THE OPENING TIP

- Longwood hosts Big South unbeaten Winthrop in the midst of a three-game homestand in five days this Saturday. The Lancers opened the homestand by beating Charleston Southern Thursday and close it by hosting Campbell on Monday.
- The Lancers enter Saturday afternoon's matchup winners of three of their past four games with their lone loss during that span to Big South preseason No. 1 Radford.
- Senior forward **JaShaun Smith** became the 23rd player in program history to crack the 1,000 point threshold against Charleston Southern. He ranks eighth on Longwood's Division I scoring list with 1,006 career points and will be honored prior to tipoff for reaching the 1,000-point plateau.
- The Lancers have hit at least 10 three-pointers in five consecutive games, their longest streak under head coach **Griff Aldrich**. The Lancers are shooting .388 (59-of-152) from three-point range during that span.

LAST TIME OUT

- Longwood senior guard **Shabooty Phillips** poured in 23 points, 15 after halftime, to lead Longwood past Charleston Southern 71-63 on Thursday night in Willett Hall.
- Senior forward **JaShaun Smith** recorded his 1,000th point on the game's opening possession, and the Lancers never looked back. Longwood led for the final 35:31 of game time.
- Sophomore guard **DeShaun Wade** added 11 points on 4-of-6 shooting and swiped three steals, his second straight multi-steal performance, while point guard **Juan Munoz** continued his climb up Big South leaderboards with five assists and three steals. Junior **Jordan Cintron** snatched up a career-high seven offensive rebounds on the way to 10 rebounds in the game.
- Longwood controlled nearly every facet of the game and was boosted by a bevy of hustle plays that produced 10 steals, 12 offensive rebounds and 16 second-chance points.

LONGWOOD BASKETBALL COACH'S SHOW

The Longwood men's basketball coach's show, titled "Griff Aldrich Live at Effingham's" airs monthly at LongwoodLancers.com and re-airs 24 hours later on WVHL Kickin' Country 92.9 FM. The hour-long show takes place in front of a live audience at Effingham's, located in Hotel Weyanoke on High Street right across from Longwood's campus.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Longwood is tied for first in the Big South in made three-pointers with 219, trailing only Winthrop's 222. Both teams also lead the conference in attempted three-pointers.
- Point guard **Juan Munoz** has hit a three-pointer in 11 consecutive games and multiple treys in nine of those contests. He is shooting .439 (29-of-66) from long range during that stretch.
- Munoz also has a steal in 16 consecutive games. His 40 swipes are the most by a Lancer since Aldrich took over the program in 2018-19.
- Over the past five games, Longwood has assisted on 61.9 percent of its made field goals, compared to just 40.1 percent in its 10 games prior.
- Longwood's defense has amassed 91 steals in Big South play, tied with Winthrop for the most in league play.
- Big South opponents have turned the ball over 166 times against Longwood this season, the third most in the conference behind Winthrop (187) and UNC Asheville (174).
- Longwood has made at least 10 three-pointers in five consecutive games, including a season-high 14 in back-to-back games against Radford and Gardner-Webb. The Lancers are shooting .388 (59-of-152) from three-point range during that span while scoring 50.9 percent of their points from long range. Longwood has won three of those five contests.
- With the first bucket of the game against Charleston Southern, **JaShaun Smith** cracked the 1,000-point plateau. He became only the 23rd player in program history and the eighth in the Division I era to reach that milestone. He is also on pace to break Longwood's D-I three-point percentage record.
- Longwood is 5-2 when holding opponents under 40.0 percent shooting from the field and 9-3 when shooting 40.0 percent or better from the field.

- Longwood and Winthrop meet for the second time in 2020 and 16th time in series history.
- The Big South foes met just once during the 2018-19 season, with Longwood traveling to Rock Hill, S.C. and picking up a road win.
- In the last meeting, Winthrop poured in 16 three's to run away from the Lancers in a 91-67 win. The 16 three's allowed mark a season-high allowed by the Lancer defense.
- Senior forward **JaShaun Smith** has faced Winthrop six times in his career, the most of any Lancer in Longwood's lineup. He has scored in double figures in four of those six outings.

CHAPTER TWO

- After last year's breakthrough season under first-year head coach **Griff Aldrich**, Longwood has carried that momentum into the follow-up in 2019-20.
- Last year's Lancers won the second-most games in the program's Division I era, reached the D-I postseason for the first time and won a D-I post-season game for the first time.
- Last year's 11-7 non-conference record was Longwood's best since joining the Big South.
- For his efforts, Aldrich was named a finalist for the Joe B. Hall Award, which is given annually to the top first-year head coach in Division I basketball. He also finished third in the media and coaches voting for the Big South Coach of the Year award.
- This year the Lancers were voted No. 6 in the Big South Preseason Poll, a program high since joining the conference in 2012-13.
- Aldrich propelled Longwood to one of the biggest turnarounds by a first-year head coach in Division I basketball in 2018-19, ranking third among that group in both win improvement and winning percentage improvement.

