempts from three-point range (50.1 percent) and percent of made field goals from three-point range (41.3 percent).
- Longwood's bench has contributed 24.8 points per game, or 35.2 percent of Longwood's total scoring.
- Of Longwood's 46 double-digit scoring games this season, 13 have come from players off the bench. Guards **Seán Flood** and **Juan Munoz** have both scored in double figures three times off the bench.
- At 10-5 heading into Saturday's Big South opener, Longwood is one of only two 10-win teams in the Big South.
- Longwood is one of five teams in Virginia with double-digit wins, joining Virginia (12-0), Virginia Tech (12-1), Liberty (11-4) and Old Dominion (10-4).
- Longwood's 10-5 start is the program's first winning non-conference record since joining the Big South in 2012-13. In Longwood's 15-year Division I era, only the 2008-09 Lancers, who went 17-14 as a Division I independent, finished above .500 in non-conference play prior to 2018-19.
- Of the 18 new head Division I coaches who inherited teams that won single-digit games last year, only Aldrich and Pitt's Jeff Capel (10-3) have winning percentages above .500.

- Longwood and Radford meet for the 30th time in series history Saturday in Radford, Va.
- Radford is Longwood's longest-running Big South rival, having begun the series in the Longwood program's second year of existence during the 1977-78 season.
- Radford ended Longwood's season in 2017-18, pulling away from the Lancers in the final minute of the Big South quarterfinal en route to a 59-53 win. The game was tied 53-53 before Donald Hicks hit a go-ahead three-pointer with 34 seconds remaining.

RECORD-BREAKING START

- Longwood is off to its best start of the Division I era under first-year head coach **Griff Aldrich**, wrapping up a program-record 10-5 non-conference record following the 110-94 win at The Citadel in the non-conference finale.
- With 10 wins through 15 games, the 2018-19 Lancers are the quickest to reach double-digit wins since the 2000-01 team opened the year 10-1 en route to a 23-8 final record.
- In the 10 prior seasons that Longwood won at least 10 of its first 15 games, the Lancers finished above .500 nine times.
- Longwood started the season 4-0, the third-longest winning streak to start a season, trailing only the 12-0 start in 1979-80 and the 7-0 start in 2000-01.

NEW COACH ON THE BLOCK

- At 10-5, **Griff Aldrich** ranks eighth in winning percentage among the 55 newly hired Division I head coaches in 2018-19.
- Aldrich and Pitt's Jeff Capel are the only newly hired head coaches who are above .500 after inheriting teams that won single-digit games a year ago. Longwood went 7-26 during the 2017-18 season and 6-24 in 2016-17.
- Aldrich's 10-5 start is the third best by a first-year Longwood head coach, trailing only the 11-4 start by Cal Luther in 1981-82 and matching the 10-5 start by Dr. Ron Bash in 1978-79.
- Aldrich led Longwood to its best non-conference record since joining the Big South in 2012-13 and only the second winning non-conference record in the program's 15 Division I era. The 2018-19 Lancers, who went 17-14 as a Division I Independent, are the only other Division I Lancer team to post a winning record against non-conference teams.

EMPHASIS ON DEFENSE

- Key to Longwood's 10-5 start has been a stifling defense built on preventing easy layups, forcing teams to settle for contested three-pointers, and defensive rebounding.
- That strategy has propelled Longwood to the top of the Big South leaderboards in opponent scoring average and opponent field goal percentage, rebound margin and defensive rebound percentage.
- Longwood has held eight of its first 15 opponents under 40.0 percent shooting from the field.
- Only five teams — Delaware State, Seattle, Duquesne, Cornell and The Citadel — have managed to score at least 70 points against Longwood.
- Longwood has protected its own paint, allowing just eight dunks this season and outrebounding opponents by a Big South-leading +4.9 rebounds per game.
- The Lancers have outrebounded 11 of 15 opponents this season.
- The Lancers grab an average of 76.4 percent of rebounds on their defensive glass, the highest clip in the Big South.
- Three of the Big South's top 15 defensive rebounders are Lancers, including the No. 2 ranked player on that list, guard **Shaboody Phillips** (5.5 drpg.).

