### THE OPENING TIP

- Coming off a 10-point win over Big South preseason No. 2 UNC Asheville, Longwood heads to the Palmetto State for a two-game Big South series against USC Upstate Monday and Tuesday.
- Including the USC Upstate series, Longwood's final eight Big South road games will all take place in South Carolina with upcoming road trips to Winthrop (Jan. 14-15), Presbyterian (Jan. 29-30) and Charleston Southern (Feb. 11-12).
- Longwood head coach **Griff Aldrich** and USC Upstate head coach Dave Dickerson were both hired at their respective institutions within eight days of each other in March of 2018.
- Longwood has gotten a combined 19 starts from freshmen this season, the most in the Big South. Three Lancer freshmen are averaging double-digit minutes, including **Justin Hill** and **Jesper Granlund**, who are both averaging more than 27.0.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Behind 14 points from **Heru Bligen** and a second straight 30-point effort from the bench, Longwood took down Big South unbeaten UNC Asheville 65-55 on New Year's Eve in Willett Hall.
- Bligen, in only his fourth game back since injury, came off the bench to lead a resurgent Lancer team by hitting 5-of-9 shots from the field and playing lockdown defense against UNC Asheville's high-powered attack.
- Fellow reserves **Justin Hill** and **Ilija Stefanovic** scored eight points apiece as the once-injury-plagued Lancers used their newfound depth to outlast the Bulldogs in their final game of 2020.
- With Bligen returning to form and **DeShaun Wade** moving into the starting lineup also in his fourth game back since injury, Longwood had eight players score at least five points. Freshman **Jesper Granlund** also scored a career-high 12.

## BY THE NUMBERS

- In a college basketball season impacted heavily by the COVID-19 pandemic, Longwood is tied with Presbyterian for playing the most games in the Big South. The Lancers have played 10 contests, with only three getting canceled or postponed.
- Since guards **Heru Bligen** and **DeShaun Wade** returned to the lineup four games ago, the Lancer bench is averaging 31.3 points per game. While those two were hampered by injuries in the six games prior, Longwood's bench contributed just 16.8 points per game.
- Bligen and Wade have both played more than 20 minutes apiece in each of the past three games. Together they are averaging 20.7 points per game during that span.
- Wade and Bligen have accounted for three of Longwood's nine double-digit scoring performances since their return to the lineup four games ago.
- Longwood's freshmen have accounted for 39 percent of the team's total minutes.
- Jesper Granlund** is one of only three freshmen in the Big South to have started every game this season, joining High Point's Ahmil Flowers and Presbyterian's Rayshon Harrison.
- Granlund is averaging 7.5 points per game over his past four contests compared to 4.3 in his six games prior.
- Through the first 10 games, six different Lancers have led the team in scoring, while five had led the team in rebounding.
- Longwood is averaging 33.2 points in the paint this season compared to 22.6 in 2019-20. **Leslie Nkereuwem** leads the team with 6.3 points in the paint per game in games he has played this season, while Hill ranks second with 5.6.
- Longwood is among the top three-point defending teams in the Big South, holding opponents to a .310 clip that ranks second in the league.

- Longwood and USC Upstate meet for the 10th time in series history and the fifth and sixth times as members of the Big South Monday and Tuesday in Spartanburg, S.C.
- The series is split 2-2 since USC Upstate joined the Big South in 2018-19.
- Both of Longwood's two wins in the series have come under head coach **Griff Aldrich**. Those two victories have come within the past three meetings.
- As members of the Big South, Longwood and USC Upstate have traded wins in the four prior matchups. Longwood won the most recent meeting by 10 points on Feb. 20, 2020 in Spartanburg. Both teams are 1-1 on their home courts in the Big South era.