RAISING THE BAR ACADEMICALLY

- The fall 2019 semester was the best ever by the Longwood men's basketball program. The Lancers amassed a Division I-era record 3.13 GPA and had four players named to the Dean's List.
- That performance marked the fifth consecutive semester the Lancers have raised their team GPA from the prior semester under second-year head coach **Griff Aldrich**.
- **Sean Flood**, **Bennett Mohn**, **Juan Munoz** and **Cameron O'Conner** were all named to the Dean's List with GPAs of at least 3.50.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Longwood has exercised its home court advantage under head coach **Griff Aldrich**, amassing a 15-10 record in Willett Hall since his arrival in 2018-19.
- The Lancers went 10-5 at home last season and are 5-5 on Jerome Kersey Court this year.
- Longwood strung together five straight wins in Willett Hall from March 20, 2019 to Nov. 15, 2019.
- Longwood's 5-5 record is currently the program's second-best home-court winning percentage since Longwood joined the Big South in 2012-13, trailing last season's 10-5 record.

SCORING BURSTS APLENTY FOR LONGWOOD EARLY IN 2019-20

- In its first 24 games this season, Longwood has put together 22 different scoring runs of at least nine consecutive points.
- The longest of those was a 15-0 surge in the season-opening 73-51 win against Marymount, during which the Lancers hit 7-of-8 field goals while holding the Saints to 0-of-8 shooting. That stretch took place over a span of 5:34 in the second half.
- Longwood's longest run in Big South play was a 13-0 tear in the first half of a 74-56 win against Charleston Southern on Jan. 8.

DEFENSE HOLDING STRONG

- Longwood has emerged as one of the Big South's top defensive teams, ranking fourth in conference play in scoring defense and among the top five in field goal defense.
- Longwood has held 11 opponents under 70 points and has allowed only two, Winthrop and Hampton, to reach the 80-point plateau in regulation.
- Longwood went the first 11 games of the season without allowing a 20-point scorer until The Citadel produced two in triple-overtime on Dec. 19. Only nine players have scored 20 points against Longwood this season.

- One of the nation's most athletic players, **JaShaun Smith** boasts a 49-inch max vertical leap and is among the top defensive players in the Big South.

The Joan Perry Brock Center: Longwood Basketball's New Home

Longwood basketball reached new heights in 2018-19. Now thanks to the largest gift in Longwood University's 180-year history, the Lancers will continue to climb for years to come.

With a \$15 million gift from philanthropist Joan Brock '64, Longwood announced Wednesday plans to build a new university convocation center that includes the new home of Longwood men's and women's basketball. The Joan Perry Brock Center will be located along Brock Commons near Willett Hall, the current home of the Lancers, with a projected opening by the spring of 2022.

Brock's \$15 million gift is the largest in history for Longwood University and ushers both Longwood basketball programs into the next phase of their Division I growth while also spearheading the construction of a venue with immeasurable potential for the university and Farmville community. The facility will be designed in Longwood's traditional architectural style and will serve as a host for speakers, concerts and shows in addition to Longwood basketball games.

Design schemes for the Joan Perry Brock Center show a planned basketball capacity of 2,500 to 3,000 seats, increasing the Lancers' current capacity of 1,807 in Willett Hall but purposefully maintaining the intimate feel and energy of Longwood's current home.

"The Joan Perry Brock Center will be a jewel in the crown of Brock Commons, and it means the world that Longwood students will be walking to these great university events, concerts and basketball games right in the very heart of campus," said President W. Taylor Reveley IV. "This building will have real character, inside and out."

At its planned opening in 2022, the Joan Perry Brock Center will elevate Longwood into the top tier of its peer basketball venues in the Big South, joining 2019 Big South regular season Campbell and 2018 champion UNC Asheville with the newest arenas in the conference. The Brock Center will be the Big South's first newly constructed arena since UNC Asheville's Kimmel Arena opened in 2011 and High Point's Quebein Arena, which is scheduled to open in 2021.

