- The Lancers and now ranked No. 22 The University of Central Florida found themselves in not one but two pitching duels, with the Knights coming out on top in both games, 3-1, and 2-0.
- Longwood tabbed junior Sydney Backstrom for four starts, and one relief appearance in the Invitational and Backstrom did not disappoint. The preseason Big South Conference Pitcher of the Year delivered 28.0 innings of work in the circle for the Lancers, only allowing eight runs and 18 hits while striking out 16 hatters
- Junior Leah Powell delivered for Longwood offensively against Columbia as Powell finished with a team-best two hits and one RBI in the Lancer win.
- The bats came alive against Long Island as Sydney Jacobsen, Madison Blair, Kasey Carr recorded two hits, with Carr driving in two RBI's for the Lancers.
- Freshman Kelly Park made a name for herself against now ranked No. 22 The University of Central Florida. Park went 2-of-3 from the plate against the Knights in the finale of the UCF Invitational.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Longwood looks to get back to the NCAA Regionals in 2020, as the Lancers look to win their sixth Big South Championship in eight seasons.
- Longwood's 2020 slate will pit the five-time Big South Champion Lancers against a stacked non-conference gauntlet that includes four conference champions, six NCAA Regional qualifiers, and one opponent who participated in the Women's College World Series. On the schedule in 2020 consists of College World Series contender, the University of Florida, along with ACC power-houses, Florida State, Duke, University of North Carolina, and Virginia Tech. NCAA Regional qualifiers, North Dakota State. Florida A&M. and James Madison and South East Louisiana also appear on the docket for the Lancers.
- For the fifth straight season, Longwood was tabbed to win the Big South. Despite capturing five Big South Championships in its seven previous seasons.
- Youth is the center of Longwood's offensive success early in the season. Sophomore Sydney Jacobsen and Freshman Lauren Taylor have combined for 22 hits through nine games, with Jacobsen recording a team-best 14 hits.
- Sophomore Sydney Jacobsen leads Longwood with a .368 batting average, with a team-best 14 hits and six RBIs.
- The Big South Preseason Pitcher of the Year, Sydney Backstrom leads Longwood with 43 strikeouts in 54.2 innings in the circle for the Lancers. Backstrom captured her first victory of the 2020 season on opening day, pitching 8.0 innings for the complete game, striking out 13 batters in the process.
- Senior Kasey Carr is third in fielding double-plays in the Big South as the senior shortstop has turned six double-plays for the Lancers in 14 contests. First baseman Madison Blair has been on the receiving end of three of Carr's double-plays.
- Newcomer Lauren Taylor leads the Lancer offense with the longest on-base-streak of the season. Taylor reached base in eight straight contests for the Lancers. Sydney Jacobsen has the longest active streak for Longwood at six games.
- Longwood has swept 25 of the threegame series it has played among conference foes while accumulating a 122-39 (.758) regular-season record since joining the Big South.
- The Lancers have won 44 of their 52 series against Big South conference opponents since joining the league.

SCOUTING CREIGHTON

Three-time Big South Coach of the Year Kathy Riley has built Longwood softball into the dynasty of the Big South.

With a career record of 809-482-1 in her 26 years as a head coach, Riley is among the most decorated and respected coaches in all of college softball. She has spent 22 of those years at the helm of Longwood's program, amassing a 722-400-1 record with the Lancers without a single season below .500 on her resume.

Riley has thrust Longwood onto the national stage through the success of her softball program, taking the Lancers to five NCAA Regionals in 2013, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2019 with Blg South Championships in each of those years. Longwood has reached 30 wins 16 times, including all seven years as a member of the Big South, as well as three 40-win seasons. She has been named Big South Coach of the Year three times, earning that peer-selected honor in 2015, 2016 and 2019.

Longwood's players have also become equally decorated in Riley's tenure, with two Lancers earning All-America honors in Megan Baltzell and Brooke Short, three earning Big South Player or Pitcher of the Year in Baltzell, Short and Elizabeth McCarthy, and nearly two dozen receiving All-Big South recognition.

With every NCAA Tournament berth, Riley's teams have ventured closer to an NCAA Super Regional. In the program's historic first visit to an NCAA Regional in 2013, the Lancers suffered back-to-back losses for a quick exit from the Knoxville Regional. Longwood's next trip, which was a return to Knoxville in 2015, featured another historic first when the Lancers upset Commonwealth rival Virginia Tech for the school's first-ever Division I NCAA

Tournament win. One year later, the Lancers earned victories against ACC foe North Carolina and Princeton at the Harrisonburg Regional on the same day to advance to the NCAA Regional Championship series against nationally-ranked James Madison. The following year, Longwood battled back once again to reach the NCAA Regional Championship showdown once more in Knoxville before falling to host Tennessee.iversity in 1982.