## TWO YEARS WORTH OF MILESTONES UNDER ALDRICH

- In just three seasons at the helm of the Lancer program, head coach **Griff Aldrich** has led Longwood to a bevy of milestones and program firsts.
- Since taking over in March of 2018, Aldrich has guided the Lancers to their first Division I post-season bid, their most Big South wins in a single season, their highest Big South finish, and the program's single-season record for made three-pointers. That is on top of sustained academic success, record-high GPAs and a perfect graduation record.
- Those milestones began in year one when Aldrich's first edition of Longwood basketball earned a bid to the 2019 College Basketball Invitational and pulled off a stunning 90-66 upset of Southern Miss. That was the program's first-ever Division I postseason bid and postseason win.
- That CBI win punctuated a breakout debut for the Lancers under Aldrich in which they won the second-most games of the Division I era (16), had the third-best win improvement in all of D-I basketball (+9), sank a school-record 333 three-pointers, went 11-5 in non-conference play and 10-5 at home.
- The momentum continued in year two when the Lancers rattled off the best Big South run in their eight-year tenure in the league, winning eight of their final 11 conference games to finish 9-9 overall and fourth place in the final standings. That performance marked the program's most Big South wins, best Big South winning percentage and highest Big South finish since joining the league in 2012-13.
- Those two seasons allowed Aldrich to reach 30 career wins just two years into his first head coaching job and become only the third coach in Longwood's program history to hit that milestone by year two.
- Longwood's climb from ninth place in the Big South in 2018-19 to fourth place in 2019-20 was the conference's biggest single-season jump since High Point climbed from ninth place in 2011-12 to first place in 2012-13.
- In the classroom, Longwood has broken grade point average records for three consecutive semesters, including the 2020 spring when a record nine Lancers finished with a GPA above 3.0.

## YOUNG GUNS

- Following the graduation of a four-man senior class last season, Longwood has leaned heavily on youth this season.
- With only one senior on the roster, 10 of Longwood's 17 players had never played a game in a Lancer uniform entering this season. Seven of those are freshmen.
- Only two Lancers — **Juan Munoz** and redshirt sophomore forward **Abraham Deng** — have been in the Longwood program at least two full seasons.
- The Lancers have gotten more than 50 percent of their total minutes from newcomers this season. More than 38.9 percent of those have come from freshmen, including true freshmen **Justin Hill** (29.9 mpg.) and **Jesper Granlund** (27.5 mpg.) who have started all but one game together.
- Longwood has gotten a combined 19 starts from freshmen this season, the most of any team in the Big South.
- Despite the youth, Longwood head coach **Griff Aldrich** labeled this year's Lancer team "the most talented group I've had in my three years here."

## LANCERS WELCOME RETURN OF KEY GUARDS BLIGEN & WADE

- For the first six games of the season, Longwood played without the impact guard duo of junior **DeShaun Wade** and sophomore **Heru Bligen**.
- Both injured, Wade missed the first six games of 2020-21 before making his debut against The Citadel on Dec. 19. Meanwhile, Bligen was limited to just two games and 13 minutes until making a 20-minute return against Virginia Tech on Dec. 21.
- Since both returned to the lineup on Dec. 19 versus The Citadel, the Lancer bench is averaging nearly twice as many points per game with the scoring average of 16.8 in the first six games of the year jumping to 31.3 in the past four.
- Wade was a key starter last season, starting 14 of Longwood's final 15 games and finishing with 7.1 points, 3.7 rebounds and 1.4 assists per game.
- Bligen emerged as a key contributor in the back-court rotation as a true freshman, averaging 13.0 minutes per game while appearing in 28 contests.

## TOP OF THE HILL

- Longwood has the Big South's freshman assists leader and No. 2 freshman scorer in **Justin Hill**.
- The Big South Freshman of the Week on Dec. 14, Hill's 3.7 assists per game ranks seventh overall in the Big South, while his 10.9 points per game ranks 19th overall and second among league freshmen.
- A native of Houston, Texas, who was ranked as a top-25 recruit in Texas and a top-10 prospect in Houston as a senior, Hill also ranks eighth in the conference with a 1.5 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Head coach **Griff Aldrich** has deployed Hill heavily, starting him in nine of Longwood's first 10 games and playing him an average of 29.9 minutes per game.
- Hill already has a double-digit assist game on his resume and a near triple-double after racking up 11 assists, nine points and eight rebounds in a win over North Carolina A&T on Dec. 8.
- Basketball success runs in Hill's blood, with his mother, Donna Holt Hill, a former All-American and ACC Player of the Year at Virginia and his father, Keith Hill, an All-Big West first-team point guard at New Mexico State.