"We could not be more excited about the Joan Perry Brock Center and the new future home of Longwood basketball," men's basketball head coach Griff Aldrich said. "The 'JPB' is certainly a game-changer for our program as it will provide Longwood with a state-of-the-art venue in which to play basketball games. This new facility significantly elevates our program as it allows us to provide our student-athletes and fans with a premier arena in which to compete. We are so grateful to Mrs. Brock for her generosity, which will impact not only our basketball program and Longwood University, but also our broader community."

"So many people are drawn to Longwood because of both the sense of community and the steadfast commitment to grow this university," women's basketball head coach Rebecca Tillett said. "Joan Brock's generous gift will impact generations of students. In addition it will elevate every aspect of our women's basketball program, including immediately aiding our efforts to attract high-quality student-athletes. It will also positively



influence and empower every woman who chooses this program."

"Joan Brock once said, 'You just give back. It's the American way,'" Tillett continued. "Generously giving to Longwood is certainly the 'Brock Way,' and our program will be forever grateful."

The news follows a breakthrough 2018-19 season for the Longwood men's program under Aldrich, during which the Lancers won the second most games of the Division I era and earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational, the first postseason tournament in the school's D-I history. Meanwhile, the Longwood women also turned the page to a new chapter under Tillett, who this year turned junior Dayna Rouse into an All-Big South forward and has assembled a foundation-building recruiting class in her first full recruiting cycle.

"This is truly a transformative day for Longwood University, Longwood athletics and the future of our men's and women's basketball programs," said Interim Athletics Director Michelle Meadows. "The Joan Perry Brock Center takes us to a championship level in our ability to recruit and compete, while providing our students, fans and community a venue they can be proud of and a place to share and display their collective Longwood spirit for years to come. We wish to extend our deepest thanks to Mrs. Brock for her belief and investment in Longwood's future."

The Brock Center will take the mantle of Longwood's home court from Willett Hall, which has played host to nearly 1,000 Longwood basketball games since it first opened in 1980. The historic arena is in its fourth decade as Longwood's home, during which it has been the backdrop for eight NCAA Tournament teams, nearly 600 wins and the 2016 Vice Presidential Debate. Willett Hall's historic resume continued into the 2018-19 season as well when the men's team defeated Southern Miss 90-68 in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational, securing the program's first postseason win of the Division I era in the final home game of the year.

The name of the Jerome Kersey Court, dedicated in December of 2016 in honor of the late NBA

star and Longwood's most accomplished basketball alumnus, will transfer to the Brock Center.

"Willett Hall has been a fantastic home to our basketball programs for four decades now, and there is a palpable history within its walls," Meadows said. "It will continue to serve as our basketball home for the next several years while the Brock Center is constructed, and it will undoubtedly play host to many more historic moments."

"However, what has made Willett Hall such a special place over the years is the energy created by our teams and the environment sustained by our students, fans and the Longwood and Farmville communities. We have long been fortunate to have such a dedicated local fanbase, and the Joan Perry Brock Center will be just as much a boon to our fans and gameday atmosphere as it will be to our student-athletes, athletics programs and Longwood as a whole."

Along with Longwood's home court, the convocation center will also be designed as a future site to host major events in the Central Virginia region, including a possible future opportunity to host another national general election debate. Also part of the project will be the migration of the Longwood tennis courts to a new facility that will be constructed on the south end of campus.

Brock's \$15 million gift toward the convocation center is the latest act in a decades-long philanthropic relationship that dates back to before the opening of Willett Hall. She and her late husband Macon are the namesakes and benefactors of numerous hallmarks of Longwood University, including Brock Commons and The Brock Experience.

That unifying potential of the Joan Perry Brock Center, to which Longwood basketball will contribute significantly, was the impetus of Brock's gift and will be at the heart of the project as it enters the design phase.

Now within the next half decade, the Joan Brock Center will proudly overlook Brock Commons, bringing Longwood students and faculty, fans and members of the Farmville community and beyond together to share in a common bond of Longwood spirit.

On and off the basketball court, the career of new Longwood men's basketball coach Griff Aldrich has been marked by two constants: a passion for transforming lives, and success at every step.

Standout prep and college player. Partner in a top-tier international law firm, and CFO of an investment company. High-level AAU coach who helped develop players including NBA and NFL standouts, and community leader who founded an elite, faith-based basketball program for at-risk youth.

The most recent stop: leaving the business world to follow his passion for coaching, and helping orchestrate some of the most drastic turnarounds in all of Division I basketball at two different universities.

In the three-plus years since Aldrich took a leap of faith back into the college coaching profession, he has played key roles in rebuilding two programs, first at NCAA Tournament darling UMBC from 2016-18 and most recently at Longwood.