- Isaiah Walton is on pace to become one of the most prolific scorers of Longwood's Division I era.
- In just three seasons as a Lancer, the 6-5, 185-pound guard is closing in on 1,000 career points and would become the 22nd player in school history — and seventh in the Division I era — to reach that benchmark.
- After leading Longwood in scoring in 2017-18, Walton is averaging a team-high 18.6 points per game this season.
- Walton has scored at least 20 points in five of his seven games this season, leading Longwood to a 5-0 record in those outbursts. Longwood is 11-8 all-time when Walton scores at least 20 points.
- Walton's scoring has been balanced, with 46.5 percent coming on two-point field goals, 32.9 percent on threes and 20.6 percent on free throws.

PHILLIPS EMERGES AS ONE OF BIG SOUTH'S TOP NEWCOMERS

- Lorenzo “Shabooty” Phillips has made a splash in his first season at Longwood, averaging 14.2 points per game while ranking among the Big South's top 10 in assists, rebounding, free throw percentage, assist-to-turnover ratio, made three-pointers per game, defensive rebounds and minutes played.
- Of Phillips' 59 assists this season, 45 have come on Longwood three-pointers. Including those assists and his team-high 36 treys, 54.7 percent of Longwood's treys have gone through Phillips.
- Phillips is among the Big South's top rebounding guards, ranking second in the conference with 5.5 defensive rebounds per game and fourth among league guards with 5.9 boards per game.

SMITH FULFILLING POTENTIAL IN JUNIOR SEASON

- Junior wing **JaShaun Smith** is off to the best start of his collegiate career in 2018-19, averaging career highs in nearly every offensive category, including scoring (10.9 ppg.), field goal percentage (.496) and made three-pointers per game (1.5).
- One of the most athletic players in the country, Smith boasts a 49-inch max vertical leap and has scored in double figures 10 times in his first 15 games this season. He scored in double digits just 14 times in the first 62 games of his career.
- Smith is a career .382 (66-of-173) shooter from three-point range, which would rank first on Longwood's all-time Division I list.

OKAFOR MAKES A SPLASH

- Freshman **Gus Okafor** made a splash in his Longwood debut, knocking down four three-pointers en route to 14 points in the 84-56 win over Randolph.
- Okafor's 14 points were the second most on the team in the season opener, behind only **Isaiah Walton**'s 20, and the most in a season-opening debut by a Longwood freshman since Ryan Badowski scored 21 against Averett on Nov. 4, 2014.
- Okafor hit 4-of-7 shots from three-point range and 5-of-8 from the field overall while adding five rebounds, a block and two steals in just 22 minutes.

POINT GUARD FLOOD BRINGS INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE

- New point guard **Seán Flood**, a transfer from Santa Fe College, brings extensive playing experience at the international level, having played with the Irish National Team as a member of the program's 16U, 18U, 20U and Senior Team levels.
- A native of Dublin, Ireland, Flood captained the Irish National Team's 16U, 18U and 20U squads and led the Templeogue Basketball Club to four National Cup Championships. He was named MVP of the 18U National Cup and Superleague Rookie of the Year in 2015-16.
- Flood has made an immediate impact, averaging 7.6 points and 2.4 assists per game while amassing a 1.6 assist-to-turnover ratio. He has scored in double figures five times, including a 21-point outburst against Stetson, and has hit at least one three-pointer in seven consecutive games.
- Flood comes to Longwood after a breakout sophomore campaign at Santa Fe College, during which he averaged 7.7 points, 3.0 assists, and 1.2 steals per game. He shot .533 (32-of-60) from three-point range and .576 (57-of-99) from the floor as Santa Fe went 21-11 overall. Santa Fe went 16-7 with him in the lineup and 5-4 in nine games without.

ASSISTANT COACH MCGILLAN RETURNS TO BIG SOUTH

- Longwood assistant coach **Marty McGillan** returned to the Big South as a member of head coach **Griff Aldrich**'s first staff, coming back to a conference in which he won three titles as a member of Winthrop's staff from 2007-11 and 2012-17.
- As an assistant coach for those nine seasons with the Eagles, McGillan helped Winthrop to a 96-58 record in Big South play and reach the Big South Championship game six times, including 2017 when the Eagles finished 26-7 with a 15-3 record.
- A 28-year coaching veteran, McGillan has helped five different teams reach the NCAA Tournament a total of eight times. Seven of those eight trips came at the mid-major level, including at East Carolina, UNC Wilmington, Winthrop and Wright State.
- McGillan also has seven conference championship rings, winning titles in the Big South, Horizon League and Colonial Athletic Association.
- McGillan is 464-370 (.556) as an assistant coach at the Division I level. The past 17 years of his 28-year coaching career have produced a 310-213 (.593) record with 12 winning seasons.
- In his past four seasons in the Big South — all at Winthrop — McGillan has reached the Big South Championship game every time, winning in 2017 and finishing as runner-up in 2014, 2015 and 2016.