## MUNOZ FINDS HIS FOOTING AT THE POINT

- Last season **Juan Munoz** emerged as one of the Big South's top point guards, doing so after overcoming back-to-back season-ending injuries at the start of his career.
- Now a redshirt junior, Munoz is Longwood's leading scorer for the second straight season, following up his team-high 10.3 points per game in 2019-20 with a team-leading 12.5 this season.
- Munoz ranks among the Big South's top 15 in scoring, assists (3.1), made threes per game (2.0) assist-to-turnover ratio (1.0) and minutes per game (33.1)
- Munoz hit a three-pointer in 26 consecutive games before snapping that streak against UNC Asheville on Dec. 30.
- Munoz scored 29 points in this year's Big South opener at Radford, which is tied for the second most by a Big South player this season.
- Munoz missed his first two seasons due to back-to-back season-ending injuries. Both were knee injuries that happened just weeks before the start of his freshman and sophomore seasons. He has been granted two additional years of eligibility by the NCAA due to medical hardship.
- Now pursuing his MBA, Munoz earned his bachelor's in business administration from Longwood in May of 2020.

- Playing under the motto of "Let It Fly," three-point shooting has been key to Longwood's offense.
- Since Aldrich took over in 2018-19, Longwood has made and attempted the second-most three-pointers in the Big South, hitting 693-of-1,997. That trails only Winthrop's 756-of-2,091.
- In Aldrich's debut season in 2018-19, that approach yielded school records for made three-pointers (333) and three-point attempts (939).
- This year the Lancers rank second in the Big South with 53 made three-pointers and 174 attempts.

## POINTS IN THE PAINT

- Longwood has significantly increased its points in the paint this year, averaging 33.2 points per game in the paint compared to 22.6 in 2019-20.
- Longwood has scored at least 20 points in nine of 10 games this season, topping 30 points seven times. Last season the Lancers topped the 30-point mark just five times total.
- Among those performances is 58 paint points against The Citadel, which is the most the Lancers have scored in the **Griff Aldrich** era.

- New to Longwood's frontcourt rotation this year is **Zac Watson**, who comes to Longwood after playing his previous two seasons at UC Riverside.
- A member of head coach **Griff Aldrich's** 2020-21 signing class, Watson played in 58 games for the Highlanders and already has more than 1,100 minutes of Division I basketball experience.

- Watson came off the bench in Longwood's first wave of substitutions five times in the first six games before breaking into the starting lineup on Dec. 19 against The Citadel.
- Watson leads the team with 1.5 blocks per 40 minutes of play and ranks second with 8.7 rebounds.
- At UC Riverside, Watson was a starter as a true freshman and averaged 4.6 points and 3.5 rebounds per game in his two seasons there.

# ***The Joan Perry Brock Center: Longwood Basketball's New Home***

Longwood basketball reached new heights in 2018-19. Now thanks to the largest gift in Longwood University's 180-year history, the Lancers will continue to climb for years to come.

With a \$15 million gift from philanthropist Joan Brock '64, Longwood announced Wednesday plans to build a new university convocation center that includes the new home of Longwood men's and women's basketball. The Joan Perry Brock Center will be located along Brock Commons near Willett Hall, the current home of the Lancers, with a projected opening by the spring of 2022.

Brock's \$15 million gift is the largest in history for Longwood University and ushers both Longwood basketball programs into the next phase of their Division I growth while also spearheading the construction of a venue with immeasurable potential for the university and Farmville community. The facility will be designed in Longwood's traditional architectural style and will serve as a host for speakers, concerts and shows in addition to Longwood basketball games.

Design schemes for the Joan Perry Brock Center show a planned basketball capacity of 2,500 to 3,000 seats, increasing the Lancers' current capacity of 1,807 in Willett Hall but purposefully maintaining the intimate feel and energy of Longwood's current home.

"The Joan Perry Brock Center will be a jewel in the crown of Brock Commons, and it means the world that Longwood students will be walking to these great university events, concerts and basketball games right in the very heart of campus," said President W. Taylor Reveley IV. "This building will have real character, inside and out."

At its planned opening in 2022, the Joan Perry Brock Center will elevate Longwood into the top tier of its peer basketball venues in the Big South, joining 2019 Big South regular season Campbell and 2018 champion UNC Asheville with the newest arenas in the conference. The Brock Center will be the Big South's first newly constructed arena since UNC Asheville's Kimmel Arena opened in 2011 and High Point's Quebein Arena, which is scheduled to open in 2021.