When Aldrich joined the staff at University of Maryland-Baltimore County (UMBC) in 2016, the program had endured eight straight losing seasons and averaged 24 losses per season. During Aldrich's two seasons on the bench with head coach Ryan Odom, the Retrievers enjoyed the best two-year stretch in program history, which included back-to-back 20-win seasons and this year's America East Conference title.

And that was before the 2018 NCAA Tournament, and the stunning 20-point win over No. 1 national seed Virginia in the NCAA Tournament that made UMBC a household name across the country.

In March of 2018, Aldrich returned home to Virginia, and a community he loves and knows well from his days as a player and assistant coach on a string of dominant teams under Tony Shaver at nearby Hampden-Sydney College.

Now the success that has followed Aldrich in career as both an attorney and basketball coach has come to Farmville. In his first year leading the Lancers, Aldrich engineered a 2018-19 season that was full of firsts for Longwood's upstart Division I program. On the foundations of physical, lockdown defense and an up-tempo, three-point focused offense, Longwood amassed the second-most wins of the Division I era, earned its first postseason tournament berth and win of the Division I era and broke the school's three-point record.

Highlighting Longwood's lengthy resume in Aldrich's first year was a signature win over Commonwealth rival Richmond, a 10-5 record in Willett Hall, a historic 90-68 win over C-USA powerhouse Southern Miss in the first round of the Roman College Basketball Invitational, and a school-record 333 three-pointers. The Lancers took down several perennial Big South powers, including a regular-season sweep over High Point as well

as victories over Winthrop and UNC Asheville.

Leading that charge was Aldrich recruit and mentee Sha-booby Phillips, who was named Big South Newcomer of the Year after leading Longwood in scoring, assists and three-pointers. Phillips, who played for Aldrich on the AAU circuit as a middle-schooler in Houston, was one of numerous impact newcomers added to the program in year one alongside fellow junior guards Jaylon Wilson and Sean Flood.

Aldrich's success at Longwood last season followed his two-year tenure as UMBC's Director of Recruiting and Program Development from 2016-18. In that role, he acted as chief of staff

for Odom – his college teammate and son of legendary college coach Dave Odom – and was involved in all aspects of UMBC's turnaround from NCAA cellar-dweller to America East Champion and NCAA Tournament giant-killer.

At UMBC, Aldrich oversaw the recruiting and program development efforts during those two seasons, helping bring in a wealth of talent that included AEC Defensive Player of the Year K.J. Maura and AEC All-Rookie Team selections Daniel Aiken and Arkel Lamar. He was involved in all aspects of the program from recruiting and scouting, to quality control and campus and community engagement.

UMBC's remarkable run of success in the 2018 postseason thrust the Retrievers into the national spotlight, earning it an estimated \$120 million in equivalent advertising, a spate of national news articles spotlighting the university itself, and a 20-fold increase in Twitter followers.

Aldrich's success in his return to the college basketball coaching ranks is the most recent chapter in a diverse career in which winning has consistently followed the 1996 magna cum laude Hampden-Sydney graduate and Phi Beta Kappa inductee.

As a player he helped lead the Tigers to a 79-31 record during his career, which included two NCAA Tournament appearances, and was team captain his senior year. After earning his Juris Doctorate from the University of Virginia School of Law, Aldrich rejoined his former college coach Tony Shaver on the Hampden-Sydney bench for the 1999-2000 season. That year, Aldrich helped Shaver lead the Tigers to their best season in

school history with a perfect 24-0 record in the regular season, a No. 1 Division III national ranking, the Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) Championship and a trip to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

After that championship season at Hampden-Sydney, Aldrich shifted his professional sights to the private sector where he began a successful 16-year career in law and business. He became a partner at Vinson & Elkins, a leading international law firm, working in Houston and London. Later, he established and built a private oil and gas company in Texas, and held the position of Managing Director & Chief Financial Officer in a national energy-focused private investment firm.

But even as his professional resume grew, Aldrich's heart remained in coaching, and he never stepped out of the elite coaching ranks. While at Vinson & Elkins, he served as head coach at several elite-level AAU basketball programs for high school players. He went on to found the HIS Hoops program in Houston's Third Ward, one of the most impoverished areas of the city, where his work with students focused on faith, academics and basketball. Several of his players there and at other AAU programs advanced to the college and professional ranks, including L.A. Clippers forward DeAndre Jordan, international professionals Jay Cousnard, P.J. Cousnard and Brandon Peters, and NFL linebacker Orie Lemon.

Aldrich and his wife, Julie, live in Farmville with their three children – Scott, Ford and Laura Lee.