On and off the basketball court, the career of new Longwood men's basketball coach Griff Aldrich has been marked by two constants: a passion for transforming lives, and success at every step.

Standout prep and college player. Partner in a top-tier international law firm, and CFO of an investment company. High-level AAU coach who helped develop players including NBA and NFL standouts, and community leader who founded an elite, faith-based basketball program for at-risk youth.

The most recent stop: leaving the business world to follow his passion for coaching, and helping orchestrate one of the biggest recent turnarounds in Division I basketball. When Aldrich joined the staff at University of Maryland-Baltimore County (UMBC) in 2016, the program had endured eight straight losing seasons and averaged 24 losses per season. During Aldrich's two seasons on the bench with head coach Ryan Odom, the Retrievers enjoyed the best two-year stretch in program history, which included back-to-back 20-win seasons and this year's America East Conference title.

And that was before the 2018 NCAA Tournament, and the stunning 20-point win over No. 1 national seed Virginia in the NCAA Tournament that made UMBC a household name across the country.

In March of 2018, Aldrich returned home to Virginia, and a community he loves and knows well from his days as a player and assistant coach on a string of dominant teams under Tony Shaver at nearby Hampden-Sydney College.

Troy Austin, Longwood athletics director from 2006-18, appointed Aldrich as Longwood's new men's basketball head coach, making him the ninth coach in program history.

"From the start of this process, Griff established himself as a unique candidate who will be an outstanding fit for our community, for our program and for Longwood's citizen-leadership mission," Austin said. "President Reveley and I knew entering this search that we needed a coach who placed an emphasis on building a culture of success through selective recruiting, player development and engagement with the community. Griff, with his strong ties to Farmville and the Commonwealth, meets all those criteria, and he has demonstrated his ability to run a program in a very unique, 'Chief of Staff' role at UMBC.

"Honestly, we have been excited about Griff as a candidate from our earliest conversations with him at the beginning of this process. It just took a little while to get him to campus after UMBC won the America East and then made NCAA Tournament history. It was a pretty good reason for a short delay, and we're glad we can now call him a Lancer."

As UMBC's Director of Recruiting and Program Development from 2016-18, Aldrich acted as chief of staff for Odom — his college teammate and son of legendary college coach

Dave Odom — and was involved in all aspects of UMBC's turnaround from NCAA cellar-dweller to America East Champion and NCAA Tournament giant-killer.

"I am extremely excited about joining the Longwood basketball program and broader Longwood community," said Aldrich, a 1996 graduate of Hampden-Sydney College and a 1999 graduate of the University of Virginia School of Law. "Returning to Farmville is personally significant as it is connected to a tremendous opportunity while allowing me to return to my home state and to a town where I spent my most formative years. sity of Virginia School of Law, Aldrich rejoined his former college coach Tony Shaver on the Hampden-Sydney bench for the 1999-2000 season. That year, Aldrich helped Shaver lead the Tigers to their best season in school history with a 24-0 record in the regular season, a No. 1 Division III national ranking, the Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) Championship and a trip to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

After that championship season at Hampden-Sydney, Aldrich shifted his professional sights to the private sector where he began a successful 16-year career in law and business. He became a partner at Vinson & Elkins, a leading international law firm, working in Houston and London. Later, he established and built a private oil and gas company in Texas, and held the position of Managing Director & Chief Financial Officer in a national energy-focused private investment firm.

But even as his professional resume grew, Aldrich’s heart remained in coaching, and he never stepped out of the elite coaching ranks. While at Vinson & Elkins, he served as head coach at several elite-level AAU basketball programs for high school players. He went on to found the HIS Hoops program in Houston’s Third Ward where his work with students focused on faith, academics and basketball. Several of his players there and at other AAU programs advanced to the college and professional ranks, including L.A. Clippers forward DeAndre Jordan, international professionals Jay Couisnard, P.J. Couisnard and Brandon Peters, and NFL linebacker Orie Lemon.

Aldrich and his wife, Julie, have three children — Scott, Ford, and Laura Lee.