"We could not be more excited about the Joan Perry Brock Center and the new future home of Longwood basketball," men's basketball head coach Griff Aldrich said. "The 'JPB' is certainly a game-changer for our program as it will provide Longwood with a state-of-the-art venue in which to play basketball games. This new facility significantly elevates our program as it allows us to provide our student-athletes and fans with a premier arena in which to compete. We are so grateful to Mrs. Brock for her generosity, which will impact not only our basketball program and Longwood University, but also our broader community."

"So many people are drawn to Longwood because of both the sense of community and the steadfast commitment to grow this university," women's basketball head coach Rebecca Tillett said. "Joan Brock's generous gift will impact generations of students. In addition it will elevate every aspect of our women's basketball program, including immediately aiding our efforts to attract high-quality student-athletes. It will also positively



influence and empower every woman who chooses this program."

"Joan Brock once said, 'You just give back. It's the American way,'" Tillett continued. "Generously giving to Longwood is certainly the 'Brock Way,' and our program will be forever grateful."

The news follows a breakthrough 2018-19 season for the Longwood men's program under Aldrich, during which the Lancers won the second most games of the Division I era and earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational, the first postseason tournament in the school's D-I history. Meanwhile, the Longwood women also turned the page to a new chapter under Tillett, who this year turned junior Dayna Rouse into an All-Big South forward and has assembled a foundation-building recruiting class in her first full recruiting cycle.

"This is truly a transformative day for Longwood University, Longwood athletics and the future of our men's and women's basketball programs," said Interim Athletics Director Michelle Meadows. "The Joan Perry Brock Center takes us to a championship level in our ability to recruit and compete, while providing our students, fans and community a venue they can be proud of and a place to share and display their collective Longwood spirit for years to come. We wish to extend our deepest thanks to Mrs. Brock for her belief and investment in Longwood's future."

The Brock Center will take the mantle of Longwood's home court from Willett Hall, which has played host to nearly 1,000 Longwood basketball games since it first opened in 1980. The historic arena is in its fourth decade as Longwood's home, during which it has been the backdrop for eight NCAA Tournament teams, nearly 600 wins and the 2016 Vice Presidential Debate. Willett Hall's historic resume continued into the 2018-19 season as well when the men's team defeated Southern Miss 90-68 in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational, securing the program's first postseason win of the Division I era in the final home game of the year.

The name of the Jerome Kersey Court, dedicated in December of 2016 in honor of the late NBA

star and Longwood's most accomplished basketball alumnus, will transfer to the Brock Center.

"Willett Hall has been a fantastic home to our basketball programs for four decades now, and there is a palpable history within its walls," Meadows said. "It will continue to serve as our basketball home for the next several years while the Brock Center is constructed, and it will undoubtedly play host to many more historic moments."

"However, what has made Willett Hall such a special place over the years is the energy created by our teams and the environment sustained by our students, fans and the Longwood and Farmville communities. We have long been fortunate to have such a dedicated local fanbase, and the Joan Perry Brock Center will be just as much a boon to our fans and gameday atmosphere as it will be to our student-athletes, athletics programs and Longwood as a whole."

Along with Longwood's home court, the convocation center will also be designed as a future site to host major events in the Central Virginia region, including a possible future opportunity to host another national general election debate. Also part of the project will be the migration of the Longwood tennis courts to a new facility that will be constructed on the south end of campus.

Brock's \$15 million gift toward the convocation center is the latest act in a decades-long philanthropic relationship that dates back to before the opening of Willett Hall. She and her late husband Macon are the namesakes and benefactors of numerous hallmarks of Longwood University, including Brock Commons and The Brock Experience.

That unifying potential of the Joan Perry Brock Center, to which Longwood basketball will contribute significantly, was the impetus of Brock's gift and will be at the heart of the project as it enters the design phase.

Now within the next half decade, the Joan Brock Center will proudly overlook Brock Commons, bringing Longwood students and faculty, fans and members of the Farmville community and beyond together to share in a common bond of Longwood spirit.

## **GRIFF ALDRICH**

**Head Coach**

**Third Season**

**Hampden-Sydney, '96 | Virginia '99**

**Career Record: 32-44 (Third Season)**

**Longwood Record: 32-44 (Third Season)**

In just two seasons at the helm, head coach Griff Aldrich has led Longwood men's basketball to one of the most drastic turnarounds in all of college basketball. Signature wins, record finishes in the Big South standings, and all-time high grade point averages evidence the upward trajectory of a Longwood program that has taken off since Aldrich took over in March of 2018.

Those efforts have earned Aldrich national attention, from his selection as a finalist for the 2019 Joe B. Hall Coach of the Year Award to his profile in best-selling author John Feinstein's 2020 book "The Back Roads to March." Now, coming off a breakthrough 2019-20 season that saw the Lancers achieve a program-record fourth-place finish in the Big South, Longwood enters year three under Aldrich poised to continue that climb.

Finishing last year's regular season as one of the Big South's hottest teams, the Lancers made history in 2019-20 by amassing the most conference victories (9), best conference winning percentage (.500) and highest league finish (4th) since joining the Big South Conference in 2012-13. That performance, which the team punctuated by winning eight of their final 11 regular-season games, earned Longwood a first-round bye in the Big South Championship tournament for the first time in program history and elevated the Lancers four spots higher than their previous best Big South finish.

That turnaround has been more than two years in the making since Aldrich took over the program in March of 2018. During that time, he assembled his first two impact recruiting classes, implemented a high-scoring, three-point focused offensive system, and established a culture built on "The Longwood Five," five principles that include Excellence, Grit, Humility, Gratitude and Service.

Upon that foundation, Longwood's program has strengthened on and off the court. With multiple impact additions to the team such as All-Big South guard Shaboody Phillips, versatile transfers DeShaun Wade and Christian Wilson, and high-ceiling freshmen Heru Bligen and Leslie Nkereuwem, Longwood has asserted itself as a Big South contender. For the first time since joining the Big South Conference, the team has won double-digit games in back-to-back seasons and own a 32-34 record under Aldrich that is the program's best two-season stretch in the Division I era.

In 2018-19, Aldrich's first version of the Lancers broke the school record for most three-pointers, reached the postseason for the first time in the Division I era, and put an exclamation point on that debut breakout by taking down Conference USA powerhouse Southern Miss 90-68 in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational. The Lancers also picked up an early-season signature win at Commonwealth rival Richmond, swept the Tubby Smith-led High Point Panthers, and won six Big South games, including a 14-point road takedown of perennial championship

contender Winthrop.

Phillips, whose relationship with Aldrich spans more than a decade back to Aldrich's time as an AAU coach at The Forge in Houston, Texas, was named Big South Newcomer of the Year that season, while Aldrich was named one of 10 finalists for the Joe B. Hall Coach of the Year award, which goes to the top first-year coach in all of Division I basketball.

That success proved more than a flash in the pan, as Aldrich carried the momentum into a 2019-20 season that saw the Lancers ignite in Big South play and achieve a program-record fourth-place finish. Led by a four-man senior class that includ-

ed Aldrich recruits Phillips, Sean Flood and Jaylon Wilson, and 1,000-point scorer JaShaun Smith, Longwood won eight of its final 11 regular-season games, including an 84-81 overtime win at reigning Big South champion Gardner-Webb, another season sweep over High Point, and a milestone victory over eventual Big South runner-up Hampton.

At 9-9 in Big South play, Aldrich set new program highs for Big South wins and winning percentage and did so by uniting a roster made up of players he both inherited and recruited on his own. Along with the contributions of his own signees such as Phillips, Wilson and transfers DeShaun Wade and Christian Wilson, Aldrich mentored point guard Juan Munoz into a breakout sophomore season in which he led the team in points per game and steals. He also oversaw the development of four-year forward JaShaun Smith, who started all 32 games and became the 23rd Lancer to reach the 1,000-point plateau.

That on-court success in 2020 was a milestone semester in the classroom, during which the program achieved a record 3.20 grade point average and had 11 players post a GPA of at least 3.00. All four seniors earned their degrees, as did Munoz, who earned his bachelor's in business administration and immediately transitioned into Longwood's MBA program.

The new heights Longwood basketball has enjoyed under Aldrich are the latest successes in the former attorney's unique career path, which has taken him from the highest rungs of the corporate ladder to the hardwood where his passions for the game of basketball and the mission of developing young people through sport lie.

From his days as a member of the Hampden-Sydney men's basketball program, to his first coaching job alongside Commonwealth coaching stalwart Tony Shaver, to his career as a partner in a top-tier international law firm, and finally to his role in helping UMBC pull off the greatest upset in NCAA Tournament history, Aldrich has found success at every step of his professional career.

As a collegiate player, he helped lead the Tigers to a 79-31

record during his career, which included two NCAA Tournament appearances, and was team captain his senior year. After earning his Juris Doctorate from the University of Virginia School of Law, he rejoined his former college coach Shaver on the Hampden-Sydney bench for the 1999-2000 season. That year, Aldrich helped Shaver lead the Tigers to their best season in school history with a perfect 24-0 record in the regular season, a No. 1 Division III national ranking, the Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) Championship and a trip to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

After that championship season at Hampden-Sydney, Aldrich shifted his professional sights to the private sector where he began a successful 16-year career in law and business. He became a partner at Vinson & Elkins, a leading international law firm, working in Houston and London. Later, he established and built a private oil and gas company in Texas, and held the position of Managing Director & Chief Financial Officer in a national energy-focused private investment firm.

But even as his professional resume grew, Aldrich's heart remained in coaching, and he never stepped out of the elite coaching ranks. While at Vinson & Elkins, he served as head coach at several elite-level AAU basketball programs for high school players. He went on to found the HIS Hoops program in Houston's Third Ward, one of the most impoverished areas of the city, where his work with students focused on faith, academics and basketball. Several of his players there and at other AAU programs advanced to the college and professional ranks, including L.A. Clippers forward DeAndre Jordan, international professionals Jay Cousnard, P.J. Cousnard and Brandon Peters, and NFL linebacker Orie Lemon.

In 2016 that passion for the game of basketball finally pulled Aldrich back to the court full time. At the urging of his college teammate and then-newly hired UMBC head coach Ryan Odom, Aldrich left behind his law career to become UMBC's Director of Recruiting and Program Development and helped Odom engineer one of the great turnarounds in college basketball. In that role, he acted as chief of staff for Odom – his college teammate and son of legendary college coach Dave Odom – and was involved in all aspects of UMBC's turnaround from NCAA cellar-dweller to America East Champion and NCAA Tournament giant-killer.

At UMBC, Aldrich oversaw the recruiting and program development efforts during those two seasons, helping bring in a wealth of talent that included AEC Defensive Player of the Year K.J. Maura and AEC All-Rookie Team selections Daniel Aiken and Arkel Lamar. He was involved in all aspects of the program from recruiting and scouting, to quality control and campus and community engagement.

UMBC posted back-to-back 20-win seasons during Aldrich's tenure and had that success culminate during a postseason run that put the Retrievers on the map. After winning the America East Conference title in 2018 to earn a bid to the NCAA Tournament, UMBC shocked the college basketball world when they pulled off the biggest upset in tournament history by taking down No. 1 overall seed Virginia in the first round.

Weeks later, Longwood University President W. Taylor Reveley IV and former Longwood athletics director Troy Austin introduced Aldrich as Longwood's next head coach. Now more than two years after that introductory press conference, Longwood men's basketball has experienced a bevy of firsts, from postseason wins, to academic highs and record attendance in Willett Hall.

Heading into year three, Longwood's roster will be made up almost entirely of players Aldrich and his staff recruited and led by a seasoned core of juniors that includes the veteran Munoz and fellow contributors Wade and Wilson.

Aldrich and his wife, Julie, live in Farmville with their three children – Scott, Ford and Laura Lee.

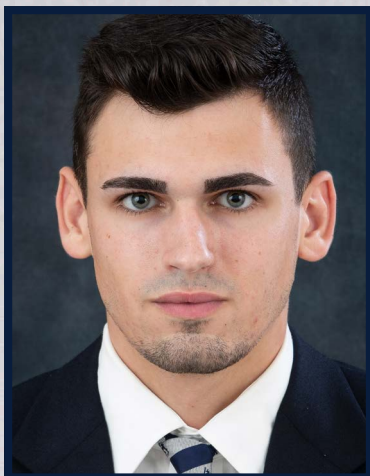
